Bait10 - Forgiveness Required - Matthew 18:21-35

In the Bible - <u>MERCY</u> is <u>Compassion In Action</u> toward someone who <u>DOES NOT</u> deserve it

In the most sacrificial way possible

GOD acted in Eternal Compassion toward US

When we did not, could not, and never would
DESERVE his MERCY

MERCY is <u>Compassion In Action</u> toward someone who <u>DOES NOT</u> deserve it

& it is **God's FREE GIFT** of **MERCY** – That **LEADS US** to **Freely Giving** - **Total Divine Forgiveness**

<u>Divine Forgiveness</u> - Is <u>Not something</u> <u>We Can <u>Produce</u> in <u>OUR</u> Own <u>Nature</u></u>

The **ONLY** way we can **GIVE OUT Divine Forgiveness** - is by the **Life** of **Jesus** Christ Living **IN US** - & **THRU US**

Let's Pray

We have done SO MUCH teaching on Divine Forgiveness (because it has been a big part of my life & testimony)

At <u>WordByMail.com</u> you can search the word "Forgiveness" and <u>get</u> a <u>hold</u> of a <u>bunch of msgs</u>

But <u>the one</u> I would <u>suggest</u> – to <u>GO WITH This Msg</u> is called - <u>5 and 5 For Divine Forgiveness</u>

It's <u>Msg #12</u> in our <u>series</u> on <u>Joseph</u>
& it <u>would</u> be <u>great</u> to <u>LISTEN TO</u> or <u>READ</u> - <u>along</u> with <u>this</u> msg

HOW Important is it – that we **Live** in this **Divine Mercy** that **LEADS to Divine Forgiveness?**

James 2:13 (NLT)

13 There will be <u>no mercy</u> for those who have <u>not shown mercy</u> to others. But <u>if you</u> have been merciful, <u>God will</u> be merciful when he judges you.

& what about the 2 vs's that FOLLOW - The Lord's Prayer

Matthew 6:14-15 (NLT)

14 "If you forgive those who sin against you, your heavenly Father will forgive you.

15 But if you refuse to forgive others, your Father will <u>not forgive</u> your sins.

WHAATTT ????

<u>I know</u> – you <u>want</u> to <u>Know Exactly</u> what <u>THAT MEANS</u>

BUT – for today – Can you just take a deep breath & say
Ohhh – that's definitely NOT GOOD

& <u>We'll SEE</u> today – that <u>God</u> calls us to <u>Divine Forgiveness</u> FOR OUR OWN GOOD God has Made a Way - to SAVE You from the Self-Inflicted PRISON of UN-Forgiveness

By GIVING YOU - HIS OWN Divine Forgiveness -

Because Hardened Unforgiveness
bring BONDAGE & DESTRUCTION - into a Christian's Life

But <u>God</u> has <u>Given</u> you his <u>UNFAILING MERCY</u> to <u>FREE YOU</u> from the <u>TORTURE</u> of <u>Unforgiveness</u>

- & <u>I KNOW</u> <u>SOME</u> have had <u>Very Serious</u> & <u>Very Traumatic</u> events in their <u>lives</u>
- & I am <u>NOT saying</u> that <u>God's Divine Forgiveness</u> is <u>EASY</u> or <u>INSTANTANEOUS</u>

But I <u>am saying</u> - God <u>DESIRES</u> to <u>FREE you</u> from the <u>BONDAGE</u> & <u>DESTRUCTION</u> of <u>Unforgiveness</u> in your life

& so - I'd like you (right now) - to ask God - to SHOW you

THAT PERSON – that you are Holding **UNFORGIVENESS toward**

<u>Or THAT SITUATION</u> – where you need to experience <u>God's Divine Forgiveness</u>

& as **we Go On** - Please - **ALLOW** the **Holy Spirit** to Continue to **Bring up** that **PERSON** or **SITUATION** in your mind

<u>Today</u> - We <u>will SEE</u> - <u>3 SUPERNATURAL Steps</u> to **Experience Divine Forgiveness** in your life

ALL of which we get - from this Parable in MAT Ch 18

- 3 Supernatural Steps to Divine Forgiveness
- 1) We must Receive God's Mercy
- 2) We must Make the Comparison
- 3) We must Give Out God's Mercy

There is **SO MUCH MORE** – that we have taught on In this area of **Divine Forgiveness**

But for today - & for this Parable

These 3 Supernatural Steps are enough

In Mat 18 - just After the section on how to Correctly RECONCILE & RESTORE a Believer

We pick it up in Matthew 18:21 (NLT)

21 Then Peter came to him and asked, "Lord, how often should I forgive someone who sins against me? Seven times?"

<u>That</u> sounds <u>reasonable</u> – 7 *Times? - Good Job Peter*

& - Once again – PETER gets CORRECTED by Jesus

In Matthew 18:22 (NLT)

22 "No, not seven times," Jesus replied, "but seventy times seven!

Some translations have <u>77 times</u> here But – **whether 77** - or **70 Times 7** - **everyone** is in agreement

<u>Jesus</u> is saying – <u>We</u> are Called to <u>FORGIVE</u>

"An <u>UNLIMITED</u> amount of <u>times</u>"

& then Jesus tells us A PARABLE to help us UNDERSTAND

Just How HIGH a "PRIORITY" God puts On US
Living in HIS Divine Forgiveness

Again – these are **the 3-Steps** to **Divine Forgiveness** we **see** here

- 1) We Receive God's Mercy
- 2) We Make the Comparison
- 3) We Give Out God's Mercy

Matthew 18:23-24 (NLT)

23 "Therefore, the Kingdom of Heaven can be compared to a king who decided to bring his accounts up to date with servants who had borrowed money from him.

24 In the process, one of his debtors was brought in who owed him <u>millions of dollars</u>.

First - let's set the stage correctly

The **KING** is **GOD**

& here - The SERVANT with the Debt - is YOU

& **Jesus** says (v.23)

the kingdom of heaven can be compared - to THIS situation

& in <u>V.24</u> - <u>YOU</u> <u>owe GOD</u> – a <u>DEBT</u> - of <u>MILLIONS of Dollars</u>

The <u>Literal</u> here is <u>10,000 TALENTS</u>

10,000 Talents is 375 TONS of Silver
At today's Silver price – that is \$276,000,000

YOU owed the KING of Heaven
an Absolutely, Unimaginable & Unrepayable DEBT

Our SIN – was a DEBT – that we Owed to God – & it was an Absolutely Unrepayable DEBT

You could **NEVER repay the DEBT** of your **Sin** toward **God**

<u>& So - COL 2:14 says</u>

God CANCELLED the Record of your Debt

By NAILING IT to the Cross – Under the BLOOD of Jesus

& so cont'g in Matthew 18:25 (NLT) \rightarrow

Matthew 18:25 (NLT)

25 He (that's you) couldn't pay (the debt), so his master ordered that he be sold—along with his wife, his children, and everything he owned—to pay the debt.

This was the Normal & Customary response at the time

In fact - This was the Correct & "Righteous" Response
When a Debt this BIG could NOT be Re-Paid

IN the SAME WAY – the WRATH of God's Judgment
Is the Correct & Righteous Response - to your Debt of SIN

Then - cont'g in Matthew 18:26 (NLT)

26 "But the man fell down before his master and begged him, 'Please, be patient with me, and I will pay it all.'

Could he, Really?

Could the Servant ever PAY this "Un-Repayable Debt"?

No – Of course he could NEVER Re-Pay it

JUST AS we could Never Re-Pay God for the Debt of our SIN

& So - The MASTER Responds in

Matthew 18:27 (NLT)

27 Then his master was <u>filled with pity</u> for him, and he <u>released</u> <u>him</u> and <u>forgave his debt</u>.

The <u>Master</u> – The <u>KING of Heaven</u> – <u>Had PITY on YOU</u> & <u>RELEASED</u> You – And <u>FORGAVE your DEBT</u>

& THIS IS STEP #1 - WE MUST RECEIVE GOD'S MERCY

We must TRULY EMBRACE – HOW MUCH Mercy & Grace
WE have Received from GOD

RESULTING in us being FORGIVEN

& RELEASED from our Debt of SIN

If <u>YOU</u> have <u>received</u> God's <u>Free Gift</u> of <u>Salvation</u> in <u>Jesus</u> Christ <u>THIS</u> is What <u>God</u> has Done for <u>YOU</u>

God has Completely RELEASED You,

& Completely FORGIVEN - the Unrepayable Debt you owed him

1st – We must <u>FULLY RECEIVE</u> that <u>FREE GIFT</u>
Of God's Mercy & Forgiveness of our DEBT of SIN

<u>THEN - The Parable moves</u> on - to <u>YOU</u> & <u>YOUR Dealings</u> with the <u>person</u> who has <u>OFFENDED you</u>

STEP #2 – WE MUST MAKE THE COMPARISON

Matthew 18:28(a) (NLT)

28 "But when the man left the king, he went to a fellow servant who owed him a few thousand dollars . . .

So - You WENT OUT and FOUND one of your fellow servants

& that person owes you a few thousand dollars

Compared to the MILLIONS you have just been forgiven of

THIS is The Comparison

You've been forgiven of a Completely Unrepayable Debt

& <u>Yet</u> - you are <u>hunting down</u> <u>someone</u> who <u>owes you</u> a <u>Much SMALLER Debt</u> by comparison

& <u>then</u> – in the <u>2nd half of V.28</u> – we <u>see</u> what <u>you do</u> <u>when</u> you <u>find</u> that <u>person</u> who has <u>wronged</u> you

Let's read the full Vs - Matthew 18:28 (NLT)

28 "But when the man left the king, he went to a fellow servant who owed him a few thousand dollars. He grabbed him by the throat and demanded instant payment.

THAT doesn't seem right, does it?

Jesus is COMPARING how MUCH - GOD has Forgiven YOU
With how MUCH - YOU have Forgiven OTHERS

As <u>Freely Forgiven</u> Christians – <u>How are we doing</u> at **Freely Forgiving** those who have **OFFENDED** us?

Is <u>there a CHANCE</u> – that we are <u>actually holding</u>
<u>Someone</u> who has <u>Wronged</u> us – in some <u>sort of PRISON</u>

Even if it's just a Prison "in our own Minds" As we refuse to Forgive Them for their OFFENSE toward us

So – in our **Parable**:

You track down your fellow servant - & get them in a Choke-Hold

& THEN - THEY Say to YOU

Exactly what YOU Just Said to GOD

Matthew 18:29-30 (NLT)

29 "His fellow servant fell down before him and begged for a little more time. 'Be patient with me, and I will pay it,' he pleaded.

30 But his creditor (you) wouldn't wait. He (you) had the man arrested and put in prison until the debt could be paid in full.

YOUR Servant asked YOU - for the same Mercy that YOU have received from GOD

But – Even **tho YOU** have **been Forgiven SO MUCH**

You show NO Mercy

to the **one** who **Owes** you **MUCH LESS** than **YOU OWE GOD**

& then YOU throw Your fellow servant into Prison until he (or she) PAYS FOR What they have Done to you

FOR US- the most Dangerous Prison we can put people in who have wronged us – is the Prison of OUR OWN Minds

We **hold them** in the **PRISON of our Minds** & we **TRY** to **make them PAY**

But – <u>WHAT HAPPENS IS</u> <u>WE</u> are the <u>ones</u> - who <u>end up</u> - <u>IN SHACKLES</u>

& <u>then</u> – I think <u>v.31</u> may <u>possibly</u> be the <u>SADDEST Vs</u> in the <u>entire Parable</u>

Because in v.31 – I Imagine the ANGELS going to God on this whole thing

Matthew 18:31 (NLT)

31 "When some of the other servants saw this, they were very upset. They went to the king (God) and told him everything that had happened.

Can you see the Angels - In DISBELIEF - Going to God - & Saying

"Lord, It cost you SO MUCH, to Forgive that person – & you GAVE them that Forgiveness SO FREELY

But then, they hunted down a person who had Offended them

& they choked them out & threw them in Prison to MAKE THEM PAY

& <u>so</u> – in <u>Vs's 32-33</u>
We <u>SEE HOW God Responds</u> to this <u>Unforgiving Servant</u>

Matthew 18:32-33 (NLT)

32 Then the king (God) called in the man he had forgiven (you) and said, 'You evil servant! I forgave you that tremendous debt because you pleaded with me.

33 Shouldn't you have mercy on your fellow servant, <u>just as</u> I had mercy on you?'

Shouldn't you have mercy on your fellow servant, <u>just as</u> I had mercy on you?

The Words - JUST AS Mean
In the same way, or to the same extent

Shouldn't you have mercy on your fellow servant, [in the same way, & to the same extent, as] I had mercy on you?

Shouldn't WE – Be Showing MERCY to others - in the same way that God has Shown MERCY to US?

WE MUST MAKE THIS COMPARISON

& <u>I Know</u> – <u>sometimes</u> this <u>Seems</u> <u>IMPOSSIBLE</u> to <u>DO</u>

<u>& I Know</u> – <u>there</u> are <u>Situations</u> that <u>make</u> this seem *UNIMAGINABLE*

<u>BUT</u> – <u>What if</u> I <u>told you</u> that <u>Showing MERCY</u>, & <u>Giving DIVINE FORGIVENESS</u> in your <u>life</u>

Is Actually for YOUR OWN GOOD

WHAT IF God is calling us

to Live in Divine Forgiveness

in <u>order</u> to <u>KEEP US</u> from <u>Being TORTURED</u> By our <u>UN-Forgiveness</u>?

So - Back to The Servant (You) - who would NOT Forgive IN the SAME WAY - AS He had Been Forgiven

We read in - Matthew 18:34 (NLT)

34 Then the angry king (God) sent the man (you) to prison to be tortured until he had paid his entire debt.

What do you mean - TO BE TORTURED
Until he had PAID his Entire Debt

That <u>seems</u> a little <u>MUCH</u> doesn't it?

<u>Is God saying</u> – <u>THAT will happen to me</u>, -If I <u>refuse</u> to <u>Forgive those</u> who have <u>Wronged Me</u>?

All we can do is read the Next Vs

(the answer is ALWAYS in the Next Vs)

Matthew 18:35 (NLT)

35 "That's what my heavenly Father will do to you if you refuse to forgive your brothers and sisters from your heart." [REPEAT]

Seriously Lord? You would **Allow THAT** to happen to **ME**?

Are you saying I will be <u>TORTURED</u> – If I <u>refuse</u> to <u>Forgive</u> IN THE SAME WAY - as you have <u>forgiven me?</u>

<u>Please hear me</u> – <u>Hardened Unforgiveness</u> <u>becomes - MENTAL</u> & <u>EMOTIONAL</u> <u>TORTURE</u> in your Life

<u>Hardened Unforgiveness</u> <u>ALWAYS</u> ends up – <u>Imprisoning Us</u> – AND <u>Torturing Us</u>

& <u>UN-Forgiveness</u> – <u>Can become</u> a <u>Ruthless Torturer!!</u>

BUT – What God CALLS US TO God PROVIDES FOR US

God KNOWS - we could NEVER accomplish
ANY of this - on our Own

BUT - By the Life of Jesus - Taking over OUR Life
The LIFE of Jesus BECOMES Divine Forgiveness - IN US

This is Not something we can Work Up on our own

This is Something we SURRENDER to the Lord

& AS we SURRENDER - Divine Forgiveness becomes

a FRUIT of the Holy Spirit Living in us& Miraculously Transforming Us

Jesus has given us HIS DIVINE POWER - in The Person of the Holy Spirit

For us to be FREED from the Torture of Unforgiveness

OUR Part is to <u>Continually CHOOSE</u> To <u>WALK</u> in the <u>New Life</u> that <u>Jesus Christ</u> has given <u>you</u>

& SO, STEP #3 – WE MUST GIVE OUT GOD'S MERCY

- 1) We've **RECEIVED God's Mercy**
- 2) We've Made the COMPARISON in order to Crucify our Flesh
- 3) Now we **GIVE OUT God's Mercy** that is Inside of us

We **ALLOW** - The **DIVINE Nature of God**To **REPLACE** our **SIN NATURE**

We Allow GOD'S MERCY Living inside us to "REPLACE" our Unforgiveness

& Then . . . We GIVE THAT OUT!

We <u>GIVE OUT</u> - <u>DIVINE FORGIVENESS</u> – Flowing From the <u>New Life</u> of <u>Jesus</u> Christ <u>Living inside</u> of <u>us</u>

Again - This is **NOT Something WE** do **Ourselves**It's **Something Jesus** Christ **DOES** - **IN US**

We've GOT TO GIVE UP – Our RIGHT to HOLD ON to the Cancer of Un-Forgiveness in our hearts

We've GOT TO GIVE OVER to God

The <u>Things</u> we Can't <u>FIX</u> & The <u>Things</u> we Can't <u>CONTROL</u>

& We've GOT TO REPLACE those things

with **GOD'S Supernatural MERCY**Which **Leads** to **Divine Forgiveness**

I KNOW this is NOT EASY

& I KNOW this is NOT IMMEDIATE

But I KNOW how BIG, & How MERCIFUL - Our GOD IS !!

WOULD YOU PRAY with me <u>right now</u> that the <u>Lord</u> would <u>Transform</u> you in <u>THIS Area</u>

WOULD YOU TRUST HIM to DO IT

WOULD YOU CONTINUE to CRY OUT to Him

To <u>GIVE YOU</u> - <u>Divine Forgiveness</u> . . . <u>For that PERSON</u> – <u>Or that SITUATION</u> in your <u>Life</u>

God wants to FREE YOU - from the BONDAGE & DESTRUCTION of your Unforgiveness

He wants to RENEW, & RESTORE, & TRANSFORM You

& By the POWER of The Holy Spirit

God wants to Give you the GIFT of Divine Forgiveness
