Bait13 - Be Reconciled - Matthew 5:21-26

RECONCILIATION is more important than being RIGHT

think of an offense . . . get it in your mind . . . got it?

Ok, now . . What SIDE of the Offense were you ON?

Were you the one who "WAS offended"
Were you the one who "DID the offending"?

& <u>what if</u> I told <u>you</u> – <u>God's Word</u> makes it <u>clear</u> that it <u>Doesn't Matter</u> <u>WHICH SIDE</u> of the <u>Offense</u> <u>you</u> are <u>on</u>

God's Command is exactly the same . . . BE RECONCILED

Whether you are on the

"I WAS Offended" Side - or on the

"I DID the Offending" Side

<u>Either way</u> - <u>If</u> we <u>want</u> to be <u>FREE</u> of the <u>Bait of Satan</u>

<u>We've</u> got to <u>keep one GOAL</u> in <u>mind</u> at <u>all times</u>

BE RECONCILED

Let's Pray

Turn over to Matthew 5:21

In this section of the Sermon on the Mount

Jesus is TAKING a Command from the Law of Moses that is about our ACTIONS

& **showing** the **FULFILLMENT** of **that Command**By **Applying it** to our **HEART**

in <u>these Vs's</u> - <u>Jesus</u> is talking <u>specifically</u> about <u>HARBORING OFFENSE</u> – <u>IN</u> our <u>HEART</u>

& <u>Jesus wants</u> us to <u>KNOW</u> – there are <u>serious consequences</u> to <u>HARBORING OFFENSE</u> in our <u>HEART</u>

Matthew 5:21 (NLT)

21 "You have heard that our ancestors were told, 'You must not murder. If you commit murder, you are subject to judgment.'
(this is the focus on actions in the Law of Moses)

Matthew 5:22(a) (NLT)

22 But I say, if you are even <u>angry</u> with someone, you are subject to <u>judgment!</u> . . . (this is the focus on your Heart – in the fulfillment of the Law)

& <u>so</u> - <u>if you</u> are <u>Harboring Offense</u> in your <u>Heart</u>, & have <u>become Angry</u> – <u>you</u> are <u>subject</u> to <u>Judgement</u> & then – Notice (in v.22) the INCREASING JUDGMENT – as the ANGER in your HEART increases

Matthew 5:22(b) (NLT)

22 . . . (then) If you call someone an <u>idiot</u>, you are in danger of being brought before the <u>court</u>.

This is a ref to INSULTING the person you are angry at

so <u>when</u> you <u>move</u> from <u>ANGER</u> to <u>INSULTING</u> you are <u>subject</u> to an <u>Increased Judgement</u>

& then - Matthew 5:22(c) (NLT)

22 . . . And if you <u>curse</u> someone, you are in danger of the fires of hell.

Guys - when you are **HARBORING** an **OFFENSE**

& **you go** from **Anger**, to **Insulting**, to **Cursing** someone – **you** are in **danger** of **greater** & **greater judgment**

This is very similar to the <u>Unforgiving Servant</u> in <u>MAT 18</u>
Who was <u>Sent</u> to <u>Be Tortured</u> – <u>Because</u> of his <u>Unforgiveness</u>

In <u>both situations</u> - <u>Jesus</u> is clearly <u>saying</u> – <u>Harboring Offense</u> that **brings** increasing **ANGER** - **LEADS** to **Judgment** in your life

the ANSWER is – FORGIVE - & BE RECONCILED with those who have Wronged you, or Offended you

Vs's 21 & 22 are <u>for</u> the <u>person</u> who is <u>on</u> the "<u>I WAS Offended</u>" Side of <u>things</u>

But <u>look</u> how <u>Fast</u> <u>Jesus SWITCHES</u> to the "<u>I DID the Offending</u>" Side of <u>things</u>

Matthew 5:23-24 (cont the same thought) (NLT)

23 "So if you are presenting a sacrifice at the altar in the Temple and you suddenly remember that someone has something against you, (meaning they are Harboring Offense against YOU) 24 leave your sacrifice there at the altar. Go and be reconciled to that person. Then come and offer your sacrifice to God.

WAIT JUST A MINUTE!

This is an ENTIRELY Different Situation

Now – we're talking about a person who FEELS – that WE have Offended THEM

We're <u>talking</u> about a <u>person</u> – who <u>is on</u> that <u>Increasing</u> Scale of <u>ANGER</u> – <u>TOWARD US</u>

BUT - what if we **DIDN'T EVEN DO ANYTHING WRONG??**

Jesus is really clear – In Matthew 5:24(a) (NLT) 24 leave your sacrifice there at the altar . . .

This implies an URGENCY to try to FIX this

this **does NOT mean** - you are **NOT ELIGIBLE** to **worship God** If **someone** is **ANGRY** at you

Jesus is conveying the Importance & the Priority - of BEING RECONCILED

<u>Maybe</u> - <u>BEING RECONCILED</u> to the <u>person</u> who is <u>Offended</u> is a <u>TRUE Act of Worship</u> - & a <u>True Sacrifice</u>

So Again Matthew 5:24 says (NLT)

24 leave your sacrifice there at the altar. Go and be reconciled to that person. Then come and offer your sacrifice to God.

WHY would Jesus express SUCH URGENCY

In us <u>Being Reconciled</u> to a <u>Person</u>
who is <u>holding</u> an <u>offense against us</u>?

Is this <u>Urgency</u> for <u>OUR GOOD?</u>
Or is it <u>for</u> the <u>OTHER PERSON'S GOOD?</u>

It's for the OTHER PERSON'S GOOD!!

Because if <u>THAT PERSON</u> is moving from <u>Anger</u> to <u>Insulting</u> to <u>Cursing</u> us – then <u>THEY are IN DANGER</u>

& if we can do something to help them OUT of that DANGER

then <u>Jesus says</u> – <u>that</u> is a <u>HIGHER PRIORITY</u> <u>than</u> us <u>bringing</u> our <u>Sacrifice</u> (or offering) <u>to God</u>

Now - here is a really HARD TRUTH to ACCEPT

In this situation - RIGHT or WRONG doesn't Matter

What Matters is the URGENCY & PRIORITY of BEING RECONCILED

When we read BOTH SIDES – TOGETHER From V.21 to V.24

<u>Jesus</u> is being <u>clear</u> – <u>No Matter WHICH SIDE</u> of the <u>OFFENSE</u>

You <u>ARE ON – His Command</u> to you <u>is</u> the same

<u>BE RECONCILED – As Quickly As Possible</u> <u>& Make it a Priority</u>

& Can I just say one other important thing

When we find ourselves on the "I DID the Offending" Side of this

We <u>Often DON'T THINK</u> – we <u>Did NOT</u> Do anything <u>WRONG</u> <u>In fact</u> – we are <u>Often</u> – <u>PRETTY CERTAIN</u> of it

<u>BUT – Here is what John Bevere says about this:</u>
"Often we judge <u>ourselves</u> by <u>our INTENTIONS</u> and we judge <u>everyone else</u> by <u>their ACTIONS</u>"

This is SO TRUE - - [REPEAT]

Often – we have an INCORRECT VIEW of our ACTIONS Because we believe our INTENTIONS are Good

<u>I've been</u> on the <u>Receiving End</u> of a <u>person</u> who <u>prides themselves</u> in <u>being <u>brutally honest</u> - with their <u>own opinion</u></u>

no matter how much damage their opinion does - to another person

<u>because</u> (<u>shockingly</u>) <u>they believe</u> their <u>intentions</u> are <u>good</u> – <u>even</u> in their <u>destructive words</u>

& - as much pain as that has caused me

<u>I realize</u> – <u>there</u> are <u>times</u> when I <u>have also</u> had an <u>Incorrect View</u> of <u>MY OWN ACTIONS</u> toward <u>other people</u>

Because | BELIEVED My Intentions were Good

The **POINT IS** – **We can ALL Justify** our **Actions By Believing** our **Intentions are GOOD**

But Jesus is NOT talking about us - Justifying our ACTIONS

Jesus is Exhorting Us to BE RECONCILED

Whether we are *Right or Wrong*Whether we had *Good Intentions or Not*

Jesus says - GO to that Person - & BE RECONCILED!

Whichever SIDE of the OFFENSE we are on

Either - <u>I WAS Offended</u>" – or "<u>I DID the Offending</u>"

Either way - We are called to take the First Step – TO BE RECONCILED

Psalm 34:14 (NLT)

14 Turn away from evil and do good. <u>Search</u> for peace, and <u>work</u> to maintain it.

Romans 14:19 (NET)

19 So then, let us <u>pursue</u> <u>what makes for peace</u> and for building up one another.

We are <u>called</u> to <u>PURSUE</u> what <u>MAKES</u> for <u>PEACE</u> & <u>PURSUE</u> what <u>LEADS</u> to <u>Building Up</u> One Another

Which Means – we MUST Approach Reconciliation
With the RIGHT ATTITUDE

We've got GO - SEARCHING for PEACE, & WORKING (striving) to MAINTAIN PEACE

We've got to PURSUE PEACE,

& **PURSUE** the **BUILDING UP** of the other **person**

Which MEANS – We've got to Crucify our PRIDE & go in True HUMILITY

Going IN PRIDE –
Or DEFENDING & JUSTIFYING our Actions

Will just pour JET FUEL on the FIRE of OFFENSE

EVEN IF you are **Right**

& **EVEN IF** you **believe** you **haven't done** anything **wrong**

When we Go – We MUST GO – with True HUMILITY
& with ONE SINGLE GOAL – BE RECONCILED

& <u>Jesus Makes</u> this <u>PRIORITY CLEAR</u>

As he **continues** – **still** in these **same vs's** (in **Mat 5**)

Cont'g - Matthew 5:25-26 says (NLT)

25 "When you are on the way to court with your adversary, settle your differences quickly. Otherwise, your accuser may hand you over to the judge, who will hand you over to an officer, and you will be thrown into prison.

26 And if that happens, you surely won't be free again until you have paid the last penny.

Vs's.21-22 say - If you are ANGRY – over some offense - BE RECONCILED

Vs's 23-24 say - If someone has Been Offended BY YOU - BE RECONCILED

Vs's 25-26 say - If you Have An Adversary For ANY Reason - BE RECONCILED

The command from <u>Jesus</u> – in <u>ALL THREE</u> <u>situations</u> is <u>exactly</u> the <u>SAME</u> – <u>BE RECONCILED</u>

& <u>in TWO</u> of these <u>3 Situations</u> – <u>there</u> are <u>clear</u>
<u>NEGATIVE Consequences</u> – <u>TO NOT BEING RECONCILED</u>

Let's look at just one other Text today (cause it's important)

Turn over to Matthew 18:15

<u>Unfortunately</u> – <u>this</u> <u>section</u> of <u>Mat 18</u> has <u>most often</u> been <u>described</u> as "<u>Church Discipline</u>"

Implying that the Primary GOAL here is the church "Discipling" a believer

But **that** is clearly **NOT** the **PRIMARY GOAL** of this **Section**

The **NET BIBLE** (which I highly recommend) **Gets it RIGHT**

The <u>Section heading</u> over <u>Mat 18:15</u> - in the <u>NET BIBLE</u> - says *Restoring Christian Relationships*

THAT is the PRIMARY GOAL of this section

So - Let's Read - Matthew 18:15 (NLT)

15 "If another believer sins against you, go privately and point out the offense. If the other person listens and confesses it, you have won that person back.

The <u>PRIMARY GOAL</u> here – is to <u>WIN</u> that <u>Person Back</u> <u>MEANING</u> – <u>BE RECONCILED</u> to that <u>person</u>

GO to that person – in <u>Humility</u>, & <u>Gentleness</u>, <u>Pursuing Peace</u> and <u>Unity</u>

GO to them & <u>let</u> them <u>know</u> – <u>in love</u> that <u>they</u> have <u>HURT YOU</u>

The **GOAL being** – that **person** would "**HEAR YOU**" & **APOLOGIZE**

& **you** would **BE RECONCILED** to that **Person**

& The <u>2nd Step</u> – <u>STILL</u> has <u>RECONCILIATION</u> <u>as</u> the <u>PRIMARY GOAL</u>

Matthew 18:16 (NLT)

16 But if you are unsuccessful (at reconciliation), take one or two others with you and go back again, so that everything you say may be confirmed by two or three witnesses.

These Witnesses are NOT the BRUTE SQUAD to threaten this person with "Church Discipline" (ridiculous)

The goal here is STILL RECONCILIATION & these 1 or 2 others – are for accountability

<u>AND</u> they can <u>function</u> as <u>counselors</u> – to Try to <u>RECONCILE</u> the <u>person</u> who has <u>Caused the Offense</u>

Then - the 3rd Step - Matthew 18:17 (NLT)

17 If the person still refuses to listen, take your case to the church. Then if he or she won't accept the church's decision, treat that person as a pagan or a corrupt tax collector. (meaning don't associate with them)

EVEN HERE – the **GOAL** is **STILL RECONCILIATION**

Even if this person won't accept the church's counsel & are removed from the church

the **GOAL** is **STILL RECONCILIATION**

We see this play out completely in 1 COR 5 & 2 COR 2 (together) - & in 2 THES 3

The POINT TODAY is this

Thru ALL of the <u>Teaching</u> in the <u>N.T</u> that <u>deals</u> with <u>OFFENSE in the church</u>

IN it all - & THRU it all the Absolute Primary GOAL is - BE RECONCILED

& Without a Doubt the #1 Obstacle to RECONCILIATION

In MY LIFE & In EVERY Situation of OFFENSE I've seen

The #1 Obstacle to RECONCILIATION – IS PRIDE

PRIDE KILLS - & We've All - Got the Disease

& **if we** are **going** to **Receive** this **command** to **BE RECONCILED**

Then **First** - we are **going** to **have to** - **CRUSH our PRIDE**

Remember – Defending your-SELF or Justifying your ACTIONS

Will **NEVER** Bring **RECONCILIATION** where there has been OFFENSE

It is only thru an **ATTITUDE** of True **HUMILITY**, **GENTLENESS**, & **PATIENCE**

With a Commitment to MAKE ALLOWANCE for each other's faults – because of our LOVE

& <u>only</u> by <u>Making Every Effort</u> - to <u>remain UNITED</u> in the <u>Spirit</u> <u>Binding</u> ourselves <u>together</u> with <u>PEACE</u> . . .

That we can BE RECONCILED

Ephesians 4:1-3 (NLT)

1 Therefore I, a prisoner for serving the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of your calling, for you have been called by God.
2 Always be <u>humble</u> and <u>gentle</u>. Be <u>patient</u> with each other, <u>making allowance</u> for each other's <u>faults</u> because of your <u>love</u>.
3 <u>Make every effort</u> to keep yourselves <u>united</u> in the <u>Spirit</u>, <u>binding</u> yourselves together with <u>peace</u>.

that is what our LORD JESUS
Calls Each & Every Believer To

Do NOT be IMPRISONED in OFFENSE

DO NOT TAKE - The BAIT of SATAN
