## Col203 - Reconciler of All Things - Colossians 1:19-23

Last wk we looked at the Supreme Preeminence of Jesus Christ

Jesus Christ is <u>BEFORE ALL things</u> & He is <u>ABOVE ALL things</u>

Jesus Christ is fully "God In Expression" to Man

& we tried to make it clear – that BECAUSE of WHO Jesus Christ <u>Truly IS</u> - & WHAT Jesus Christ has <u>Truly DONE</u>

That <u>His Sacrifice ALONE</u> – was able <u>to RECONCILE us</u> to God

To Be Reconciled is
To bring back to a former state of harmony

& I <u>want</u> you to <u>KNOW</u>
That GOD - is the <u>AUTHOR</u> & the <u>FINISHER</u>

of US being <u>Reconciled</u> to Him of US <u>being brought back</u> to a former state of harmony with Him

## 2 Corinthians 5:18 (ESV)

18 All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself . . .

Jesus Christ is the Reconciler of All Things

Let's **start** w/ a little **REVIEW** from last week

## Colossians 1:19 (NLT)

19 For God in all his fullness was pleased to live in Christ,

God in all his fullness . . . lived in Christ

the word "FULLNESS" means;
"Inherently & Permanently filled"

ALL the Fullness of God – Lives Inherently & Permanently
IN Jesus Christ

<u>It MEANS</u> - the <u>Father DID NOT "GIVE"</u> <u>the fullness of God</u> to <u>Jesus</u>

#### But, instead

God in all his fullness - Inherently & Permanently lives in Christ

THAT is a HUGE Deal - when we're talking about

WHO Jesus Christ Truly IS - &

WHAT Jesus Christ has Truly DONE

So – let's read Vs's 19-20 together

## Colossians 1:19-20(a) together (NLT)

19 For God in all his fullness was pleased to live in Christ, 20 and through him God <u>reconciled everything</u> to himself . . .

Jesus Christ is The FULLNESS of GOD

Reconciling ALL THINGS - BACK TO - The FULLNESS of God

#### **Because there was NO OTHER WAY**

Because **NO OTHER** - **Philosophy**, **Ideology**, or **Religion**, **can reconcile** us **BACK** to the **FULLNESS of God** 

It <u>took</u> the <u>FULLNESS of God</u> – <u>In Christ</u>
To <u>RECONCILE ALL THINGS</u> – <u>BACK to God</u>

Jesus Reconciled all things - "BACK to God"

Because <u>God</u> created <u>MAN</u> - & <u>ALL CREATION</u>
In <u>Perfect HARMONY</u> with Him

& then – <u>Came SIN</u> - & the <u>Fall of MAN</u> & the <u>CURSE of Sin</u> on this <u>World</u>

& - The FULLNESS of GOD - in Jesus Christ

Has <u>RECONCILED Man</u> - & <u>ALL of Creation</u>

BACK to that former state of Perfect Harmony with GOD

In a **PRACTICAL Sense** - that **Reconciliation** 

is still *IN THE PROCESS* of *Being Accomplished*Practically – it is still IN PROCESS

**BUT POSITIONALLY** (in a **POSITIONAL** Sense) *IT - IS - FINISHED* !!

## Then - Just as a SIDE NOTE - to VS 20(a)

When <u>v.20 says</u> through Christ God <u>reconciled everything</u> to himself

This <u>does NOT mean</u> (unfortunately) that <u>ALL people</u> will be <u>automatically</u> - <u>Reconciled to God</u>

The **OFFER** – to be **Reconciled to God** is **ABSOLUTELY** for **ALL PEOPLE** 

But the **Bible** is **clear** – **Being Reconciled to God comes** THRU Your **FAITH** in **Jesus** - as **your Savior** 

John 3:16 says: For God so loved the world that he gave his only son (that's the offer to ALL people)

BUT then the Vs says – that whosoever BELIEVES in him (puts their faith in him) would NOT perish but HAVE everlasting life

THAT is the condition to YOU RECEIVING this Reconciliation to God

WHY? - - Because THRU Your Faith in Jesus

**You** are **IDENTIFIED WITH** – (Made One With)

WHO Jesus IS - &

WHAT Jesus has DONE - ON YOUR BEHALF

#### **Jesus Christ CAME to Earth**

To MAKE PEACE – between a <u>Fallen</u>, <u>Sinful World</u>, and a <u>Holy</u> & <u>Just God</u>

## As Colossians 1:20(b) says (NLT)

20 . . . <u>He made peace</u> with <u>everything</u> in heaven and on earth <u>by</u> means of Christ's blood on the cross.

When <u>SIN entered</u> this <u>World</u> – <u>All of Creation</u> was <u>Separated</u> from <u>God</u> - <u>BY the Curse of Sin</u>

The Bible says – By our Sin, we became HOSTILE to God

& <u>What Jesus</u> Christ has <u>done</u> – in his <u>Life</u>, <u>Death</u>, and <u>Resurrection</u> Is to <u>MAKE PEACE</u> - <u>FOR US</u> - <u>with God</u>

NOT ONLY between <u>US & God</u>

But ALSO between this Fallen World & God

<u>ALL things</u> (<u>including creation</u>) are <u>Reconciled</u> - <u>Back to God</u> <u>THRU</u> the <u>Person</u> & the <u>Work</u> of <u>Jesus Christ</u>

## Romans 8:19-21 (NLT)

19 For all creation is waiting eagerly for that future day when God will reveal who his children really are.

20 Against its will, all creation was subjected to God's curse. But with eager hope,

21 the creation looks forward to the day when it will join God's children in glorious freedom from death and decay.

Jesus is the Reconciler of ALL THINGS !!!

& <u>ALL</u> of <u>Creation</u> is <u>Waiting Eagerly</u> for the <u>Day</u> <u>When</u> that <u>Reconciliation</u> - will be <u>Completely Accomplished</u>

Again - Colossians 1:20 says – God made peace with everything in heaven and on earth by means of Christ's [sacrifice] on the cross

But the <u>REAL</u> – <u>PERSONAL</u> – <u>GOOD NEWS</u> *Is in Vs. 21* 

## Colossians 1:21 (NLT)

21 <u>This includes you</u> who were once <u>far away</u> from God. You were his <u>enemies</u>, <u>separated</u> from him by your evil thoughts and actions.

The Phrase "*far away*" is <u>LIT</u> - "*ALIENATED*"

& it is in the **Perfect Tense** – meaning

you were <u>Permanently Alienated</u> <u>Permanently Separated</u> from God – <u>Because of Your SIN</u>

- & You had NO Possible Way to Correct the Sin Problem
- & <u>Not only</u> were you <u>SEPARATED</u> from <u>God</u> by your <u>Sin</u> <u>But</u> you <u>were</u> also <u>HIS ENEMY</u>

## Romans 8:7 (NLT)

7 For the sinful nature is always hostile to God . . .

**BY** your *fallen sin nature* – AND by *your Actions*You were *permanently Separated* from God

BUT – In Jesus Christ - "The Fullness of God" has Reconciled you BACK to Himself

He has brought you back - to a former state of harmony
That you were originally created FOR

HOW has Jesus RECONCILED us?
& WHAT is the RESULT?

# Colossians 1:22 (NLT)

22 Yet now he has reconciled you to himself through the death of Christ in his physical body (that's how). As a result, he has brought you into his own presence, and you are holy and blameless as you stand before him without a single fault. (that's the result)

Jesus Christ has reconciled us

Through his death in a physical body

Jesus had to come - in a physical body in order to die in our place . . . There was no other way !

## Romans 6:23 (NLT) →

## Romans 6:23 (NLT)

23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord.

Because God is FIRST

Perfectly HOLY, RIGHTEOUS, & JUST

The Penalty for our sin - had to be PAID

It CANNOT be simply overlooked

& <u>there</u> was <u>no one on earth</u> who <u>could PAY</u> that <u>Penalty</u> on <u>our Behalf</u>

& so – the <u>FULLNESS of God</u> came in the <u>Person</u> of <u>Jesus Christ</u>

to pay that full & complete Penalty
ON OUR BEHALF - & IN OUR PLACE

## 2 Corinthians 5:21 (NLT)

21 For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ.

The <u>FULLNESS of God</u> came – to TAKE ON our sin & to <u>Pay</u> the <u>Full & Complete Penalty</u> for it

SO THAT we could be made right with God through Christ.

& <u>We</u> are <u>MADE RIGHT</u> with <u>God</u> <u>Because</u> the <u>Penalty</u> for <u>OUR Sin</u>

Has been PAID IN FULL - TETELESTAI - it is Finished

## & <u>BECAUSE</u> <u>Jesus Christ</u> has <u>paid</u> our <u>Full Debt</u> <u>IN our Place</u> – <u>JUST as IF we had Paid it</u>

When God looks at Us

He **sees** the **Perfect Righteousness** of **Jesus Christ** 

Guys - We don't need "Higher Spiritual Knowledge"
We need to be Reconciled to a HOLY GOD

& the <u>Fullness of God</u>, in <u>Jesus Christ</u> – <u>Came to earth</u>
<u>AS</u> the <u>Reconciler of All Things</u>

<u>& Jesus TOOK</u> our <u>Sin</u> - & <u>DIED</u> in our place to <u>PAY</u> the <u>Full & Complete Penalty</u> for <u>OUR Sin</u>

So that He could PRESENT US before God

Holy, Blameless, & Without a Single FAULT

# (again) Colossians 1:22 (NLT)

22 Yet now he has reconciled you to himself through the death of Christ in his physical body. As a result, he has brought you into his own presence, and you are holy and blameless as you stand before him without a single fault.

<u>Jesus</u> Christ <u>died for you</u> – in <u>order</u> to <u>BRING You</u> into *God's Own Presence* 

& to PRESENT you to God

**HOLY - BLAMELESS - WITHOUT A SINGLE FAULT** 

## Jesus Christ doesn't just "get us in" to Heaven

He Presents us

**HOLY** before God

**BLAMELESS** before God

WITHOUT A SINGLE FAULT before God

& that Phrase "Without a Single Fault"

MEANS - NOT EVEN ABLE TO BE ACCUSED

Jesus Christ is the <u>Reconciler of ALL Things</u>
And <u>he</u> is the <u>ONLY ONE</u> who can <u>RECONCILE US to God</u>

That is what <u>WE REALLY NEED</u> is to be <u>made right</u> – <u>to be Reconciled</u> – to <u>God</u>

<u>Don't be duped</u> into <u>chasing after</u>

<u>Some other</u> form of <u>Spirituality OR Religion</u>

Because there is <u>nothing else</u> – in <u>all of creation</u>
That can compare to

WHO Jesus Christ <u>Truly IS</u> – & WHAT Jesus Christ has <u>Truly DONE</u>

Put your faith in Jesus - & Hold On To HIM!

STAND Firmly in your Faith
& DON'T Drift away from Your Assurance in Christ

## **BECAUSE - Colossians 1:23(a) (NLT)**

23 <u>But you must continue</u> to <u>believe this truth</u> and stand firmly in it. <u>Don't drift away</u> from the <u>assurance</u> you received when you heard the Good News . . .

<u>Suddenly</u> – we <u>have a WARNING</u> here about our *RECONCILIATION in CHRIST?* 

<u>This</u> is <u>one</u> of the "<u>IF" verses</u> in the <u>N.T</u>. that <u>tend</u> to <u>shake people</u> up – (which <u>might</u> be the <u>goal</u>)

**Most Lit** Translations = **if indeed** you continue in the faith

<u>The Wuest</u> expanded GK NT = <u>assuming indeed</u> that you are adhering to the Faith

The <u>NLT's</u> – "But you must continue" – is TRUE But it <u>doesn't get across</u> the full idea

In the original – this is called a First Class Condition

which assumes that the premise is true for the sake of argument

In <u>other words</u> – <u>Paul</u> is <u>ASSUMING</u> - <u>These Believers</u> <u>WILL</u> "<u>Continue</u>" & "<u>Stand Firmly</u>" & "<u>Not Drift Away</u>"

PLEASE LISTEN to me <u>closely</u> as I <u>deal</u> with this Because a <u>LOT of people</u> struggle with <u>this</u>

What we call - The ASSURANCE OF SALVATION We SEE Very CLEARLY in the Bible

# <u>Meaning</u> – If you are <u>TRULY SAVED</u> <u>Then</u> you are <u>PERMANENTLY SAVED</u>

#### **BUT** – True Faith Includes - **PERMANENCE**

#### Meaning – IF your faith is REAL

Then you will **CONTINUE IN IT** 

Or you will COME BACK TO IT - if you have slipped away

#### & so - In the Bible there is BOTH

An ASSURANCE of your <u>TRUE SALVATION</u> – <u>AND</u>

A WARNING about a <u>SUPERFICIAL SALVATION</u>

**Because TRUE FAITH** is **Ultimately** - **Permanent Faith** 

# & So (again) Paul says – in Colossians 1:23(a) (NLT)

23 <u>But you must continue</u> to <u>believe</u> this truth and <u>stand firmly</u> in it. <u>Don't drift away</u> from the <u>assurance</u> you <u>received</u> when you heard the Good News . . .

Paul is **NOT implying** that we **can have salvation one** day - then **lose it** the **next** day

But – the ONLY one way for YOU to KNOW

<u>IF INDEED</u> – you've been <u>Permanently Reconciled</u> to God <u>thru Faith in Jesus</u>

<u>IS – IF INDEED</u> - you continue to <u>believe the truth</u> of Jesus – <u>Standing FIRM</u> in it - & <u>NOT drifting away</u> from the <u>Assurance</u> you Received – Through FAITH

#### & WHAT IF YOU ALREADY HAVE DRIFTED AWAY?

<u>Then</u> – <u>THANK</u> the <u>Lord</u> today <u>that you</u> are <u>still</u> on <u>This side of Eternity</u>

Because you can come back to FAITH in Jesus
You can repent - be forgiven

#### & you can become one of those who

continue in the faith, grounded & steadfast, and are not moved away from the hope of the gospel (NKJ)

#### I Say to you - What GOD says to you - in

## 2 Corinthians 5:19-20 (NLT)

19 For God was in Christ, reconciling the world to himself, no longer counting people's sins against them. And he gave us this wonderful message of reconciliation.

20 So we are Christ's ambassadors; God is making his appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, "Come back to God!"
