Mrk44 - Do We Owe God? - Mark 11:27-12:12

THANK YOU Pastor Jeff!!

Our **last msg** in the **Gospel of Mark** was – "We Need Real Faith"

I read thru that msg Fri night - & thought

Man, this msg is exactly what I NEED

So – I <u>encourage you</u> to go back & <u>watch</u>, <u>listen</u>, or <u>read</u> that msg on The <u>Word By Mail</u> phone app – or on the <u>Church website</u>.

& so – <u>this morning</u> we <u>pick up</u> on that <u>SAME Day</u> after the <u>Real Faith Lesson</u> of the <u>Fig Tree</u>

& today - **Jesus** enters **Jerusalem** again – w/ the **Disciples**

& he <u>comes</u> <u>into</u> the <u>city</u> – <u>Ready</u> for a <u>No Holds Barred</u> – <u>Cage Fight to the Death</u>

Jesus is going into the RING
With the Religious Leaders of the day

& IT IS a Cage Fight - TO HIS DEATH

& <u>today</u> – <u>Jesus starts</u> this final – <u>Spiritual Boxing Match</u>
By <u>just throwing</u> a few <u>JABS</u> - (to <u>get under their</u> skin)

But He's letting them know - right up front

The Gloves Are Off - & the Championship Fight for WHO is Truly KING - HAS BEGUN

& guys – Us Putting Ourselves IN this section of scripture Is really, really GOOD for us – So Get Ready

I'm just going to READ straight thru our First Section today

Just **so** you **can se**e - The **Religious Leaders come** at **Jesus** with a **half-hearted swing**

& <u>Jesus lands</u> his <u>FIRST JAB</u>
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Mark 11:27-33 (NLT)

- 27 Again they entered Jerusalem. As Jesus was walking through the Temple area, the leading priests, the teachers of religious law, and the elders came up to him. (the entire group that will orchestrate his death)
- 28 They demanded, "By what authority are you doing all these things? Who gave you the right to do them?" (referring to the cleansing of the Temple)
- 29 "I'll tell you by what authority I do these things if you answer one question," Jesus replied. (that's a Jab)
- 30 "Did John's authority to baptize come from heaven, or was it merely human? Answer me!" (notice the Exclamation Point)
- 31 They talked it over among themselves. "If we say it was from heaven, he will ask why we didn't believe John.
- 32 But do we dare say it was merely human?" For they were afraid of what the people would do, because everyone believed that John was a prophet.

33 So they finally replied, "We don't know." And Jesus responded, "Then I won't tell you by what authority I do these things."

BAAM – **Round One** - goes to **Jesus** & he **wins it** with **One Punch**

& the Religious Leaders
stumble back into their corner

to put an Ice Pack on their Nose

& <u>AS Round 2 Begins</u> - the <u>Religious Leaders</u> are <u>standing</u> in their <u>corner</u> – getting <u>Angier & Angrier</u>

Mark 12:1 (NLT) (put up entire vs)

1 Then Jesus began teaching them with stories (parables): . . .

Only the NLT uses the phrase "teaching them" all other versions say "speaking to them"

Because Jesus Was Speaking To the Religious Leaders
But they certainly Weren't Learning Anything

So Jesus 'Speaks to them' - in a Parable

A Parable that would be a "Sucker Punch"

Knocking the Wind Out of them – for Round TWO

(cont'g in vs 1) 1... "A man planted a vineyard. He built a wall around it, dug a pit for pressing out the grape juice, and built a lookout tower. Then he leased the vineyard to tenant farmers and moved to another country.

Now – <u>you</u> may <u>Not Immediately Know</u> that <u>Jesus</u> is <u>using</u> a <u>Common Illustration</u> of <u>God & Israel</u>

But I <u>assure you</u> – the <u>Religious Leaders</u> <u>Knew Immediately</u>

Because <u>Jesus</u> was <u>referring</u> to - the <u>National SYMBOL</u> of <u>Israel's Relationship with God</u>

<u>In fact</u> - on the <u>gates leading</u> from the <u>Outer Court</u> into the <u>Temple Proper</u> was a <u>MASSIVE Grapevine</u>

& thru-out the OT - Israel is referred to as God's Vineyard

So – the Religious Leaders knew Immediately

Jesus was talking about - God & THEM

But **Please** - **listen to me** very **carefully** Right Here

WE are Also God's People Today

<u>Grafted in</u> – As <u>Spiritual Sons & Daughters</u> of <u>Abraham</u>

& <u>So</u> – this is <u>no longer</u> just a <u>SUCKER-PUNCH</u> For the **Religious Leaders** in Jesus' Day

NOW - This Confrontation Parable COULD - Knock the Wind - OUT OF US

So – <u>I'm just</u> going to <u>start saying US</u> – *Okay?*

So – <u>Vs.1 says</u> - <u>God</u> has <u>gone</u> to <u>Great Lengths</u> To <u>prepare</u> the <u>Vineyard of OUR lives</u>

- (<u>v.1</u> says) <u>He Planted</u> the <u>Vineyard</u> of our <u>lives</u>
- He Hemmed it in on all sides
- He Made a way to bring FRUIT out of our lives
- & He Built a watchtower to Protect it from the enemy

& then – God gave the Vineyard of our lives -TO US – FOR US To Manage

& we <u>have to know</u> – with all that God did for the Nation of Israel

<u>Today</u> – from a <u>Spiritual Standpoint</u> -God has done <u>SO MUCH MORE</u> for <u>US</u> - <u>Hasn't he?</u>

We may have NO "Living Prophets" Quite like Israel did Who Israel Routinely REJECTED

BUT – we have the Living Word of God

that we may Routinely REJECT

Just like Israel - Rejected the Prophets

& <u>even more</u> – <u>If we</u> have <u>Put Our FAITH</u> in <u>Jesus Christ</u> today

we have the power of the Holy Spirit - Living in us

& the <u>Holy Spirit</u>
Brings the <u>Word of God</u> to <u>Life</u> – <u>IN our Hearts</u>

& so <u>The Soil</u> of the <u>Vineyard</u> that God has <u>made</u> <u>OUR LIVES</u>

Is <u>actually FAR RICHER</u> - <u>Spiritually</u> than that of the <u>Religious Leaders</u> of <u>Israel</u>

AND - WE can REJECT – what We Owe to God

Just like the Leaders of Israel did – Can't We?

& <u>God</u> has been <u>SO PATIENT</u> with us – <u>Hasn't He?</u>

<u>Just like</u> he <u>was</u> (& <u>still is</u>) with the <u>Nation of Israel</u>

& <u>so now</u> - <u>God sends</u> a <u>Servant</u> – to <u>collect the Fruit</u> <u>from</u> the <u>Vineyard of our lives</u>

Mark 12:2-3 (NLT)

2 At the time of the grape harvest, he (the vineyard owner, representing God) sent one of his servants to collect <u>his share</u> of the crop.

3 But the farmers grabbed the servant, beat him up, and sent him back empty-handed.

Could this Really BE US?

Could there be a time
when God has sent His Servant TO US

to <u>collect</u> the <u>Fruit</u> - that <u>should be coming</u> from the <u>Vineyard</u> that <u>God has created</u> in our <u>lives</u>

But - - when the Servant gets to our lives

We DON'T Gratefully Give God - the Fruit he deserves

INSTEAD - We beat the servant up & send him back empty handed

NO FRUIT FOR YOU - GOD!

Instead – we have only Anger or Frustration toward God

But **God** is **so Merciful** - & **so Patient** – **isn't he?**

Mark 12:4-5 (NLT)

- 4 The owner then sent another servant, but they <u>insulted him</u> and beat him over the head.
- 5 The next servant he sent <u>was killed</u>. Others he sent were either beaten or killed,

There **IS Historical Record** of this "**Actually Happening**" **DURING** the time of Jesus

But the Religious Leaders KNEW Jesus was actually talking about Them – Spiritually

Because this is Exactly the Way they Treated the Prophets
Who WERE - the Word of God to them

And <u>WE HAVE</u> – the <u>Living Word of God</u> that <u>God</u> has <u>sent to us</u> – <u>Don't we?</u>

Is there a Chance

that WE are treating the LIVING Word of God

the <u>same way</u> - <u>Israel</u> Treated the <u>Prophets</u> who <u>SPOKE the Word of God</u>?

Is there a Chance that WE are treating

The <u>Living Word of God</u> - & The <u>Living Testimony of the Holy Spirit</u>

In the <u>Same way</u> - the <u>Farmers</u> in the <u>Parable</u> were <u>treating</u> the <u>Servant</u> sent by *Vineyard owner?*

& WHY DID the Farmers REJECT the Servants

who were sent from the Vineyard owner to collect what rightfully belonged to the owner?

Don't you think it was because they VIEWED their Vineyard - (meaning their LIFE)

- as <u>THEIR OWN</u> & <u>NOT belonging</u> to <u>the One</u> who <u>gave it to them</u>
- & so <u>they felt JUSTIFIED</u> in <u>doing</u> with <u>Their Lives</u>
 Whatever <u>THEY WANTED</u> to <u>do</u> with <u>Their Lives</u>

& they felt NO OBLIGATION

for what they OWED to the One who gave it all to them

& so they had no problem - REJECTING - INSULTING - BEATING - & KILLING

the <u>Servants</u> who <u>came</u> – to <u>collect</u> the <u>fruit</u>
that was <u>rightfully OWED</u> – to the <u>Owner</u> of their Lives

& so Finally - The Vineyard owner Sent His Own Son

Now – <u>I know</u> when <u>we read</u> this <u>you're going</u> to <u>think</u> about <u>Israel Rejecting</u> <u>Jesus Christ</u>

& that is **CERTAINLY TRUE**

But – can you <u>try to see</u> with me HOW this may relate to our lives?

So - the Owner had sent all his servants

& then we read in - Mark 12:6-8 (NLT)

6 until there was only one left—his son whom he loved dearly. The owner finally sent him, thinking, 'Surely they will respect my son.'

7 "But the tenant farmers said to one another, 'Here comes the heir to this estate. Let's kill him and get the estate for ourselves!' 8 So they grabbed him and murdered him and threw his body out of the vineyard.

That is Graphic - & Hard to Read

But <u>remember</u> – <u>FOR US</u>
The <u>ESTATE</u> - is a <u>picture of OUR Lives</u>

& the Son is coming to collect the FRUIT – From the life that God has created for us

<u>& the Picture here – is this</u>

Tho Jesus Christ is the RIGHTFUL HEIR to our Spiritual Lives

INSTEAD of Bearing the Fruit that he CREATED us to Bear

We RADICALLY Remove Him - FROM our lives

<u>SO THAT</u> – we <u>can have</u> our <u>Lives</u> <u>TO OURSELVES</u>

& NOT Have To Give Him - the Fruit we Owe Him

So - Can I Ask you - to Ask God a Really HARD Question Right Now

& **Be READY** – to **Really Listen** for the **answer**

Here in the room - & at home - can we just bow our heads & get ready to talk to God for a minute?

Josh is going to play some music to help keep us focused

& <u>we're going</u> to <u>ask God</u> – a <u>Hard Question</u> & then <u>really Listen</u> – for <u>Him to Answer</u>

Ready? - Let's Pray

Here is the HARD Question

What is the Fruit - that God expects from me?

What is the Fruit – that God expects to receive
From the Abundant Spiritual Life - He's Given Me?

Lord, What Fruit – Do I OWE You from the life you've given me?

- From ALL that you've created in me
- From ALL that you've done for me
- From ALL that you've prepared my life to Produce

What fruit – are you Expecting to receive?

What Fruit – do you come seeking from me
Out Of the Abundant Spiritual Life you've given me

Forgiveness

Mercy

Grace

Long-Suffering

Faith - Trust - Contentment

What is it Lord, that you have prepared my life to produce?

What Fruit are you EXPECTING to Receive From my life?

Is it Righteousness

Is it Holiness – in a <u>specific area</u> of my life?

<u>I'm just</u> going to <u>be quiet</u> for a <u>Minute</u>

Please - Don't Lose Focus
Stay in this place with God

Until you **KNOW** – what **Specific Fruit The Lord** is **expecting to receive** from **your life** – today

[Just MUSIC Playing]

[END MUSIC at end of Dave Closing Prayer]

Jesus Christ – is COMING TO OUR LIFE

to **Receive the Fruit** – that **God created US** to **produce**

& for all the times – that we have Rejected Him

Charles Spurgeon said these words

"If you reject him, he answers you with tears; if you wound him, he bleeds out cleansing; if you kill him, he dies to redeem; if you bury him, he rises again to bring resurrection. Jesus is love made manifest."

& <u>Jesus</u> will <u>continue to come</u> to the <u>Vineyard of your life</u>

until your last breath in THIS VINEYARD

BUT- there is a Day - when it becomes - TOO LATE

Speaking to those who **NEVER RECEIVE the Son** God sends . . .

Mark 12:9 (NLT)

9 "What do you suppose the owner of the vineyard will do?" Jesus asked. "I'll tell you—he will come and kill those farmers and lease the vineyard to others.

The Parables are some of the Most Graphic Teachings of Jesus

Because Jesus is SERIOUSLY TRYING To get the truth across to us

<u>& I THINK – THAT Vs – Gets it across</u>

But then comes - The Ultimate Triumph

In this Cage-Fight

Between Jesus - & the Religious Leaders

Mark 12:10-11 (NLT)

10 Didn't you ever read this in the Scriptures? 'The stone that the builders rejected has now become the cornerstone.

11 This is the Lord's doing, and it is wonderful to see.'"

The Religious Leaders Would Reject Jesus & put him to Death

But Jesus would become – the CORNERSTONE
Of the Eternal, Spiritual, Temple of God

& Phil Ch 2 says – One Day EVERY KNEE will Bow
& EVERY TONGUE will confess

That Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father

& right here - R. Kent Hughes tells us

[The Religious Leaders] had heard an eloquent description of the <u>hope</u> of God, the <u>kindness</u> of God, the <u>severity</u> of God, and the <u>triumph</u> of God. They had heard all this from the most authentic voice that ever spoke . . . <u>And what was the result</u>?

Mark 12:12 (NLT)

12 The religious leaders wanted to arrest Jesus because they realized he was telling the story against them—they were the wicked farmers. But they were afraid of the crowd, so they left him and went away.

The **Religious Leaders** of Israel **REJECTED** the **Son of God**

When he came to Receive
What was Rightfully His

& they did it - to their Eternal LOSS

May we, Instead - Receive Jesus Christ

As the Lord of the Vineyard of our Lives

& may we bring to him – The Fruit
That he created our lives to Produce
