#### Neh 13 – Responding to God's Word – Neh 8:1-12

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I've <u>said</u> many times in this study that <u>WE</u> are actually the <u>Wall of Testimony</u> for God

& today we're going to see that unfold in the Neh

You see – God <u>didn't send</u> Nehemiah to Jerusalem <u>ultimately</u> to build a wall of <u>blocks & mortar</u> –

A <u>wall</u> – or a building – or <u>anything</u> built physically on this earth would <u>NEVER</u> be God's ultimate intention

in fact – He allowed <u>His own Temple</u> to be destroyed <u>TWICE</u> & then made it clear that <u>WE</u> (His believers) are actually His Temple

We are **God's Living Stones**, being built up as a **spiritual house**, to offer spiritual sacrifices to Him

& so - the <u>2<sup>nd</sup> half</u> of Nehemiah shows us the <u>ULTIMATE PURPOSE</u> of Rebuilding the Wall

God's <u>ultimate purpose</u> was, actually – to <u>raise up God's people</u>

Into a **Worshipping Community** that would be an **Undeniable Testimony** to the world around them

The Wall of Block & Mortar was NOT the End Goal for God

God's **end goal** was to **Transform His People** into a **Great Worshipping Community** 

that would be an **Undeniable**, Unstoppable, **Testimony** to Him

### **Let's Pray**

The physical Wall of Testimony had been built

& now it was time to Build the Much More Important,
Spiritual Wall of Testimony – meaning – the People

<u>Last week</u> we saw Nehemiah <u>Organize</u> the People, & put all the <u>leaders</u> in place - - & put all the <u>servants</u> in place

& this week – we see God begin the great transformation

of these <u>50,000 ragtag Jews</u> – into a <u>unified</u>, <u>purposeful</u>, <u>wonderfully worshipping</u>, <u>community</u>

Ahhh – this is a **GOOD**, **GOOD** Ch – **I LOVE this CH** 

We are going to see - a **phenomenal worship service** today

that **sparks a Revival** - & begins the Building of the **REAL** Wall of Testimony - among God's people

<u>Previously</u> - at the end of <u>Ch 7</u><u>Nehemiah</u> had sent everyone back to their own towns after the <u>miraculous finish</u> of the wall

& maybe as he dispatched them – he told each family group Hey – you need to be back here in ONE WEEK

Because we've got something else that's HUGE that we need to do together

It's <u>funny to me</u> – that <u>the event</u> we read about today occurred <u>just one week</u> after the Wall was finished

& I love this for **Ministry training** – because Nehemiah says;

Hey, <u>great job</u> on the miraculous finish of the Wall <u>see you in a Week</u> for the <u>NEXT HUGE</u> undertaking

**Isn't that** what the **ministry feels like** most of the time?

Now <u>remember</u> – these <u>50,000 people</u> who returned to Jerusalem had <u>Mostly</u> been <u>born & raised</u> in <u>Babylon</u>

They <u>certainly</u> knew <u>OF</u> God's Word, & probably knew <u>SOME</u> of God's Word

but they had **probably NEVER** heard it **Publically** taught or **Responded** to – so this is a Huge Moment

#### Nehemiah 7:73(B)-8:1 - NLT

73... In October, when the Israelites had settled in their towns, 1 <u>all</u> the people assembled <u>with a unified purpose</u>...

There's an **entire Msg** right there – **ALL the people assembled with a unified purpose . . .** 

... at the square just inside the Water Gate. They asked Ezra the scribe to bring out the Book of the Law of Moses, which the LORD had given for Israel to obey.

The way this is written – it appears THE PEOPLE asked Ezra to bring out God's Law

**THIS** is what they had **gathered** for - - they had **come back** after only being home a **few days** 

& they <u>came back</u> <u>anxious</u> & <u>excited</u> to hear the <u>Word of God</u> Read & Taught

This is like the <u>Joy of teaching</u> in the bush in <u>Africa</u>, where the <u>Bible</u> has <u>never</u> been <u>clearly & accurately taught</u>

The response to the Word of God - is **OVERWHELMING** 

So the people gathered <u>together</u> – Probably <u>ORGANIZED</u> by <u>Nehemiah</u> (with his <u>kingly</u> gifts)

& they *WANTED* to hear God's Word
They were *ASKING* to hear God's Word

Man – this is a **Preachers DREAM** 

**Ezra** was a scribe (& priest) he had **translated** the Torah (Pentateuch) from *Hebrew to Aramaic* 

& we know he was an expert on matters of God's Law

& the **PEOPLE** asked him to bring out

The Book of The Law of Moses - - & READ IT

Thru 70 yrs of captivity -

& incredible difficulty getting Jerusalem Rebuilt

God's people maintained a deep reverence,

& strong desire - to Hear God's Word

I LOVE THIS CHAPTER

# Neh 8:2 - NLT

2 So on October 8 <u>Ezra</u> the priest brought the Book of the Law before the assembly, which included the men and women and <u>all</u> the children old enough to understand.

Notice – **EZRA** – *Not* Nehemiah

Remember from last week - Nehemiah had kingly gifts,

- & so he steps aside & allows **Ezra** to use his **prophet** gift to bring the Word of God to the people
- & in a minute we'll see the <u>Levites</u>, who have the <u>priestly</u> gifts, & we'll see them get in there & care for the people one on one
- & so we see; the **prophet** gifts, the **priest** gifts, & the **king** gifts & it **takes ALL 3** for the ministry of God to move forward
- Now in these next vs's we're going to see one of the Clearest Biblical examples of **EXPOSITIONAL PREACHING** there is
- & BTW **Expositional Preaching** is what we are committed to here, and what I try to do for you each week –

#### **Expositional Preaching means simply:**

To "set forth" the accurate meaning & purpose of a scriptural text - & to convey it in a way that makes it easily understood

#### **Chuck Swindoll - - the 3 tests of Expositional Preaching are;**

- 1) Is it Biblically **ACCURATE**
- 2) Is it **CLEARLY** explained
- 3) Can you **APPLY** it to your life

- That is exactly what we're about to see here in Neh AND THAT is what I strive for EVERY single week
- & we're <u>about to see</u> that it is <u>EXPOSITIONAL PREACHING</u> that <u>Lit the Revival</u> in the Book of Nehemiah
- & it is **EXPOSITIONAL PREACHING** that has been at the heart of **Every Great Revival** since the Reformation
- So Wherever you're at Find a church or find a way to hear Genuine EXPOSITIONAL Teaching of God's Word
- & if you're <u>not hearing it here</u> then find <u>somewhere else</u> to hear it Please <u>don't settle</u> for anything less

Because **the Regular**, in-depth, **study** of God's Word will **RADICALLY** Transform your life

#### Neh 8:3 - NLT

3 He (Ezra) faced the square just inside the Water Gate from early morning until noon (SIX hours) and read aloud to everyone who could understand. All the people listened closely to the Book of the Law.

This is the **<u>summary statement</u>** of all that follows here – this is the Big Picture

#### [REPEAT / REVIEW V.3]

Now <u>THAT</u> my friends – is a <u>CHURCH</u> service & don't worry – the <u>WORSHIP</u> is coming

Vs's 4 - 5 - 6 - fill in all the details of what was happening

#### Neh 8:4 - NLT

4 Ezra the scribe stood on a high wooden platform that had been made for the occasion. To his right stood Mattithiah, Shema, Anaiah, Uriah, Hilkiah, and Maaseiah. To his left stood Pedaiah, Mishael, Malkijah, Hashum, Hashbaddanah, Zechariah, and Meshullam.

So <u>Ezra</u> stood Literally – on a High Wooden <u>Platform</u> – Lit the word is "Tower"

Which – **BTW** – is the **1**<sup>st</sup> use of pulpit in the Bible

& <u>notice</u> (end of 1<sup>st</sup> sentence) – *it had been made for the occasion* I'm sure – due to <u>Nehemiah's</u> <u>kingly</u> planning

& <u>around him</u> stood <u>13 men</u>
Presumably other <u>Priests</u> & <u>Scribes</u>

This was a **full-on**, **Well-Planned**, **Massive** Church Service

Then – in <u>V.5</u> - something <u>very powerful</u> happens

## Neh 8:5 - NLT

5 Ezra stood on the platform in full view of all the people. When they saw him open the book, they all rose to their feet.

God's Word is raised above the people (on the pulpit)
& when it is opened they all RISE to their feet - out of Reverence

Which is **very cool** - & still **Literally Done** at many churches

& I want you do know – <u>at this church</u> – we stand in <u>absolute awe</u> & <u>reverence</u> to God's Word

because it is <u>God-Breathed</u> & <u>the Infallible rule</u> of Faith & Practice, <u>EVERY SINGLE WORD OF IT</u>

## 1Tim 3:<u>16-17 - ESV</u>

16 All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness,

17 that the man of God may be competent, equipped for every good work.

We don't **press** our **opinions** or our **feelings** on God's Word God's Word **presses** His **truth** into our **Lives** 

& we don't <u>reinterpret</u> or <u>skip over</u> anything we <u>don't like</u>, or <u>don't want to hear</u>

We **STRIVE** - with everything we've got to;

Teach it ACCURATE - Explain it CLEARLY - & APPLY it to your Life

& I Sincerely **PRAY** – **THAT** is what you **WANT** us to do, *Amen?* 

ALRIGHT - In V.6 this Church Service really takes off

As Ezra stops – to <u>PRAISE the Lord</u> – either <u>after</u> (or <u>during</u>) the <u>Reading</u> (or Preaching) of the Word

## Neh 8:6 - NLT

6 Then Ezra praised the LORD, the great God, and all the people chanted, "Amen! Amen!" as they <u>lifted their hands</u>. Then they <u>bowed down</u> and worshiped the LORD with their <u>faces to the ground</u>.

MAN – **THIS** is a **HUGE VERSE** 

# I want to show you THREE Responses to God's Word

that are <u>ALL ATTACHED</u> to one another - & that are <u>ALL REQUIRED</u> in each of our lives

You <u>may not</u> participate fully in the "<u>Physical Display</u>" of these three responses

But we <u>MUST</u> fully <u>EMBRACE</u> what each of these three responses <u>MEAN</u> – - what they <u>ILLUSTRATE</u>

# 1<sup>st</sup> Response is – the AMEN

6 Then Ezra praised the LORD, the great God, and all the people chanted (LIT Responded) "Amen! Amen!"

Chuck Swindoll says; "Saying AMEN to a Preacher, is like saying "Sic 'Em" to a Bull Dog"

It means YES Lord, I agree, may it be so, & may it be so in MY life

This is the **BEGINNING** of the people **RESPONDING** to God's Word

They called out <u>AMEN</u> – Meaning - May it BE SO – In our lives !!

This is the **FIRST** Appropriate **RESPONSE** to God's Word

# & then - The 2<sup>nd</sup> Response is - An Act of Surrender

... and all the people chanted, "Amen! Amen!" as they <u>lifted their</u> <u>hands</u>.

Let's just talk about **lifting hands** for a minute

#### Let's read some Psalms

**Ps 28:2** - "I cry out to you for help, as I <u>lift my hands</u> toward your holy sanctuary."

**Psa 63:4** - "I will praise you as long as I live, <u>lifting up my hands</u> to you in prayer."

Psa 77:2 - "All night long I prayed, with hands lifted toward heaven,"

Psa 88:9 - "O LORD; I lift my hands to you for mercy."

**Psa 119:48** - "I will <u>lift up my hands</u> toward your commandments, which I love,"

**Psa 134:2** - "Lift up your hands to the holy place and bless the LORD!

**Psa 141:2** - "Accept my prayer . . . and <u>my upraised hands</u> as an evening offering."

**Psa 143:6** - "I <u>lift my hands</u> to you in prayer. I thirst for you as parched land thirsts for rain."

Obviously – the <u>Lifting of Hands</u> is a <u>Biblical</u> form of Worship But – <u>WHY</u> do we Raise our Hands ??

Because **THIS** (Raised Hands) – is a **SIGN** of **SURRENDER** 

I give up - - - I give up God

I give up all my **Pride**, all my **Self-Centeredness**, all My **Ways**,

I give up, I **Surrender** all to you

You are God, & I am Not - I surrender

## **Lifting** your hands is a **sign of surrender**

- & even if you <u>NEVER</u> Lift your hands "Physically" We <u>MUST SURRENDER</u> to <u>God's Ways</u> & <u>God's Word</u>
- & the <u>more uncomfortable</u> you <u>feel</u> about showing a sign of surrender to God - <u>the more</u> you might need to try it
- So the **FIRST Response** to God's Word was AMEN **May it BE SO – In my life**
- & then the **SECOND Response** is; Lord – **I SURRENDER ALL** – I give up all my own ways
- & then the **THIRD Response** is in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of V.6
- ... Then they bowed down and worshiped the LORD with their faces to the ground.

This is describing the **Kneeling position** with your face to the floor

this is a <u>very appropriate</u> - & a <u>very healthy</u> response to understanding <u>WHO'S GOD</u> - - - & who's <u>NOT</u>

So often we Stand at God and (at least in our hearts) & we shake a fist at him – or at least Wag a finger

& we **puff out our chest**& we try to **convince God** to do things **OUR** way

## <u>THIS RESPONSE</u> – is the <u>OPPOSITE</u> – of <u>THAT</u> <u>Please – try it sometime</u>

<u>I do this</u> most often when <u>I'm alone</u> because it is a <u>very vulnerable</u> thing to do

You <u>ARE</u> welcome to <u>bow down</u> with your face to the ground right here – during <u>worship</u> – <u>anytime</u>

But I would <u>especially encourage you</u> – to bow down, <u>privately</u> with you <u>face to the ground</u> as you cry out to God for some matter

Really, please TRY IT – *Humble yourself in the sight of the Lord* & *He will Lift you up* 

This Response to God's Word says
You are the God of Heaven & Earth, & I am NOT

So – <u>I will Bow to your will Lord</u>- <u>I will Serve YOU</u> do you see it?

FIRST Response - - - May it BE SO - In my life

SECOND Response - - - I SURRENDER All

THIRD Response - - - I will Bow to your will

& NOTICE - ALL of this is done in an Environment of Worship

It <u>began</u> with Ezra <u>PRAISING</u> the Lord <u>After</u> (or during) the <u>Proclaiming</u> of God's Word

**God's Word** should bring a **Response of Worship** 

Now - I know that the "Physical Display" of these Worship Truths is difficult for some

<u>Some of us</u> were raised in an environment that says "we believe the Bible – we just don't want it so SHOW"

Or <u>worse yet</u> – an environment that said - "just because you love God, that doesn't mean it has to SHOW"

here's a good test for you
apply that to your spouse for the next year or so

make sure you <a href="NEVER">NEVER</a> show <a href="ANY">ANY</a> outward response to them
Just <a href="stare-blankly-ahead">stare blankly ahead</a> anytime you're in their presence
<a href="MoVER">& NEVER</a> show any <a href="response">response</a> of your love for them
<a href="moVER">& see how that works</a> out for you in your marriage

Now <u>I KNOW</u> there are different "<u>personalities</u>" when it comes to <u>RESPONDING</u> to God

I know the <u>demonstrative</u>, <u>outgoing</u> people Respond <u>demonstratively</u> & <u>outgoing</u>,

& the more <u>reserved people</u> respond more <u>reservedly</u> I know that - & that's **OK** 

But the <u>Word of God</u> – Alive in a person's life by the Holy Spirit <u>will</u> accomplish <u>SOME PURPOSE</u> - - - Some Response

#### <u>Isa 55:11 – ESV</u>

11 so shall my word be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it.

# God's Word is designed to "Accomplish a Purpose" in our lives

& that purpose – for us personally (individually)

Always involves some LEVEL – some TYPE – of Response

Now – Here's the **NEXT** really **cool thing** here

Not only was there Public **PREACHING** - & Responsive **WORSHIP** – but there was **ALSO** - **In-Depth Discipleship** 

& this is **AMAZING** – because this is **exactly** what **we're trying so hard** to do here

## After Ezra had Read the Law

& after (or maybe during) the People's Response in Worship

The **Levites** moved out among the people

& they taught them the deeper meaning of what they had just heard

This is the **follow-up** to the **Proclamation** of the Word,

& the **Response** of Worship

#### Neh 8:7-8 - NLT

7 The Levites—Jeshua, Bani, Sherebiah, Jamin, Akkub, Shabbethai, Hodiah, Maaseiah, Kelita, Azariah, Jozabad, Hanan, and Pelaiah—then <u>instructed the people</u> in the Law while everyone remained in their places.

8 They read from the Book of the Law of God and <u>clearly</u> <u>explained the meaning</u> of what was being read, helping the people understand each passage.

This is the **beginning** of Nehemiah & Ezra's **Discipleship Group Ministry** 

- & it's exactly what we're doing around here
- The <u>Levites</u> (those who were qualified) put the people in <u>small groups</u>
- & they clearly explained the meaning of what was being read helping the people understand each passage

The Levites **explained** the meaning – & **helped** the people understand what Ezra was Preaching from the Pulpit

THAT is Such a POWERFUL & LIFE CHANGING thing to do & THAT is why we STILL do it - TODAY

This is **exactly** what our **Discipleship hour** is for & what our **midweek Discipleship groups** are for

- & you can <u>come over</u> to one of the <u>Discipleship tables</u> or <u>go into</u> one of the <u>classrooms</u> or <u>attend</u> one of the <u>midweek groups</u>
- & have a *qualified person* **Explain** & **Help you Understand** what **God's Word** really says for your life **IS THAT COOL OR WHAT**
- & for our <u>Word-By-Mail</u> Family
  Please try to find a <u>Small Discipleship Group</u> if Possible

Because in small groups we can dig in deep & understand what God is saying to us personally

& it's in <u>Small Discipleship Groups</u> where we really learn to <u>APPLY</u> God's Word

& So - After the <u>Proclamation</u> of God's Word
After the <u>Response</u> of Worship
After the <u>Instruction & Meaning</u> were given

After all that - - - The people broke down and CRIED

They were **CRYING** – they're **WEEPING** – they're **MOURNING** just glance ahead at the **end of V.9** 

"For the people had all been weeping as they listened to the words of the Law"

Why were the people crying & weeping in response to the Law being read & explained to them?

Allow me to give you the NT explanation of this OT truth

You can't have the <u>JOY</u> of a Savior, until you have the <u>CONVICTION</u> of Judgment

You can't have the <u>JOY</u> of being <u>Given New Life</u>
Until you're <u>fully aware</u> you're currently <u>DEAD</u> in your Sin

The <u>hardest person</u> to get to see their <u>need</u> for Jesus is <u>the person</u> that thinks they're <u>alright with God</u>

But <u>if we'll allow</u> the <u>Holy Law of God</u> to thoroughly <u>convict</u> a person of their sin – *like it was designed to do* 

Then **they will** not only **fully recognize** their **need** for a Savior but will be **ANXIOUS** to make Him their **LORD** 

# Gal 3:24 says that the OT LAW was our GUIDE to Lead us to Christ

because <u>without</u> God's Law we <u>don't know</u> of our great <u>NEED</u> for a Savior

& so the **LAW** had done its **JOB** 

But now – Nehemiah & Ezra needed to turn that MOURNING into DANCING

#### Neh 8:9 - NLT

9 Then Nehemiah the governor, Ezra the priest and scribe, and the Levites who were interpreting for the people said to them, "Don't mourn or weep on such a day as this! For today is a sacred day before the LORD your God." For the people had all been weeping as they listened to the words of the Law.

It seems this day was actually a FEAST DAY - - apparently - the Feast of Trumpets

& so <u>Nehemiah</u> & <u>Ezra</u> encouraged the people - <u>NOT to weep</u> because it was actually a **celebration** "feast day"

However - At the very **ROOT** of **Spiritual Revival** - is **BOTH** 

A <u>clear Realization</u> - of God's <u>Holiness</u>, <u>Justice</u> & <u>Right Judgment</u> upon our sin

AND a clear Receiving - of His Unending Grace & Mercy to save us from the judgment we rightly deserve

**GREIF** because of our <u>Sin</u> - & <u>JOY</u> because of <u>God's Salvation</u> are <u>NEVER too far</u> apart

So - <u>thru the Law</u> – the people had a <u>Good Grasp</u> on the <u>Judgment</u> that was <u>rightly due</u> for their sins

But Nehemiah & Ezra (because it was a FEAST DAY) wanted the people to Move FROM;

Mourning their Sin - & the Judgment they rightly deserved

**TO**; **Rejoicing** in God's Grace that provides Salvation from that Judgment

So **Nehemiah** sends them away **REJOICING** instead of **MOURNING** 

& in doing so – he tells them something Critically Important

#### Neh 8:10 - NLT

10 And Nehemiah continued, "Go and celebrate with a feast of rich foods and sweet drinks, and share gifts of food with people who have nothing prepared. This is a sacred day before our Lord. Don't be dejected and sad, for the joy of the LORD is your strength!"

Nehemiah & Ezra were beginning to bring the people to OBEDIENCE to God's Word

& since this was a **FEAST DAY**they were **encouraging** the people - to **celebrate** it correctly

But notice the **GREAT TRUTH** at the end of **V.10** for the joy of the LORD is your strength!

The <u>Joy of the Lord</u> is the Joy that strengthens us in <u>ANY</u> situation <u>Because</u> of <u>Our Relationship</u> with the Lord

It is a **JOY** found in **Communion** with the Lord in **ANY** Situation

The <u>Joy of the Lord</u> is <u>NOT</u> <u>contingent</u> on <u>ANY</u> outside <u>circumstance</u> or <u>situation</u>

When we can say with Paul – in ANY Situation
"That I may KNOW HIM" - & be able to Commune with Him there

The "Result" will be - Supernatural Joy

& what does this **Joy** Bring (v.10) ? - - - **STRENGTH** 

The word <u>Strength</u> here means; "<u>A Place of Safety</u>" – "<u>A Refuge</u> or <u>Protection</u>"

The <u>Joy of the Lord</u> – is our <u>Place of Safety</u> - <u>Refuge</u> – <u>Protection</u>

<u>IF</u> - we will learn to <u>MEET Him</u>, and <u>COMMUNE with Him</u> in **ANY Circumstance or Situation** 

**THEN** – the Joy of the Lord – **WILL BE** our Strength

The <u>Joy of the Lord</u> comes from; an <u>Ever-Increasing</u>, <u>Intimate</u>, <u>Personal</u> <u>Relationship</u>, with the Lord

& I can <u>ASSURE YOU</u> – That <u>Relationship</u> . . . is a <u>RESPONSE RELATIONSHIP</u>

& to grow in your **RELATIONSHIP** - <u>with</u> Him you must grow in your **RESPONSE** - <u>to</u> Him

# No matter WHERE you're at with Jesus Christ today

you can grow in your **RELATIONSHIP** with Him – & your **RESPONSE** to Him

Maybe Mourning & Crying is the appropriate First Response as you come to grips with your Sin & God's Judgment

But <u>IF</u> you will <u>Acknowledge</u> your condition before God & <u>REPENT</u> of your Sin - & <u>Come to Him</u> for Forgiveness

You will **KNOW** the **JOY** of the Lord

& as you **GROW** – in your **RESPONSE** to Him The **JOY OF THE LORD** – Will be your Strength !!!

Let's Close

#### Neh 8:11-12 - NLT

11 And the <u>Levites</u>, too, <u>quieted the people</u>, telling them, "Hush! Don't weep! For this is a sacred day."

12 So the people went away to eat and drink at a festive meal, to share gifts of food, and to celebrate with great joy [WHY?] because they had heard God's words and understood them.

The people went away – to <u>Celebrate</u> with Great <u>JOY</u> because they had heard God's Word and understood it.

# My **NUMBER ONE Prayer** for this **Church** - & for **W-B-M** is that;

You would <u>HEAR</u> God's Word You would <u>UNDERSTAND</u> God's Word You would <u>RESPOND</u> to God's Word

& by a <u>Growing RESPONSE</u> to God's Word
The <u>JOY OF THE LORD</u> – WILL be your <u>STRENGTH</u>
