Ruth 02 - Repentance?? - Ruth 1:6-18

We <u>met</u> our <u>THREE key characters</u> in our 1st msg <u>Boaz</u> - <u>Naomi</u> - <u>Ruth</u>

<u>Today</u>, we're going to see a <u>REAL Comparison</u> (or <u>Contrast</u>) Involving <u>TWO</u> of our Key Characters - <u>NAOMI</u> & <u>RUTH</u> . . .

<u>AND</u> - another <u>MINOR character</u> who quickly <u>drops off</u> the scene just like we saw <u>Elimelech</u> do last week

<u>Today</u> - the <u>QUESTION</u> is - <u>REPENTANCE</u>?? Meaning - **IS THAT Genuine Repentance??**

we're **going to see** Three "**PICTURES**" of Repentance in our **Text** Today

& <u>ONLY ONE</u> of them we would say <u>was</u> <u>TRUE</u> (or Genuine) <u>Repentance</u>

& it's <u>important</u> because we <u>see</u> many <u>different</u>
LEVELS or APPROACHES to Repentance today - *Don't we?*

So - **before** we see our **THREE** Different "**PICTURES**" of **Repentance** today

Let's **get a Grasp** on what **GENUINE REPENTANCE** IS:

The <u>Definition</u> we are most <u>familiar</u> with is: *A Turning Away FROM* Sin, and a Turning TO God

Holman Bible Dictionary - Repentance [is] a <u>deeply seated</u> and <u>thorough</u> turning from self to God.

New Dictionary of Biblical Theology: Repentance [is] the turning away from those actions and attitudes that are offensive to God and his nature. It includes the confession of sin, accompanied by mourning and regret. Often expressed as 'turning back' to God,

Repentance Always involves

CONFESSION of Sin

REMORSE for your Sin - &

ACKNOWLEDGING your need for God's **Forgiveness**

GENUINE Repentance is **FAR more** just "Going Thru the Motions"

King David - in his Famous Psalm of Repentance - Psa 51. . .

Realized that "Going thru the Motions" - WITHOUT a
Complete Change of Heart - was WORTHLESS to God

Psalm 51:16-17 (ESV)

16 For you will <u>not delight</u> in sacrifice, or I would give it; you will <u>not be</u> pleased with a burnt offering.

17 The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise.

Genuine Repentance involves:

A <u>Complete</u> - <u>All In</u> - <u>Covenant Commitment</u> to Turn <u>FROM</u> Sin - & Turn <u>TO</u> God - With <u>Everything</u> in you

& <u>today</u> we're going to see <u>THREE</u> "<u>Pictures</u>" of people <u>TURNING</u> - or <u>RE-TURNING</u> - to God

One's Repentance is - is **NON-EXISTENT**One's Repentance is - is **QUESTIONABLE**

One's Repentance - Opens the Flood-Gates of Heaven . . .

for God to **pour out Blessings** we will continue to **see** - **throughout** the **rest** of this book - And **into Eternity**!!

& so <u>Today</u> - I'm going to <u>ask US</u> to <u>Consider</u> our <u>OWN Level</u> - of <u>Repentance</u>

Is it NON-EXISTENT?
Is it QUESTIONABLE?
or Will it OPEN the Flood-Gates of Heaven . . .

& <u>Allow</u> God to <u>Pour out His Blessings</u> of His <u>Mercy</u> & <u>Grace</u> into <u>our lives</u> . . . all the way <u>into Eternity</u>

Let's Pray

Last week - we <u>left Naomi</u> - "<u>Holding the Bag</u>" of her & her husband's "<u>Turning AWAY from God</u>"

They had **chased** the "**Grass is Greener**" **syndrome** into the **Ungodly** world of **MOAB** - Running **FROM** God - & **INTO** Sin

Their <u>2 sons</u> had married <u>Moabite women</u>, <u>Who</u>, by their <u>Culture</u> - were <u>far away</u> from God

& <u>then</u> - What we might call a "<u>CONSEQUENCE</u>" occurred <u>Naomi's Husband</u> & both her <u>Sons</u> - <u>DIED</u>

<u>Leaving Naomi</u> & her Moabite <u>Daughters-in-law</u> to <u>fend</u> for <u>themselves</u> - which was <u>generally impossible</u> in that culture

& <u>Then</u> - at some point - <u>Naomi heard</u> - the <u>Famine</u> in Israel was <u>over</u> & <u>suddenly</u> she was "<u>MOTIVATED</u>" to <u>Return to the Lord</u>

Ruth 1:6 (esv)

6 Then she (Naomi) arose with her daughters-in-law to <u>return</u> from the country of Moab, for <u>she had heard</u> in the fields of Moab that <u>the Lord had</u> visited his people and <u>given them food</u>.

The <u>tables</u> had turned - Now <u>Naomi</u> was <u>Stuck</u> in The Fields of <u>MOAB</u> & the <u>Lord was Blessing</u> His people in <u>ISRAEL</u>

& **suddenly** - **Naomi Decides** she needs to **RETURN** to the Lord & to **His people** in **Bethlehem**

The word Translated "RETURN" here . . .

is the **SAME Hebrew Word** Translated "**REPENT**" **Because** to Repent means - to **RETURN** to the Lord

& <u>so here</u> (in some way) is a <u>picture</u> of a "<u>Repenting</u>" Naomi - She desires to **RETURN** to the Lord

But <u>GENUINE Repentance</u> requires a True <u>CHANGE of HEART</u> It's a <u>Turning</u> of All that we <u>ARE</u> - <u>Away</u> From <u>Sin</u>, & <u>To God</u>

Was <u>THAT</u> the <u>condition</u> of <u>Naomi's heart</u> ??

Had she acknowledged her sin - & did she have a Wholehearted Desire to Return - to a Right Relationship with the Lord . . . OR

Was it because she heard there was EASY FOOD there ??

And she knew Israel took care of its Widows

YES - Naomi is RETURNING to the Lord

YES - this is "Kind-Of" a Picture of Repentance . . .

BUT - Do you sense GENUINE REPENTANCE, or NOT?

So - Naomi AROSE - with her daughters-in-law to RETURN to the Lord - maybe with Questionable Motives

Ruth 1:7 (esv)

7 So she set out from the place where she was <u>with her two</u> <u>daughters-in-law</u>, and they <u>went on the way</u> to return to the land of Judah.

Now - Here's an interesting thing

It was <u>custom</u> in the <u>East</u> (& I believe it still is) - to make <u>a parting</u> "On the Road" - <u>not at the door</u> of a house <u>like</u> we <u>would</u>

So Naomi's Daughters-in-Law both "Went on the Way" with her

But <u>at this point</u> - we <u>don't know</u> if it's just to <u>say good-bye</u> - <u>or if</u> they are <u>RETURNING</u> to the <u>Lord</u> with her

But <u>we find</u> out soon <u>enough</u> - as <u>Naomi</u> <u>STOPS</u> on the road to <u>Address</u> these <u>two women</u>

At this point - all THREE women are Moving toward RETURNING to the Lord

Like when you see a **thousand people** walk **down** front at a **Large Crusade** - all **moving** in the **same direction**

Ruth 1:8-9(a) (esv)

- 8 But Naomi (stopping on the road) said to her two daughters-inlaw, "Go, return each of you to her mother's house. May the Lord deal kindly with you, as you have dealt with the dead (their deceased husbands) and with me.
- 9 The Lord grant that you may find rest (security), each of you in the house of her (new) husband!"...
- Naomi is (in some way) RETURNING to the Lord . . .
- But <u>IF</u> She really <u>HAD</u> that Real <u>Covenant Relationship</u> with the Lord <u>wouldn't</u> she have <u>Encouraged</u> her <u>daughters</u> to <u>RETURN</u> w/ her
- She <u>Did LOVE</u> them She <u>wanted</u> what was <u>best</u> for them But <u>she encouraged</u> them to <u>STAY</u> in a land <u>FAR</u> from God
- She <u>encouraged</u> them to <u>TURN AWAY</u> from the <u>TRUE GOD</u> & <u>go back</u> to <u>worshipping</u> their <u>FALSE GODS</u> in MOAB & <u>hopefully</u> find <u>NEW Husbands</u>
- Naomi <u>LOVED</u> her <u>Daughters</u>-in-Law She just <u>didn't have</u> the <u>FAITH</u> in the Lord, to <u>Encourage them</u> to <u>RETURN</u> with her
- <u>That's LIKE</u> a person who says: **Yeah I'm goin to Church for the**wife & kids but you bro, you gotta stay in the world
 & party hardy for <u>BOTH</u> us man . . .
- I gotta do the "Church Thing" you know

 But it's better for you to stay in the world & maybe go to Hell
- <u>Listen</u> if <u>you're</u> a <u>FRIEND</u> like <u>THAT</u> to somebody then <u>they Don't NEED</u> an <u>ENEMY</u>
- **Cause** that's **CRAZY TALK** to someone you **CARE ABOUT**

So - Naomi says they should STAY in the World - Away from God

& so we read in Ruth 1:9(b)-10 (esv)

9... Then she kissed them, and they lifted up their voices and wept.

10 And they said to her, "No, we will return with you to your people."

That's like someone saying to you

No, I really **WANT** to **go to Church** with you . . .

I Really want to change my life too

I want to **TURN** to the Lord **TOO**

Look at the end of v.10 - we will return with you to your people Come on - Let us Turn to the Lord with you - Pleassseee!

& <u>Notice</u> again the word <u>RETURN</u> in <u>v.10</u>

This is a **Critical Word** in **Repentance** . . . to **RETURN** to the Lord

ALL TURNING TO the Lord - Is a <u>RETURN</u> to the <u>God</u> who <u>Made</u> you & the <u>God</u> who <u>Loves</u> you

Naomi was the MOST "Returning"

because she had (presumably) **walked** with the **Lord** before

But these two Moabite women ALSO had a chance here to RETURN to the One True God . . .

to leave behind their gods of Moab

& commit themselves wholly & completely to the God of Heaven

<u>But</u> they were **<u>gonna</u>** have to **<u>do it</u>** - **<u>AGAINST</u>** the counsel of our "**SEMI-REPENTING**" Naomi

& so **she** continues 'Working Them" with Logic . . .

Ruth 1:11-13(a) (esv)

11 But Naomi said, "Turn back, my daughters; why will you go with me? Have I yet sons in my womb that they may become your husbands?

12 Turn back, my daughters; go your way, for I am too old to have a husband. If I should say I have hope, even if I should have a husband this night and should bear sons,

13 would you therefore wait till they were grown? Would you therefore refrain from marrying? . . .

MAN Naomi - can you PLEASE JOIN God in His PLAN here ??

Naomi is referring to a Law of Israel called LEVIRATE MARRIAGE

Which <u>required</u> the <u>brother</u> of a <u>deceased husband</u> to <u>MARRY</u> the widow - & to <u>continue</u> the <u>blood line</u>

& so <u>Naomi</u> - Or, as <u>J. Vernon McGee</u> calls her <u>LITTLE MERRY SUNSHINE</u> . . .

<u>Little Merry Sunshine</u> is just <u>telling these Girls</u> - Look, there's <u>NO HOPE</u> in <u>Retuning</u> to the <u>LORD in Israel</u> with Her . . .

Cause she **can't** have any **more sons** that they could **marry**

& <u>right here</u> - we <u>catch</u> what might be <u>another</u> one of <u>Naomi's</u> underlying Mo<u>t</u>ives

<u>See</u> - these <u>Moabite women</u> - will be <u>DETESTED</u> in Israel **Israel hated**, the **MOABITES**

& so Naomi (Little Merry Sunshine) may be saying . . .

LOOK, You're **gonna be HATED** in Israel - you're **never** gonna get **married there** . . .

so **why not** go **back** to your **OLD Life** - & **do the best** you can

PLUS - there's just one other little PERSONAL thing . . .

<u>See</u> - It was also <u>against</u> the <u>Law of Moses</u> for the <u>men of Israel</u> to <u>MARRY</u> women <u>OUTSIDE</u> Israel

& so - Naomi knew - when she came traipsing into town with TWO Moabite Daughter's-in-law . . .

she was gonna have some SPLAININ to do !!

I'm <u>kinda giving</u> Naomi a <u>Bad Rap</u> here & <u>she IS</u> going to be <u>used by God</u> - for <u>GOOD</u> - in the story

But <u>right here</u> - she is a <u>MESS</u> spiritually - & She is **NOT** our **picture** of **GENUINE REPENTANCE**

& we see her True Condition of her heart - at the end of V.13

Ruth 1:13(b) (esv)

13... No, my daughters, for it is exceedingly <u>bitter to me</u> for your sake that the <u>hand of the Lord</u> has gone out against me."

Genuine Repentance requires CONFESSION of OUR sin (means we AGREE with God - what we've done is SIN)

& it <u>Requires REMORSE</u> over being <u>SEPARATED</u> from <u>God</u> - <u>BY</u> your sin

& <u>Naomi</u> displays - <u>NEITHER</u> here - -The <u>translation</u> of this <u>Vs</u> is <u>Difficult</u> - & the <u>NLT</u> does a <u>Good Job</u>

Ruth 1:13(b) (NLT)

13... Things are far more bitter for me than for you, because the Lord himself has raised his fist against me."

THAT is "Little Merry Sunshine's" True heart condition

Things are far more bitter <u>for me</u> than for you, because the Lord himself has raised his fist against me

Have you ever known anybody who BLAMES the LORD for the Consequences of their own SIN ??

Man - Why did the God take my family & everything I had while I was drunk for those 15 years ?

Man - Why did God let my wife leave me, I was just messin around with a few other women??

<u>Sometimes</u> we <u>blame God</u> - for the <u>Consequences</u> of our <u>own Sin</u> & it <u>seems</u> like <u>Naomi</u> is <u>doing that</u> here

This is **NOT** a **Genuinely Repentant** heart

Naomi **DOES** eventually **get** into a "**Right Place**" with God & **she does** "**Walk by FAITH**" before **the book** is finished

But here - She's NOT our Prime Example - of Genuine Repentance
Can you see that ??

So - Naomi is making this REALLY HARD on her Daughters-in-Law

& <u>Now</u> - - It's <u>TIME</u> for <u>each</u> of these Girls to make <u>THEIR OWN CHOICE</u> about <u>RETURNING</u> to the Lord

Remember - the Daughters are named - ORPAH & RUTH

Ruth 1:14 (esv)

14 Then they (all 3) lifted up their voices and wept again. And Orpah kissed her mother-in-law, but Ruth clung to her.

The word "KISSED" is - as in "Kissed Good-Bye"

ORPAH Made her <u>choice</u> - She had <u>started out</u> on the <u>Road to Returning</u> to the Lord

Like someone who goes down front at a Crusade with a Friend

BUT - She had been <u>CONVINCED OTHERWISE</u>
The LOGIC of the "<u>Things of this World</u>" - <u>CONVINCED HER</u>

- & She <u>Kisses Naomi</u> goodbye & **she turns her back** on the **House of God**
- & <u>her place</u> in the <u>Plan of God</u> is Done <u>She's chosen</u> to **TURN AWAY** from the Lord & **go back** to the **World**

But RUTH . . . is a **DIFFERENT STORY V.14** says Ruth **CLUNG** to Naomi

This is the **SAME** Hebrew **WORD** used in the **famous Marriage** vs -

Gen 2:24 - Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and CLEAVE to his wife, - - (Same Word)

Same **ROOT word** used in **Deut** when **Moses** is **calling Israel** into a **Covenant Relationship** with **God** He says

Deuteronomy 10:20 (ESV)

20 You shall fear the Lord your God. You shall serve him and <u>hold</u> <u>fas</u>t (CLEAVE) to him . . .

THIS is a Serious Word - Ruth is:

CLEAVING to **NAOMI** -

CLEAVING to Naomi's **PEOPLE**

CLEAVING to Naomi's **GOD**

& <u>Ruth</u> is about to <u>get a chance</u> to CONFIRM her Commitment When <u>Naomi challenges</u> her - <u>AGAIN</u>

Ruth 1:15 (esv)

15 And she (Naomi) said (to Ruth), "See, your sister-in-law has gone back to her people and to her gods; return after your sister-in-law."

Really Naomi - you're kidding me right?

Do you not get it? Ruth wants to be SAVED She wants to be PART of God's Plan

& <u>Ruth</u> is gonna <u>make</u> her <u>COVENANT COMMITMENT</u> Incredibly <u>CLEAR</u> - - Right Now

Ruth 1:16 (esv)

16 But Ruth said, "Do not urge me to <u>leave</u> you or to return from following you . . .

The word **LEAVE** - means - **To ABANDON**

These two women are on a long road - ALONE ORPAH'S back is fading into the Horizon

& Ruth says - I WILL NOT Abandon you

I WILL NOT Leave you

I Am ALL IN - With Everything I've got

GUESS who our **HEROINE EXAMPLE** of **Genuine Repentance** is?

& <u>right here</u> - in <u>Vs's 16 & 17</u> . . .

is **one** of the **Greatest Commitments** in **ALL the Bible** of **Following God** - **ALL in**, & with **NO Turning Back**

THIS is the **BEST PICTURE** you can get . . .

of <u>Turning From</u> your <u>OLD</u> Life & <u>Committing</u> to a <u>Covenant Relationship</u> with <u>GOD</u>

Ruth 1:16(b)-17 (esv)

16... For where you go I will go, and where you lodge I will lodge. Your people shall be my people, and your God my God.
17 Where you die I will die, and there will I be buried. May the Lord do so to me and more also if anything but death parts me from you."

This is the <u>strongest possible vow</u> a person could <u>make</u> - - <u>The Hebrew</u> here shows <u>ABSOLUTE DETERMINATION</u>

Where you <u>GO</u> - I will <u>GO</u>
Where you <u>STAY</u> - I will <u>STAY</u>

<u>YOUR People</u> - will be <u>MY People</u>

<u>YOUR God</u> - will be <u>MY God</u>

Where you <u>DIE</u> - I will <u>DIE</u>

- & then the last sentence in V.17 Is an OATH to God saying:
- May God pout out His JUDGMENT upon me if I don't keep this Covenant Commitment
- & <u>in that OATH</u> (v.17)- Ruth uses the <u>PERSONAL Name</u> for God The <u>name</u> Given to <u>Israel</u> The <u>COVENANT Name</u> of God

She Uses YAHWEH - MY Lord & My God

- RUTH the Moabite has just made a COVENANT unto DEATH with YAHWEH Her PERSONAL LORD & GOD
- <u>Guys</u> <u>God is looking</u> for those who will <u>WHOLEHEARTEDLY</u> <u>Turn</u> to Him - <u>Leaving ALL else</u> behind - Just <u>Like THIS</u>
- & <u>in the Rest</u> of the <u>Book</u> we'll see the <u>BLESSINGS</u> that <u>come</u> from <u>THIS</u> "<u>All In</u>" <u>commitment</u> from Ruth . . .
- to <u>Turn Completely FROM</u> her <u>OLD</u> Life & <u>Turn Completely TO</u> God with <u>NO turning</u> Back
- & THAT is what it Looks Like
 When you & I Genuinely TURN from OUR sin
 & Wholeheartedly Surrender OUR Lives to the Lord

Do you SEE IT ??

<u>Unbelievably</u> - Naomi <u>CANNOT</u> bring herself - to <u>Encouragement</u> It must not have been her gift . . .

Ruth 1:18 (esv)

18 And when Naomi saw that she was determined to go with her, she <u>said</u> no more (she stopped talking).

Really Naomi - that's all you got for our HEROINE ??

That's <u>all you got</u> for <u>one</u> of the <u>most Incredible</u>
"<u>Statements of Faith</u>" in all the <u>Bible</u>??... Really?

Scholars compare Ruth's Faith - to Abraham's Faith - When he Left HIS Land & HIS People - to Follow God

& ALL Naomi can do - is just "Quit Talking"?

I guess My MOTHER was Right when she said "If you can't say something nice - don't say anything at all"

<u>Sometimes</u> - we have to <u>make</u> our "<u>All In</u>" <u>Commitment</u> to the Lord . . . <u>IN SPITE</u> of the <u>Christians</u> around us

& THAT'S what it seems like Ruth had to do here

So - we've seen THREE "Pictures" of Repentance here

1) ORPAH - that's easy

She <u>just turned back</u> to the world - <u>NO Repentance</u> at all & she <u>disappears</u>

2) NAOMI - She's walking the fence

She's in **some kind** of **half-hearted** - **wrong motive** - **self seeking** Repentance

Two Vs's later - she asks to have her name changed to a name that means BITTERNESS

She is **BITTER** - & She is in **Grave DANGER**She's **TOYING** with **Repentance** - - **Not Good**

3) RUTH - Our Heroine

Ruth Turns FROM her Old Life APART from God - & turns completely, & without reservation - TO a Life WITH GOD

& Her <u>Complete</u> - <u>All in</u> - <u>Repentance</u> <u>OPENS up</u> Heaven's <u>Flood-Gates</u> . . .

To <u>allow God's</u> Undeserved <u>MERCY</u> & <u>GRACE</u> to <u>pour out</u> on her in <u>ways</u> she can't even <u>IMAGINE</u>

The **QUESTION TODAY** is **Which one** of these **Pictures** - is **MOST LIKE US**

HOW would **WE define OUR Repentance** - **OUR** Turning **TO God**??

Is it NON-EXISTANT? - You can change that today

Is it WALKING THE FENCE ? - You NEED to change that today

Is it <u>ALL IN</u>, <u>SOLD OUT</u>, <u>COMPLETE SURRENDER</u> to a <u>Covenant Relationship</u> - with your <u>Personal</u> LORD & SAVIOR

<u>Isa 55:7 (NLT) Explains Repentance very well</u>

7 Let the wicked change their ways and banish the very thought of doing wrong. Let them turn to the Lord that he may have mercy on them. Yes, turn to our God, for he will forgive generously.

Let's Pray
