#### Neh 15 - Four Marks of True Revival - Neh 9:1-38

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# Just to clarify right up front

Revival is **NOT** for **UN-believers**Revival is for **Believers** 

# **Evangelism** is for **unbelievers**

Revival is <u>RESTORING</u> believers to a Joyful & Right relationship with God

# Let me say that again Revival is RESTORING believers to a Joyful & Right relationship with God

& We are in the Midst of an Incredible Revival in the Book of NEH

In began in <u>CH 8</u> soon after the wall was finished & it is <u>STILL rolling</u>

& seeing this **Revival** in the people of God has been **really exciting** for me

Because we have been going thru a REBUILDING here as we REFOCUS our Ministry on Making Disciples

- & <u>what we see</u> in Nehemiah is the <u>Rebuilding</u> of God's people into **FULL-TIME FOLLOWERS** of God in a word **DISCIPLES**
- & it is this **Rebuilding** of the People into Followers of God *THAT* **brings Revival**
- & Restores the people to a Joyful & Right Relationship with GOD

Which is *Our Exact purpose* here & so *today* in Nehemiah – we see <u>FOUR Marks of True Revival</u>

These are the **EVENTS** (steps, if you will) that **Restore God's People** to a Joyful & Right Relationship with Him

My <u>outline</u> is adapted from <u>Alan Redpath</u> today whose teaching I Greatly Appreciate

Here are the **FOUR MARKS of TRUE REVIVAL** we'll see today

Repentance & Brokenness

Remembering God's Goodness

Recognizing our True Condition

Renewing our Obedience

That's **the PATH** we'll be **walking** in Nehemiah today

# Let's Pray

Let me just **remind you** – I'm **teaching** Nehemiah out of the **NLT** just to give you a **FEEL** for that Translation

But I haven't **SWITCHED** Teaching **Translations** I'm still **committed** to teaching from the **ESV** 

so **don't stop** bringing your **ESV's** cause I'll **be going back** to the **ESV** when Nehemiah's done

Alright - **Let's start** with a quick **review**:

The reading of the law was on the 1st day of 7th mo

On the <u>2nd day</u> of 7th mo - the <u>leaders</u> studied the Bible together Then <u>Feast of Tabernacles</u> began on <u>15th day</u> & lasts <u>7 days +1</u> – so it lasts thru the <u>23rd day</u> of the 7<sup>th</sup> mo.

- & <u>Today</u>, as we pick it up it is the <u>24th day</u> Or . . . <u>THE VERY NEXT DAY</u> (Oct 31 in the NLT)
- & so this has been a Mind-Boggling Marathon Revival

#### Nehemiah 9:1 - NLT

1 On October 31 (24th day of the 7th mo) the people assembled <u>again</u>, and this time they fasted and dressed in burlap (sackcloth) and sprinkled dust on their heads.

The **FIRST MARK** of True Revival is **Repentance & Brokenness** 

<u>All thru</u> the Bible we see <u>Fasting</u>, <u>Sackcloth</u>, & <u>Ashes</u> (dust) as clear signs of <u>Mourning</u>, <u>Repentance</u>, & <u>Brokenness</u>

Fasting is an outward sign of an inward commitment

It's a sign that our Spiritual Need is greater than our Physical Need

# It's a sign to God (& to us)

that we're willing to <u>sacrifice</u> our <u>Physical</u> needs in order to **focus** completely on our **Spiritual** Needs

<u>Fasting</u> is a sign that we're willing to <u>crucify</u> our flesh in order to be **devoted** to our spiritual needs – (make sense?)

- & <u>Fasting</u> is often connected to times of <u>Mourning</u> & <u>Brokenness</u> & to <u>Crying out</u> to God in Great <u>NEED</u>
- & so the people start with **FASTING**

Next, they dressed in Burlap (Sackcloth)
This was also a classic sign of Repentance & Mourning

**Sackcloth** is very **coarse** cloth – made from **goats hair** & **worn** next to the **skin** or tied around the waist

it was <u>designed</u> to be <u>uncomfortable</u> & it symbolized <u>Humility</u> & <u>Brokenness</u> & <u>Mourning</u>

Next - <u>Dust</u> – which (in this use) is <u>synonymous</u> with <u>ASHES</u> was <u>commonly</u> used IN times of <u>Deep Repentance</u> & <u>Mourning</u>

<u>People</u> would put <u>dust</u> or <u>ashes</u> on their heads to symbolize the <u>lowest</u> & <u>most humble</u> position before God

it was a picture of **deserving judgment** (ashes) or being at the **lowest place possible** (dust of the earth)

You know - **So often** we see Christians in **great need** of **Repentance** & **Brokenness** before God

but <u>instead</u> they try to go <u>toe-to-toe</u> with God & <u>demand answers</u> from Him

Or they try to <u>force God</u> to do things their way <u>As if</u> God could be <u>FORCED</u> – by our <u>WILL</u>

**Contrary** to that *False Teaching* . . .

The **FIRST MARK of True Revival** – is a clear sign that we understand our **RIGHT position** before God

that we are <u>LOW</u> - & He is <u>HIGH</u> that we are <u>HUMBLED</u> - & He is <u>EXALTED</u> that we are **REPENTANT** - & Deserving of **His Judgment** 

**THAT** is the First Mark of **True REVIVAL** 

Alan Redpath says: "God only plants the seed of His life in a soil which has been broken up by repentance."

Next - In <u>V.2</u> - we see the people make a <u>SERIOUS Commitment</u>

<u>AND</u> begin to <u>confess their sins</u> – Which is Part of Repentance

#### Nehemiah 9:2 - NLT

2 Those of Israelite descent separated themselves from all foreigners as they confessed their own sins and the sins of their ancestors.

This 'Separation from all foreigners' goes back to the command God gave Israel before entering the Promised Land

& it is the same as the <u>NT</u> command in <u>2Cor 6:14</u> for <u>Believers</u> not to be <u>Unequally Yoked</u>

<u>Meaning</u> we are not to be "<u>BOUND TO</u>" or "<u>PARTNERED</u>" with <u>unbelievers</u>

& so they <u>separated themselves</u> from Foreigners - <u>& notice this</u> they <u>confessed</u> their <u>own</u> sins <u>AND</u> the sins of their <u>ancestors</u>

To Confess means "To Agree with God"

& so <u>here</u> the people are <u>Agreeing</u> with God about <u>their own sin</u>, & the <u>sins</u> of their <u>ancestors</u>

# Confession is a critical part of our Repentance & Brokenness

Because it is our **PRIDE** that prevents us from **AGREEING** with God about our Sin

& **PRIDE** will always be the **number one thing** that **separates** us from God

Confession ALSO means to agree with God about WHO HE is & WHAT He's done

& we're going to see a TON of that type of confession in a minute

& so - Repentance - Humility - & Confession of sin is ALWAYS the starting point of True REVIVAL

NEXT – we get an idea of how COMMITTED the people were to this Revival

Remember – These people have <u>ALREADY been</u>
Responding to God's Word - & Worshipping God – for 3 WEEKS

Now – in <u>V's.3-4</u> – we get a <u>An Overview</u> – of what happened on this <u>DAY AFTER</u> the <u>Feast of Tabernacles</u>

Nehemiah 9:3 – NLT  $\rightarrow$ 

#### Nehemiah 9:3 - NLT

3 They remained standing in place for three hours while the Book of the Law of the LORD their God was read aloud to them. Then for three more hours they confessed their sins and worshiped the LORD their God.

Like we saw in **Ch 8** – this is a **summary statement** of **all** that happened that day

#### This was A 6 HOUR EVENT

3 Hrs of the public reading of God's Word - & 3 Hrs of Confession & Worshipping God

& while, in today's culture, a 6 hour church service would be considered a HOSTAGE SITUATION . . .

Besides the 6 HOUR part – if you think about it
We follow the same basic format in Worship Services today

# Our Worship Service is basically split in HALF

HALF the <u>Proclaiming of God's Word</u> - & HALF Worshipping God & Confession of Sin

#### So – at the core of what we do here each Sunday

it's **basically the same** as **Nehemiah's** Worship Service over **400 years** Before Christ – & **that is Very Cool** 

& <u>then</u> - even what we see in <u>V.4</u> we <u>hope</u> you <u>see</u> <u>here</u> in our services

# Nehemiah 9:4 - NLT

4 The Levites—Jeshua, Bani, Kadmiel, Shebaniah, Bunni, Sherebiah, Bani, and Kenani—stood on the stairway of the Levites and cried out to the LORD their God with loud voices.

These Levites stood on a Raised platform & Cried out to the Lord with Loud Voices

Proclaiming God's Word
 & encouraging the people in Worship & Confession

& <u>that's exactly</u> what we do here – we just <u>have the convenience</u> of an <u>incredible Sound Team</u> to help us w/ - the "<u>Loud Voices</u>" part

Alright – <u>NOW</u> - Remember I said that <u>CONFESSION</u> also means to <u>agree with God</u> about <u>WHO</u> He is - & <u>WHAT HE's</u> done?

Well – that takes us to - the **SECOND Mark** of True Revival **Remembering God's Goodness** 

& to begin this 2<sup>nd</sup> MARK - in Vs. 5 – we see again exactly what we call this congregation to at the beginning of every single service

When we say "Let's stand up & Praise the Lord – For He ALONE is Worthy to be Praised – So LET'S PRAISE HIM . . . "

When we do that – It's <u>not</u> <u>Motivational Hype</u> It is a Scriptural <u>CALL TO WORSHIP</u>

& it's **exactly** what we see in **V.5** 

#### Nehemiah 9:5 - NLT

5 Then the leaders of the Levites—Jeshua, Kadmiel, Bani, Hashabneiah, Sherebiah, Hodiah, Shebaniah, and Pethahiah—called out to the people: "Stand up and praise the LORD your God, for he lives from everlasting to everlasting!" Then they prayed: "May your glorious name be praised! May it be exalted above all blessing and praise!

<u>THAT</u> is <u>Exactly</u> what we call you to – & <u>Exactly</u> what we Pray - <u>EVERY Single Sunday</u> at the beginning of the Service

Let's stand up & PRAISE the LORD – Because of WHO He IS - & WHAT HE's done

& we pray – "Lord, may your Glorious Name be praised, & may it be exalted above ALL ELSE"

Right ?? Haven't you heard me say almost those EXACT words??

So <u>next time you</u> hear me **start** the service like that Just KNOW - - that is very scriptural

Alright – Now - starting in <u>V.6</u> – we have very probably the **LONGEST Public Prayer** in the OT

But before we dive in - I need to point out a couple things

One – Notice that God's People <u>SEE themselves</u> as "One Body" which is just what the **NT** teaches

They <u>realize</u> that the <u>sins</u> of their <u>ancestors</u> Affect <u>them</u> & that their <u>current sins</u> Affect <u>ALL</u> of God's <u>People</u>

& we **really need** to **understand** this more today

In <u>General</u> – Christians <u>don't really see</u> their actions as <u>Negatively Affecting</u> the Church Body

But what we see here is just the Opposite

God's people <u>recognize</u> – the <u>sins of others</u> Affect <u>them</u> & <u>their sins</u> Affect <u>God's People</u> as a <u>WHOLE</u>

So – look for that lesson here

The **SECOND THING** critical to notice in this prayer is that it comes **straight out of SCRIPTURE** 

Much of this prayer actually <u>quotes scripture</u>
& it is <u>ALL</u> (at the very least) - a <u>paraphrase</u> of scripture

One Ref book said EVERY LINE of this prayer could be footnoted with References to other Bible Verses – EVERY LINE

Which brings up a very interesting point

**Very seldom** are Christians actually **TAUGHT** to pray

& <u>most of us</u> assume that <u>prayer</u> is just <u>ASKING God</u> for what we <u>WANT</u> – & hoping for the best

But Jas 4:3 says - ESV

3 You ask and do not receive, because you ask wrongly, to spend it on your passions.

On the other hand – 1Jn 5:14 says

#### 1Jn 5:14 – ESV

14 And this is the confidence that we have toward him, that <u>if we ask anything according to his</u> will he hears us. And if we know that he hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests that we have asked of him.

& <u>IF</u> we are praying <u>GOD'S WORD</u> - IN correct <u>CONTEXT</u> then we will be <u>praying according</u> to God's <u>will</u>

And <u>praying According</u> to God's Will – is <u>the basis</u> of <u>Effective</u> - & <u>Answered</u> - Prayer

We've **GOT** to **LEARN** to pray <u>"Accordance to God's Will"</u>

- & the <u>sure fire way</u> to do that is to "Pray His Own Word, Back to Him"
- & if you <u>want to learn</u> how to *Pray God's Word* <u>I'm</u> going to be <u>teaching</u> that at <u>My</u> Discipleship <u>Table</u> today
- & Remember now the **2nd Mark of Revival** is **Remembering God's Goodness**
- & that is the actual PURPOSE of this prayer
- & if will <u>follow me</u> thru this prayer & <u>stay focused</u> & <u>attentive</u> to the <u>Holy Spirit</u>

You will **see truths** & **lessons** in this prayer that **SPECIFICALLY Apply** to your life – **so stay with me, OK?** 

The <u>prayer</u> starts – <u>where</u> all prayers of <u>Confession</u> & <u>Adoration</u> <u>should</u> start – by <u>acknowledging</u> God's <u>rightful place</u> in creation <u>Nehemiah 9:6 - NLT</u> 6 "You alone are the LORD. You made the skies and the heavens and all the stars. You made the earth and the seas and everything in them. You preserve them all, and the angels of heaven worship you.

# **AMEN** – **THAT** is a **GREAT** way to start **EVERY PRAYER**

And **then** we go to the **beginning** of **God's Covenant** with His people

#### Nehemiah 9:7-8 - NLT

- 7 "You are the LORD God, who chose Abram and brought him from Ur of the Chaldeans and renamed him Abraham.
- 8 When he had proved himself faithful (by believing), you made a covenant with him to give him and his descendants the land of the Canaanites, Hittites, Amorites, Perizzites, Jebusites, and Girgashites. And you have done what you promised, for you are always true to your word.
- & <u>then</u> the prayer goes to <u>God's deliverance</u> of His people from <u>Egypt</u>
   which is a <u>picture</u> of our deliverance from <u>sin</u>

# Nehemiah 9:9-12 - NLT

- 9 "You saw the misery of our ancestors in Egypt, and you heard their cries from beside the Red Sea.
- 10 You displayed miraculous signs and wonders against Pharaoh, his officials, and all his people, for you knew how arrogantly they were treating our ancestors. You have a glorious reputation that has never been forgotten.
- 11 You divided the sea for your people so they could walk through on dry land! And then you hurled their enemies into the depths of the sea. They sank like stones beneath the mighty waters.
- 12 You led our ancestors by a pillar of cloud during the day and a pillar of fire at night so that they could find their way.

& <u>then</u> the prayer goes to the <u>giving of the LAW</u> which <u>shows</u> us our <u>need</u> for Christ

**AND** we also see the **Manna from Heaven**& the **Water from the Rock** – both **pictures** of Christ

# Nehemiah 9:13-15 - NLT

13 "You came down at Mount Sinai and spoke to them from heaven. You gave them regulations and instructions that were just, and decrees and commands that were good.

14 You instructed them concerning your holy Sabbath. And you commanded them, through Moses your servant, to obey all your commands, decrees, and instructions.

15 "You gave them bread from heaven when they were hungry and water from the rock when they were thirsty. You commanded them to go and take possession of the land you had sworn to give them.

& the <u>Unconditional</u> <u>MERCY & LOVE</u> of <u>GOD</u> - - **WHILE** His people wandered in the **Wilderness** 

which still today – accurately pictures where some of us are at with God

#### Nehemiah 9:16-21 - NLT

16 "But our ancestors were proud and stubborn, and they paid no attention to your commands.

17 They refused to obey and did not remember the miracles you had done for them. Instead, they became stubborn and appointed a leader to take them back to their slavery in Egypt! But you are a God of forgiveness, gracious and merciful, slow to become angry, and rich in unfailing love. You did not abandon them,

18 even when they made an idol shaped like a calf and said, 'This is your god who brought you out of Egypt!' They committed terrible blasphemies.

19 "But in your great mercy you did not abandon them to die in the wilderness. The pillar of cloud still led them forward by day, and the pillar of fire showed them the way through the night.
20 You sent your good Spirit to instruct them, and you did not stop giving them manna from heaven or water for their thirst.
21 For forty years you sustained them in the wilderness, and they lacked nothing. Their clothes did not wear out, and their feet did not swell!

But **then** – when the next Generation **DID BELIEVE** 

God <u>took them</u> into the <u>Promised Land</u> & <u>gave</u> them incredible <u>VICTORY</u>

**Another** critical Lesson **for many** of us today

#### Nehemiah 9:22-25 - NLT

- 22 "Then you helped our ancestors conquer kingdoms and nations, and you placed your people in every corner of the land. They took over the land of King Sihon of Heshbon and the land of King Og of Bashan.
- 23 You made their descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky and brought them into the land you had promised to their ancestors.
- 24 "They went in and took possession of the land. You subdued whole nations before them. Even the Canaanites, who inhabited the land, were powerless! Your people could deal with these nations and their kings as they pleased.
- 25 Our ancestors captured fortified cities and fertile land. They took over houses full of good things, with cisterns already dug and vineyards and olive groves and fruit trees in abundance. So

they ate until they were full and grew fat and enjoyed themselves in all your blessings.

What **incredible blessings** from God!!

You would think after <u>ALL</u> that <u>VICTORY</u> the people of <u>God</u> would <u>serve the Lord</u> all their days

but the **SIN** Nature is **Strong** - & it is **Stubborn** 

#### & so - watch this cycle of

God **saving** His people

Then them turning from Him in Rebellion

& experiencing the **consequences** of their sin

& then God saving them again in His Mercy

#### Nehemiah 9:26-28 - NLT

26 "But despite all this, they were disobedient and rebelled against you. They turned their backs on your Law, they killed your prophets who warned them to return to you, and they committed terrible blasphemies.

27 So you handed them over to their enemies, who made them suffer. But in their time of trouble they cried to you, and you heard them from heaven. In your great mercy, you sent them liberators who rescued them from their enemies.

28 "But as soon as they were at peace, your people again committed evil in your sight, and once more you let their enemies conquer them. Yet whenever your people turned and cried to you again for help, you listened once more from heaven. In your wonderful mercy, you rescued them many times!

Really, Honestly – How many of our lives does that perfectly describe??

& so the **people** continue to **Rebel** against God & **God** continues to give **Grace** & **Mercy**, instead of **Judgment** 

## <u>Nehemiah 9:29–31 - NLT</u>

29 "You warned them to return to your Law, but they became proud and obstinate and disobeyed your commands. They did not follow your regulations, by which people will find life if only they obey. They stubbornly turned their backs on you and refused to listen.

30 In your love, you were patient with them for many years. You sent your Spirit, who warned them through the prophets. But still they wouldn't listen! So once again you allowed the peoples of the land to conquer them.

31 But in your great mercy, you did not destroy them completely or abandon them forever. What a gracious and merciful God you are!

Many people **think** the **God** of the **OT** was the **harsh judge** & He **somehow** became the **God of Love** in the **NT** 

But God <u>never changes</u> - & what the <u>OT</u> really <u>shows</u> is

the incredible <u>Grace</u> & <u>Mercy</u> of God in <u>response</u> to the incredibly <u>stubborn SIN</u> of His people

But the <u>real point here</u> is – The <u>SECOND MARK of True Revival</u> is Remembering God's Goodness

& that's exactly what this prayer is doing

It's <u>Remembering God's Goodness</u> Even in response to our <u>Rebellion</u> We are **generally** so busy **ASKING God** for what we **want next** 

that we **seldom** take the time to **Remember**His **Incredible Goodness** toward us – *over our entire Lives* 

& I can <u>assure</u> you – <u>Rehearsing</u> God's <u>Goodness</u> <u>IS FAR MORE</u> Valuable

than **trying to DEMAND** that He give us the next thing we **WANT** 

So Please – take the time to <u>CONFESS to God</u> <u>His Goodness</u> in your life

Remember His Grace & Mercy toward you when you really deserved nothing but His Judgment

& then Confess His Goodness - BACK to Him

Tell Him How **GOOD** HE's **been** to you & how **little** you've **deserved** it

<u>That</u> is a Very Powerful Part of <u>REVIVAL</u> . . . of being <u>RESTORED</u> to a <u>JOYFUL & RIGHT</u> Relationship with God

The **FIRST MARK** of True Revival is **Repentance & Brokenness** 

The **SECOND MARK** of True Revival is **Remembering God's Goodness** 

& now – starting in V.32

# we see the THIRD MARK of True Revival Recognizing our True Condition

This <u>Public Prayer</u> now turns to Acknowledge the <u>Honest Condition</u> that <u>SIN</u> has <u>put</u> God's People in

#### Nehemiah 9:32-37 - NLT

32 "And now, our God, the great and mighty and awesome God, who keeps his covenant of unfailing love, do not let all the hardships we have suffered seem insignificant to you. Great trouble has come upon us and upon our kings and leaders and priests and prophets and ancestors—all of your people—from the days when the kings of Assyria first triumphed over us until now. 33 Every time you punished us you were being just. We have sinned greatly, and you gave us only what we deserved. 33 Our kings, leaders, priests, and ancestors did not obey your Law or listen to the warnings in your commands and laws. 35 Even while they had their own kingdom, they did not serve you, though you showered your goodness on them. You gave them a large, fertile land, but they refused to turn from their wickedness.

36 "So now today we are slaves in the land of plenty that you gave our ancestors for their enjoyment! We are slaves here in this good land.

37 The lush produce of this land piles up in the hands of the kings whom you have set over us because of our sins. They have power over us and our livestock. We serve them at their pleasure, and we are in great misery."

Remember – <u>Jerusalem</u> is still under – <u>PERSIAN RULE</u> God's people are still <u>SERVANTS</u> of the <u>King</u> of <u>PERSIA</u>

& it is **so important** that we **Recognize our True Condition** before God

We think we're all that – but often we are just **SLAVES** in this **Good Land that God has given us** 

<u>Slaves</u> to our <u>Self-Centered</u>, <u>Material Driven</u> <u>World</u>, <u>Slaves</u> to our <u>LUSTS</u> - <u>Slaves</u> to our <u>SIN</u>

We have Demanded that <u>SELF</u> be our <u>LORD</u>
& **God** has allowed us the **consequences** of Serving *Lord SELF* 

& so the <u>THIRD MARK</u> of True Revival is to Recognize our True Condition before God

& so now we've seen **THREE MARKS** (signs) of **True Revival**;

- 1) Repentance & Brokenness
- 2) Remembering God's Goodness
- 3) Recognizing our True Condition
- & <u>Finally</u> in <u>Vs 38</u> & <u>into Ch 10</u> we see the <u>FOURTH MARK of True Revival</u>

The **FOURTH MARK** of True Revival is **Renewing our Obedience** 

We are going to **Primarily Save** this *Final Mark* for **Next Week** 

But to see the Big Picture - Let's just read a few Vs's

Nehemiah 9:38 - NLT

38 The people responded, "In view of all this, we are making a solemn promise and putting it in writing . . .

#### Nehemiah 10:29(B) [last sentence] - NLT

29... They solemnly <u>promised</u> to carefully follow all the commands, regulations, and decrees of the LORD our Lord:

& then FOUR Specific Commitments to Obey God in CH 10

#### Nehemiah 10:30 - NLT

**30 We <u>promise</u> not to . . .** let our daughters marry the pagan people of the land, and not to let our sons marry their daughters.

#### Nehemiah 10:32 - NLT

**32 In addition, we <u>promise</u> to . . .** obey the command to pay the annual Temple tax of one-eighth of an ounce of silver for the care of the Temple of our God.

#### Nehemiah 10:35 - NLT

**35 We <u>promise</u> to . . .** bring the first part of every harvest to the LORD's Temple year after year—whether it be a crop from the soil or from our fruit trees.

# & the End of Nehemiah 10:39 - NLT

**39...We <u>promise</u> together not to** ... neglect the Temple of our God.

# The **FOURTH MARK** of **True Revival** is **Renewing our Obedience**

But Now - stopping here leaves me with a Dilemma

I am <u>afraid</u> there may be <u>SOME</u> – <u>WHO</u> . . <u>Knowing</u> that we <u>might</u> be talking about <u>Obedience</u> Next Week

<u>might</u> already be <u>planning</u> to be <u>sick</u>, <u>busy</u>, or otherwise <u>indisposed</u>

So – If you are **not here** next week I might just **call you**, & **hunt you down** 

This CH is **WONDERFUL** Overview of **FOUR MARKS of True Revival** in the people of God

& <u>Remember</u> – <u>**REVIVAL**</u> is

RESTORING believers to a Joyful & Right relationship with God

& Every Single One of Us - Needs that

#### We all need to:

Return to Repentance & Brokenness
