Top - Messages From The Cross - Luke 23:33-46

Last week we looked at Jesus AS He was Approaching the cross

We <u>looked</u> at His <u>Love</u> - <u>SHOWN</u> in His <u>Radical Humility</u> - <u>SET</u> in the events of the <u>night before</u> the Cross

& that <u>set the stage</u> for the <u>single darkest day</u> of all time the day that <u>Jesus</u> Christ would <u>bear the sin</u> of the world

<u>Since</u> the <u>Triumphal Entry</u> - the <u>enemies</u> of Jesus had been <u>plotting</u> and <u>scheming</u> his <u>Murder</u>

While <u>Jesus</u> had been <u>preparing</u> for <u>the pre-ordained time</u> - that would <u>SHATTER</u> the <u>hold</u> of <u>Sin & Death</u> on all of <u>Creation</u>

Let's Pray - before we look at that "**Eternity Changing**" Day

When the time was RIGHT

Jesus was arrested in the Garden

Tried illegally in the shadows

Presented as a criminal

Beaten mercilessly, **flogged** to within **an inch** of His life

Demeaned, **Belittled**, **Mocked**, **Ridiculed**, & **Spat** upon

<u>Isaiah 50:6 Prophesied of Jesus (ESV)</u>

6 I gave my back to those who strike, and my cheeks to those who pull out the beard; I hid not my face from disgrace and spitting.

& <u>that</u> is <u>exactly</u> what He <u>did</u> - thru out the <u>displays</u> of <u>ruthless</u> <u>brutality</u> - He <u>gave himself</u> to those who would put Him on <u>the Cross</u>

Isaiah 53:7 (ESV)

7 He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth; like a lamb that is led to the slaughter, and like a sheep that before its shearers is silent, so he opened not his mouth.

he opened not his mouth . . . Meaning He never spoke in His Own Defense - He never corrected His accusers

He never <u>called down</u> the <u>legions of Angels</u> that <u>were</u> at His <u>Beck & Call</u> at every moment

But Jesus **DID speak** - He **spoke ON the CROSS**

He **spoke carefully** - & **purposefully** & with **Great Eternal meaning** each time

After the <u>humiliating brutality</u> - & <u>barely</u> making the <u>Agonizing Trek</u> to <u>Golgatha</u> under the <u>weight</u> of <u>his own Cross</u>

Jesus then <u>Laid Himself</u> on that <u>Cross</u> - & the <u>Roman Soldiers</u>
Drove <u>Railroad Spikes</u> through His <u>Wrists & Feet</u>

Sending <u>Excruciating Pain</u> like <u>Electrical SHOCK</u> continually thru His <u>body</u> from the <u>severing</u> of the <u>crucial nerves</u>

<u>Then</u> the <u>cross</u> was <u>raised</u> - & <u>Dropped</u> into the <u>hole</u> - <u>Dislocating</u> his <u>arms</u> and <u>shoulders</u> - & making it more & more <u>difficult to breath</u>

& then - Jesus spoke His Last Words

He spoke <u>SEVEN times</u> from the <u>Cross</u> & <u>every word</u> had <u>Eternal Meaning</u> - <u>Every word</u> was a <u>Sermon</u>

We're <u>often intrigued</u> by the <u>last words</u> of a <u>person Dying</u> -But How <u>much MORE</u> - when that <u>person</u> is <u>Jesus Christ</u> & <u>All of Eternity</u> is about to be <u>changed</u> - on the Cross

The 1st Msg from the Cross - was a Msg of 1) Forgiveness Offered

The first words from Jesus on the Cross came just AS

His **Murderers** were **Driving Spikes** into His **body**

& **<u>Dropping</u>** the **<u>Cross</u>** with a bone breaking **<u>THUD</u>** into its **<u>hole</u>**

& as the mockers were reviling & shouting insults at Him

AS the Blood of the Sacrificial Lamb began to flow Our Great High Priest was already interceding for us

These <u>first words</u> of <u>Jesus</u> from the Cross <u>are all-encompassing</u>

They **encapsulate** the **REASON** for the **CROSS** - & They **reveal** the **REASON** Jesus Christ **came to Earth** in the 1st place

& they <u>were spoken</u> at the <u>moment</u> of the <u>most excruciating pain</u> - <u>AND</u> when the <u>evilness of man</u> was at a <u>frenzied</u> level

Read with me - the SURROUNDING Vs's - of this FIRST Statement

Luke 23:33-37 (ESV)

33 And when they came to the place that is called The Skull, there they crucified him, and the criminals, one on his right and one on his left.

34(b) . . . And they cast lots to divide his garments.

35 And the people stood by, watching, but the rulers scoffed at him, saying, "He saved others; let him save himself, if he is the Christ of God, his Chosen One!"

36 The soldiers also mocked him, coming up and offering him sour wine

37 and saying, "If you are the King of the Jews, save yourself!"

In the <u>Crucible</u> of the <u>Evilness</u> of <u>Mankind</u>
In the most <u>Excruciating Physical Pain</u> inflicted by Man In the face of the **Vile Insults** of His **Murderers** . . .

Jesus PRAYED

He prayed in Luke 23:34 (ESV)

34 . . . "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do." . . .

We're you there?

We're you there when Jesus Prayed "Father, forgive them . . . "

Was it **YOUR Sinfulness**? - Was it **YOUR Evilness**? That **Jesus** was **interceding** for?

Romans 6:6 (ESV)

6 We know that our old self was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing . . .

Jesus was praying for those "Physically Involved"

But <u>His PRAYER</u> was <u>for ALL</u> who would <u>ever RECEIVE</u> the <u>Gift</u> of His <u>Salvation</u> - <u>Including YOU</u>

It was the **Roman Mallet** that **drove** the **Spike** thru His Hand But it was **YOUR SIN** that **PUT HIM** on the **Cross** & it was **His LOVE for YOU** that **Held Him** there

Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do

Those who **Physically INFLICTED** the **Agony** of the Cross **Didn't know** they were **Murdering** the **Son of God**

& maybe today - YOU are not aware - that it was YOUR SIN that actually PUT the Son of God ON that Cross

THIS is WHY Jesus came to Earth

THIS is WHY Jesus was on the CROSS

He was there **IN YOUR PLACE**

Paying the Full Penalty for YOUR Sin

Dying in **Your Place** - So that **you** would **Never HAVE to**

The 2nd Msg of the Cross - was a Msg of

2) Eternal Life - Guaranteed

<u>Maybe</u> that <u>1st Prayer</u> of Jesus - Would <u>PEIRCE YOUR HEART</u> - <u>Like it Did</u> to <u>ONE</u> of the <u>Thieves</u> who were <u>Crucified</u> with Him

It <u>seems</u> like (initially) <u>both criminals</u> may have <u>joined</u> in the mocking **But hearing** this **Prayer of Forgiveness** from Christ

Softened the heart of **ONE** of these **Hardened Criminals**

Luke 23:39-42 (ESV)

39 One of the criminals who were hanged railed at him, saying, "Are you not the Christ? Save yourself and us!"
40 But the other rebuked him, saying, "Do you not fear God, since you are under the same sentence of condemnation?
41 And we indeed justly, for we are receiving the due reward of our deeds; but this man has done nothing wrong."
42 And he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."

This thief has a serious problem that should scream LOUDLY to each of us

Arthur Pink says:

He could **not WALK** in **Righteousness because** he had a **NAIL** in his **feet**

He <u>could not perform</u> any <u>Good Works</u> <u>because</u> he had <u>NAILS</u> in his <u>hands</u>

He could not live a better life - because he was DYING

This thief was Utterly HELPLESS - & SO are YOU & I

The **truth is** - We are in **the same place** as this **Thief**

When it **comes** to **DOING something** in order to be **accepted by God** - we are **absolutely**, **completely**, & **utterly HELPLESS**

This **thief KNEW** he was **dying** - & **he knew** he had **only ONE HOPE** - **to BELIEVE** that **Jesus Christ IS** who He **says He IS**

& <u>in response</u> to the <u>Prayer of Faith</u> from this <u>thief</u> <u>Jesus spoke</u> His <u>second words</u>

Luke 23:43 (ESV)

43 And [Jesus] said to him, "Truly, I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise."

No Chance to get **Baptized** or take **Holy Communion**

No Chance to be a **member** of the "**Only Right**" church

No Stop Off in Purgatory - No Nap in Soul Sleep

No ANYTHING that we **like** to **Connect to Salvation**

NOTHING but FAITH - NOTHING but FAITH - NOTHING but FAITH

A <u>FAITH</u> that was <u>Willing</u> to <u>Speak up</u>
Out of a <u>CONVICTION</u> for <u>WHO</u> Jesus Christ <u>IS</u>

& in <u>that moment</u> - a Great <u>Eternal Exchange</u> was <u>taking place</u> between <u>Jesus Christ</u> & that <u>Sin-Filled Thief</u>

JESUS was TAKING ON that thief's SIN & GIVING that Thief - His own RIGHTEOUSNESS

& His promise to YOU today - is AS SURE as it was - to that THIEF

If you will Recognize - you are "Helpless" to save yourself & look in Faith to Jesus Christ on the Cross

Jesus will **GIVE YOU** - His **Forgiveness** & His **Righteousness** just **like** He did this **thief**

In <u>the picture</u> of the <u>Two Thieves</u> - is <u>the message</u> that <u>each</u> of us <u>MUST CHOOSE</u> whether to <u>RECEIVE</u> the <u>Offer of Forgiveness</u> in Jesus Christ - <u>OR NOT</u>

The 3rd Msg from the Cross - was a Msg of 3) Compassion

30 yrs earlier - In <u>Luke Ch 2</u> - when <u>Joseph & Mary</u> brought the baby <u>Jesus</u> into the <u>Temple</u> to <u>dedicate him</u> according to Jewish Custom

An <u>old Prophet</u> named <u>Simeon</u> was there - to <u>whom</u> the Lord had <u>promised</u> he would <u>not die</u> until he had <u>seen the Messiah</u>

That day <u>Simeon took Jesus</u> into <u>his arms</u> & <u>spoke to God</u> - saying he was now <u>ready to die</u> - because he had <u>seen the Messiah</u>

Then he <u>prophesied</u> about <u>Jesus</u> & the <u>Nation of Israel</u> - & <u>ended</u> his <u>prophecy</u> with a very <u>direct statement</u> to <u>MARY</u>

In Luk 2:35 he said - And a sword will pierce your very soul

Mary was now experiencing the PIERCING of that Sword

Of the few there at the cross who loved Jesus - among them no agony could compare to Mary His Mother

The face she kissed as a baby was now spit upon & marred beyond recognition

The hair she combed was now matted with blood from the crown of thorns

Her **son hung helplessly**, & **innocently**, as a **criminal mocked**, **abused**, **beaten**, & dy**i**ng

& there was nothing she could do

& Jesus fully aware & in control - Met His mothers EYES

As they **both remembered** a **childhood** of **Loving Care Jesus SPOKE** his **Third words** from the Cross

<u>Mary</u> was <u>standing</u> with the <u>Apostle John</u> & <u>other women</u> including John's own mother

& in John 19:26-27 we read (ESV)

26 When Jesus saw his mother and the disciple whom he loved standing nearby, he said to his mother, "Woman, behold, your son!"

27 Then he said to the disciple, "Behold, your mother!" And from that hour the disciple took her to his own home.

tho dying in the most Excruciating Pain - AND knowing the Full Judgment of God was about to be poured out upon Him

Jesus had such great compassion on his mother -

& he committed her care to his best friend - the Apostle John

The 4th Msg from the Cross - was a Msg of

4) Jesus, Forsaken In OUR PLace

It was TIME

In these incredible Next Words from Jesus on the Cross -

Was the <u>culmination</u> of the <u>Plan of Redemption</u> <u>Worked out</u> before the <u>foundation of the World</u>

THIS was the Turning Point -

This moment makes God's Plan of Salvation Possible

The Moment Jesus Dreaded Most

& the **moment God** the Father **Dreaded Most**

But if THIS moment had NOT occurred -

you & I would still be Lost in our Sin & Separated from God

It was High Noon - but at this Moment DARKNESS fell over the land

This is **the moment** - that **1Peter 1** says **even** the **Angels can't** fully **understand**

Matthew 27:45-46 (ESV)

45 Now from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land until the ninth hour.

46 And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?" that is, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"

(eh-lee, eh-lee, le-mah, sa-bakh-than-ee)

THIS is the Moment - that 2Cor 5:21 says

He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us

THIS is the Moment - that God poured out the Full Judgment required to PAY for our sin - upon the Sinless Christ

Jesus Christ was FORSAKEN by God - In our Place so that we would Not have to be

Galatians 3:13 (ESV)

13 Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us . . .

Jesus was Forsaken by God on the Cross
So that we could be Forgiven By God for Eternity

& **we** are **either going** to be **SAVED**by Acc**ep**ting **Christ's PAYMENT** in our place . . .

Or **God** will be **Forced to Forsake us** because of **our Sin**

THIS was <u>Jesus Experiencing</u>
the <u>JUDGMENT of God</u> upon sin - <u>IN OUR PLACE</u>

For God to REMAIN God - This Judgment MUST come upon SIN

It either falls on Christ in OUR PLACE

Or we CHOOSE to Receive that Judgment ourselves

We must NOT Take Our Sin LIGHTLYit REQUIRES God's JUDGMENT

& <u>THIS</u> is the <u>moment</u> - Jesus <u>TOOK</u> that <u>Judgment</u> - <u>IN our PLACE</u>

The 5th Msg from the Cross - was a Msg of

5) The Humanity of Jesus

In JOHN 19:28 - Jesus said simply "I THIRST"

Just as it was Prophesied in Psalm 22:14–15 (ESV)

14 I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint; my heart is like wax; it is melted within my breast; 15 my strength is dried up like a potsherd, and my tongue sticks to my jaws; you lay me in the dust of death.

Psa 22 details the <u>specific effects</u> of <u>Crucifixion</u> miraculously well & <u>this is exactly</u> what <u>Jesus</u> was <u>feeling</u> - as <u>Fully MAN</u>

Jesus Was Fully God AND Fully Man

He suffered the Unimaginable Pain of Paying for our Sin - as GOD & he suffered the Unimaginable Pain of the Crucifixion as MAN

God entered into YOUR Suffering - Fully Human - In Fact Heb 2:10 says He was made PERFECT Thru His Suffering

BUT - Was there another Reason Jesus said "I Thirst" ??

Let's read ALL of - John 19:28 (NKJV)

28 After this, Jesus, knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the Scripture might be fulfilled, said, "I thirst!"

Watch carefully - in Psa 69 - A PROPHECY of Jesus it says in

Psalm 69:21 (ESV)

21 . . . and for my thirst they gave me sour wine to drink.

Now let's finish reading in

John 19:29 (ESV)

29 A jar full of sour wine stood there, so they put a sponge full of the sour wine on a hyssop branch and held it to his mouth.

trust me - a <u>little Vinegar</u> on a <u>sponge</u> - <u>wasn't going</u> to help the <u>Crucifixion Thirst</u> of <u>Jesus</u>

But it was <u>critically important</u> - <u>every Prophecy</u> about this moment be <u>FULFILLED</u> - so <u>Jesus made sure</u> - <u>this Prophecy</u> was <u>Fulfilled</u>

The 6th Msg from the Cross - was a Msg of

6) FINALITY

IN ONE Greek Word - Lies the Assurance of our Salvation

ONE WORD says - If we will put our Faith in Jesus Christ - our debt to God will be completely & forever PAID IN FULL

In Fact <u>this Word</u> was used to <u>Stamp Records</u> Of <u>Debt</u> "<u>PAID IN FULL</u>"

If you belong to Jesus Christ (or If you WILL)

He **cried out** this **WORD** on **YOUR BEHALF**

TETELESTAL!! - IT - IS - FINISHED !!!!

Your Debt has been Paid in Full & Taken OFF the Books

We read in John 19:30 (ESV)

30 When Jesus had received the sour wine, he said, "It is finished," . . .

The Work of **YOUR Salvation** Was **FINISHED The PRICE** to Pay **YOUR DEBT** in **FULL** - **Was PAID**

IT - IS - FINISHED !!!!

You <u>cannot ADD</u> <u>one thing</u> to the <u>Finished work</u> <u>of Salvation</u> in <u>Jesus Christ</u>

No More than that <u>pitiful Thief</u> could have <u>come down</u> & <u>added something</u> to <u>HIS Salvation</u>

No <u>Religious Ritual</u> - <u>No Observance</u> - No <u>certain church</u> - Not <u>speaking in tongues</u> - or <u>being baptized</u> a certain way or <u>anything else</u> - <u>No thing</u> - <u>No thing</u> - <u>Nothing</u>

You either **RECEIVE** the **FINISHED** work of **Jesus Christ** completely **BY FAITH** - Or you **REJECT it** - (that's IT)

When <u>Jesus Christ</u> finished the work of <u>OUR salvation</u> -He said - IT - IS - FINISHED! - & <u>We</u> Should <u>BELIEVE HIM</u>

The 7th Msg from the Cross - was a Msg of 7) RELEASE

For the <u>First 3 hrs</u> - Jesus <u>suffered</u> under the <u>Hands of Men</u>
For the <u>Second 3 Hrs</u> He <u>suffered</u> under the <u>Wrath of God</u>

Finally - Luke 23:46 (ESV)

46 Then Jesus, calling out with a loud voice, said, "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit!" And having said this he breathed his last.

& we read at this point from Matthew 27:51-54 (ESV)

51 And behold, the curtain of the temple was torn in two, from top to bottom. And the earth shook, and the rocks were split. 52 The tombs also were opened. And many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised,

. . .

54 When the centurion and those who were with him, keeping watch over Jesus, saw the earthquake and what took place, they were filled with awe and said, "Truly this was the Son of God!"

There was NO WAY that the EARTH Could NOT Respond to this most significant moment of all of Time

The EARTH - & the Believers IN it - HAD to Respond

AND - - It was at **THIS MOMENT** - **ON this DAY** - that the **Passover Lambs** were **being Killed** at the Temple

& it was at this Moment that the Proclamation of John the Baptist came to Pass - when he said in

John 1:29 (ESV)

29 . . . "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!

THIS was the Lamb of God -

& THIS was Him - PAYING for the Sin of the World

This work was Now Finished - ALL of creation was responding

& Jesus Committed His Spirit into the Hands of the Father

No One TOOK His life from Him -

This was **PLANNED** - From the **Foundation of the World**

... & now - that work was over

Oh yeah, there's still the Conquering Death & the Grave part

- We'll get to that Next Sunday

But that is a Foregone Conclusion -

Because **NO Grave** can hold the **Author of LIFE**

SIN had been Conquered Death & the Grave WOULD BE Conquered

The **only thing** now - is for **YOU to DECIDE**

Whether to ACCEPT or REJECT

the **Gift of Salvation** Jesus **Died that day** to Give you

IF you will put your Faith in Jesus - You will Never Die

Because on the cross that day - Jesus died IN YOUR PLACE
& Paid the Full Penalty for your Sin

& <u>IF</u> you <u>Reject</u> His <u>Free Gift of Salvation</u>

The Bible does <u>not offer</u> you <u>any other way</u> to be <u>saved</u>

Acts 4:12 (ESV)

12 And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.

Just knowing about the SEVEN TIMES Jesus Spoke from the Cross

Should be enough - for us to Clearly SEE our NEED for a Savior

& to Gladly Receive the Free Gift of Salvation
That God has offered us in Jesus Christ
