Jsph 12 – 5 & 5 for Divine Forgiveness - Gen 45:1-15

I want to start by <u>acknowledging</u> the teaching of <u>R.T. Kendall</u> on the subject of <u>Forgiveness</u>

<u>R.T. Kendall</u> is a Preacher <u>born & raised</u> in <u>Kentucky</u> - but spent his <u>Preaching Career</u> at <u>Westminster Chapel</u> in <u>London England</u>

His teachings on <u>Total Forgiveness</u> are <u>sown</u> thru <u>many</u> of my <u>forgiveness msg's</u> - & thru my life

Last week the msg was "<u>Correct Perspective</u>" & we said it was the <u>Crescendo Text</u> in the life of Joseph

<u>After everything</u> Joseph had <u>experienced</u> - after <u>all</u> those <u>yrs</u> - Joseph <u>finally</u> revealed himself to his <u>brothers</u>

& <u>he did it</u> in a way that is <u>THE Heavenly Example</u> of <u>how</u> we are called to <u>Live</u> in <u>Divine Forgiveness</u>

<u>Joseph Forgave his brothers</u> <u>Immediately</u> - <u>Completely</u> - & with <u>No Strings</u> attached it was <u>Total Unconditional Forgiveness</u>

& if we call <u>Jesus Christ</u> our <u>LORD</u> today

then we <u>MUST</u> make sure - the <u>Supernatural Gift</u> of <u>Divine Forgiveness</u> - is <u>operating</u> in our lives

Because God's Word is Overwhelmingly Clear . . .

We are called to Forgive - IN THE SAME PROPORTION that Jesus Christ has forgiven us & so <u>Divine Forgiveness</u> becomes a <u>Crucial TEST</u> of how <u>TRULY surrendered</u> our lives are - to <u>Jesus Christ</u>

If we would stand up & say Proudly with Paul the apostle in Gal 2:20 20 I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me...

Then <u>I would say</u> - if Jesus Christ is <u>Truly Living</u> in me AS <u>LORD</u> then <u>one</u> of <u>THE</u> most <u>supernatural evidences</u> will be - -

Am I living in "Divine Forgiveness" ??

So <u>today</u> I'd like to look at the <u>5 & 5 for Divine Forgiveness</u> <u>5 TESTS</u> - <u>5 STEPS</u>

<u>**5 TESTS</u>** that you can apply to your life to see if you have <u>**TOTALLY Forgiven**</u> Someone - &</u>

5 STEPS to take - - if you *FAIL* those 5 TESTS

Let's Pray

I know this can be a Very Painful Process

I know there are **Hurts** in some of our lives that **SEEM TOO BIG**

They seem <u>TOO BIG</u> - to simply apply <u>5 TESTS</u> & <u>5 STEPS</u> & <u>BAAM</u> ! - We're healed

<u>I know</u> - there are <u>some events</u> that seem <u>TOO BIG</u> <u>even for God</u> to bring <u>Divine Forgiveness</u> into

But I Promise You;

There is no offense that cannot be overcome by God's Divine Forgiveness

There are <u>some</u> that may- <u>SEEM</u> <u>Too Big</u> But <u>I promise</u> you - they are <u>NOT</u> <u>Too Big for God !</u>

We've said all along that Joseph is a "type" (picture) of Christ

And <u>never more so</u> - than when we study his Total Forgiveness of his brothers

Joseph here, is a "Type" (picture) of Christ Forgiving US . . .

& <u>he is also</u> an Incredible <u>Example</u> of <u>HOW</u> we are called to <u>Live in Divine Forgiveness</u>

Now Guys - this <u>Level of Forgiveness</u> can't be <u>worked up</u> in the <u>Flesh</u>

<u>This Divine Forgiveness is AN Evidence (a Fruit)</u> of <u>Jesus Christ</u> truly being <u>Lord</u> of your Life - & the <u>Holy Spirit</u> truly being in <u>Charge</u> of your life

<u>So today</u> - as we "<u>Re-Look</u>" at Joseph's <u>Total Forgiveness</u> of his brothers

<u>I'd like</u> to use it as a <u>TEST</u> (<u>5 Tests</u>) that <u>we can apply</u> to our own lives . . .

<u>To see</u> if we have <u>Truly</u> - <u>TOTALLY</u> - <u>Forgiven</u> <u>those</u> in our lives who <u>have hurt us</u> (even sinned against us) So let's **<u>RE-OPEN</u>** that <u>*Crescendo Text*</u> we looked at last week

Remember (from last week) - at the <u>end of CH 44</u> <u>Judah</u> is making that <u>Impassioned Plea</u> for <u>Benjamin</u> . . .

& then at the beginning of CH 45 - we see TEST # 1 . . .

<u>TEST # 1</u>

Are you willing to keep the Offense just between those involved ?

Gen 45:1 - ESV

1 Then Joseph could not control himself before all those who stood by him. He cried, "<u>Make everyone go out from me</u>." So no one stayed with him when Joseph made himself known to his brothers.

Joseph sent everyone out of the room -

This was <u>between</u> Joseph & his brothers & <u>Joseph</u> was about to <u>RELEASE them</u> forever of their Offense

So there was no need for anyone else to be there

He <u>didn't want</u> his brothers to have to <u>endure</u> the <u>gossip</u> around the <u>palace</u> . . .

"Oh, did you hear what Joseph's brothers did to him ???"

this type of "Gossip" is actually bringing a form of judgment / revenge - upon those who've wronged us . . .

But <u>TRUE Divine Forgiveness</u> actually <u>protects</u> the person from having to live <u>in the shame</u> of what they've done

Jer 31:34 - ESV

34 . . . For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more."

God says He will <u>CHOOSE</u> to <u>not remember</u> our sin ! & in <u>Divine Forgiveness</u> - we are <u>called to do the same</u>

& THAT - is what Joseph is preparing the way for - right here

<u>TEST # 2</u>

Are you willing to put your Offender AT EASE ??

<u>Gen 45:2-4A - ESV</u>

2 And he wept aloud, so that the Egyptians heard it, and the household of Pharaoh heard it.

3 And Joseph said to his brothers, "I am Joseph! Is my father still alive?" But his brothers <u>could not answer him</u>, for they were <u>dismayed at his presence</u>.

4 So Joseph said to his brothers, "<u>Come near to me, please</u>." And they came near . . .

Remember from the msg last week . . .

<u>In Hebrew</u> - this Phrase "<u>Come near to me</u>" is an <u>invitation</u> to come <u>intimately close</u> (used even for "<u>to kiss</u>")

<u>Joseph</u> wanted his <u>brothers</u> to come <u>close</u> enough to him to see there was no <u>HATE</u> - no <u>VENGENCE</u> in his eyes

He <u>wanted them to know</u> by the look on his face that they could be <u>At Ease</u>

Heb 4:16 - NLT

16 So let us come boldly to the throne of our gracious God. There we will <u>receive his mercy</u>, and we will <u>find grace</u> to help us when we need it most.

God wants to put us At Ease re: our own sin

& He calls us to put others At Ease re: their offenses toward us

<u>TEST # 3</u>

Are you willing to totally release your Offender from ALL Debt ??

Joseph's incredible <u>statement of forgiveness</u> starts at the end of <u>V.4</u>

Gen 45:4B-5 - ESV

4... And he said, "I am your brother, Joseph, whom you sold into Egypt.
5 And now <u>do not be distressed or angry with yourselves</u> because you sold me here, for <u>God sent me</u> before you to preserve life.

As <u>they're looking</u> into his <u>tear swollen eyes</u> - Joseph says; "I am your brother Joseph, whom you sold into Egypt . . .

& <u>then Immediately</u> - <u>in the same breath</u> - he says to them; "now do not be distressed or angry with yourselves because you sold me here . . .

If we <u>ever work up</u> our <u>own forgiveness</u> (in the flesh) it'll <u>sound</u> something like this ; "Well . . . I forgive you . . . but I certainly hope you've learned a good lesson here . . .

I certainly hope you understand the pain your actions have caused"

& we **PILE ON** the "I forgive you BUTS" !!!

Psa 103:10 - ESV

10 He does not deal with us according to our sins, nor repay us according to our iniquities.

& <u>God calls us</u> to forgive "<u>In The Same Way</u>" that we've <u>been forgiven</u>

Divine Forgiveness is <u>NOT</u> <u>Approving</u> of or <u>Excusing</u> sin Divine Forgiveness is <u>NOT</u> <u>Denial</u> (or turning your head) to sin Divine Forgiveness is <u>NOT</u> <u>Pretending</u> we're not hurt

Divine Forgiveness is being aware of what's been done . . .

& right <u>in the midst</u> of that awareness - making a <u>choice of the will</u> to forgive <u>in the same proportion</u> that we have been forgiven

I'm <u>not saying</u> it's <u>EASY</u> - I'm saying <u>Christ Living in you</u> is your <u>Power</u> to forgive - <u>in the same proportion</u> that <u>He</u> has forgiven you

<u>TEST # 4</u> - is the <u>hardest</u> one - it's the one that <u>at times</u> is <u>excruciating</u> for me to <u>even consider</u> - much less have to <u>say</u>

It's the one that <u>can't be done</u> by <u>Logic</u> - or <u>Understanding</u> - or <u>Human Reasoning</u>

& tho it's # 4 - it's actually the Ultimate Test

& I will <u>tell you</u> - there are <u>areas in my life</u> that <u>I am</u> still <u>fighting</u> to believe this <u>by faith</u>

<u>TEST # 4</u>

Are you willing to believe that God was actually AT WORK In the Midst of this Offense (sin) - FOR GOOD

<u>At times</u> this seems <u>impossible</u> to even consider but <u>BY FAITH</u> - we can trust - that <u>IT IS TRUE</u> !

Gen 45:5B-8A - ESV (Joseph cont'g)

5... for <u>God sent me</u> before you to preserve life.
6 For the famine has been in the land these two years, and there are yet five years in which there will be neither plowing nor harvest.

7 And <u>God sent me</u> before you <u>to preserve for you</u> a remnant on earth, and to keep alive <u>for you</u> many survivors. 8 So it was <u>not you</u> who sent me here, <u>but God</u> . . .

<u>Notice</u> - Joseph says "God sent me . . . to preserve <u>FOR YOU</u>" & then "to keep alive <u>FOR YOU</u> many survivors"

<u>Not only</u> are these the famous <u>BUT GOD</u> Verses !! <u>Not only</u> does Joseph see God <u>AT WORK</u> - for <u>GOOD</u> !! <u>But He sees</u> God <u>AT WORK</u> -

for **the GOOD** of those who *sinned against him* . . . !!!

& he <u>reassures them</u> - that it was <u>GOD AT WORK</u> <u>in the midst</u> of their sin - that <u>landed him</u> in Egypt

& then - <u>to top it off</u> - he tells them that <u>God was AT WORK</u> <u>not just</u> for his good - but <u>for their good</u>

THAT is understanding - <u>by faith</u> that God is <u>AT WORK</u> - <u>IN ALL THINGS</u> !!

<u>There are times</u> when it takes <u>everything</u> in me to <u>look a person</u> in the eyes & <u>tell them this</u> !!

But I know that God is <u>AT WORK</u> - in the Midst of <u>ALL THINGS</u> & I know that His <u>Plan</u> & <u>Purpose</u> for me <u>is GOOD</u>

& I know that Rom 8:28 is TRUE

<u>Rom 8:28 - NIV</u>

28 And we know that <u>in all things</u> God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.

<u>TEST # 5</u>

Are you willing to never bring up the offense again; to the offender to others to yourself ??

<u>I promise you</u> - at this point - this is <u>FINISHED</u> for Joseph it's <u>over</u> - <u>done</u> - <u>never</u> to be brought up again

Look at the way this incredible text ends

<u>Gen 45:9-15 - ESV</u>

9 Hurry and go up to my father and say to him, 'Thus says your son Joseph, God has made me lord of all Egypt. Come down to me; do not tarry.

10 You shall dwell in the land of Goshen, and you shall be near me, you and your children and your children's children, and your flocks, your herds, and all that you have.

11 There I will provide for you, for there are yet five years of famine to come, so that you and your household, and all that you have, do not come to poverty.'

12 And now your eyes see, and the eyes of my brother Benjamin see, that it is my mouth that speaks to you.

13 You must tell my father of all my honor in Egypt, and of all that you have seen. Hurry and bring my father down here." 14 Then he fell upon his brother Benjamin's neck and wept, and Benjamin wept upon his neck.

15 And he kissed all his brothers and wept upon them. After that his brothers talked with him. [NLT = talked freely with him]

This little <u>ISSUE</u> - of Joseph's brothers <u>trying to kill him</u> & then <u>selling him into slavery</u> . . .

IT'S DONE - FINISHED - NEVER TO BE BROUGHT UP AGAIN & it never is brought up again

& there's <u>no indication</u> - <u>Jacob</u> ever knew the events <u>that led up</u> to Joseph being <u>Prime Minister</u> of Egypt

In fact - the subject starts to come up again just after Jacob's death & Joseph squashes it . . .

Even then he will have NOTHING to do with it !!

Joseph has **removed** this offense as far as the **<u>East</u>** is from the <u>West</u>

Psa 103:12 - ESV

12 as far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our transgressions from us.

& God <u>calls us to forgive</u> - <u>JUST AS</u> (in the same way) That <u>He has forgiven</u> us in Christ

OK - Here's a quick review of the 5 TESTS

These are <u>all things</u> we <u>see Joseph do</u> in his <u>Total Forgiveness</u> of his brothers

<u>TEST # 1</u>

Are you willing to keep the Offense just between those involved ?

<u>TEST # 2</u>

Are you willing to put your Offender at ease ?

<u>TEST # 3</u>

Are you willing to totally release your Offender from ALL Debt ?

<u>TEST # 4</u>

Are you willing to believe that God was actually AT WORK In the Midst of this Offense (sin) - FOR GOOD ?

<u>TEST # 5</u>

Are you willing to never bring up the offense again; to the offender - to others - to yourself ? Now - <u>we said</u> there were <u>5 TESTS</u> - & 5 STEPS so we better get to the <u>5 STEPS</u>

- These 5 steps are <u>taught</u> in detail in <u>the msg</u> "*Living in Divine Forgiveness*"
- & altho <u>it's part</u> of the <u>marriage</u> study it's <u>highly recommended</u> for everyone
- But because they-re taught in detail in that message & because we're running out of time here . . .
- <u>I can only</u> give you a <u>**REVIEW**</u> of these <u>5 Steps to Living in Divine Forgiveness</u>
- <u>Now I don't say this very often . . .</u> but God <u>gave me</u> these steps while I was eating an <u>overpriced Omelet</u> at IHOP with Walt Stoermer
- For the full Msg (w/ all the scrip) you gotta get the CD "Living in Divine Forgiveness"

STEP # 1) Recognize Unforgiveness in your heart

We must begin by **recognizing** Un-Forgiveness in our lives

We've just seen <u>5 TESTS</u> to Recognize <u>whether</u> we are Living in Divine Forgiveness - - <u>or NOT</u>

<u>Unforgiveness</u> is a sin that "<u>Grieves the Holy Spirit</u>" it <u>separates us</u> from <u>God</u> & from those in our lives

& we end up feeling "*Tortured*" Just like the "Unforgiving Servant" in <u>MAT 18:21ff</u>

<u>Anger</u> – <u>Bitterness</u> – <u>Resentment</u> – <u>Jealousy</u> – <u>Envy</u> – are ALL <u>Signs</u> you must <u>Recognize</u> – as <u>Un-Forgiveness</u>

STEP # 2) Receive God's Command to forgive (by faith)

Faith is the <u>opposite</u> of Feeling & God is waiting for you <u>to say</u>...

"I <u>Receive</u> your <u>Command</u> to <u>Forgive</u> just as I've been forgiven"
"I <u>Believe</u> your <u>Word</u> - & I will <u>Crucify</u> my own Self-Will in order <u>to Receive</u> Your command"

If You will <u>Receive</u> God's <u>command to Forgive</u> (w/o reservation)

<u>THEN</u> - you will begin to <u>experience</u> the <u>supernatural transformation</u> of <u>Divine Forgiveness</u> in your life

You Must <u>Receive</u> God's Command to Forgive (by Faith)

STEP # 3) Repent of your sin (with Godly sorrow)

<u>Un-Forgiveness</u> is a <u>sin that separates you</u> from <u>God</u> & <u>gives the Devil</u> a wide-open door to <u>wreak havoc</u> in your life

it is **a sin** that must be **<u>Repented of</u>** – just like <u>any other sin</u> !

& 2Cor 7:10 says

10 For godly sorrow produces repentance leading to salvation, not to be regretted . . .

<u>Godly Sorrow</u> produces "A change of <u>Mind</u>, <u>Purpose</u>, <u>and</u> <u>Action</u>"

The greatest display of *repentance* in the Bible – Psa 51

If you desire to move toward <u>Divine Forgiveness</u> – <u>Psa 51 MUST</u> be the prayer of your heart

We must <u>Repent</u> – w/ Godly Sorrow, of our Sin of Un-Forgiveness

4) Replace your hard heart with God's heart (be transformed)

Eze 36:26 - NLT

26 And I will give you a new heart, and I will put a new spirit in you. I will take out your stony, stubborn heart and give you a tender, responsive heart.

& at the cross - there was that "*Exchange of Hearts*"

<u>Jesus Christ</u> took upon Himself our <u>heart of sin</u> & He gave us <u>His own Heart</u> (<u>2 Cor 5:21</u> & <u>Rom Ch 6</u>)

<u>Rom 12:1-2</u> - explains how this Transformation take place
 <u>Eph 4:22-24</u> - explains our role of
 <u>Putting off</u> the Old Nature - & <u>Putting On</u> the New Nature

This is the MASSIVE STEP - & I can't go thru it all here so you gotta get the msg - & study it

But God has <u>made a way for us</u> (in Christ) to <u>have the Attributes</u> of God's <u>Own Heart</u> - & not our own

We must <u>Replace</u> our <u>Hard</u> Heart – with <u>God's</u> heart

& then *finally* - STEP # 5 - is the EASY ONE

STEP # 5) Repeat - as often as necessary

This is **the Secret** to LIVING in Divine Forgiveness !!

- So <u>If you FAILED</u> in any of the <u>5 TESTS</u> of Divine Forgiveness then here are the <u>5 STEPS</u> you must begin to take
- 1) Recognize Unforgiveness in your heart
- 2) Receive God's Command to forgive (by faith)
- 3) Repent of your sin (with Godly sorrow)
- 4) Replace your hard heart with God's heart (be transformed)
- 5) Repeat as often as necessary

you don't have to be a <u>slave</u> to your <u>Unforgiveness</u>

anger, bitterness, and resentment don't have to destroy your life

There is no offense that cannot be overcome by God's Divine Forgiveness

& you can begin this process - *<u>Right Now</u>*

<u>You can</u> begin to <u>get Victory</u> <u>over</u> the sin of <u>Un-Forgiveness</u> - <u>Right Now</u>

God is waiting for you
