Acts 15 - Arrested by Christ - Acts 9:1-18

Have you been **ARRESTED** by Christ - By the Risen Lord?
Has He **Halted you** in your tracks?
Has He **Changed the direction** of your life?

Today - we look at that **History Changing Moment**

When Jesus Christ ARRESTED SAUL of Tarsus & eventually made him PAUL the Apostle

Today we see that "*Turning Point*" Event that made <u>SAUL</u> - into - <u>PAUL</u>

Saul was Traveling down a Dark Road - BENT on his own Plans Until he was **ARRESTED**, & Saved, by Jesus Christ

<u>Maybe</u> today - <u>YOU</u> are <u>BENT</u> on Your Own <u>PLANS</u>

Maybe today - <u>YOU</u> need to be **ARRESTED** by **CHRIST**

Let's Pray

Something had "*flipped a switch*" in the Pharisee named **SAUL**

He had **known** about **Jesus** - & **known** of his **death all from** his **synagogue** in **Tarsus** - where he was a **leader**

But then - along comes <u>Stephen</u> - who begins <u>debating</u> the Jews in <u>Saul's synagogue</u> about <u>Jesus</u> being the <u>Messiah</u>

& that - eventually - led to Stephen's DEATH in many ways, at the hand of SAUL

But <u>Stephen's WITNESS</u> to Christ - <u>in his death</u> - had <u>STUCK</u> in Saul's mind

Stephen's face shining like an <u>angel</u>
his <u>incredible prayer</u> as the Jews were <u>stoning</u> him to death

Stephen looking up & seeing Jesus welcoming him home

All that - seemed to have made Saul crazy

& so he <u>tried</u> to <u>quiet</u> the <u>memories</u> of <u>Stephens</u> witness with as <u>much rage</u> & <u>hate</u> as he could muster

There was something about these Believers
They would NOT back down - NOT for any reason

How could a <u>Crucified Carpenter</u> from Galilee produce such <u>RESOLVE</u> - such <u>PEACE</u> - in the midst of <u>persecution</u>

So <u>to drive</u> those <u>Gnawing Questions</u> from his mind <u>Saul</u> turned up the <u>RAGE</u> - until he was <u>out of control</u> with it

He **started** in **Jerusalem** - **driving** Christians into **outlying** areas

& all of <u>Ch 8</u> was about <u>PHILIP</u> - & the <u>Supernatural growth</u> of the church - - in <u>Response</u> to Saul's persecution

& then - we start Ch 9 - with a BIG BUT . . .

Acts 9:1 (esv)

1 But Saul (contrasted with the great work of Philip in Ch 8), still breathing threats and murder against the disciples of the Lord . . .

AT Robertson says:

"Threatening and slaughter had come to be the very breath that Saul breathed, "like a warhorse who sniffed the smell of battle"

Saul was <u>out of control</u> - <u>like</u> a person who <u>Brutally</u> <u>over-reacts</u> to <u>protect</u> their <u>Pride</u> & their <u>Position</u>

Many **years** later - standing before **King Agrippa** as a prisoner

Paul said - in Acts 26:9-11 (esv)

9 "I myself was convinced that I ought to do many things in opposing the name of Jesus of Nazareth.

10 And I did so in Jerusalem. I not only locked up many of the saints in prison after receiving authority from the chief priests, but when they were put to death I cast my vote against them.

11 And I punished them often in all the synagogues and tried to make them blaspheme, and in raging fury against them I persecuted them even to foreign cities.

Saul was on a Rampage - But God was not moved one bit

Not only did God use Saul IN his persecution

But God was about to ARREST Saul - & instantly Convert him from Greatest Persecutor - to Greatest Apostle

& so our 1st Lesson today is

NO ONE is EVER beyond the <u>Life Transforming</u> work of God - NO ONE

God can **ARREST** - ANYONE!

Again - Acts 9:1-2 \rightarrow \rightarrow

Acts 9:1-2 (esv)

1 But Saul, still breathing threats and murder against the disciples of the Lord, went to the high priest 2 and asked him for letters to the synagogues at Damascus, so that if he found any belonging to the Way, men or women, he might bring them bound to Jerusalem.

These "Letters" were actually "Extradition Requests"

Claiming these Christians who fled had committed crimes
& must be returned to Jerusalem to pay the penalty

This required **EXTREME EFFORT** on the part of Saul to **try to destroy** this movement

<u>Damascus</u> was a <u>150 mi WALK</u> - a <u>6 day</u> journey & <u>so</u> - this was not just - "*I'll hate them as I go about my life*"

This was a <u>determined</u>, <u>focused</u>, <u>consuming</u>, <u>personal</u> <u>WAR</u> against "<u>The WAY</u>", & against Jesus Christ

Notice that phrase "<u>The WAY</u>" in <u>V.2</u> - <u>I love this phrase</u>
It was used in the <u>1970's</u> - & it was used in the <u>1st Century</u>

It refers to "<u>the whole way of life</u>" of following Jesus
But it's emphasis is really on <u>THE Way</u> - as in <u>THE ONLY WAY</u>

Jesus Christ is <u>THE ONLY WAY</u>
He Is <u>The Way</u>, <u>The Truth</u>, <u>The Life</u>

& **no matter** how **MESSED U**P our world gets With **Relativism**, & **Humanism**, & **Islamism**...

Jesus Christ will **ALWAYS** be - **THE WAY** - **The ONLY WAY** !!

Acts 9:3 (esv)

3 Now as he (Saul) went on his way, he approached Damascus, and suddenly a light from heaven flashed around him.

For at least **5 days** - Paul had been **Marching** in his **HATE**

THE WAY had expanded to Damascus

& Saul was determined to stop it there

<u>Damascus</u> was actually a bit of an "<u>Oasis</u>" in the desert <u>fed</u> by <u>two rivers</u> - & known for its <u>ORCHARDS</u>

& <u>now</u> - <u>Saul</u> could <u>see those Orchards</u> in the distance <u>reviewing</u> his final <u>attack & destroy</u> plans

& then **BAAM** !! - a light from heaven **FLASHED** around him

Paul describes it in Acts 26 as - "more brilliant than the sun"
Like Lightening Striking right next to you

Acts 9:4 (esv)

4 And falling to the ground he heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?"

Ch 26 says ALL the men with Saul - FELL FLAT to the ground

& so - as <u>Saul</u> is lying there <u>Face down</u> in the <u>Dirt</u> - Afrai<u>d</u> to even move

Instead of **THUNDER** - He hears a **Voice from Heaven**

The Lord **Emphatically** calls his name - **twice** which is **meant** to express **deep emotion**

- & <u>Then</u> Saul <u>hears the question</u> that unravels his entire life "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?"
- & <u>Saul manages</u> the only <u>response</u> he can <u>muster</u> up still <u>face down</u> in the dirt . . .

Acts 9:5 (esv)

5 And he said, "Who are you, Lord?" . . .

The word "Lord" here is actually used just as term of respect

- But <u>Saul</u> is now "<u>In the Process</u>" of finding out <u>just how much</u> the term <u>LORD</u> really applies <u>to the one</u> speaking to him
- But <u>now</u> comes the <u>RESPONSE</u> Saul was <u>SO AFRAID</u> to hear the <u>ONLY RESPONSE</u> he definitely <u>DID NOT</u> want to <u>hear</u>
- The <u>RESPONSE</u> that would suddenly turn all his worse <u>FEARS</u> immediately into <u>REALITIES</u>
- 5... And he said, "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting.
- Suddenly <u>ALL</u> those <u>questions</u> Saul was <u>carrying</u> about the <u>followers</u> of "<u>The Way</u>" were <u>answered</u>!!
- <u>All</u> the <u>questions</u> about why <u>Jesus' followers</u> were so willing to <u>Suffer & Die</u> for Him were Suddenly <u>ANSWERED</u>
- That **GNAWING** Feeling that **Saul** was fighting something **bigger** than a mere **human following** . . .
- Probably had him pounding his head into the Dry, Hard Ground, of the Damascus road

<u>Saul's World</u> - Has Been - <u>ROCKED</u> !! to <u>the extent</u> that it will <u>never</u> be the <u>same</u> again

Saul - has been ARRESTED - by Jesus Christ !!

<u>Stopped</u> in his tracks - <u>Face down</u> in the dirt <u>Everything</u> he thought he <u>KNEW</u> suddenly <u>disintegrates</u>

With the words from heaven . . . "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting . . .

Not only did Saul now realize WHO Jesus WAS

But he <u>also realized</u> - it was the <u>LORD Himself</u>
Saul was <u>Persecuting</u> - - & <u>not</u> just His <u>followers</u>

& then - in the **NKJV** right here - are **the words** "it is hard for you to kick against the goads"

A goad was a sharp stick you poke an ox with to get him moving in the direction you wanted him to move

- & <u>Sometimes</u> an ox would <u>kick up its heels</u> at the <u>goad</u> in a <u>Futile Attempt</u> to <u>NOT</u> go <u>where</u> his Master <u>wanted</u> him to go
- & <u>Jesus</u> says to <u>Saul</u> why are you <u>KICKING</u> against the <u>Goads</u> that <u>I've been using</u> to <u>move you</u> in the right direction

The **impact** Stephen left on you

The **believers** who **refuse** to **deny** Me & **instead** - chose **suffering**, & even **death**

WHY have you NOT let these things MOVE you It is HARD to Kick against the Goads, isn't it?

And **maybe** that's **YOU** - or **someone** you **know**

Has the <u>Lord</u> been "<u>Goading</u>" you gently <u>prodding</u> you in the <u>Right Direction</u>

& have you been KICKING against Him

Are you **Fighting** against **the direction the Lord** has **set** for your life . . . ?

Can I just share something with you

The Lord has a way of getting us "Face-Down in the Dirt"
where all our Kicking & Fighting him suddenly disintegrates

& we're <u>left pounding</u> our <u>head</u> on the <u>Dry Damascus road</u> & <u>wondering</u> how it is we got so - <u>Face-Down</u> in the Dirt !!

But guys Listen - when we're there . . .

Licking Road Dirt, & Afraid to even Look Up

God is so Merciful - He is So Gracious
He does NOT REMIND US of our sins
He does NOT RUB our face in it

He simply tells us to **RISE U**P & **FOLLOW HIM**

THAT'S what it means to REPENT & that's exactly what happens here to Saul

in V.6 - the NKJV starts with the sentence 6 So he, trembling and astonished, said, "Lord, what do You want me to do?"

This line from the <u>NKJV</u> gives us a good idea of <u>How WE</u> should <u>respond</u> - when Jesus <u>ARRESTS</u> <u>US</u>

FIRST - We should be <u>trembling and astonished</u>
That God would <u>SEEK</u> us - & that He would <u>ARREST</u> us

NEXT - We must simply say **Lord, what do You want me to do?**

& then - Just as Paul does - for the rest of his life
When the Lord tells us what to do - - - we simply DO IT

Vs.6 in the **ESV** starts with the **Lord's Command** to Saul

<u>Acts 9:6 (esv)</u>

6 But rise and enter the city, and you will be told what you are to do."

It's <u>interesting</u> - there's <u>no salvation prayer</u> here not even a verbal confession of faith from Saul

So - <u>HOW</u> do we <u>know</u> that Saul was <u>REALLY</u> <u>SAVED</u> that <u>day</u> on the <u>Damascus</u> Road ??

We **know** - because his **life CHANGED** from that day forward

Saul was **NEVER** the **SAME** Again he started **Thinking** different & **Acting** different

& guys - <u>THAT</u> is <u>Exactly</u> how we <u>KNOW</u> <u>IF</u> a person is <u>Truly Saved</u> today The <u>ONLY way</u> you can know - if <u>the Life</u> of <u>Jesus Christ</u> has taken over your SIN Life - - Is if you are a CHANGED Person

Are you thinking different?

Are you acting different?

Are you **feeling different** about the sinful things you used to do?

Are you <u>desiring</u> to truly <u>Change the Direction</u> of your life & <u>Follow God's</u> plan - <u>instead</u> of your <u>own</u>?

Then Praise the Lord

The Life of Jesus Christ is taking over your Old Sin Life

& you can be sure of this

as Phil 1:6 says

6... he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ.

What the Lord STARTS - He FINISHES

All we do is make <u>sure</u> - We've been <u>ARRESTED by Christ</u>

Have we <u>surrender our will</u> to Him

Has He truly <u>taken over</u> - as <u>LORD of our Lives</u>

& **IF SO** - The He **WILL complete the work** He started

Continuing on . . . Vs.7 is actually a "Parenthetical Vs" to let us know what's happening with Saul's men

Acts 9:7 (esv)

7 The men who were traveling with him stood speechless, hearing the voice but seeing no one.

At this moment Jesus is calling Saul - alone

But I <u>gotta think SOME</u> of these <u>men</u> had to get <u>SAVED</u> <u>especially</u> after seeing <u>Saul's</u> life change

but <u>HERE</u>, <u>TODAY</u> - Jesus is <u>ARRESTING</u> SAUL for a <u>very specific</u> purpose

Sometimes God calls the **Masses** - **Sometimes** God calls **ONE** & **we've seen that** right **here** in our own **church**

& <u>so</u> - in the <u>next vs</u>

<u>Saul</u> begins to <u>BLINDLY</u> "<u>Follow Jesus</u>" - - LITERALLY

Acts 9:8 (esv)

8 Saul rose from the ground, and although his eyes were opened, he saw nothing. So they led him by the hand and brought him into Damascus.

Saul had said in his RAGE
"I will Go to Damascus - & I Will FIND those Christians"

& God said - "Yes you will Saul but Not LIKE you think - & Not for the PURPOSE you think"

How about instead - I break your Stubborn Pride on the way & have you humbly led into Damascus - - BLIND !!

& <u>instead</u> of you <u>PERSECUTING</u> those Christians <u>how about</u> if I have them <u>MINISTER</u> to you instead ??

Who says God doesn't have a sense of humor?

& so God <u>Blinded Saul</u> - to get his <u>complete attention</u> & to <u>give him</u> a few days with <u>NO distractions</u>

Acts 9:9 (esv)

9 And for three days he was without sight, and neither ate nor drank.

<u>Three days</u> - <u>Alone</u> with God - with <u>No Distractions</u> as <u>Saul</u> is prepared to be <u>Transformed</u> into <u>Paul the Apostle</u>

But <u>even though</u> <u>God Himself</u> will <u>instruct</u> Paul <u>Paul</u> still <u>needed</u> the <u>Disciples</u> to "Come Along Side of Him"

& that's what happens starting in Vs.10

Acts 9:10-12 (esv)

10 Now there was a disciple at Damascus named Ananias. The Lord said to him in a vision, "Ananias." And he said, "Here I am, Lord."

11 And the Lord said to him, "Rise and go to the street called Straight (coincidental name), and at the house of Judas look for a man of Tarsus named Saul, for behold, he is praying, 12 and he has seen in a vision a man named Ananias come in and lay his hands on him so that he might regain his sight."

We **don't know much** about **Ananias**

but Acts 22:12 says

12... [he was], a devout man according to the law, well spoken of by all the Jews who lived there,

Some say he may have been the leader of the new Church in Damascus

Church tradition says Ananias **became** the **Bishop of Damascus**, and **eventually died** a **martyrs** death

But we know **THIS** about **Ananias** . . .

Ananias **KNEW** of Saul's **Reputation** & he **KNEW WHY** Saul had come to **Damascus**

& so - I Guess we can <u>understand</u> - <u>when</u> Ananias here somehow <u>thinks</u> it's a good idea - to <u>Question God's Judgment</u>

Acts 9:13-14 (esv)

13 But Ananias answered, "Lord, I have heard from many about this man, how much evil he has done to your saints at Jerusalem. 14 And here he has authority from the chief priests to bind all who call on your name."

How'd you like to be the guy who argued with God about Paul the Apostle

Ananias is LUCKY - That he LIVED - to DIE a Martyr's death !!

God is **SO Gracious** to us - *Isn't He?*God <u>doesn't owe</u> Ananias an <u>explanation</u> - but He <u>gives him</u> one

Acts 9:15-16 (esv)

15 But the Lord said to him, "Go, for he is a <u>chosen</u> instrument of mine to <u>carry my name</u> before the <u>Gentiles</u> and <u>kings</u> and the children of <u>Israel</u>.

16 For I will show him how much he must suffer for the sake of my name."

This just shows **God's IMMEASURABLE GRACE** to us **Even** while **He's using us** - in His service

But **the real point** is **God** reveals to **Ananias** - His **PLAN** for "**The Greatest Apostle**"

"He is a Chosen Instrument to carry My Name before Gentiles, & Kings, & the Children of Israel"

Notice <u>God's Plan</u> for Paul in <u>Vs.15</u> - is to: <u>Carry My Name</u> to <u>GENTILES</u>, <u>KINGS</u>, & The Children of <u>ISRAEL</u>

& there's something very cool we can see here

ALL that God had PLANNED for Paul

He had already PREPARED Paul for - LONG before He saved him

Paul was raised in a Wealthy Family,So Witnessing to Kings did not intimidate him

Paul had the best education in BOTH GREEK & JEWISH Culture

His education in Greek Philosophy allowed him to understand the Gentiles

& His <u>Thorough Education</u> in <u>Jewish Law</u> allowed him to <u>Completely Understand</u> the Children of Israel

God had been <u>preparing Paul</u> his entire life - for <u>THIS</u> plan & <u>Guys</u> - <u>God does</u> the exact <u>same thing</u> with US!!

God has been <u>preparing YOU</u> - <u>for</u> the Plan He has <u>for YOU</u> - All your life !! **BELIEVE** it - **LOOK** for it

& then Actively **JOIN God** in His Plan for your Life

THAT'S what the Apostle Paul is about to do
& THAT - is the Secret to True Fulfillment in this life

BELIEVE God has a Plan for your Life **LOOK** for it **ACTIVELY JOIN Him** in His Plan for you!!

But **there's one thing** you have to know . . .

Vs.16 is just as **TRUE** - as **V.15**

16 For I will show him how much he must suffer for the sake of my name."

IT'S **NOT FAIR** leaving that part out . . .

Romans 8:17 (NLT)

17 And since we are his children, we are his heirs. In fact, together with Christ we are heirs of God's glory. But if we are to share his glory, we must also share his suffering.

& Paul will CERTAINLY Learn - How TRUE that Vs is !!

In the <u>mean time</u> - in <u>V.17</u>

Ananias DOES what God has Called him to do

Acts 9:17 \rightarrow \rightarrow

Acts 9:17 (esv)

17 So Ananias departed and entered the house. And laying his hands on him he said, "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus who appeared to you on the road by which you came has sent me so that you may regain your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit."

This had to be an incredibly MOVING scene

The Enemy, Saul - had been Arrested by the Lord & now he was sitting, alone, & blind

Ananias knew <u>people</u> who had <u>suffered</u> under the <u>hand of Saul</u>
<u>Women</u> who were now <u>Widows</u>, or <u>Children</u> now <u>Orphans</u>

But now - In Obedience to the Lord all the ANGER Ananias had for Saul - just MELTED AWAY

- & <u>he entered</u> the house & <u>LOVINGLY LAID</u> his Hands on <u>Enemy #1</u> of the <u>New Christian Church</u>
- & <u>Ananias</u> whose name means "<u>God is Gracious</u>" spoke words of <u>Acceptance</u> & <u>Restoration</u> to Saul

"Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus who appeared to you on the road by which you came has sent me so that you may regain your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit."

He <u>called</u> Saul <u>BROTHER</u> - & then he <u>prayed for him</u> - for <u>Return of his sight</u> - & for the <u>Filling of the Holy Spirit</u>

& then in Acts 9:18 we read (esv)

18 And immediately something like scales fell from his eyes, and he regained his sight. Then he rose and was baptized;

What a picture that must've been

For the <u>Pharisee of Pharisee's</u> to be <u>BAPTIZED</u> in the Name of the <u>Father</u>, the <u>SON</u>, AND the <u>Holy Spirit</u>

After the SCALES falling from his eyes . . .

I once was Lost . . . But Now I'm Found I was Blind . . . But now I See

THIS - was AMAZING GRACE Poured Out on Saul the Persecutor

& that **SAME Amazing Grace** is available **TO US** - **TODAY**

No matter who you ARE
No matter what you've DONE or where you've BEEN

Jesus Christ wants to ARREST you - TODAY

He wants to <u>STOP you</u> in your tracks - <u>TURN</u> your Life Around & <u>PUT YOU</u> on <u>HIS Path</u>

I don't know <u>WHERE</u> you're headed I don't know <u>WHAT'S</u> Driving you

But <u>I know</u> that <u>JESUS</u> - wants to <u>ARREST</u> YOU & <u>Transform</u> you life - <u>FOREVER</u>
