Rom 202 - Our Sin & God's Wrath - Rom 1:18-32

The Gospel of Jesus Christ is **the Power of God** for Salvation to **Everyone** who believes

& <u>in it</u> - the <u>Righteousness of God</u> is revealed - **From Faith - To Faith**

But <u>the truth is</u> - The <u>Depths</u> of God's Love & the <u>True Power</u> of His Gospel - can never be grasped

Until we understand the truth of God's **Required Wrath** upon Sin

God's Character (Nature) is First & Foremost Holy - Just - Righteous

& God <u>CANNOT</u> Deny His <u>Holy Nature</u> & <u>therefore</u> - He MUST <u>Judge</u> sin

& <u>Depths</u> of the Love - & the <u>Incredible</u> Power of the *Gospel of Jesus Christ* is

that <u>thru it</u> - <u>God's Wrath</u> for our sin <u>Falls on</u> Jesus Christ - <u>In</u> our Place

Both <u>Satisfying</u> God's Required <u>Judgment</u> on our Sin & making us <u>Justified</u> (righteous) in God's Sight

That is the *miracle of the Gospel* - for ALL who put their Faith in Jesus Christ

HOWEVER - if we <u>never face</u> the <u>true Depravity</u> of our sin we'll <u>never understand</u> the true **depth of His Sacrifice** for us

The <u>truth is</u> - We were <u>born in sin</u> - each one of us & <u>regardless</u> of how we <u>look</u> on the outside . . .

Heb 4:13 says - NLT

13 Nothing in all creation is hidden from God. Everything is naked and exposed before his eyes, and he is the one to whom we are accountable.

We must understand - <u>God saw</u> the true <u>Depravity</u> of our sin <u>When</u> Jesus Christ <u>died in our place</u> on the cross

- & <u>in this section</u> of Romans we can *(at the very least)* get a little **Glimpse** of <u>that Depravity</u> of our **Sin Nature**
- & <u>IF</u> we will try to <u>understand</u> some of the **Wretchedness** of our *Sin Nature*

Then we will better <u>understand</u>
the <u>True Miracle</u> of our <u>Forgiveness</u> in Jesus Christ

We must be able to say with the Apostle Paul

Rom 7:18 - For I know that nothing good dwells in me, that is, in my flesh. . .

Rom 7:24 - Wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death?

- <u>if</u> Jesus Christ is our <u>Lord</u> today then <u>today's msg</u> is - the depth of sin we've <u>been saved from</u>
- <u>if</u> Jesus Christ is <u>NOT</u> our <u>Lord</u> today <u>then today's msg</u> is the depth of sin <u>we must</u> one day <u>Face God With</u>

Let's Pray

Rom 1:18 - ESV

18 For the <u>wrath</u> of God is revealed from heaven against all <u>ungodliness</u> and <u>unrighteousness</u> of men, who by their unrighteousness <u>suppress</u> the truth.

For the wrath of God . . .

There are **Two Greek words** used to express <u>wrath</u>

- 1) "Thumos" (thermometer) = red-hot anger, impulsive, out-of-control not used for God's wrath
- 2) "Orge" (here) A <u>settled</u>, abiding condition It is <u>in control</u>, & is <u>Just</u> & <u>Fair</u>

God's wrath is Holy - Perfectly Just - & Fair

[& it] is revealed from heaven against all <u>ungodliness</u> and <u>unrighteousness</u> of men, who by their unrighteousness <u>suppress</u> the truth.

Who by their unrighteousness - Suppress the Truth

Suppress means to - <u>Actively Hold Down the Truth</u>
This is <u>NOT</u> an <u>Ignorance of the Truth</u>

It means - Man's Unrighteousness actively Holds down the truth

It's like the little boy who snuck **his puppy** into his bedroom & **then** - when his **mom** was coming . . .

he **<u>put the puppy</u>** in the <u>toy box</u> & sat on the lid ignoring the <u>**banging**</u> & <u>**barking**</u> coming from inside & <u>as he "Suppressed"</u> that Puppy in the toy box He <u>asked</u> his mom "What's wrong Mom?"

As IF she doesn't know that he's Actively Holding Down that Puppy

Sin <u>purposefully Suppresses</u> (holds down) the <u>knowledge of God</u> - so we can **satisfy** our own fleshly desires

& **the reason** - we must **Actively Suppress** the *knowledge* of God is **because** - God has *made Himself known* to us

Rom 1:19 - ESV

19 For what <u>can be known</u> about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them.

We certainly don't have the capacity to know ALL there is to know about God

But "what can be known about God" - has been made plain to us because God Himself has shown it to us

When God created man in His own image
He put in us the capacity to know Him

& then he made Himself <u>Abundantly Known</u> to us in <u>ALL the Rest</u> of His Creation

Rom 1:20 \rightarrow \rightarrow

Rom 1:20 - ESV

20 For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been <u>clearly perceived</u>, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse.

God's invisible attributes

specifically His Eternal Power & His Divine Nature

Have been <u>clearly perceived</u> by man <u>ever since</u> the creation of the World

Man's **capacity** to know God - **Started** when God created Man

& His *Eternal Power & His Divine Nature* are clearly <u>PERCEIVED</u>

<u>IN</u> the Wonder of God's creation

Psa 19:1-4 - NLT

- 1 The heavens proclaim the glory of God. The skies display his craftsmanship.
- 2 Day after day they continue to speak; night after night they make him known.
- 3 They speak without a sound or word; their voice is never heard.
- 4 Yet their message has gone throughout the earth, and their words to all the world. . .

God <u>made Man</u> with the capacity to <u>PERCEIVE</u> God's <u>Eternal Power</u> & <u>Divine Attributes</u>

- & He made man with the <u>Free Will</u> <u>at some level</u> to either <u>Accept</u> Or <u>Reject</u> <u>that Capacity</u> to know God
- & so WE ARE WITHOUT EXCUSE (end of v.20 says)

Because - as Rom 1:21 says - ESV

21 For although they knew God, they did not honor him as God or give thanks to him, but they became futile in their thinking, and their foolish hearts were darkened.

If we **REJECT** - that capacity - to **Know God** then we are **WITHOUT EXCUSE**

Because God made us - **to be able** - to know Him & if we **Refuse** to *Honor* Him - or Give *Thanks* to Him

Then <u>we are without excuse</u>

When we face <u>His Wrath</u> - instead of <u>His Forgiveness</u>

We were Created in God's Image;

<u>Placed</u> in a World that <u>screams out</u> the Glory of God & <u>made</u> (at the basic level) to <u>KNOW</u> there is a GOD

BUT - The *fall of Man* made us in turn **rebellious** & sinners *by our sin nature*

& so, altho we've been given the Capacity to know God we rebel against that knowledge

We refuse to <u>Honor God</u> - refuse to <u>Give Thanks</u> to God & <u>instead</u> - we <u>run after</u> our own <u>FUTILE</u> thinking

& that <u>Futile Thinking</u>
ONLY causes our <u>Foolish Hearts</u> - to <u>become Darkened</u>

& **not only that** - But . . .

Rom 1:22 says - ESV \rightarrow

Rom 1:22 says - ESV

22 Claiming to be wise, they became fools,

This is talking about **US** - Living in our **Sin Nature**

The <u>Greek word</u> for "Fools" is the <u>same word</u> we get our word "Moron" from

We think we're so smart

But in our Futile Thinking - we have become FOOLS

& in that Rebellious, Futile Thinking not only have we become FOOLS - but we have . . .

as Rom 1:23 says - ESV

23 and exchanged the glory of the immortal God for images resembling mortal man and birds and animals and reptiles.

Now **THAT** really shows off our **wisdom** doesn't it ??

As soon as Moses goes up the mountain to hear from God we make a Golden Calf & start dancing around it naked (Exo 32)

God <u>created us</u> with the <u>Capacity</u> to know Him -Then he <u>Proclaims Himself</u> to us in all of creation

& instead of <u>Honoring</u> Him - & <u>Giving Thanks</u> to Him we become <u>futile</u> <u>in our thinking</u> our <u>foolish hearts become</u> <u>darkened</u>

& we begin <u>dancing around</u> some <u>Golden Calf</u> of this World

& we exchange the Glory of the <u>Immortal God</u> for <u>images</u> of <u>this world</u> - & <u>the Lust</u> therein

Unbelief refuses to worship God for Who He is

& instead reduces God to something we want, or something we can control

& If we <u>would be honest</u> with ourselves for *ONE second* we would agree with God's <u>WORD</u>

WE DESERVE GOD'S JUDGMENT! (we are without excuse)

Rom 1:24 - ESV

24 Therefore God gave them up in the lusts of their hearts to impurity, to the dishonoring of their bodies among themselves,

We are **talking about people** who have **REFUSED** to **Believe** in God - & in His **Gospel**

Those who (in their Sin Nature)
have SUPPRESSED the Truth that can be known of God

This is the 1st of THREE times we find the words

<u>Therefore</u> - "God gave them up"

When man <u>continually rejects</u> God's Truth - **at some point**<u>THEREFORE</u> - **God gives them up**

He Abandons them to their own sinful choices

A.T. Robertson - Word pictures in the New Testament → →

A.T. Robertson - Word pictures in the New Testament

"These people had already willfully deserted God, Who merely left them to their own self-determination and self-destruction, part of the price of man's moral freedom. . . Three times Paul uses [this word] here, not three stages in the giving over, but a repetition of the same withdrawal. The words sound to us like clods on the coffin as God leaves men to work their own wicked will."

The Wrath of God described here;

is God <u>allowing man</u> to decline into his sin, <u>by his own choice</u>, <u>even into</u> the pit of hell

WHY? - What would cause God to give us over to our own sin?

Rom 1:25 - ESV

25 because they exchanged the truth about God for a lie and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever! Amen.

Guys - God <u>WILL</u> allow you - to <u>Exchange His Truth</u> for the <u>Lie of this world</u>, or <u>even</u> for the <u>Lie of the devil</u>

He will allow us to worship & serve

the things of this world, & our flesh, rather than the Creator - Who is blessed forever

& if we, in our rebellion, demand to make that exchange (of God's Truth for Sin's Lie)

then <u>God will</u> ultimately <u>allow</u> the <u>consequences</u> of Our Choices to <u>become His Wrath</u> upon our Sin

Which is what we find - as we continue

Rom 1:26 - ESV

26 For this reason God gave them up to dishonorable passions. . .

For WHAT Reason ??

- 1) v.18 In ungodliness & unrighteousness we have Suppressed (held down) the Truth
- 2) v.19-21 even tho God has made Himself Known to us we refused to Honor Him, or give Thanks to Him & we became Futile in our Thinking & Foolish in our Hearts
- 3) v.22 By claiming to be wise we became fools
- 4) <u>& v.23</u> We <u>exchanged</u> the glory of the <u>Immortal God</u> for <u>Images</u> of man & beast . . .

FOR THIS REASON . . .

again - Rom 1:26 - ESV

26 For this reason God gave them up to dishonorable passions. For their women exchanged natural relations for those that are contrary to nature;

27 and the men likewise gave up natural relations with women and were consumed with passion for one another, men committing shameless acts with men and receiving in themselves the due penalty for their error.

Now - <u>Why</u> - in describing the <u>depths</u> of man's <u>depravity</u>, <u>does Paul</u> turn first - to <u>homosexuality</u>?

Probably because - This sin was all around him (NOT a new sin)

Greek culture encouraged homosexual love

1 "mark" of a "High Society Greek" - was open homosexuality

14 of the first 15 Emperors of Rome were homosexuals

& ALSO because - homosexuality is a perfect example of How Man's Sin Corrupts God's Intended Design

Just as <u>Hate & Murder</u> are a <u>Corruption</u> of <u>God's Design</u> of <u>Love & Forgiveness</u>.

The Bible clearly states

Homosexuality is a <u>Corruption</u> of God's Design for a <u>man & woman sexually</u>

Guys - The Bible says simply - Homosexuality is a sin

From a **Biblical Perspective**

for a **Christian** to accept Homosexuality as an **alternative lifestyle**

then they must <u>also accept</u> <u>Drunkenness</u>, <u>Adultery</u>, <u>Theft</u> & <u>Murder</u> as "alternative lifestyles"

PLEASE HEAR ME - God is NOT "out to get Homosexuals"
God is "out to get sin"

The **good news** is – since **it is a sin**, it can be **overcome** in Christ

1Cor 6:9-11 - NLT

9... Don't fool yourselves. Those who indulge in <u>sexual sin</u>, or who <u>worship idols</u>, or commit <u>adultery</u>, or are male prostitutes, or practice <u>homosexuality</u>,

10 or are <u>thieves</u>, or <u>greedy</u> people, or <u>drunkards</u>, or are <u>abusive</u>, or <u>cheat</u> people—none of these will inherit the Kingdom of God.

11 Some of you were once like that. But you were cleansed; you were made holy; you were made right with God by calling on the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God.

<u>ALL</u> believers were <u>Dead in Sin</u> <u>Before</u> they were <u>Cleansed by Faith</u> in Christ

& many of us were once in Sexual Sin, Worshipped Idols, Committed Adultery - Were Thieves - Were Greedy - Were Drunkards, Were Abusive, & Were Cheaters

But to get into Heaven - those sins must be Cleansed

By **Calling** on the Name of the Lord Jesus - &

By **Submitting** to the Spirit of God

So - <u>it's True</u> - Homosexuality is <u>sin</u> & <u>it's damage</u> - both <u>emotional</u> & <u>physical</u> - is **well documented**

& so we've got to deal with that last OMINOUS statement in V.27

Rom 1:27 (END)

... men committing shameless acts with men and receiving in themselves the due penalty for their error.

Are there *Emotional* & *Physical* Consequences to the sin of *Homosexuality* - **YES**!

But – Is God **punishing** homosexuals ???

If an <u>alcoholic</u> dies from <u>liver</u> failure – *is God punishing him*?

If a <u>drug addict</u> dies from an <u>over dose</u> – *is God punishing him*?

If you <u>destroy</u> your marriage thru <u>adultery</u> - *is God punishing you*?

Guys - There are consequences to sin

& if we <u>Deliberately CHOOSE</u> to <u>CONTINUE</u> in our <u>Sin</u>
Then God will *GIVE US OVER* to the **Consequences** of that sin

The **Consequences** - Which ultimately end - in **Death**

<u>Jas 1:14-15 - NLT</u>

14 Temptation comes from our own desires, which entice us and drag us away.

15 These desires give birth to sinful actions. And when sin is allowed to grow, it gives birth to death.

Death is the *Ultimate Consequence* of - **ALL SIN**!

& if you or I <u>Choose</u> a life of <u>sin</u> - in <u>Rebellion to God</u> there will be <u>consequences</u> - that Ultimately will end in <u>Death</u>

Now - Paul is **going to end** this difficult Passage with the **WORST** of all **SINS**

The Sins of The Debased Mind

In V.24 - God gave up the ungodly to "Physical Impurity"
 In V.26 - God gave up the ungodly to "Shameful Passions"
 In V.28 - God gives up the ungodly to "A Debased Mind"

& notice - it's **NOT** the <u>Sexual Sins</u> that end this <u>difficult text</u> on The Wrath of God **it is** the sins of a **Debased Mind**

Rom 1:28 - ESV

28 And since they did not see fit to acknowledge God, <u>God</u> <u>gave them up to a debased mind</u> to do what ought not to be done.

THEY - are those who have **Refused** to **Acknowledge God**

& instead have "<u>taken hold of</u>" & "<u>become slave to</u>" their <u>own sin nature</u>

But **notice** please - This **upcoming List** is Broad & All-Encompassing

If you can't see your <u>PERSONAL SIN NATURE</u> in this list then you may not be able to see your need <u>FOR A SAVIOR</u>

This <u>coming list</u> - of the <u>worst sins</u> against God - <u>applies to ALL</u> of us "ALL have sinned, and fall short of the Glory of God" (Rom 3.23)

Rom 1:29-32 - ESV → →

Rom 1:29-32 - ESV

29 They were filled with all manner of unrighteousness, evil, covetousness, malice. They are full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, maliciousness. They are gossips,

30 slanderers, haters of God, insolent, haughty, boastful, inventors of evil, disobedient to parents,

31 foolish, faithless, heartless, ruthless.

32 Though they know God's decree that those who practice such things deserve to die, they not only do them but give approval to those who practice them.

PLEASE - See yourself in that List because it is your only hope - to see your need - for a Savior

God <u>Help</u> us - God <u>Protect</u> us - God <u>Save</u> us <u>from</u> our own sin nature

We must <u>first see</u> - we are <u>Justly Deserving</u> God's <u>Judgment</u> <u>Before</u> we will <u>run into the arms</u> of a <u>Forgiving Savior</u>

As Paul says in Rom 7:24-25 - NLT

24 Oh, what a miserable person I am! Who will free me from this life that is dominated by sin and death?
25 Thank God! The answer is in Jesus Christ our Lord. . .

<u>The Answer</u> - The Only <u>True</u> Answer is <u>IN</u> <u>Jesus Christ our Lord</u> - & in Him <u>ALONE</u>

Just as the Vs's following these say

Rom 8:1-2 - NLT

1 So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus.

2 And because you belong to him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death.

Guys - We ARE SINNERS - Once destined for Death

But for those who belong to Jesus Christ

The **Power** of the *Life-Giving Spirit* has freed you from the **power** of *sin* that leads to *death*

So there is ONLY ONE Question

There's Only One **question** today

& Only One question on that day - that you meet your Creator

DO YOU BELONG TO JESUS CHRIST ??

Are you His?

Have your <u>sins</u> been forgiven - by His <u>Righteousness</u>?

Has the <u>Power of Jesus Christ</u> living in you - <u>Freed</u> you from the <u>power of sin</u> that leads to Death

If you have <u>not</u> been <u>SET FREE</u> from Sin & Death by putting your <u>Faith</u> in Jesus Christ Alone

<u>PLEASE</u> - don't leave here until you <u>Receive Christ</u> as your Savior
