Rom 204 - Religion or Relationship - Rom 2:17-29

Congratulations - Mr. & Mrs. Hank & Breezy Palan & Mr. & Mrs Chris & Angela Keeler

Both of whom have been married since we were last together

Thank you **Jeff Bell** (& **Nick N**.) for covering for me

Quite a msg from **J. Bell** last week (pick it up) True Repentance - Changed Life

A msg that **fits perfectly** into this section of Romans & into what God is doing right now - in this church family

back in **Romans** - we are in our 4th msg & in our 3rd straight msg dealing w/ God's judgment upon our sin

Pls remember - IF we do not come to grips w/ the fact that we rightfully deserve God's Judgment

Then we will **not be ready** to Receive God's Free Gift of Salvation in Jesus Christ

& beginning in the **very next Msg** - God's Salvation, His Divine Remedy for our sin begins to unfold

& it gets real good from there

However - there is **One More group** of people the Holy Spirit wants to <u>address</u>,

before He moves on to *God's Glorious Remedy* for ALL of our sin

& this last group of sinners - are the RELIGIOUS

Those who <u>Trust</u> in Religious <u>Precepts</u>, <u>Practices</u> & <u>Ceremony's</u> but have <u>NO</u> personal "<u>Response Relationship</u>" w/ God

Commentator Donald Barnhouse says;

they have <u>Ritual</u> w/o <u>Redemption</u>, <u>Works</u> w/o <u>Worship</u>, the <u>Form</u> of Service w/o the <u>Fear</u> of God

They are those of <u>US</u> - who <u>Profess</u> a Right <u>Religion</u> w/o <u>Possessing</u> a Right <u>Relationship</u>

In the Gospels <u>Jesus</u> calls them <u>Pharisees</u> - <u>Hypocrites</u> - <u>Whitewashed Tombs</u> & even much Worse

& again - just like in our <u>last 2 msg's</u> it's critically important that we call these <u>Religious Sinners</u> - <u>US</u>!

May God help us in this msg;

See our own Religious Hypocrisy
See our own False Religious Security
See our own need for a Right Relationship with Him

& if we will Truly <u>See our Need</u> - then the rest of Romans will come like a <u>Miraculous Healing Flood</u> - upon our <u>Fatal Wound of Sin</u>

Let's Pray

Is it possible to sit in church your entire life & **NOT** enter heaven . . . **YES**

Is it possible to be the <u>Most Religious Person</u> in the church & still **NOT** enter heaven . . . **YES** - Absolutely

Jesus addresses this very truth in **Mat 7:21**

Mat 7:21 - ESV

22 On that day many will say to me, 'Lord, Lord, <u>did we not</u> prophesy in your name, and cast out demons in your name, and do many mighty works in your name?'
23 And then will I declare to them, 'I never <u>knew you</u>; depart from me, you workers of <u>lawlessness</u>.'

When Jesus says "I never KNEW you" he uses the GK word for "personal, intimate knowledge" (Ginosko)

- & when he calls them "Workers of lawlessness (sin)"
 He's saying they've done all these things in His name,
 Yet they've never been cleansed of their sin,
- & <u>Paul's point</u> today in Romans is even the <u>Most Religious</u> of us <u>cannot</u> be cleansed of our Sin - <u>by our Religion</u>
- & <u>once we accept</u> that then we are <u>ready to hear</u> of God's Provision for our Salvation, thru a <u>Personal Relationship</u> w/ Jesus Christ
- in **Romans** today the Holy Spirit is wrapping up the truth that we are **ALL** sinners (incld'g the most religious of us)

And we **ALL** need God's **remedy**

Which <u>CANNOT</u> be found in <u>RELIGION</u> no matter how <u>OLD</u> or seemingly "<u>Right</u>" that religion is

<u>God's remedy</u> for our sin comes only in a <u>Right Relationship</u> w/ Him, <u>no matter</u> How Religious we Think we are

Rom 2:17 - ESV (English Standard Version)

By the way - for those who may have recently joined us

We went thru a very <u>Thorough</u> - <u>Critical Review Process</u> of the <u>Major Bible translations</u> - which took well over <u>2 yrs</u>

& I now recommend **TWO** Bible Translations the **NLT** (New Living Translation) for devotional, home reading

the **ESV** (English Standard Version) for critical V-by-V study

NO - We are **NOT** Anti King James (or NKJ) & you'll find that the **ESV** reads very close to your **NKJ**

Rom 2:17 - ESV

17 But if you call yourself a Jew . . .

Paul speaks *emphatically* - if *YOU* call yourself a *JEW*

the term Jew is the religious name of God's people; they were,

Hebrew by "Race"

Israelites by "Nationality"

Jewish by "Religion"

& actually - during the time of Christ - the term "Jew" came to imply the "*Most Religious*" of the Israelites

To show you just How Much the Jews came to trust in their Religion

let me **quote** a few *Rabbinic sayings* recorded <u>long after</u> Romans was written

See if you can "Discern" their Trust in their Religion

Recorded Rabbinic Sayings;

"Circumcision is equivalent to all the commandments of the Law"
"To live in Palestine is equal to the commandments"
"He that has his abode in Palestine is sure of eternal life"

This is a <u>Mis-Guided Trust</u> - in Religious Claims that (of course) are found <u>nowhere</u> in the Bible

HOWEVER - before you start "*Pointing*" at the Jews

Can you **think of Churches** in our culture today that strongly *Imply*

that **belonging** to the right church - is what makes you **right** with God

The are <u>many today</u> - both in <u>Catholic</u> & <u>Protestant</u> churches who believe they are "<u>SAFE</u>" with God because they belong to the "<u>Right Religion</u>, or the "<u>Right Church</u>"

- & (of course) <u>just like</u> the Jewish sayings that can be found *NO WHERE* in the Bible
- & if we believe we are <u>OK</u> with God by <u>ANY</u> act of Religion, or <u>belonging</u> to any certain church

Then we <u>put ourselves</u> exactly in the place <u>of the Jew</u> that Paul is writing Romans to

So now - Paul is **going to list** the Religious Claims that lead to *Pride & Hypocrisy* - & to the <u>fatal disease</u> of *Pharisaism*

Rom 2:17-20 - ESV

17 But if <u>you</u> call yourself a <u>Jew</u> [most religious] and rely on the law and boast in God

18 and know his will and approve what is excellent, because you are instructed from the law;

19 and if you are sure that you yourself are a guide to the blind, a light to those who are in darkness,

20 an instructor of the foolish, a teacher of children, having in the law the embodiment of knowledge and truth—

Wow - the Hit Parade of Religious Confidence

Rely on the Law

Boast in God

Know His will

Approve what is excellent

Instructed from the Law

A guide to the Blind

A light to those in Darkness

An instructor of the Foolish

A teacher of children (the childish)

Having in the Law, the embodiment of knowledge & truth . . .

WOW - How can **THAT** be bad ???

All that & a Big church too

well, that's got to be good, Right ?? (wrong)

The "Religious" ones that Paul is writing to are probably *feeling pretty good* right now *(yeah, that's me)*

Unfortunately - Paul is about to drop the **hammer** on them!

But **before** he does - let me point out one thing

At the End of **V.20** it says;

having in the law the embodiment of knowledge and truth—

The **Embodiment** means - the "**Outward Form**" of knowledge & truth

Kenneth Wuest translates this Greek phrase;

"having the rough sketch [outward form] of the experiential knowledge of the truth in the law"

Paul's saying - you've got the "<u>Ruff Sketch</u>" the "<u>Outward Form</u>" of the "<u>Truth of God</u>"

BUT - you've <u>stopped</u> there !!

do you think having the "<u>Outward Form</u>" of <u>Religion</u> equals having the "<u>Knowledge & Truth</u>" of a <u>Relationship</u>?

I hope not - because **that would be** like *trading* in your Wife for a **PICTURE** of your Wife

"No honey, I don't need you, it's OK, I have a picture of you, that's all I need"

I have a "Ruff Sketch" - the "Outward Form" of you
I don't really need a "Personal Relationship" with you

<u>That</u> is what it means - to have the "<u>Embodiment</u>" of the <u>Knowledge & Truth of God</u>

So - Paul is going to say to the Religious;

You have ALL these Religious Claims . . . HOWEVER

Are you not Still SINNERS - in Need of A Savior?

Have your Religious Claims - Actually made you right before God ??

Or do you have the

"Ruff Sketch" the "Outward Form" of Religion

While lacking the Life Changing "Personal Relationship" with God?

Paul is going to "<u>turn the guns</u>" on the <u>Religious</u> here but Please - <u>DON'T</u> misunderstand him

He's <u>not saying</u> the Religious need to get <u>MORE</u> religious & <u>try harder</u> to "<u>Clean-Up</u>" that "<u>Outward Form</u>"

Paul's point here is;

The <u>Most Religious</u> among us - Are <u>EQUALLY</u> sinners with us & they <u>Equally Need</u> a <u>Savior</u> - Just like the <u>Rest of Us</u>

This is the point Paul is proving in **Rom 2:21-22**

Rom 2:21-22 - ESV \rightarrow \rightarrow

Rom 2:21-22 - ESV

21 you then who teach others, do you not teach yourself? While you preach against stealing, do you steal?
22 You who say that one must not commit adultery, do you commit adultery? You who abhor idols, do you rob temples?

In our last **ROM** Msg (Judged by Judging) the Holy Spirit made it clear

that **by us judging** something in someone else, we were actually *convicting ourselves* (because of our knowledge)

& that's Exactly what Paul is saying here;

Do you <u>preach</u> against <u>stealing</u> - then steal (a little) yourself
Do you <u>preach</u> against <u>adultery</u> - then lust in your own mind
Do you <u>preach</u> against <u>idols</u> - then use those same idols for yourself

(which is what "Rob Temples" implies)

Remember - Paul **is not trying** to get the religious to **Try Harder** to become **MORE** Religious

He's **showing them** that they are *just as bad* (or worse) sinners than **ALL** those that they are condemning

Guys - we are <u>ALL</u> lost in our sin (<u>including</u> the most religious) & so we <u>ALL</u> need a Savior (<u>including</u> the most religious)

& maybe - those who are <u>The Most Religious</u> are actually in <u>greater danger</u> than those with only the <u>simple knowledge</u> of right & wrong & we see that - in the next two vs's

Rom 2:23 - ESV

23 You who boast in the law dishonor God by breaking the law.

Now **THIS** really begins to get to *the heart of the matter*

You who "boast" in the law dishonor God by breaking the law

Do we <u>BOAST</u> in our <u>Religion</u> ??
Do we <u>BOAST</u> in our <u>Church</u> Affiliation ??
Do we <u>BOAST</u> in our <u>Efforts</u> on behalf of God ??

<u>If so</u> - then we need to be Greatly Afraid because we may well be "*The Religious*" that Paul is talking to

In the <u>FINAL Vs's</u> of Galatians Paul writes <u>Gal 6:14</u> w/ <u>his own hand</u>

Gal 6:14 - ESV

14 But far be it from me to boast (NKJ=God Forbid) except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.

The **MORE** Paul knew Jesus - the more he knew, to **NEVER Boast** in his <u>Religious Accomplishments</u>

God Forbid that I should Boast, except in the cross of Jesus Christ

<u>& WHY is it</u> - that Paul warns us so strongly
<u>NOT</u> to Boast in the law (our <u>Religious Accomplishments</u>) ??

Because of what he writes in the very next Vs

Rom 2:24 - ESV

24 For, as it is written, "The name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles because of you."

<u>Every one of</u> us - Either <u>IS</u> someone - or <u>KNOWS</u> someone who's <u>turned their back</u> on God because of some <u>Religious Hypocrisy</u>

I know someone who's wife left him out of the blue & his church told him there was no hope for him

While many in that same church were committing much greater sins than his Divorce

The <u>number one smokescreen</u> that unbelievers use to stay away from the church is that *we're all* a bunch of **Hypocrites**

But I promise you it's **NOT** our imperfections that label us as Hipocrites it's of our *Religious Pride*

Could it be that <u>THAT</u> is WHY Paul wrote; God forbid that I should boast except in the cross of Jesus Christ

Or why Paul also wrote in 1Tim 1:15-16 - NLT;

15... "Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners" - and I am the worst of them all.

16 But God had mercy on me so that Christ Jesus could use me as a prime example of his great patience with even the worst sinners. Then others will realize that they, too, can believe in him and receive eternal life.

Now <u>THAT</u> is the way - to <u>prevent</u> the name of God from being <u>Blasphemed</u> because of you (as <u>v.24</u> says)

Recognize that you are an equal sinner & boast ONLY in the power of the Cross

Now - Paul is going to **end this section**by addressing the Jews **BOASTING** in their Circumcision

This would be the **Exact same thing** as **US** boasting in our "*Religion*" - or our church attendance

or the fact that we were **baptized**, **sprinkled**, **membered**, or *anything else*

Rom 2:25 - ESV

25 For circumcision indeed is of value if you obey the law, but if you break the law, your circumcision becomes uncircumcision.

<u>Circumcision</u> was given by God to Abraham as a <u>SIGN</u> of the covenant of faith - God made with Abraham

But the sign is **only of value** - **IF** the **covenant** is kept

The wearing of your <u>Wedding Ring</u> is only of value if you keep <u>the Vows</u> of your marriage

& if you are <u>breaking the vows</u> of your Marriage then your <u>Ring</u> - Don't mean a <u>Thing</u>

& it's the same with your Religion

it's <u>ONLY</u> of Value - if it's a <u>SIGN</u> of your <u>Right Relationship</u> with God

Otherwise - the **Sign of Religion** - **Don't mean** a Thing

Paul continues in Rom 2:26-27 - ESV

26 So, if a man who is uncircumcised keeps the precepts of the law, will not his uncircumcision be regarded as circumcision? 27 Then he who is physically uncircumcised but keeps the law will condemn you who have the written code and circumcision but break the law.

Now - Paul is **NOT saying** that we need **the SIGN** of Circumcision **AND** we must never *break God's Law*

He's saying the SIGN of Religion By Itself - Does NO GOOD!

Even in the Law of Moses

<u>Circumcision</u> was a sign of the **HEART**

Deut 10:16 - NIV

16 Circumcise your hearts, therefore, and do not be stiff-necked any longer.

Deut 30:6 - NIV

6 The Lord your God will circumcise your hearts and the hearts of your descendants, so that you may love him with all your heart and with all your soul, and live.

This is **NOT** something New Circumcision (Religion) is a **SIGN**

But there <u>MUST</u> be something <u>BEHIND</u> the Sign & that something is <u>NOT more Religion</u> - it is <u>a Relationship</u>

& **THAT** is how Paul is going to end this Ch

He's going to tell us that <u>OUTWARD Religion</u> is <u>Useless</u> But an <u>INWARD Relationship</u> is <u>Everything</u>

Rom 2:28-29 - ESV

28 For no one is a Jew who is merely one <u>outwardly</u>, nor is circumcision <u>outward</u> and physical.

29 But a Jew is one <u>inwardly</u>, and circumcision is a matter of <u>the heart</u>, by the Spirit, not by the letter. His praise is not from man but from God.

Paul says a <u>True Jew</u> (follower of God) is NOT one <u>Outwardly</u>
Nor are the <u>Signs</u> - <u>Outward</u> & <u>Physical</u>

But a **True Jew** (follower of God) - is one **Inwardly**

& the <u>TRUE SIGN</u> - is a Matter of the <u>HEART</u> by the <u>Spirit of God</u>, not by the <u>letter of the Law</u>

& His praise is <u>NOT</u> from man - but from <u>God</u>

It's like this;

<u>I ask</u>, "Are you Born Again?" <u>You answer</u>, "Oh, I'm a catholic"

I say, "that's great, but do you know Jesus Christ"You answer"I was baptized when I was 2"

I say, "do you know that you're going to heaven"
you answer, "I go to church don't I" ?

See - THAT is trusting in Outward Religion

Jesus Christ <u>Did NOT Die</u> - to give us an <u>Outward Religion</u> He Died - to give us a <u>Transforming Inward Relationship</u>

& the saddest thing in the world

is when we <u>begin to believe</u> that our <u>Outward Religion</u> - will <u>PASS</u> - for an <u>Inward Relationship</u>

Are you Married to a <u>PICTURE</u> of your Spouse - or Are you Married to the <u>PERSON</u> of your Spouse

If you are Trusting in your <u>Religion</u> Today then your relationship - is w/ a <u>PICTURE</u> of God but not God Himself

Christ Died - to give you a Personal **Relationship** - with a Real Living God

Don't Exchange that Offer of a living **Relationship** with God for the Masquerade of an Outward **Religion**

Let's Pray
