Neh 04 - The Work Begins - Neh 2:11-20

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When we <u>first met</u> Nehemiah in Ch 1 he was the <u>cupbearer</u> to the King – his <u>confidant</u>, <u>advisor</u>

But remember we said - Nehemiah goes

from <u>Cupbearer</u>, to <u>Engineer & Builder</u> & finally, to <u>Governor</u>

& today – we **see Nehemiah** begin his work as **Engineer** & **Builder**

We're going to see the <u>massive project</u> of <u>Re-Building</u> the <u>Wall of testimony</u> around Jerusalem - <u>BEGIN</u>

Remember – it's **been 90 years**, **since** God's people had **returned** to Jerusalem

& the **Wall of Testimony** was still in **RUINS**

& today – Nehemiah is going to **BEGIN** the work of Rebuilding the Wall

Let's Pray - & we'll dig in

here's our 1st important point

This <u>critical period</u> of Nehemiah's life - begins <u>very simply</u> - with <u>no fanfare</u> or <u>excitement</u>

The <u>most important part</u> – of the work God is always done - **Alone** with God

- It is <u>THERE</u> that God <u>Prepares</u> you, & <u>Equips</u> you for <u>the task</u> he's calling you to
- For <u>Moses</u> his 40 yrs of <u>leadership</u> was <u>PRECEEDED</u> by 40 yrs in the <u>wilderness</u>, leading (real) sheep
- & in those <u>40 yrs</u> of silence, God Prepared <u>Moses</u> for <u>40 yrs</u> of leading the flock of God
- <u>King David</u> also began his service to God <u>ALONE</u>, with just the sheep of his father
- & then <u>Alone</u> & <u>running</u> for his life from King <u>Saul</u> in the wilderness
- Paul the greatest Apostle didn't <u>begin</u> his <u>Apostleship</u> with a great <u>missionary journey</u> & church planting

He **began** his Apostleship **ALONE** – in **Arabia** for 3 years

Even **Jesus** was prepared this same way

Immediately after His baptism
He fasted **ALONE** for 40 days

& then faced Satan – <u>ALONE</u> in preparation for **the Great Work** He had come to accomplish

God most often - prepares us **ALONE** (in the desert) **for the work** he has for us - in our Jerusalem

After months of fervent prayer in Ch 1

After God opening the **Door of Opportunity** in Ch 2 . . .

Now - Nehemiah spends over <u>3 months</u> traveling the <u>800 mi</u> from Susa to Jerusalem

& we can be sure **every day** he spent time **alone** with God **being preparing** for the task that lay before him

& so we come - to Neh 2:11-12 - NLT (might stay w/ NLT)

11 So I arrived in Jerusalem (after 800 mi's). Three days later, 12 I slipped out during the night, taking only a few others with me. I had not told anyone about the plans God had put in my heart for Jerusalem. We took no pack animals with us except the donkey I was riding.

After <u>3 months</u> traveling & after <u>3 days</u> in Jerusalem (probably resting)

Nehemiah - FINALLY was about to begin investigating the wall

- & he **slipped out** at night taking only a **few others** with him
- & he had told no one about the plans God had put in his heart

WHY? – Because he was allowing God to CONFIRM the plan & to SPELL OUT the DETAILS

before he spoke to even one person about it

& so he <u>carried the burden</u> that God had given him, *around the wall*

- & he <u>carried the shame</u> of this testimony of God *that had been torn down*
- & He was **LOOKING** closely, & carefully at the task to try to **grasp the magnitude** of what God had called him to

<u>Last week</u> – I mentioned - when <u>We</u> came <u>here</u> to Nuevo, I <u>drove up & down</u> every street of this community – <u>Alone</u> Praying for every house, <u>more than once</u>

- & we <u>tried our best</u> to come to grips with <u>the reality</u>, & the <u>magnitude</u>, of the <u>spiritual condition</u>, of this community
- A great deal, of the <u>wall of testimony</u> of this community had been <u>torn down</u> by the enemy
- there was only **one church in town**, & praise God for them & there was the **Grejada family's** food bank & ministry building
- but **every new church** that had been **started** in this community for many years

had been **torn down** by the enemy - & **run out** of town

During that same time - there were **thousands** of new homes being built **20 miles south** of here - in **French Valley**

- & **thousands** of new homes usually means **INSTANT** church **growth**
- & I <u>have</u> to be <u>honest</u> with you . . . I <u>drove around</u> down there <u>also</u>, & I <u>dealt with God</u> <u>ALONE</u> there

- & I <u>knew</u> that God <u>hadn't called us</u> to the place with <u>thousands</u> of new homes
- God <u>called us</u> to <u>Nuevo</u> to help build the <u>wall of testimony</u> <u>HERE</u>, In this community
- <u>& most</u> of our ministry team had also <u>carefully</u> & <u>solemnly</u> counted the <u>cost</u> & measured the <u>magnitude of the task</u>
- one member had a dream in which the enemy told them
- that he would do them **great harm** if they **DARED** come to **Nuevo** to begin this work
- We <u>surveyed</u> the Wall of Testimony we <u>acknowledged</u> the damage the enemy had done we <u>counted</u> the cost . . .
- & we **set out to REBUILD** the wall of testimony to God in this community
- & if **you** consider yourself a **permanent part** of this body
- Then <u>God</u> has also called <u>YOU</u> to help **REBUILD** the wall of Testimony **HERE** *Amen* ?
- Let's <u>rejoin Nehemiah</u> as he carefully <u>investigates</u> the <u>condition</u> of the Wall
- In <u>Vs's 13-15</u> Nehemiah takes his <u>Nighttime TOUR</u> to closely <u>INSPECT</u> the ruins of the wall

Neh 2:13-15 - NLT

13 After dark I went out through the Valley Gate, past the Jackal's Well, and over to the Dung Gate to <u>inspect</u> the broken walls and burned gates.

14 Then I went to the Fountain Gate and to the King's Pool, but my donkey couldn't get through the rubble.

15 So, though it was still dark, I went up the Kidron Valley instead, inspecting the wall before I turned back and entered again at the Valley Gate.

Nehemiah **INSPECTED** the wall

The word "inspect" is a medical term

It means to **examine** something very **carefully** to **determine** the **details** of it

Nehemiah was **thinking** thru every **detail** of the work

He's planning - he's thinking

who will he need to build with him

& what would they need to be gifted at

& that's **exactly** what is required for **ANY** Wall of testimony to be built by the people of God

EACH person comes with different **giftings** & different **weaknesses**

& we <u>Must EACH work</u>, within our <u>Gifting</u> allowing others to <u>support</u> us – in our <u>weaknesses</u> does that make sense?

The only **GIFT** that God has **NOT** given **ANYONE** is the **GIFT** of **TEARING** down **the wall** that others are building

God creates us **to build** a WALL of Testimony

The **enemy** inspires us

to **TEAR down** the **wall** that others are building

So here's how it's gone for Nehemiah so far:

- 1) He <u>received the burden</u> from God
- 2) He **<u>prayed</u>** & **<u>fasted</u>**, even mourned, carrying that burden
- 3) He watched for the **Door of Opportunity**
- 4) HE was **ready with a plan** when God opened the door
- 5) HE carefully **inspected** the work & **counted** the cost

THIS is the process that will PREPARE us - to not look back once we have put our hand to the plow

This is the process where God will **INSTILL strength** in us To **see us** all the way thru

<u>right up</u> to that day - when <u>we</u> stand before Him,
& He says "Well done My good & faithful servant"

& guys - this applies to EVERY work of God

whether raising <u>children</u>, <u>working</u> to earn a living,

or serving in the **ministry** --- **THESE** same truths **APPLY**

& <u>notice</u> again – Nehemiah did this <u>ALL Alone</u> with God <u>before</u> he ever <u>spoke</u> to One person about his <u>plans</u>

Look at Neh 2:16 - NLT

16 The city officials did not know I had been out there or what I was doing, for I had not yet said anything to anyone about my plans. I had not yet spoken to the Jewish leaders—the priests, the nobles, the officials, or anyone else in the administration.

He had **NOT YET** spoken to anyone . . .

But Nehemiah also **knew** he **could NOT** build this wall alone

He KNEW - he would need EACH of God's people to build THEIR OWN wall of testimony around their own lives

in order for the entire wall to be built – to the Glory of God
& we'll see that SPECIFICALLY next week

But <u>for today</u> – let's <u>look closely</u> at how God used Nehemiah to <u>call the people</u> - to <u>the task</u> that was before them

Neh 2:17 - NLT

17 But now (finally) I said to them, "You know very well what trouble we are in. Jerusalem lies in ruins, and its gates have been destroyed by fire. Let us rebuild the wall of Jerusalem and (that we may-esv) end this disgrace!"

When Nehemiah finally spoke to the city officials - Look very carefully at the words - WE - US - WE

Nehemiah never said "Man, you guys have really blown it, your testimony is a mess"

"You guys have done so many things wrong I can't believe it In fact – let me LIST ALL the things you've done wrong"

We <u>have people</u> in the church that really believe – <u>THAT</u> is their job

But see, that is not **building** the wall of testimony, that's **tearing down** whatever testimony may have existed

& there will <u>always people</u> – in every church who specialize in <u>tearing down</u> whatever good may exist

But Nehemiah does none of that – He says look at the trouble <u>WE</u> are in Let <u>US</u> rebuild together that WE may end this disgrace

The language of a **BUILDER** – Has **No** finger pointing, **No** criticism, **No** dissention

Nehemiah is there – not only to ReBuild the Wall he's there to ReBuild the People

& so after months of agony in prayer after sharing his burden with the King after traveling to Jerusalem after inspecting the details of the work

After <u>ALL THIS</u> – <u>the first thing</u> he says to the <u>LEADERS</u> of Jerusalem is

"Hey guys, *I am IN THIS WITH YOU*, this is a *OUR wall of testimony* - that must be rebuilt" WE together - are in TROUBLE
WE together - can REBUILD
WE together - can END - OUR disgrace

Nehemiah came - to **BUILD UP**, not **TEAR DOWN** & **EVERY SINGLE** one of us must <u>make this choice</u>

Have we been <u>CALLED</u> by <u>God</u> <u>to BUILD UP</u> or have we been <u>CAPTURED</u> by the <u>Enemy</u> <u>to TEAR DOWN</u>

& **to know** which **BOAT** you're in – **all** you have **to do** is **LOOK at your actions**

Are you <u>Building up</u> the <u>people</u> & the <u>work</u> of God
Or are you <u>Tearing down</u> the <u>people</u> & the <u>work</u> of God

<u>Please</u> – if you are part of <u>ANY ministry</u> of God – <u>PLEASE</u>

be One who BUILDS UP God's People & God's Work

<u>DO NOT</u> be one – that the Enemy uses to <u>TEAR DOWN</u> God's <u>People</u> - & God's <u>Work</u>

Nehemiah says – WE – We're in this together for OUR GOOD - & for God's GLORY

Now - There's **something else** here that is **SO COOL**

Nehemiah **DOES NOT** use External **MOTIVATION** to **call the people** to the work of God

<u>External Motivation</u> in what we use on small children – if you be good I'll give you a piece of candy – We never see Nehemiah use - that type of Motivation

<u>HE NEVER</u> says – Hey, the first one done gets an all expense paid trip to <u>Disneyland</u> (or Babylon)

He doesn't promise a <u>prize</u> or a <u>material reward</u> he uses <u>something</u> much <u>more powerful</u> than that

He makes his case at a much deeper level

he says guys, Our testimony for God is in ruins

& We CAN - REBUILD our Testimony for God

& We **CAN** - NO LONGER be a Disgrace

But we **MUST JOIN TOGETHER** – to rebuild the Wall of Testimony to the GLORY of GOD – <u>AMEN ?</u>

& <u>next week</u> we will see – that this work of God was divided among <u>42 groups</u>

FORTY TWO separate groups of people - ALL joined together to rebuild the Wall around the City of God

42 groups – Each one determined to DO the work that God had PUT before THEM

Knowing that they were working in HARMONY with 41 other groups

All <u>working together</u> for a <u>CAUSE</u> larger than <u>ANY</u> single group individually

& they each one - worried **ONLY** about doing the job that **THEY** - had been given

& they each **knew** that if **they** would **focus** on their own job

that God would **ORCHESTRATE** all the groups together into One **Giant SYMPHONY**

GOD is the Conductor, and each group plays it's part trusting the Conductor – to put it all together

DO YOU SEE IT?

Alan Redpath quotes S.D. Gordon at this point who was a Preacher & wrote 25 books in the early 1900's

S.D. Gordon;

Cooperation increases efficiency in amazing proportions. Two working together in perfect agreement have five-fold the efficiency of the same two working separately . . . <u>A united church</u>, would be an unconquerable church."

Let me just ask you – <u>Why</u> do you think the <u>enemy</u> <u>inspires</u> people to **start division** in the church?

BECAUSE - A united church, would be an unconquerable church

THAT'S why the enemy constantly **stirs up division** & that is why he's **stirring** it up **in this church**, right now

BECAUSE - A united church, would be an unconquerable church

Alan Repath follows up S.D. Gordon's quote with one of his own on this same subject

Alan Redpath:

<u>The greatest menace</u> to revival <u>is the Christian</u> who refuses to work with other people because his views differ on certain matters of Biblical interpretation which are nonessential in relation to evangelism

A united church, would be an <u>unconquerable</u> church A divided church, is already in the process of being <u>conquered</u>

& <u>THAT</u> is why – the enemy will <u>ALWAYS</u> be inspiring someone to **bring division** into the church

So – <u>Nehemiah</u> calls the people to a <u>Higher Calling</u> to a **GOD-SIZED** purpose

- & <u>THEN</u> <u>HE</u> gives them his <u>personal testimony</u> of the <u>HAND of GOD</u> upon his life
- & then we'll see them **IMMEDIATELY Stand** to **JOIN** the work of God

Neh 2:18 - NLT

18 Then I told them about how the gracious hand of God had been on me, and about my conversation with the king. They replied at once, "Yes, let's rebuild the wall!" So they began the good work.

they <u>replied</u> at once "YES! let's rebuild the wall" & So they began the good work.

& next week we'll see the **AMAZING BEGINNING** of the work

an incredible **LAUNCH** of the work of God with *God's supernatural force* - **driving it** the entire way

But . . . that's for next week

For today – we close with <u>Vs's 19-20</u> of Ch 2 & notice please . . .

As soon as Nehemiah calls the people to Rebuild Right Away strong opposition comes against them

<u>Last Week</u> our text ended with <u>OPPOSITION</u> from <u>Sanballat & Tobiah</u> - back in <u>V.10</u>

Neh 2:10 - NLT

10... they were very displeased that someone had come to help the people of Israel.

Opposition **LAST** week – Opposition **THIS** week

& we'll <u>continue to see Opposition</u> thru-out <u>the rebuilding</u> of the Wall of Testimony For when the people of God say "Let us arise and BUILD" the enemies of God say "Let us arise and OPPOSE"

Same **THEN** – Same **NOW**

Now – for <u>V.19</u> I need to go back to the <u>ESV</u>

<u>because</u> I need to point out 2 specific <u>words</u> $\underline{NLT} = thought-for-thought - - \underline{ESV} (\underline{NKJ}) = word-for-word$

Neh 2:19 - ESV

19 But when <u>Sanballat</u> the Horonite and <u>Tobiah</u> the Ammonite servant and <u>Geshem</u> the Arab heard of it, they <u>jeered</u> at us and <u>despised</u> us and said, "What is this thing that you are doing? Are you rebelling against the king?" they asked.

He says the "<u>OPPOSERS</u>" were "<u>Jeering</u>" at them - & "<u>Despising</u>" them

<u>JEERED</u> = To Mock, to repeatedly speak words of ridicule & scorn <u>DESPISED</u> = To raise the head loftily, and look down the nose

& so the <u>trouble makers</u>
<u>held</u> their heads high in <u>false superiority</u> – with <u>noses</u> in the air

& they **mocked** the people of God with **ridicule** & **scorn** . . .

MAN - I have BEEN to that church - & it is ugly

But there's something else very CRITICAL in V.19
Look at the list of those opposing God's work

Back up in <u>V.10</u> – there were only <u>Two Names</u> now how many trouble makers do we count in <u>V.19</u> (3) . . .

The opposition has grown, hasn't it?

& **here's what** we're going to **see** as we **continue**:

<u>Sanballat</u> – was the Governor of Samaria – to the <u>NORTH</u>
<u>Tobiah</u> – was an Ammonite Official – to the <u>EAST</u>
<u>Geshem</u> – (now they've added) – was a Ruler to the <u>SOUTH</u>

So now – <u>the Two</u> original trouble-makers have <u>drawn in a 3rd</u> member a member to the **SOUTH** (Geshem)

& we'll see in Neh CH 4 – that these 3 will add a FOURTH member to their opposition force

The <u>Ashdodites</u> (AKA the Philistines) who controlled the land <u>WEST</u> of Jerusalem

& so – the people of God

WILL BE surrounded – by Opposition

& guys – **those who oppose** the work of God will always **work very hard**

to <u>convince others</u> to <u>join</u> them until they think they have the **people of God** surrounded

But here's what **REALLY** Blows my mind

God continually <u>ALLOWS</u> His people – to be <u>SURROUNDED</u> by those who <u>Oppose</u> the work of God

Isn't it interesting – that **APPARENTLY** God **KNOWS** . . .

that the **Strongest Wall** of Testimony is Built under **CONSTANT OPPOSITION**

Let me repeat that . . .

in a way that we **cannot understand** - God knows

that the <u>Strongest Wall</u> of Testimony, is the one built under <u>CONSTANT OPPOSITION</u>

& so – those who **OPPOSE** the work of God are **actually** a part of what God is **USING** to **make** the Wall of Testimony **EVEN STRONGER**?

HOWEVER - there is still a **VERY HIGH RISK**

that the <u>Trouble-Makers</u> will <u>deceive</u> the people of God into <u>joining</u> their RANKS

PLEASE BE CAREFUL

Just one more thing

Look at their **First THREAT** to Nehemiah (end of V.19)

Neh 2: 19 - NLT

19... "What is this thing that you are doing? Are you rebelling against the king?.."

They're already **setting Nehemiah up** to try to *get him in trouble* with the King

& it's funny – but that's the <u>same thing</u> people do around here when they <u>OPPOSE</u> the work of God here

They always say something like;

I'm going to tell Pastor Chuck on you, then you're really going to get it!!!

I <u>actually</u> had a guy recently <u>CALL</u> Chuck Smith <u>live</u> on the radio to try to <u>damage me</u> & <u>damage</u> this church <u>LIVE</u> – on the air

Alright – **let's wrap up** here

Nehemiah had travelled

from **Susa** (Babylon) to **Jerusalem** (800 Mi)

he had **carefully inspected** the situation, & **the ruins** of the wall

he had <u>carefully planned out</u> what would be needed for the <u>Wall of testimony</u> to be rebuilt

he has **now CALLED the people** to the task of **Rebuilding** the wall of Testimony for GOD . . .

& he is **certainly NOT** going to be *intimidated* by these three **trouble makers**

& so he **addresses them** – <u>directly</u> & <u>sternly</u>

He draws a Line in the Sand

& he makes it clear which side - each of them were on

Neh 2:20 - from the ESV

20 Then I replied to them (the trouble makers), "The God of heaven will make us prosper, and we his servants will arise and build, but you have no portion or right or claim in Jerusalem."

Guys – God is calling His people to re-build a Wall of Testimony

& yes - there will be those - who oppose the work

But <u>even their opposition</u> will be <u>used</u> by God to <u>strengthen</u> the Wall of Testimony

My <u>Sincere Concern</u> – is that those <u>who OPPOSE</u> the work of God <u>want very badly</u>, to <u>enlist</u> some of you, into their <u>plan</u>

<u>Please</u>, don't be <u>deceived</u> into joining someone who is <u>opposed</u> to the work of God

God WILL win, and those who oppose His work, will be left, with only their victims

Please don't be one

Join the work of God in YOUR Life
Throw your hat in the ring - Be ALL IN

Be PART of building something ETERNAL

Everything about this life – is going to **Fade Away**Don't live for **THIS LIFE**

Live for Eternity – **Be PART** of **BUILDING** a **GOD-SIZED Testimony** in your life

$\underline{\textbf{Join}} \text{ the work of God-} \underline{\textbf{You'll be glad}} \text{ you } \underline{\textbf{DID}}$
