We have quite a bit of teaching on **DIVINE FORGIVENESS** 

In fact - I've kind of "focused"
 on teaching Divine Forgiveness for some time

we have <u>at least 8 or 10 messages</u> on the subjects of <u>Forgiveness</u> & <u>Reconciliation</u> (PLUS the Life of Joseph series)

& so - <u>if</u> the Holy Spirit <u>strikes a cord</u> in your <u>heart</u> today on this subject

<u>Today</u>, we're in <u>lesson SIX</u> of our discipleship series& we've <u>been moving</u> thru the <u>"Foundational Truths"</u> of Christianity

These are all "Foundational Truths" of knowing God

& then **BAAM** - today we <u>narrow down</u> onto a very <u>specific</u> topic - <u>Forgiveness & Reconciliation</u>

- Now <u>actually</u> we're <u>going to close</u> this little 8-Part Series with <u>2 more</u> "<u>specific</u>" topics, after this one
- But Pastor <u>Craig Caster</u> & "<u>Family Discipleship Ministries</u>" (whose <u>Discipleship Manual</u> we're following download it at wordbymail.com)
- Chose to Make <u>Forgiveness</u> & <u>Reconciliation</u> the <u>FIRST</u> <u>specific topic</u> to <u>teach</u> to a Disciple of Jesus
- & possibly the reason he chose this specific topic is for the **SAME REASON** that I would choose it
- I believe <u>THIS ISSUE</u> is at the <u>ROOT</u> of an <u>incredible number</u> of <u>crisis</u> & <u>tragedies</u> IN THE CHURCH
- I know (<u>from personal experience</u>) the need for <u>Forgiveness</u> & <u>Reconciliation</u> in the church may very well be <u>at THE TOP</u> of the <u>Transformation Needs List</u> for Disciples of Christ
- There is so much <u>PAIN</u> & so much <u>DAMAGE</u>, sown into the church thru **UNFORGIVENESS**
- That I believe <u>AFTER Salvation</u> & becoming a <u>Disciple</u>, THIS may be <u>the greatest need</u> in the church

## **Let's Pray**

# Most of us <u>do not</u> easily <u>admit</u> - the <u>Damage</u> & <u>Destruction</u> that <u>Unforgiveness</u> is causing in our lives

# <u>Damage</u> to innocent lives <u>around us</u> & <u>Damage</u> to our *own lives*

#### It's commonly known (in Counseling Circles) that:

- Pride
- Self Righteousness
- Judgmental & Critical spirit
- Lack of Trust & Intimacy
- Relationship Dysfunctions
- Broken Fellowship with God

Can ALL *(very often)* be traced back to the **HARBORING** of **Unforgiveness** 

Harboring Unforgiveness Drives Deep the *ROOT of BITTERNESS* 

#### & Heb 12:15 says - ESV

15 See to it that no one fails to obtain the grace of God; that no "root of bitterness" springs up and causes trouble, and by it many become defiled;

Guys - <u>Please HEAR me</u> - <u>MANY</u> have become <u>defiled</u> by the <u>strong root</u> of <u>Bitterness</u>

& when that **root springs up** - it causes **trouble** 

& <u>not just</u> for the person <u>Harboring Unforgiveness</u> <u>but for all</u> the <u>innocent lives</u> around them

Let's Turn over to **Eph 4:30** 

#### The CONTEXT of Eph 4 is

Putting off the Old Man,
Being Renewed,
& Putting on the New Man

It's about what the New Life in Christ LOOKS LIKE

& in Eph 4:30-32 - Paul talks about FORGIVENESS

But he <u>begins</u> - by <u>listing</u> the <u>**By-Products**</u>, of the <u>**Poison**</u> of <u>**UN-forgiveness**</u>

& then he makes a <u>very clear statement</u> regarding <u>TO WHAT EXTENT</u> - we are <u>called to forgive</u>, as Christians

#### Eph 4:30-32 - ESV

30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. (he's leading into the forgiveness issue)
31 Let all <u>bitterness</u> and <u>wrath</u> and <u>anger</u> and <u>clamor</u> and <u>slander</u> be put away from you, along with all <u>malice</u>. (byproducts of unforgiveness)
32 Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you. (underline "AS")

Paul <u>leads into</u> the Forgiveness issue with a <u>Warning</u> to <u>not GRIEVE</u> the Holy Spirit (by holding onto sin)

#### & then (v.31) lists the

Poisonous By-Products of Unforgiveness → →

#### Poisonous By-Products of Unforgiveness

- Bitterness extreme hostility
- Wrath outburst of anger (in retaliation)
- Anger state of mind marked by rage & pain
- Clamor harsh & unkind words
- Slander words that harm a person
- Malice desire to see another suffer

#### **These** are the **Poisonous By-Products** of <u>Unforgiveness</u>

& God will ALLOW these Poisons - to absolutely TORTURE you

in order to "Bring You" to a place of Brokenness
SO THAT you will accept HIS DIVINE FORGIVENESS
SO THAT you will be healed

These **By-Products** of **Unforgiveness** - cause **PAIN** in our lives

& that PAIN should send us Running to the Doctor for healing

#### **My son** used to work as **an EMT** at a motorcycle track

& <u>he would</u> always come home with these <u>hilarious stories</u> about **thick headed** motorcycle **riders** who'd **refuse** to go to the Dr.

He'd say - look man - you are hurt - Do you FEEL hurt ??

- & the guys would <u>be wincing in pain</u> about to <u>pass out</u> & <u>they'd say</u> "no man, I'm fine, I don't need a Dr"
- & <u>sometimes</u> my son would say "fine then, get up & walk" & <u>Mr tuff-guy</u> would take <u>1 step</u>, & fall down <u>in excruciating pain</u>
- & then David would say NOW . . . Are you ready to go to the DR ??

But guys - **Aren't we** the same ??

The **Byproducts of Unforgiveness** are **Destroying** our lives - there's **PAIN** strewn **ALL** around us in every direction

& we say "No man, I'm fine, I don't need a Dr"

No man - You are NOT fine
You DO need a Dr - & you need him FAST

#### & what is the Dr's Prescription

for **Healing** the *Poison of Unforgiveness* in your life

The Prescription is in the VERY NEXT VS (as it usually is)

## Eph 4:32 - ESV

32 Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, <u>as</u> God in Christ forgave you.

Be <u>Kind</u> & <u>Tenderhearted</u> - <u>TO THE ONE</u> you now hold <u>bitterness</u> - <u>wrath</u> - <u>anger</u> - <u>clamor</u> - <u>slander</u> & <u>malice</u> against

Be <u>Kind</u> & <u>Tenderhearted</u> to them . . . <u>Forgiving them</u> - - <u>AS</u> God in Christ <u>forgave you</u>

The <u>ESV</u> here - simple says <u>AS</u> - But <u>most</u> of the <u>Dynamic Translations</u> (like the <u>NLT</u>) - Say <u>"JUST AS"</u>

The phrase "Just As" means

To the <u>same Degree</u>, in the <u>same Proportion</u>

To the <u>same Degree</u>, in the same Proportion <u>AS</u> God in Christ <u>has forgiven YOU</u>

Now - <u>if Divine Forgiveness</u> is <u>NEW</u> to you <u>this</u> might be a bit of a <u>SHOCK</u>

That we are **called to Forgive** those who have wronged us

To the same Degree, & in the same Proportion

As God in Christ has forgiven us

#### THAT sounds impossible - Doesn't it?

& With <u>MAN</u> - it <u>IS</u> impossible But With <u>GOD</u> - <u>AII</u> things are possible

That is why it's called - **DIVINE FORGIVENESS** 

Let me <u>explain it</u> to you with a <u>Parable</u> from <u>Jesus Christ</u> Himself

In Mat 18 - Jesus had just finished teaching about <u>Reconciliation</u> in the church

& <u>then</u> the famous "<u>foot in mouth</u>" Disciple (<u>Peter</u>)

<u>comes</u> up to Jesus - <u>planning</u> to show the Master that he fully <u>understands</u> <u>FORGIVENESS</u>

#### Mat 18:21-22 - ESV

21 Then Peter came up and said to him, "Lord, how often will my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? As many as seven times?"

22 Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you seven times, but seventy times seven. (some trans = 77 times)

Peter thought he was doing good

cause the Rabbi's taught Forgiveness THREE times, & no more

- & so Peter raises it to SEVEN & then Jesus <u>Blows the Lid off it</u>, & says <u>Forgiveness</u> cannot be <u>numbered</u> or <u>measured</u>
- & He tells a <u>very CLEAR parable</u> that explains <u>WHY</u> the <u>By-Products</u> of Unforgiveness <u>feel like TORTURE</u>

## Mat 18:23-24 - ESV

23 "Therefore the kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who wished to settle accounts with his servants.

24 When he began to settle, one was brought to him who owed him ten thousand talents.

There are **many ways** to **illustrate** a **TALENT** - **for example**;

ONE TALENT was equal to <u>20 YEARS</u> wages for a LABORER so <u>10,000 Talents</u> = <u>200,000 Years Wages</u> for a LABORER

THAT - is an *Un-payable* Debt

## Mat 18:25-27 - ESV

25 And since he could not pay, his master ordered him to be sold, with his wife and children and all that he had, and payment to be made. (justice)

26 So the servant fell on his knees, imploring him, 'Have patience with me, and I will pay you everything.'

27 And out of pity (compassion) for him, the master of that servant released him and forgave him the debt.

THIS is a Picture - of YOU & GOD

You <u>owed God</u> a debt you <u>could not pay</u> - & by no work of your own God <u>Released you</u>, & <u>Forgave</u> your <u>UNPAYABLE debt</u>

Now - You MUST make the comparison here because this is the first step to Divine Forgiveness

#### You MUST make the comparison between

The Picture of You & God - Compared to The Picture of You & that other Person

The Picture of You & that Other Person - Begins in

#### Mat 18:28 - ESV

28 But when that same servant went out, he found one of his fellow servants who owed him <u>a hundred denarii</u>, and seizing him, he began to <u>choke him</u>, saying, 'Pay what you owe.'

That already <u>sounds strange</u>, doesn't it <u>after all</u> this servant had just been <u>Forgiven of</u>

But it sounds even **more Strange** when you realize

The first Servant was forgiven 200,000 Years of a Laborers Wage

His Fellow Servant - whom he was now "Choking" owed him a hundred Denarii

Which was about **THREE MONTHS** Laborers Wage

The Servant who had just been forgiven 200,000 YEARS wages

was choking a fellow servant who owed him a measly <u>THREE MONTHS</u> wages

#### **Unfortunately** it gets *worse*

Remember - this is a picture of you & I
being Forgiven by God a Debt we could not pay

& then turning around & Attacking a fellow servant - - with our Unforgiveness

We MUST make this Comparison

#### Continuing in Mat 18:29-30 - ESV

29 So his fellow servant fell down and pleaded with him, 'Have patience with me, and I will pay you.' (same thing 1<sup>st</sup> servant said to master) 30 He refused and went and <u>put him in prison</u> until he should pay the debt.

Man - <u>aren't we good</u> at <u>putting people</u> <u>in prison</u> that we're <u>Harboring Unforgiveness</u> against!

<u>I promise</u> you - this <u>Unforgiving Servant</u> was <u>saying to himself</u> <u>Exactly</u> what we Say to Ourselves

THEY DON'T DESERVE TO BE FORGIVEN !!!
THEY'VE WRONGED ME !!!
THEY DESERVE THIS !!!

Yeah, I know . . . & God knows

<u>AND</u> - God IS <u>WATCHING YOU</u>

<u>Just like</u> the Master of this <u>Unforgiving Servant</u>

#### Mat 18:31 - ESV

31 When his fellow servants saw what had taken place, they were greatly distressed, and they went and reported to their master all that had taken place.

I kinda see this like the **Angels** going to **God** & saying

"Lord, after all you've forgiven them of, do you know what they're doing down there to each another?"

#### <u>& so we read - in Mat 18:32-34 - ESV</u>

32 Then his master summoned him and said to him, 'You wicked servant! I forgave you all that debt because you pleaded with me. 33 And should not you have had mercy on your fellow servant, as I had mercy on you?' (THAT - is making the comparison) 34 And in anger his master delivered him to the jailers (torturers), until he should pay all his debt.

#### Wait a minute !!!

He <u>delivered him</u> to the <u>TORTURERS</u> <u>until</u> he should pay all his debt?

The **ESV** puts the word **Torturers** in as a "*Footnote*"

But <u>NLT</u> & <u>NKJ</u> both put it in the text "delivered him to the torturers"

<u>Dave</u> - - what are you saying?

Are you saying that **God** would do that to **US**, if we **refuse to forgive** ??

#### Come on - SURELY God wouldn't do that to us

Yes - SHIRLEY - He would & He says so in the very next vs.

#### Mat 18:35 - ESV

35 So also my heavenly Father will do to every one of you, if you do not forgive your brother from your heart."

God will Allow you - <u>to be TORTURED</u> by your <u>Unforgiveness</u> <u>Until</u> you are broken . . .

& Until you RELEASE that person from the DEBT they OWE YOU!

Now - - I know <u>there are some</u> here - who have <u>Tremendously Painful Experiences</u>
they are <u>Harboring Unforgiveness</u> over - & <u>I'm Sorry</u>

But <u>please believe me</u> - God wants to <u>heal you</u> of the <u>POISON</u> of your <u>Unforgiveness</u>

For YOUR own GOOD!

guys - the Bible is VERY CLEAR

Your <u>REFUSAL</u> to Forgive - <u>as Christ</u> forgave you is <u>BLOCKING</u> your "<u>Right Relationship with God</u>"

In <u>The Lord's Prayer</u> in <u>Mat 6:9</u>
Our <u>Forgiveness from God</u> is <u>TIED</u> to our <u>Forgiving others</u>

& in a **Self-Commentary** on the Lord's Prayer,

## Jesus says in Mat 6:14-15 - ESV

14 For if you forgive others their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you,

15 but if you do not forgive others their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

This <u>isn't talking</u> about your <u>Salvation</u> it's <u>talking about</u> your <u>"Right Relationship"</u> with God

& that <u>"Right Relationship"</u> is what brings <u>Peace</u> & <u>Joy</u> & the <u>Fruit of the Spirit</u> to your life

instead of the Poisonous By-Products of the Sin of Unforgiveness

#### **Mark 11:25 says - ESV**

25 And whenever you stand praying, forgive, if you have anything against anyone, so that your Father also who is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses."

Our <u>"Right Relationship"</u> with God - is BLOCKED by our REFUSAL to <u>Forgive others</u>,

Please - if you need the Miracle of Divine Forgiveness in your life

Immerse yourself in this critical area of HEALINGCall upon the Holy Spirit for Healing in this area

& ask us for Resources to help you

<u>if you DON'T</u> - The <u>TORTURE</u> of Unforgiveness in your life <u>WILL</u> continue

Now - We <u>only have time</u>, to say a few words on the <u>subject of Reconciliation</u>

We also have messages specifically on Reconciliation (at WBM)

& <u>we can also</u> get you a really good <u>workbook</u> on Reconciliation - called <u>PEACEMAKING</u> - By <u>Rick Love</u>

To **Reconcile** means to **Restore HARMONY** in a relationship

& <u>just like Forgiveness</u> - <u>Our EXAMPLE</u> of Reconciliation is found in <u>Jesus Christ</u>

Col 1:19-22 - ESV  $\rightarrow$ 

#### Col 1:19-22 - ESV

19 For in him all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell, 20 and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of his cross. 21 And you, who once were alienated and hostile in mind, doing evil deeds,

22 <u>he has now reconciled</u> in his body of flesh <u>by his death</u>, in order to present you holy and blameless and above reproach before him,

You - were **Separated** From God (alienated)

You - were **Hostile** to God

You - were in the midst of **Evil Deeds** 

& WHILE you were in the Midst of ALL THAT

Jesus Christ did the Work to Reconcile you to Himself

## & that person God calls you to be Reconciled to

They are <u>Separated</u> from you
They are <u>Hostile</u> toward you
They may have done some **Evil Deeds** 

But while YOU - were the Enemy of God

Jesus Christ did <u>ALL the work</u> of Reconciliation to <u>Restore Harmony</u> to your Relationship with God

& now - God is calling YOU, to <u>Reconcile</u> your Relationship with that other person The word <u>FORGIVE</u> - is a <u>VERB</u> - it's an <u>action word</u> which means - <u>the ACT</u> of Forgiving requires <u>ACTION</u>

We <u>must FIRST</u> Receive God's <u>DIVINE FORGIVENESS</u> in <u>our own hearts</u> - toward that person

But then - where possible - we must attempt reconciliation

Both - to those who have offended us

AND to those we have offended

I know - <u>sometimes</u> <u>face-to-face</u> <u>reconciliation</u> is <u>not possible</u> - & maybe <u>not</u> even <u>safe</u>

But where IT IS - That is what God is calling us to do

In the <u>Sermon on the MT</u> - Jesus gives a <u>very practical teaching</u> on the <u>importance</u> of <u>reconciliation</u>

After a **Very Strong Warning** regarding being **ANGRY** 

where <u>He elevates</u> the <u>Commandment</u> to <u>not Murder</u> to <u>INCLUDE</u> <u>Not</u> being <u>Extremely Angry</u> at a person

after THAT - in **V.23** - He gives a very **serious instruction** 

Mat 5:23-24 - ESV → →

## Mat 5:23-24 - ESV

23 So if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you,

24 leave your gift there before the altar and go. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.

#### Please hear me - Jesus says - LEAVE THE ALTAR

**FIRST** - Go be Reconciled to your brother, **THEN**, come & offer your gift

guys - <u>Forgiveness & Reconciliation</u> is more important to Jesus than your time at the Altar <u>worshipping Him</u>

**WHY** - How can that be ??

In Psa 51 - in David's prayer of Forgiveness for his sins

# <u>Psa 51:16-17 says - NLT</u>

16 You do not desire a sacrifice, or I would offer one. You do not want a burnt offering.

17 The sacrifice you desire is a broken spirit. You will not reject a broken and repentant heart, O God.

God desires - a <u>Broken</u> & <u>Repentant</u> heart <u>THAT</u> is what <u>He</u> <u>Wants</u>

He <u>doesn't want</u> us to <u>play church</u> in fact - <u>us playing church</u> - <u>ANNOYS</u> Him

God Desires Repentance, & Action

Let's Allow God to Search us & know our Hearts,

& let's <u>allow Him</u> to point out any <u>Poison of Unforgiveness</u> & any <u>Need for Reconciliation</u>

& then let's commit to Him - to begin the process
