NEH 06 – Will You Continue To Build? - Neh 4:1-9

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Today's msg is about <u>Criticism</u> & <u>Opposition</u> that we ALL face <u>when</u> we set out to <u>build a Testimony</u> for God

J. Oswald Sanders Says

in his great book called **Spiritual Leadership**

J. Oswald Sanders

No leader lives a day without criticism, and humility will never be more on trial than when criticism comes

- I <u>can tell you</u> right now I am still "in the process" of <u>learning</u> how to handle the criticism that <u>comes with</u> Spiritual Leadership
- & honestly | Fail at it as much as | Succeed
- So <u>I figure</u> One of Two things is occurring as I teach thru Nehemiah
- **Either 1)** God is having me **teach** what I <u>really need</u> to still **learn**, & **when** I <u>really need</u> to learn it, (which is often the case)
- or 2) God is allowing circumstances in my life, & in this church, that illustrate in Living Color exactly what we're studying
- & <u>If that's the case</u> then I should <u>probably be teaching</u> about the <u>rapture</u>

<u>Opposition</u> is inevitable - & it is inevitably <u>used by God</u> <u>for good</u>, in the building of <u>Every Testimony</u>

God <u>didn't allow</u> the wall in Nehemiah to be built <u>WITHOUT</u> Opposition

Because (in a way we can't understand)
The Opposition was actually PART of what God used

to make sure a Strong Wall of testimony - was built by His people

We're headed into **our 6th Msg** in Neh – & I really **wanted** to *PAUSE* here

& teach a <u>POSITIVE</u> msg about <u>HOW</u> to go about <u>Building</u> the <u>Wall of Testimony</u> in our Lives you know, the <u>Practical</u>, <u>Positive</u> <u>Steps</u>

But - Have you ever had <u>someone</u> start <u>telling</u> you the <u>meaning</u> of a <u>great movie</u> - just <u>half way</u> thru the movie?

Nobody likes that – so I've got to hold back on the HOW until we get further into the movie – does that make sense?

Let's Pray

OK - Our "<u>Real Life</u>" Nehemiah <u>movie</u> <u>began</u> with <u>character development</u> – back in <u>Ch 1</u>

- & then, in <u>CH 2</u> God opened the <u>Door of Opportunity</u> & <u>we felt</u> like – Ok here we go, <u>the plot</u> is really taking off
- & then, still in <u>Ch 2</u>, Nehemiah <u>arrived</u> in Jerusalem, & right <u>there</u>, we meet <u>The Bad Guys</u> for the 1st time

& <u>it looked</u> like they we're going to <u>create</u> some <u>real trouble</u> for God's people

But **Nehemiah** goes **to work** Quietly & when **everything** is finally in order

We had this "Mini Crescendo" 2 weeks ago

where **Nehemiah** Calls the people to **join** him in **Re-Building** the **Wall** of God's Testimony

& the people all respond enthusiastically - YES - We Will Build

<u>but</u> then, <u>again</u> – <u>the Critics</u> show their faces they <u>SCOFF</u> at <u>Nehemiah</u> & at <u>God's people</u>

& they **insinuate** their <u>first threat</u> – like some **street-gang hoods**

& <u>again</u>, we get that <u>sinking feeling</u> that <u>these guys</u> - are just <u>not</u> going away (2 wks ago)

But <u>then last week</u> - (Cue the Triumphant music) - in <u>Ch 3</u> we see the <u>Great Rebuilding Project</u> begin

& we're <u>feeling victory</u> as we <u>relate</u> to God's people as we <u>see them</u> tackle what seemed to be – <u>an Impossible task</u>

& we're like; "Yeah, the good guys are winning"

<u>but then</u> - we realize . . . <u>wait a minute</u><u>the movie</u> isn't even <u>half</u> over yet

it <u>seems</u> like <u>God's People</u> are winning <u>BUT</u> - - there's <u>GOT TO BE more</u> to the plot, right?

<u>Just when</u> we're <u>celebrating</u> with the good guys the music changes

the <u>camera pans</u> just to <u>The Side</u> & <u>there</u> – we see (again) <u>the bad guys</u>

& we realize; "Man, I knew that victory (last week) was too easy, I knew there was more to it than that"

That's WHY I can't stop & tell you the moral of the story yet

We <u>just reached</u> our first <u>victorious crescendo</u> but <u>there is TROUBLE</u> still <u>looming</u> around the corner

& <u>if</u> we were to <u>stop</u> here we might think; "Hey, that was easy – Mission Accomplished – Roll the credits"

EEEhhhh – sorry – way too **unrealistic**

No Victory for God – is **EVER** achieved - **without** facing the **Criticism & Opposition** that always **comes** against it

There is **no** True, **Mature**, **Bible Teacher** who would **ever say** to you

that <u>Building</u> a testimony for God in your <u>life</u>, in your <u>family</u>, or in your <u>church</u>

could **EVER** be **accomplished** - **without conflict**, **without difficulty**, & **without battle** against the enemies of God

It is only the <u>FALSE Teachers</u>, who want to <u>Tickle your ears</u> (to get you to follow them) – who would <u>ever tell you</u> otherwise

<u>Difficulty</u>, <u>Struggle</u>, & <u>Battle</u> with the enemy Are a very <u>REAL part</u> of the Christian life

Especially when you Determine – to build a **Testimony for God**

So - <u>Last week</u> – we left <u>everybody</u> <u>hard at work</u> <u>rebuilding</u> the walls - in the <u>excitement</u> of their initial <u>success</u>

& the **people** must have been **thrilled** to really **begin** to **Rebuild the Wall** for God

But - - There's **just one** little **problem**

1Pet 5:8 - NLT

8 Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He <u>prowls</u> <u>around</u> like a roaring lion, <u>looking</u> for someone to devour.

Now – **<u>Do you think</u>** your spiritual enemy is **<u>PROWLING</u>** around **<u>LOOKING</u>** for some *Professing Christian*

who's so <u>caught up in sin</u>
that his **testimony** is already in total **ruins** – or . . .

Do you think he might be **PROWLING** around **LOOKING** for someone who is *on the verge* of **Building** a **True Testimony** for God ??

I <u>promise</u> you – Your <u>spiritual enemy</u> WILL <u>go to work</u> when you set out – to <u>Build a Testimony</u> for God

& <u>today</u> - In Neh Ch 4 – we're going to look at one of the <u>most discouraging tactics</u> the <u>enemy uses</u> to **Devour** Christians

AND - We're also going to see some STEPSto overcoming this tacticso that we can CONTINUE to Rebuild the Wall in our lives

We've kind of <u>settled into</u> using the <u>NLT</u> in Nehemiah So <u>let's continue</u> with that today

Neh 4:1-2 - NLT

1 <u>Sanballat</u> was <u>very angry</u> when he learned that we were rebuilding the wall. He <u>flew into a rage</u> and <u>mocked</u> the Jews, 2 saying in front of his friends and the Samarian army officers, "What does this bunch of poor, feeble Jews think they're doing? Do they think they can build the wall in a single day by just offering a few sacrifices? Do they actually think they can make something of stones from a rubbish heap—and charred ones at that?"

Sanballat's Role in our movie – as Bad Guy #1

<u>is to</u> create constant <u>Opposition</u> & <u>Criticism</u> of God's People <u>While</u> they are <u>trying</u> to do <u>the work</u> of God

<u>& so</u> - like any good "<u>COP</u>" movie – first, we've got to look at what his <u>MOTIVE</u> might be

We know that somehow - the spiritual enemy has "Captured" Sanballat & Tobiah

to be his mouth-pieces - to do his work of opposing God's People

- & <u>we see</u> here in <u>V.1</u>– Sanballat was <u>VERY ANGRY</u> that the <u>work of God</u> was moving <u>forward</u>
- & it was **his ANGER** that caused him to **fly** into this "**Rage of Criticism**"

But I think it's important to point out

God's Word never really says specifically
 WHY Sanballat & Tobiah were so ANGRY
 to see good things happening for God's people

& that's important because when the Critic (opponent) comes against us

often what is behind their Criticism - is actually ANGER over some other issue that cannot even be seen

Often their critical spirit often comes from some completely unrelated incident

We **see this** all the time in church

because we <u>don't do</u> what they want or <u>give them</u> what they want

& sometimes (not always) - they become our biggest critics

but **that critical spirit** had been "**BIRTHED**" in their **anger** over **some other unrelated matter**

it doesn't mean their attacks don't hurt

but at least we can try to <u>understand</u> - How it is that they've been "<u>Captured</u>" by the enemy - <u>to do his will</u>

- A **great illustration** of this is in that great **Robin Williams** movie **HOOK**
- there's a <u>classic scene</u> where <u>Captain Hook</u>
 has <u>done</u> all these <u>terrible</u> things to <u>Peter Pan</u> & his <u>kids</u>
- & <u>finally</u> after a <u>huge battle</u>
 Peter Pan has <u>Hook</u> where he could easily <u>KILL him</u>
- but <u>before he does</u>, Peter Pan's <u>daughter</u> comes up next to him, & <u>she says</u> – "<u>Oh Daddy - He just needs a mommy</u>"
- & so **Peter Pan** backs down & **doesn't kill** him
- but <u>then</u> <u>Hook</u> attacks again & this time the <u>Huge Alligator</u> <u>EATS him</u> - & in the end, everything <u>works out fine</u>
- So **know this** when **Critics** rise up to **Derail** Your work for God **Try** to remember "They probably just need a mommy"
- <u>However</u> God <u>MAY STILL</u> have a <u>Huge Alligator</u> <u>EAT THEM</u> in the end
- & <u>we'll see</u> that's <u>basically</u> what Nehemiah <u>prays</u> for when he <u>addresses God</u> about his Critics
- So Sanballat is <u>very anger</u> about <u>whatever</u> he's <u>angry</u> about & he "<u>Flies into a Rage</u>" & starts <u>Mocking</u> (criticizing) God's People

& I want you to notice <u>VERY CAREFULLY</u> to <u>WHOM</u> he's <u>doing</u> his criticizing

Neh 4:2 - NLT [video whole vs]

2 <u>saying in front of his friends and the Samarian army officers</u>, "What does this bunch of poor, feeble Jews think they're doing? . . stop there

It's important to say - **NOT ALL Criticism** is <u>bad</u> – or <u>from the enemy</u> we've <u>talked about this</u> before in this series

But the <u>first line of V.2</u> – <u>shows us</u> if Criticism is **Positive** or **Negative**

<u>Positive Criticism</u> is when someone <u>comes to you</u> (& only you) <u>in Love</u>, shows you <u>an error</u> in your life

& <u>then says</u> – <u>I'm here</u> to stand <u>with</u> you, to <u>help</u> you, to <u>support</u> you

THAT is good criticism - & that is the criticism I get from our Elder board - & I respect it & appreciate it

But the first SIGN of NEGATIVE Criticism is when the Critic is talking Primarily to OTHER people which always turns their criticism into Gossip & Slander

& <u>THAT</u> is what we see here in <u>V.2</u> saying in front of his friends and the Samarian army officers . . .

Next - NEGATIVE Criticism

is almost always **General** & **Ambiguous**;

[Cont V.2] - "What does this bunch of poor, feeble Jews think they're doing? Do they think they can build the wall in a single day by just offering a few sacrifices? Do they actually think they can make something of stones from a rubbish heap—and charred ones at that?"

These are <u>Pointless Criticisms</u> thrown out to see if <u>the critic</u> can get <u>the people</u> around them to <u>BITE</u> - <u>to join them</u>

& what happens far too often is - they are successful

I'm <u>not sure why</u> – but <u>human nature</u> is very <u>easily lead</u> into <u>Negative Criticism</u> <u>which is why</u> these people are <u>so dangerous</u> in the church

& <u>SO</u> - guess who's standing <u>NEXT</u> to Sanballat - -<u>TOBIAH</u> – <u>Bad Guy #2</u> - in our real life movie

<u>Imagine</u> the school yard <u>Bully</u> – standing around the monkey bars with all his **pals** – who all **think** the bully's so **cool**

& then **the bully** starts abusing some **poor nerdy kid** walking by on the school yard - - - & then what happens ??

the <u>bully's friend</u> jumps in right? . . . YEAH, that Nerdy kid can't even TIE his SHOES

& that's exactly what we see in V.3

Neh 4:3 – NLT

3 Tobiah the Ammonite, who was standing beside him, remarked, "That stone wall would collapse if even a fox walked along the top of it!"

<u>Isn't that</u> a <u>perfect picture</u> - of a couple of <u>school yard bullies</u> standing around <u>picking on</u> the good guys ??

But **here's the thing** we've got to see

Critics <u>NEVER</u> Criticize <u>ALONE</u>
They <u>MUST</u> have someone to <u>Criticize *TO* & <u>Criticize WITH</u></u>

They have a **some need** - to *draw people* into their **Negativity** – & they **work very hard** at doing that

- & Guys we have <u>GOT to be</u> so careful <u>because</u> it is so <u>easy</u> to get <u>sucked</u> into this TRAP
- & <u>really</u>, to end up being <u>used by the enemy</u> to <u>damage</u> <u>God's people</u>, & <u>God's work</u>
- In <u>the first church</u> we started <u>I got</u> totally sucked into this very trap
- I had <u>become critical</u> of the <u>Pastor</u> that <u>myself & 2 other guys</u> hired for that position
- & man I'm <u>Pretty Sure</u> I became . . . <u>The Greatest Armchair Quarterback</u> the game had ever seen

I believe I was being considered for The Armchair Quarterback Hall of Fame

There was **Just One Problem**

Like **ALMOST ALL** Critics

I had never actually done the job I was criticizing

I had never **ACTUALLY walked** - in that man's **shoes**

- & <u>you know when</u> I stopped forever <u>criticizing</u> that man ??? . . . <u>about a year</u> after God <u>PUT ME</u> in <u>HIS</u> shoes
- & <u>as soon as</u> people started doing <u>to me</u> <u>what</u> I had been <u>doing to him</u>

it totally **HEALED me** of my **Critical Spirit** towards him

So – **Let's be careful** guys

A <u>Critical Spirit</u> can be <u>used</u> by the <u>enemy</u> to do <u>as much damage</u> – as <u>any other sin</u> in the book

& so it <u>seems strange</u> – that we, <u>as Christians</u> are <u>SO SUSCEPTIBLE</u> to it

When we KNOW - we are COMMANDED by God;

To <u>Build</u> One Another up – To <u>Edify</u> One Another To <u>Carry</u> One Another's <u>Burdens</u> Even to <u>Lay Down</u> our <u>Lives</u> for one another

So - <u>Let's be</u> very, <u>very careful</u>
that we <u>don't fall victim</u> to a <u>Critical Spirit</u>
& become "captured" by the enemy, to <u>do his will</u>

OK - <u>so now</u> (finally) – we <u>get to see</u>
<u>How</u> Nehemiah <u>handles</u> these <u>school yard Bullies</u>

at least in this instance

These **Trouble Makers** show up - **ALL thru-out** the book

They <u>never go away</u> - - <u>HOWEVER</u> . . . Nehemiah <u>handles</u> them a <u>Number of Different Ways</u>

I counted 7 different ways Nehemiah handles his Opponents

- #1 FIRST & FOREMOST HE PRAYS to God about them
- #2 He continued the Work God called him to
- #3 He **Ignored** them whenever he could
- #4 He responded to them directly only when they confronted him
- #5 He set a **guard** against them to protect God's people
- #6 He **refused** to get sucked into their traps
- #7 As a <u>Last Resort</u> He responds aggressively to them, by <u>throwing Tobiah's stuff out</u> of the Temple store room & by <u>chasing Sanballat's son-in-law</u> away

<u>The difficult part</u> – is knowing <u>which one</u> of those steps you <u>need to be at</u>, with your <u>critics</u>

Which is why First & Foremost – We MUST PRAY

But here's the M.I.P.

Nehemiah response to his opponents - is in <u>direct proportion</u> to <u>the danger</u> they pose - to the <u>people of God</u> – [REPEAT]

& we'll see that here today

These **Opponents** have already shown up twice

Once Nehemiah <u>Ignored</u> them
Once he <u>Responded</u> to them with a One-Line answer of Faith

But now – they've **stepped up** their attack

they're <u>trying hard</u> - to <u>discourage</u> those who are working for God

& so **Nehemiah** is going to **step up** his **response** to them

Guys - it's always best - if we can;

Pray for our critics
Politely Ignore them - &
Continue the work God has called us to

That is always the **best response** & **most of the time** that is **ALL** that is needed

But when those Critics become a THREAT to the people of God especially from within the body - that raises the stakes

& that is **what we see** here in **Neh Ch 4**

So - FIRST - & FOREMOST - Nehemiah PRAYS

But watch closely how he prays - because it might surprise you

Neh 4:4-5 - NLT

4 Then I prayed, "Hear us, our God, for we are being mocked. May their scoffing fall back on their own heads, and may they themselves become captives in a foreign land!
5 Do not ignore their guilt. Do not blot out their sins, for they have provoked you to anger here in front of the builders."

Pretty **intense prayer**

<u>I believe</u> Nehemiah prays at this <u>level of intensity</u> <u>because</u> the CRITICS are now - <u>right in front</u> of the builders

they're **speaking directly** to those who are **Building the Wall**

They're not in the shadows any more – they're right out in public

- & <u>Nehemiah knows</u> the <u>damage</u> they can do to the <u>Morale</u> & the <u>Faith</u> of God's people
- & so he prays accordingly

HOWEVER - - - what Nehemiah, & the people of God do next is much, much MORE important

in **FACT** – it is the **MOST Important**

Neh 4:6 - NLT

6 So we built the wall. And all the wall was joined together to half its height, for the people had a mind to work.

MAN - that is such a GREAT Vs

In RESPONSE to the Critics Attacks

AND in response - to Nehemiah's Prayer - We read . . . So we built the wall . . . for the people had a mind to work

Guys – If we $\underline{\textbf{Focus}}$ only on $\underline{\textbf{RESPONDING}}$ to our Critics

We will **NEVER**, **EVER**, get around to actually **building** the **Wall of Testimony** for God

We must <u>PRAY</u> for them always
We must <u>IGNORE</u> them when we can
We must <u>RESPOND</u> to them when we have to
We must <u>GUARD</u> the people of God from them

But we must **Remember** - **NONE** of that is **BUILDING** the Wall It's **ALL** Defensive

It <u>has</u> to be <u>done</u> – but we can <u>never allow it</u> to <u>overtake</u> the <u>purpose</u> of God

which is to **Build** the **Wall of Testimony** for *HIS Glory* around our **Lives**, around our **Families**, and around our **Church**

The <u>Critics</u> and the <u>Troubles</u> will come & go
But we **MUST** Always Continue to build the wall

The **BEST RESPONSE** to <u>Criticism & Opposition</u> is to <u>continue building</u> the WALL

& SO – We Built the WALL – For the People had a mind to work

PRAISE THE LORD !!!

Our <u>Spiritual Enemy's</u> Goal – is to <u>use those Critics</u> to **DERAIL** the work of God

& <u>Unfortunately</u>, <u>if at first</u> he <u>doesn't succeed</u> the <u>enemy</u> doesn't just <u>pack up</u> & <u>go home</u>

he **generally** just **STIRS UP** the Trouble Makers to a **Higher Level**

Neh 4:7-8 - NLT

7 But when <u>Sanballat</u> and <u>Tobiah</u> and the <u>Arabs</u> and the <u>Ammonites</u> and the <u>Ashdodites</u> heard that the repairing of the walls of Jerusalem was going forward and that the breaches were beginning to be closed, they were <u>very angry</u>.

8 And they <u>all plotted together</u> to come and fight against Jerusalem and to cause confusion in it.

- & so the <u>once</u> <u>relatively harmless</u> <u>Critics</u> are now <u>PLOTTING</u> with the <u>Real Enemies</u> of God
- to **Join Forces** to come against God's People
- & <u>remember</u> the Critics started at just <u>TWO</u> <u>Sanballat</u> & <u>Tobiah</u> <u>Then</u> - they added <u>Geshem</u>

Now - they add THREE GROUPS

who are all **enemies** of *God's people* & are usually **enemies** of *One another*

Arabs, **Ammonites**, & **Ashdodites** (Philistines)

& <u>so remember</u> what we've <u>said</u> about our <u>response</u> to the opposition

Our Response must be in Proportion to the danger of the attack, right?

Well <u>now</u> – the enemy is <u>gaining</u> more & more <u>Opponents</u> & they are <u>ALL very angry</u>

- & they are **PLOTTING together** to **come & fight** against Jerusalem
- & So **Again** . . .

<u>Critics</u> just being Critics - - <u>Pray</u> for them - & <u>Ignore</u> them <u>Critics</u> address you directly - - <u>Respond</u> to them in <u>Faith & Love</u> <u>Critics</u> plotting together, to <u>Damage</u> God's people & God's Work . . .

Then you - Put up a <u>GUARD</u> Day & Night to <u>protect</u> the people of God from what the **NT** calls – **Wolves** among the **Sheep**

Which is exactly what Nehemiah does in our last Vs today

Neh 4:9 - NLT

9 But we prayed to our God and <u>quarded the city</u> day and night to protect ourselves.

Intensified Opposition to the Work of God Calls for an Intensified Response

At this level – there is more needed than just PRAY for them & IGNORE them

There <u>comes a time</u> when we must <u>set up a Guard</u> to <u>protect the people</u> from the <u>Wolves</u> among the <u>Sheep</u>

<u>Not at first</u> – but in <u>direct proportion</u>

to the <u>increasing danger</u> to the people of God

Prov 21:31 - NLT

31 The horse is prepared for the day of battle, but the victory belongs to the Lord.

We know the Victory belongs to the Lord
But we still need to protect one another from the Wolves

<u>It's like</u> they used to <u>say</u> in the <u>Civil War</u> days "Trust in the Lord boys - & Keep your Powder Dry"

Let's close with a Review of the FOUR steps we seen today to deal with Critics & Opponents to the Work of God in your life

- 1) We must **PRAY** for them always
- 2) We must **IGNORE** them whenever we can
- 3) We must **RESPOND** to them only when we have to
- 4) We must **GUARD** the people of God from them
- & please remember this no matter what

Once the <u>Building</u> of the <u>Testimony of God</u> has <u>started</u> in your life <u>Make certain</u> of one thing . . .

NEVER, **NEVER** – Let anyone **STOP** that building

Never let your <u>Critics</u> or <u>Opponents</u> <u>Demoralize</u> you or <u>Derail</u> you from <u>Building a Testimony</u> in your life

& Remember Also

The <u>Ultimate Response</u> to those <u>Critics</u> & <u>Opponents</u>

is that you **Continue** to **Serve God** - & **Build the Wall No MATTER What**

Let's Pray

Let me say – as you <u>sit alone</u> with God

If you are <u>developed</u> a <u>Critical Spirit</u> today, you have a <u>real problem</u> in your life

Some of your criticism may even be RIGHT

But that's **not the question**

The question is – has your criticism

Built up the people around you – or

Torn down the people around you

God commands us, to **build** one another up,

to **strengthen** & **support** one another,

to **carry** one another's burdens

Has your Critical Spirit – Done **ANY** of those things?

Negative Criticism is a very, very dark place to live

Some <u>wives</u> here today have such a Critical Spirit that you are <u>systematically tearing down</u> your home

Some <u>husbands</u> here today – Are so Negative & Critical that you are <u>destroying</u> both your <u>spouse & your children</u>

Some **people** here – with Critical Spirits – are <u>systematically damaging</u> the <u>body of Christ</u> - & the <u>work of God</u>

Please, <u>let's allow God</u> to reveal to us – our own <u>Critical Spirit</u> & Let's **Repent** to Him - & ask Him to **heal** us

Rom 3 says ALL have sinned & fall short of the Glory of God We each can speak to God on this matter today

& Heavenly Father – I especially Pray for those here – who have not yet made you their Savior & their Lord . . .
