Mrk34 – Clear and Present Warnings – Mark 9:42-50

<u>There</u> is an <u>Action movie</u> with the <u>Name</u> "<u>Clear & Present Danger</u>" – which <u>I've never seen</u>

& there is a <u>Supreme Court Ruling</u> from <u>1919</u> that <u>made</u> the phrase "<u>Clear & Present Danger</u>" a <u>Legal Test</u>

Which I could very easily get <u>Side-Tracked</u> on & <u>apply</u> to our current <u>Crazy Political Situation</u>

BUT - In both of those instances

- a "<u>Clear & Present Danger</u>" is an <u>Absolute & Imminent Danger</u>
- & <u>today</u> the <u>LANGUAGE</u> that <u>Jesus himself</u> uses Is <u>SO GRAPHIC</u> - & <u>So INTENSE</u>
- <u>That</u> (to me) it <u>makes up</u> <u>this</u> same <u>*Kind of Intensity*</u>
- & <u>So</u> we'll call the <u>Three WARNINGS</u> <u>that</u> we'll <u>look</u> at <u>today</u>

Three Clear & Present WARNINGS

Let's Pray

How do we HANDLE Serious & Dramatic Warnings in the Bible?

<u>Sometimes</u> – we <u>AVOID THEM</u> <u>Just</u> kind of – <u>SKIP over</u> them

<u>Maybe</u> because we <u>think</u> <u>Certainly</u> God <u>CAN'T Mean What He Says</u>

- & <u>Often</u> <u>Bible Teachers</u> Focus <u>on</u> the "<u>Counter-Balance</u>" of the <u>Rest</u> of <u>Scripture</u>
- & it <u>IS important</u> to <u>Balance</u> the <u>Warnings</u> <u>With</u> the Big-*Picture Truths* of <u>ALL</u> the <u>Bible</u>
- But <u>Sometimes</u> we <u>do that</u> So <u>Much</u> <u>That</u> we <u>take-away</u> the <u>IMPACT</u> of the <u>Warnings</u>

BUT – When Jesus DELIVERS Dramatic Warnngs like he does today

He <u>DOESN'T Soften</u> them HE <u>DOESN'T counter-balance</u> them

He <u>DROPS them</u> with <u>Startling Force</u> & he <u>allows</u> us - to <u>Wrestle</u> with <u>them</u>

& <u>so</u> – <u>I'm going</u> to try to <u>DO THAT</u> – <u>Today</u> – Okay?

<u>Let</u> me <u>start</u> – by <u>listing</u> the <u>Three</u> <u>Clear & Present Warnings</u> - From <u>Jesus</u> - in our <u>Text</u>

#1) BEWARE of CAUSING a Believer to FALL INTO SIN
#2) BEWARE of CODDLING SIN in your own life
#3) BEWARE of LOSING your SALTINESS

<u>ALL Three</u> of these <u>Warnings</u> <u>Come</u> with <u>Very</u> <u>Graphic Descriptions</u>

That we have to Wrestle with - in our own lives

We're continuing our context - from Last week

<u>Where</u> we <u>Looked</u> at <u>THREE</u> "<u>We Still Don't Get It</u>" Situations

& the <u>3rd one</u> was the <u>Disciples</u> explaining to <u>Jesus</u>

that <u>they saw</u> someone <u>Who</u> was NOT in their group

Using the <u>Name of Jesus</u> to <u>Cast</u> out <u>Demons</u> - & so - they <u>told</u> him to <u>STOP IT</u>

& in <u>Response</u> - <u>Jesus</u> told the <u>Disciples</u> in <u>Mark 9:39</u> – *"Don't stop him!"*

& then **Jesus explained**

Anyone who is <u>Operating</u> - in the <u>Name of Jesus</u> & who is <u>Not Against Jesus</u> – <u>is FOR Jesus</u>

& that <u>Leads Jesus</u> – <u>into</u> a <u>CONTRAST</u> <u>WHICH Begins</u> our <u>Text</u> Today

So – Let's back up One Vs – to Mark 9:41 – to start

<u>Mark 9:41 (from last week) (NLT)</u> 41 If anyone gives you <u>even</u> a cup of water <u>because you</u> <u>belong to the Messiah</u>, I tell you the truth, that person will surely be rewarded.

If anyone helps or supports you In the <u>Name of Jesus</u> & Because you belong to Jesus

That person will surely be rewarded - Praise the Lord

BUT THEN – the Contrast Vs comes -

Mark 9:42 (NLT)

42 "BUT (in contrast to helping a Christ-Follower) if <u>you</u> cause one of these <u>little ones who trusts in me</u> to <u>fall into sin</u>, it would be better for you to be thrown into the sea with a large millstone hung around your neck.

THAT is a Clear & Present WARNING

<u>Now</u> – this <u>phrase</u> *"Little Ones who Trust in Jesus"*

It Certainly CAN (& does) Apply to Children

<u>But</u> – it is <u>also</u> used in a <u>Spiritual Sense</u> for <u>NEW</u> or <u>YOUNG Believers</u>

So – If you help someone (V.41 says)

<u>Because</u> they are a <u>Christ-Follower</u>, <u>AND</u> in the <u>Name of Jesus</u> – then <u>your reward</u> is <u>sure</u>

<u>BUT</u> – if you cause a <u>New Believer</u>, or a <u>Believer Young in the Faith</u> – to Fall into Sin

it would be better for you to be thrown into the sea with a large millstone hung around your neck.

A millstone is a large stone used to Grind Wheat Even the smallest ones weighing over 100 pounds

& so Jesus says

Wearing a <u>Necklace made</u> out of a <u>100 lb stone</u> & <u>being thrown</u> into the <u>Sea</u>

<u>Would</u> be <u>BETTER</u> – <u>For you</u> <u>than</u> what is <u>WAITING for you</u>

IF you <u>cause</u> a <u>New</u>, or a <u>Young Believer</u>

to Fall into Sin

In CONTRAST

to this First Clear & Present Warning

The Entire N.T. calls us:

- To Come Alongside one another
- To *Help Carry* One another's Burdens
- To Strengthen One Another
- To *Follow Jesus* Together *with* One Another

So *this First* – *DIRE WARNING* from *Jesus*

Is <u>about</u> our <u>INFLUENCE</u> - & our <u>IMPACT</u> on <u>other</u> Believers (Especially New or Young Believers)

& <u>God Help us</u>

If we *cause them* to Fall into Sin

<u>Okay – Let's move on</u>

but you're *probably going* to *wish*

<u>that</u> we <u>would've</u> <u>spent</u> more <u>time</u> on the <u>First Warning</u>

Because this **2nd Warning** - gets **even** more "**Personal**"

2nd – Clear & Present Warning

<u>These</u> are the <u>Words of Jesus</u> in the <u>Very NEXT Vs</u>

Mark 9:43 (NLT)

43 If your hand causes you to sin, <u>cut it off</u>. It's better to enter eternal life with only one hand than to go into the unquenchable fires of hell with two hands.

l <u>told you</u> it was <u>gonna get</u> <u>even</u> more "<u>Personal</u>"

<u>BUT</u> - instead of me explaining *just* - <u>Cutting Off Your Hand</u>

Let's continue - in order to get the full picture

<u>Mark 9:45 (NLT)</u>

45 If your foot causes you to sin, <u>cut it off</u>. It's better to enter eternal life with only one foot than to be thrown into hell with two feet.

<u>Alright</u> – so far we're <u>Going to Heaven</u> with <u>ONE Hand</u> & <u>ONE Foot</u>

RATHER than going to <u>Hell</u> with all our <u>Appendages</u> – Right? But – Jesus isn't Done - With this Warning YET

<u>Mark 9:47-48 (NLT)</u>

47 And if your eye causes you to sin, <u>gouge it out</u>. It's better to enter the Kingdom of God with only one eye than to have two eyes and <u>be thrown into hell</u>, 48 'where the maggots never die and the fire never goes out.'

It's <u>NOT Graphic Enough</u> For Jesus to *just* say <u>be thrown into hell</u>

& so he **adds** a **Detailed Description** of Hell in **V.48 'where the maggots never die and the fire never goes out.'**

& in the <u>King James Line</u> of <u>Translations</u> <u>that vs</u> is actually <u>inserted</u>

after EACH of these three Clear and Present Warnings

Cutting off Your HAND Cutting off Your FOOT Gouging out of EYE

THIS IS All - Hyperbole

Hyperbole is

an exaggerated statement not meant to be taken literally

We all KNOW that – Right?

So **What** is **Jesus** talking **about**?

Let me quote R. Kent Hughes here

What Jesus is calling for is <u>not physical mutilation</u>, but <u>spiritual mortification</u>—the cutting off of harmful practices from one's life.

& it is generally accepted

<u>The HAND</u> symbolizes <u>WHAT</u> we <u>DO</u> <u>The FOOT</u> symbolizes <u>WHERE</u> We <u>GO</u> <u>The EYE</u> symbolizes <u>WHAT</u> we are <u>LOOKING AT</u>

Jesus is using very Graphic HYPERBOLE

to **try** to **get this** <u>Clear & Present Warning</u> - <u>across</u> to us Are there Things we are DOING that are CAUSING US to Sin?

Jesus says - Radically Cut That Off

Are there Places we are GOING that are CAUSING US to Sin?

<u>Jesus says</u> – <u>Radically Cut That Off</u>

Are there Things we are LOOKING AT that are CAUSING US to Sin?

<u>GUESS WHAT</u> Jesus says . . . <u>Radically Cut That Off</u>

This <u>Graphic Metaphor</u> – of <u>Cutting Off</u> an <u>Appendage</u> Is <u>clearly conveying</u>

the <u>DECISIVENESS</u> - & the <u>SACRIFICE</u> Required to <u>CONQUER</u> our <u>Sinful Habits</u>

Jesus is **METAPHORICALLY saying**

<u>Better</u> a <u>little Blood</u> on the <u>Ground Now</u> <u>Than</u> an <u>Eternity</u> <u>Spent in Hell</u>

Can we just ACCEPT this Clear & Present Warning For what it is?

& Not Rationalize, Justify, or Debate the issue?

So – <u>Staying</u> with this <u>Idea</u> of a <u>Sacrifice being Required</u> – to Follow Jesus

Will <u>LEAD</u> us <u>RIGHT INTO</u> our <u>last</u> <u>Clear & Present Warning</u>

Mark 9:49 (NLT)

49 "For everyone will be tested (think of sacrifice) with fire.

<u>The ESV gives us the Literal - Mark 9:49 (ESV)</u> 49 For everyone will be <u>salted</u> with fire.

This is a really HARD sentence to translate

But there's a Definite Connection here <u>To</u> the <u>O.T. Sacrifices</u> <u>which</u> were <u>required</u> to be <u>SALTED</u>

So – Keeping with the Previous Context

<u>There is the FIRE</u> of the <u>Believer's</u> "<u>Sanctification</u>" (<u>cutting off sin</u>) & there is – the <u>Fire of HELL</u>

& Jesus seems to be saying that EVERYONE will be <u>Tested</u> by <u>ONE Fire</u> or the <u>OTHER</u>

Either the <u>Short-Term Fire</u> of <u>SANCTIFYING</u> our Lives for God

Or the Eternal Fire of HELL

If we CHOOSE - to Follow Jesus Christ

There is a "Refiner's Fire" - that Sanctifies Us

To **<u>Be Sanctified</u>** – <u>Means</u> to be "<u>Set Apart</u>" for <u>God's Use</u>, & <u>God's Glory</u>

& <u>we need</u> to <u>EMBRACE</u> The <u>Refiners Fire</u> That <u>Sanctifies</u> us

Because that Sanctifying <u>Makes Us</u> – The <u>SALT of the Earth</u> <u>Makes Us</u> – <u>USABLE</u> <u>By God</u>

<u>AND</u> – That <u>Sanctifying</u> <u>Is</u> what <u>CONFIRMS</u> - (Not Earns – but Confirms)

the <u>Alternate Fire</u> – of <u>HELL</u>

& <u>so</u> – <u>Hopefully</u> it is <u>EASY to See</u> That the <u>Refiner's Fire</u> – that <u>Sanctifies us</u>

<u>IS BETTER</u>

The the *Fire of HELL* - that <u>Separates us</u> From <u>God's Presence</u> – For <u>Eternity</u> Finally - Because of the LITERAL Words of V.49 For everyone will be <u>SALTED</u> with fire

<u>Jesus continues</u> with the <u>SALT analogy</u> <u>Which we find often in the N.T.</u>

& <u>so</u> – <u>Jesus closes</u> this <u>section</u> in

Mark 9:50 (NLT)

50 Salt is good for seasoning (that's us – Salted by the Refiner's Fire). <u>But</u> if it loses its flavor, how do you make it salty again? . . .

This is the THIRD - Clear & Present Warning

Salt is GOOD – It Preserves Things AND – it Causes Thirst

& <u>THAT</u> is <u>What</u> <u>WE</u> are <u>called to be</u> in the <u>World</u>

A <u>Preserving Influence</u> on a <u>Fallen World</u> & <u>Causing Thirst</u> in an <u>Unbelieving World</u>

THAT is what God is Transforming us TO BE

The SALT of the Earth A <u>Preserving & Thirst Causing</u> Influence BUT - the 2nd sentence in v.50 says

if Salt loses its flavor, how do you make it salty again?

This is a *Rhetorical Warning*

Implying – that once SALT (that's us) Loses its Qualities

it is impossible to make it SALTY again

It is a More Subtle – but <u>Just As SCARY</u> a <u>Warning</u> As the <u>Previous Warnings</u> today, right?

& so - THREE Clear & Present Warnings

#1) BEWARE of CAUSING a Believer to FALL INTO SIN
#2) BEWARE of CODDLING SIN in your own life
#3) BEWARE of LOSING your SALTINESS

All 3 Warnings with Really Graphic & Serious Consequences tied to them

#1) Cause a New Believer to Fall into Sin
 Better to tie a Millstone tied around your neck
 & be cast into the Sea

#2) Better to CUT OFF Sin in your Life Than Coddle Sin & Risk an Eternity in Hell

 $\rightarrow \rightarrow \rightarrow$

3) Beware of losing the "SaltQualities" of the Gospel in Your Life

Because you may not be able to get them BACK again

Hard Core – Clear & Present Warnings

So - What do we do with these Warnings?

I think – the best One Word Response is – REPENT

<u>& I think</u> there is an <u>URGENCY</u> - & a <u>DRASTIC-NESS</u> In <u>these Words</u> of <u>Jesus</u>

<u>To Support</u> the <u>Need</u> – to <u>REPENT NOW</u> <u>Turn</u> from <u>these</u> things <u>NOW</u>

& <u>Turn TO Jesus</u> For <u>Forgiveness</u> - & <u>Restoration</u> - & <u>Transformation</u>

& Genuinely Seek the DAILY "Filling with the Holy Spirit" & the DAILY "Closer Walk with Jesus"

That the <u>Refiners Fire</u> would <u>PURIFY US</u> & <u>TRANSFORM US</u>

& <u>make</u> us <u>USABLE By God</u> <u>For</u> - <u>Our GOOD</u>, & For <u>HIS Glory</u> & <u>THAT</u> is <u>how Jesus</u> <u>Finishes</u> this section At the <u>END</u> of V<u>.50</u>

Mark 9:50(b) (NLT)

50... You must have the <u>qualities of salt</u> among yourselves and <u>live in peace</u> with each other."

As Christ Followers

We <u>Must Have</u> – the <u>Preserving</u> & <u>Thirst Causing</u> - Qualities of Salt

AND - we must Live in PEACE with Each Other

Let's Pray
