- We have new <u>Grandbabies</u> & we love them as Babies But we <u>don't want</u> them to stay babies forever
- & We have all been, or are, Spiritual babies
- & God <u>loves us</u> as Spiritual Babies but He <u>doesn't want</u> us to stay Spiritual <u>Babies</u> forever
- & so today We're going to look at **God's Process** of **Spiritual Growth** & Maturity

Otherwise known as "The Process of SANCTIFICATION"

We often break down the Christian Life into 3 General Areas JUSTIFICATION - The moment we get Saved SANCTIFICATION - Spiritual Growth & Maturing GLORIFICATION - When we leave this earth for heaven

- & Our <u>Spiritual Growth</u> & Maturity falls into that **SANCTIFICATION** Area of the Christian Life
- & so <u>today</u> we're going to <u>look</u> at a bit of the **Apostle Paul's** Spiritual Growth & Maturity

In order to see the **FOUNDATION**, & maybe a bit of the **PROCESS** of **OUR** Spiritual Growth & Maturity . . . **OK**?

Let's Pray

Paul's life started with a very religious upbringing (like some of us)

Acts 22:3 says - ESV

[Paul was] . . . educated at the feet of Gamaliel according to the strict manner of the law of our fathers,

& so - Paul became a strict Pharisee

in Acts 26:5 Paul says - ESV

... according to the strictest party of our religion I have lived as a Pharisee

& his <u>religious zeal</u> was displayed in his intense <u>persecution</u> of the church

Acts 26:9-11 - ESV

9 "I myself was convinced that I ought to do many things in opposing the name of Jesus of Nazareth.

10 And I did so in Jerusalem. I not only locked up many of the saints in prison after receiving authority from the chief priests, but when they were put to death I cast my vote against them.

11 And I punished them often in all the synagogues and tried to make them blaspheme, and in raging fury against them I persecuted them even to foreign cities.

- & then Like a <u>Monster Truck</u> running into a <u>Block Wall</u>
 Paul the <u>Persecuting Pharisee</u> MET <u>JESUS CHRIST</u>
- & all that misguided <u>Religious Zeal</u> was <u>crushed</u> by a face-to-face, personal meeting, with the <u>Risen Lord</u>

The **SAME** type of meeting - that **YOU** can have today

The story is in ACTS CH 9

<u>**Paul**</u> (whose name was <u>SAUL</u>) was on his way to <u>**Persecute**</u> more Christians

& in Acts 9:3-5 we read - ESV

- 3 Now as he went on his way, he approached Damascus, and suddenly a light from heaven flashed around him.
- 4 And falling to the ground he heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?"
- 5 And he said, "Who are you, Lord?" And he said, "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting.
- & <u>THAT</u> was the beginning of a Radically <u>Transformed Life</u> for the Apostle Paul
- & guys we **EACH** need a <u>Damascus Rd Meeting</u> with Jesus Christ
- & we need to Pray that that would **be the Beginning** of a **Radical Transformation** in out lives

Paul went on to become the <u>Greatest Apostle</u>, <u>Missionary</u>, Church Planter, & <u>Divine Scripture</u> writer

he started more <u>CHURCHES</u> than we can count
 he wrote basically <u>HALF</u> the books in the NT
 he became God's #1 TOOL to spur the miraculous growth of the 1st century church

& <u>God wants</u> to do something <u>similar</u> in each of us maybe <u>not QUITE</u> as Dramatic as the Apostle Paul

But God wants to take us

from **PRIDE** to **HUMILITY**

from **DARK** to **LIGHT**

from **DEATH** to **LIFE** . . . Just like He took the Apostle Paul

Eph 2:10 says - ESV

10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

is an <u>ever-deepening relationship</u> WITH Him,

and a <u>supernaturally transformed life</u> **IN** Him

& the **PROCESS** of that <u>ever-deepening relationship</u>, & that <u>transformation</u> . . . is called **SANCTIFICATION**

<u>Sanctification</u> is the Biblical term that describes the <u>Spiritual Growth</u> & <u>Maturing Process</u> of a Disciple

<u>DEF</u> - <u>Sanctification</u> = (Easton's) **Sanctification is the carrying on to** perfection the work begun in regeneration, and it extends to the whole man.

LIT = Separated unto God. Set apart, or devoted, to God

Remember earlier we talked about the THREE General Areas of the Christian Life

<u>JUSTIFICATION</u> - The moment we get Saved <u>SANCTIFICATION</u> - Spiritual growth & Maturing <u>GLORIFICATION</u> - When we leave this earth for heaven The area we're talking about today is **Sanctification The PROCESS** of our Spiritual Growth & Maturity

& this is the <u>exact area</u> of the Christian Life where so many believers get <u>STALLED</u> in

They've <u>Received</u> Christ, & been <u>Born Again</u>, but they <u>never</u> grow out of their <u>diapers</u>

which is <u>sad</u> for them, and sad for the church

do you <u>want know why</u> I believe so many believers get <u>STALLED</u> in the Sanctification Process?

Because MORE than the other two areas of the Christian Life

Sanctification requires us to do OUR PART
& it's in the OUR PART that we get so easily STALLED

Our Part in our Spiritual Growth & Maturity is to;

Actively Abide in Christ
Purposely Grow in His Grace &
Pursue an ever deepening Relationship with Him

As we **humbly** yield to Him as our Lord As we **purposely** set our minds on things above As we **actively** walk in the Spirit . . .

THEN - we "progress" in our **Sanctification** (spiritual growth)

& <u>THAT</u> is why (because it is AS WE) that we get so <u>easily STALLED</u>

& here's an interesting note - Do you know the RESULTS most people are looking for, when they receive Christ

Are actually found in **SANCTIFICATION**Not IN the initial **JUSTIFICATION**

Often a person comes to Christ looking for Peace, Love, Joy, & Happiness

& they think that will **automatically come** to them in their Salvation

But <u>truthfully</u> - it is the Process of <u>SANCTIFICATION</u> that brings the <u>Fruit of The Spirit</u> into our lives, *right?*

So again - in a way I can't dive too much into today,

SANCTIFICATION requires more of an **OUR PART** commitment than either **JUSTIFICATION** or **GLORIFICATION**

we have **more of a ROLE** in our **SANCTIFICATION** - because if we **REFUSE** to Abide in Christ & Grow in Him

Our Transformation will be stalled

But **if** we will **Join God** in the work He is has begun in us

I Promise you - He <u>WILL BE</u> OUR <u>Power</u> to be <u>Transformed</u> & He will <u>complete</u> our <u>Transformation</u>

So <u>let's look</u> at what it takes <u>for us</u> to be ready to do <u>OUR PART</u>

What is the <u>Foundational Commitment</u> in our lives that <u>INSURES</u> that God's work of <u>TRANSFORMATION</u>

Oh, that's a good question, isn't it?

Let's look at how it worked out in the Apostle Paul's Life

<u>Possibly</u> the greatest <u>picture</u> in the Bible of the process of <u>SANCTIFICATION</u> is found in <u>Phil Ch 3</u> (my life's Vs, & this church's Vs)

This CH builds with so much momentum, & emotion
I see it kinda like an Opera (a Rock Opera)
being played out to the crescendo of a full orchestra

Phil Ch 3 is Paul's *personal testimony*

& <u>as a call</u> to <u>live</u> for Christ, it may be unmatched in the Bible - *I LOVE THIS CH*

But it's more than just Paul's Testimony

Phil Ch 3 lays out the desire, & the commitment, we must have in the Sanctification process

it lays out the "<u>Foundation</u>" of the <u>OUR PART</u> for our <u>Spiritual Growth & Maturity</u>

in Phil 3:5 - Paul starts by recounting his position before Christ& his religious Pride

Reading from the **NLT**

Phil 3:5-7 - NLT

5 I was circumcised when I was eight days old. I am a pureblooded citizen of Israel and a member of the tribe of Benjamin—a real Hebrew if there ever was one! I was a member of the Pharisees, who demand the strictest obedience to the Jewish law. 6 I was so zealous that I harshly persecuted the church. And as for righteousness, I obeyed the law without fault. 7 I once thought these things were valuable, but now I consider them worthless because of what Christ has done.

Then - in <u>V.8</u> Paul begins to share - the <u>FOUNDATIONAL MINDSET</u> that brings true <u>Spiritual Growth & Maturity</u>

Phil 3:8-9(a) - NLT

8 Yes, everything else is worthless when compared with the infinite value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have discarded everything else, counting it all as garbage, so that I could gain Christ 9 and become one with him . . .

THIS is the **mindset** - that is the **Foundation** for all *Radical Transformation* in the Christian's life

THIS is the **Mind-Set** from which ALL *True Spiritual Growth* really begins

When we **embrace** the fact that 'by comparison' **NOTHING** equals **the infinite value of KNOWING Christ**

AND - when we count **EVERYTHING ELSE** as **GARBAGE** in order to **Gain Christ**

Those are **Radical Statements**& that's **not** what our **culture** wants to hear

We want to hear that we can have everything else our flesh desires & then we can ADD Christ to that too

But guys - we've <u>all seen</u>
SO MANY Christians <u>trying</u> to live like that

<u>loving</u> the <u>pleasures</u> of this world
& <u>trying to add</u> Christ as a <u>FIRE INSURANCE</u> policy

But <u>let's be honest</u> - the Christians who live that way <u>VERY SELDOM</u> display any <u>Radical Transformation</u> in their lives

But <u>THIS</u> Mindset, in <u>Phil 3:8</u> - THIS Mindset is <u>the beginning</u> of <u>Radical Transformation</u> in a person's life

This is the beginning of **SANCTIFICATION**

& then, in **Phil 3:9(b)** - Paul **comments** on his Former Religious Pride

Phil 3:9(b) - NLT

9... I no longer count on my own righteousness through obeying the law; rather, I become righteous through faith in Christ. For God's way of making us right with himself depends on faith.

That is **the revelation** that **caused** Paul to throw away all his *Religious Efforts* & *Religious Pride*

The revelation that righteousness comes thru FAITH in Christ ALONE

& now - in **Phil 3:10** - comes *my life's vs* & this *church's foundation vs*

AND - if we'll just dig a little bit into the original language

We'll **see** the very Foundation of the **OUR PART** of the **SANCTIFICATION** Process

<u>I promise you</u> - if <u>THIS verse</u> becomes the true prayer of your life the rest of the <u>Sanctification Process</u> - <u>WILL follow</u>

Now - <u>in order</u> to convey the <u>intent</u> of the Original <u>GREEK</u> <u>without</u> having to teach all the "<u>WHYS</u>" of it

I'd like to read **Vs 10** out of the **Amplified Bible**

The <u>Amplified Bible</u> attempts to <u>EXPAND</u> the English language to convey the more colorful & <u>exact Greek</u> Language

& so - <u>the words</u> you see in the [<u>BRACKETS</u>] are the "<u>expanding</u>" or "<u>defining</u>" to <u>convey the sense</u> of the original language

& the <u>Amplified Bible</u> does an incredible job of writing <u>what I have been teaching</u> about this verse

since **MY VERY FIRST** Sunday Morning **Sermon** (on this vs)

I promise you - if you will make this verse
your Daily Prayer & Commitment

You <u>will soon be</u> on the road to <u>Radical Transformation</u> in your life

Phil 3:10 - AMP \rightarrow

Phil 3:10 - AMP

10 [For my determined purpose is] that I may know Him [that I may progressively become more deeply and intimately acquainted with Him, perceiving and recognizing and understanding the wonders of His Person more strongly and more clearly], and that I may in that same way come to know the power outflowing from His resurrection [which it exerts over believers], and that I may so share His sufferings as to be continually transformed [in spirit into His likeness even] to His death, . . .

<u>This Vs</u> conveys - The <u>foundation</u> for the beginning of true <u>Spiritual Growth</u> in your life

That **Foundation** is a **Passionate Commitment** to **KNOW CHRIST**

Paul says - For my determined purpose (passionate commitment) is that I may know Him (my life's verse)

But what do those 5 words **mean**, in the Original Language? - the **AMP Bible** does a great job expanding the meaning

[that I may <u>progressively</u> become more deeply and intimately acquainted with Him, perceiving and recognizing and understanding the wonders of His Person more strongly and more clearly]

<u>THAT</u> is what it means to <u>KNOW</u> Christ <u>in the sense</u> of the <u>GK word</u> Paul uses here - <u>GINOSKO</u>

& then - Paul continues

and that I may - <u>in that same way</u> (progressively & more intimately) come to know the power outflowing from His resurrection [which it exerts over believers], - and that I may so share His sufferings -

as to be continually transformed [in spirit into His likeness even] to His death, . . .

May I progressively & more intimately - KNOW JESUS

AND - the **Power** of His **Resurrection** (in that same way)

AND - the **Fellowship** of His **Suffering** (in that same way)

SO - I will be Continually Transformed in spirit, into His Likeness

This is at the HEART of our Spiritual Growth & Maturity

A Supreme desire to **KNOW Christ** more & more, until we are **Transformed** - into His Likeness (spiritually)

& then - <u>Phil 3:11</u> understood in a "<u>MY LIFE TODAY</u>" sense is an Absolute Bombshell

The NLT translates Phil 3:11

11 so that one way or another (by any means) I will experience the resurrection from the dead!

& we assume this phrase "Resurrection from the dead" refers to the Physical Resurrection - when we leave this life

But listen to how the AMP Bible translates the same Vs

Phil 3:11 - AMP

11 That if possible I may attain to the [spiritual and moral] resurrection [that lifts me] out from among the dead [even while in the body].

Now <u>THAT</u> really makes this Vs apply to our Spiritual Growth & Maturity - Our SACTIFICATION

<u>Listen</u> to what the GK Scholar <u>Kenneth Wuest</u> says about <u>the word</u> used here for "<u>Resurrection</u>"

Kenneth Wuest

The Greek word used here translated "resurrection" is only found here in the New Testament. It is literally, "out-resurrection." Paul is <u>not</u> speaking here of the future resurrection of the physical body of the saint . . . He has in mind the spiritual resurrection of the believing sinner . . . a resurrection out from a state in which he is <u>dead</u> in trespasses and sins to one in which he is <u>alive</u> with the divine life of God . . . This is the goal to which he is striving and the goal to which he has not yet attained.

Now - there are a **couple interpretations** as to whether this word

refers to our "Life after Death" resurrection - or our resurrection from *living DEAD in sin* to *living ALIVE in Christ*

Both **Eph 2** & **Rom 6** refer to this "*Spiritual Resurrection*" where we go from **living DEAD** in our sins to **living ALIVE** in Christ

- & **THAT** is the **GOAL** of our Spiritual Growth
- & THAT is our SANCTIFICATION Process
- & THAT was a VERY COOL study & discovery for me!

Continuing on in Phil Ch 3

where Paul is describing His own **SANCTIFICATION**

Let's **go back** to reading the **NLT**

Phil 3:12 - NLT

12 I don't mean to say that I have already achieved these things (living the resurrection life) or that I have already reached perfection (Maturity). But I press on to possess that perfection for which Christ Jesus first possessed me.

Paul says - I may not be walking perfectly in that *New Resurrection Life*

But <u>I PRESS ON</u> to lay hold of that <u>New Resurrection Life</u>

because THAT is what Christ Jesus has laid hold of me for

& finally - in <u>Vs's 13 & 14</u> - is the <u>GRAND CRESENDO</u> the final piece in this great <u>Rock Opera Testimony</u>

Phil 3:13-14 - NLT → →

Phil 3:13-14 - NLT

13 No, dear brothers and sisters, I have not achieved it, but I focus on this one thing: Forgetting the past and looking forward to what lies ahead,

14 <u>I press on</u> to reach the end of the race and receive the heavenly prize for which God, through Christ Jesus, is calling us.

<u>THAT</u> is the Crescendo of Paul's **TRANSFORMATION** commitment

He says

I <u>FOCUS</u> on <u>ONE</u> thing <u>Forgetting</u> the Past, & <u>Looking Forward</u> to what lies ahead <u>I PRESS ON</u> - to reach the <u>GOAL</u>, the <u>upward call of God</u> in Christ

Guys - Paul is <u>talking about</u> the <u>TRANSFORMATION</u> of his <u>LIFE</u>
It's the <u>TOTAL</u> <u>Transformation Process</u>
shown in those <u>THREE General Areas</u> we've been referring to

<u>JUSTIFICATION</u> - Our Initial Salvation <u>SANCTIFICATION</u> - Spiritual Growth & Maturing <u>GLORIFICATION</u> - Which is the HEAVENLY PRIZE

& guys - If we want experience <u>True Spiritual Growth</u> If we want <u>True Transformation</u> in our lives

Then **THIS** is the commitment that **WE MUST HAVE**

- (v.8) We must count **everything else as worthless**, **when compared to the infinite value of knowing Jesus as our Lord**
- (v.10) Our determined Purpose must be to <u>know Him</u> in a <u>progressively deeper & more intimate way</u>
- (v.11) So that, **whatever it takes**, we can <u>LIVE</u> in **The Resurrection Life**
- (v.12) We must **Lay Hold of** that <u>Resurrection Life</u> that **Jesus Christ has Laid Hold of us for**
- (v.13) Forgetting the Past, & focusing on what lies ahead
- (v.14) We've got to *Press On to the end of the race*to receive the Heavenly Prize for which God is calling us
- Guys <u>THAT</u> is the <u>MINDSET</u> that forms the Foundation of the <u>OUR PART</u> of the <u>Sanctification Process</u>
- & <u>when we</u> fully immerse ourselves into THAT Mindset <u>LOOK OUT !!</u>

Because <u>God</u> has got some <u>Radical Transformation</u> <u>Coming our way</u>

Let's Pray
