Rom 205 - Religious Debates - Rom 3:1-20

- <u>I said</u> in our Last Msg that we were going to get to the <u>Divine Remedy</u> for our sin in <u>ROM Ch 3</u> (& we are)
- & I was just going to "<u>Lightly Touch</u>" on the <u>1st half</u> of Ch 3 & get right into the <u>Miracle of Salvation</u> in the <u>2nd half</u>
- But instead we're going to go slow down a bit

 Partly to give the 2nd half more time next week

 Partly to pause on a very important point this week
- & that Very Important Point Is the Religious Debates we get into about God, & God's Plan of Salvation
- Have you <u>ever known</u> someone who seems like they'd <u>argue face-to-face</u> w/ God Himself about God's plan of Salvation in Jesus Christ
- Most of us have had that difficult experience of sharing God's Love in Christ to a person . . .
 Only to have them say Well . . . Here's what I believe !!!
- ... here's what you believe ???
- It's <u>hard</u> for me to <u>understand</u> how a person can consider the Bible w/ over <u>2,000 yrs</u> of <u>Miraculous Documented Proof</u> in <u>Every area of science</u> known to man
- A book that holds <u>Hundreds</u> of <u>miraculous "proofs"</u> of its <u>authenticity & protection</u> over 2,000 years

- & so many can look at all that mountain of evidence & still say well, here's what I believe !!!
- & then **go on** to basically "argue" with God . . .

using their <u>30 or 40 yrs</u> of <u>sinful, human experience</u> to argue with to over <u>2000 yrs</u> of <u>miraculous proof</u> of the scriptures

HOWEVER - we all seem to get into those **Religious Debates**

& THAT is exactly what Paul has sort of "put himself into" as we begin Rom Ch 3

<u>Paul</u> - being an EX <u>Pharisee of Pharisees</u>, <u>'anticipates'</u> the Pharisee's response

- & it's like Paul has one of these "Religious Debaters" in his mind
- & <u>as he dictates</u> this section of Romans, it's like he's *seeing himself* have this **Religious Debate** . . .

with someone who thinks that they have <u>grounds</u> to <u>debate</u> the <u>truths of God</u> based on their <u>Own Understanding</u>

Let's Pray - & we'll get into it

I'm **going to use** both the **ESV** & the **NLT** today because the *LITERAL wording* in this section can be difficult

& I'll <u>put them both</u> up side-by-side so <u>you can benefit</u> from <u>both translations</u>

In the last 2 Vs's of Ch 2 Paul had made it clear;

A <u>true</u> Jew is <u>not</u> one <u>outwardly</u>, nor is <u>true</u> circumcision <u>physical</u>

But a <u>true</u> Jew <u>is</u> one <u>inwardly</u>, & <u>true</u> circumcision is a <u>matter of the heart</u>

- & so now **Paul anticipates** the Jewish argument
- & he **begins** his *Mock Religious Debate* in **Rom 3:1** by putting himself **in the Jew's place** . . .

Rom 3:1 - ESV

1 Then what advantage has the Jew? Or what is the value of circumcision?

Rom 3:1 - NLT

- 1 Then what's the advantage of being a Jew? Is there any value in the ceremony of circumcision?
- & Paul <u>answers</u> this <u>first objection</u> re: <u>God's Sovereign Choosing</u> of the Jewish people - <u>In V.2</u>

Rom 3:2 - ESV

2 Much in every way. To begin with, the Jews were entrusted with the oracles [whole revelation] of God.

Rom 3:2 - NLT

2 Yes, there are great benefits! First of all, the Jews were entrusted with the whole revelation of God.

Paul answers the first objection;

"Of course, there are **great benefits** to being a Jew, to begin with - they were entrusted with the **Revelation** of God"

That's an incredible benefit (& honor) for the Jewish people . . .

& so Paul's imaginary "<u>Debater</u>" begins to "<u>challenge</u>" God's <u>faithfulness</u> in <u>V.3</u>

Rom 3:3 - ESV

3 What if some [of the Jews] were unfaithful? Does their faithlessness nullify the faithfulness of God?

Rom 3:3 - NLT

3 True, some of them were unfaithful; but just because they were unfaithful, does that mean God will be unfaithful?

Here - The Jewish "Debater" is challenging God's Character

This would be **Exactly like** someone saying to us; "If God is Love, then **HOW** could He send anybody to hell"

That is applying "fallen man's - human reasoning" to the Character of God

- & God's Character is always beyond Being Contested!
- & so <u>Paul answers</u> with <u>Absoluteness</u> using the Jews own scripture

Rom 3:4 - ESV

4 By no means! Let God be true though every one were a liar, as it is written, "That you may be justified in your words, and prevail when you are judged."

Rom 3:4 - NLT

4 Of course not! Even if everyone else is a liar, God is true. As the Scriptures say about him, "You will be proved right in what you say, and you will win your case in court."

Paul uses the Scripture from Psa 51 & says "that's ridiculous"

We know that God is;

Perfectly Faithful, Perfectly Just, Perfectly Fair, & Perfectly True

& this <u>SHOULD</u> <u>quiet</u> the Debater but <u>seldom</u> is it that easy

& so - the Religious Debater throws another curveball at Paul

Rom 3:5 - from the NLT

Rom 3:5 - ESV

5 But if our unrighteousness serves to show the righteousness of God, what shall we say? That God is unrighteous to inflict wrath on us? (I speak in a human way.)

Rom 3:5 - NLT

5 "But," some might say, "our sinfulness serves a good purpose, for it helps people see how righteous God is. Isn't it unfair, then, for him to punish us?" (This is merely a human point of view.)

Now **the Debate** starts to just get "Silly"

The Debater says;

"If our sin - serves a good purpose for God - in that it shows His Righteousness - Isn't it unfair for Him to punish us for our sin?"

Have you ever had a person throw up a "Smoke Screen" argument about God

"Well, if my sin shows God's Righteousness He ought to thank me for my sin - I'm just helping Him out"

Obviously **that's crazy** - & Paul points that out **in parenthesis** in **V.5** (This is merely a human point of view)

& then he responds accordingly in V.6 - Again from the NLT

Rom 3:6 - ESV

6 By no means! For then how could God judge the world?

Rom 3:6 - NLT

6 Of course not! If God were not entirely fair, how would he be qualified to judge the world?

Again Paul answers with **God's Perfect Character**

God is *Perfectly* **Just** & *Perfectly* **Fair**

& He **IS** Qualified to **Judge the World**

BUT - some Debaters Just <u>persist in Debating</u> - Don't they & **That's the kind** Paul has plenty of experience with

So the Religious Debater throws back to him in V.7 - Again NLT

Rom 3:7 - ESV

7 But if through my lie God's truth abounds to his glory, why am I still being condemned as a sinner?

Rom 3:7 - NLT

7 "But," someone might still argue, "how can God condemn me as a sinner if my dishonesty highlights his truthfulness and brings him more glory?"

This is basically a <u>Re-Phrased Question</u> from <u>V.5</u>
Which is how many of these types of debates go

When someone is Committed to arguing about <u>God's Plan</u> of Salvation - & <u>God's Word</u>

They <u>often take it</u> way past the limit & start saying stuff that's just truly crazy

Which is what Paul address in V.8 - Again - NLT

Rom 3:8 - ESV

8 And why not do evil that good may come?—as some people slanderously charge us with saying. Their condemnation is just.

Rom 3:8 - NLT

8 And some people even slander us by claiming that we say, "The more we sin, the better it is!" Those who say such things deserve to be condemned.

OK - so much for the <u>foolish arguments</u>
Paul's Patience is reached here - & he <u>throws up his hands</u>

But we've experienced similar Smoke Screens haven't we ??

<u>If God is love</u>, why would He send someone to <u>Hell</u>? <u>If there is a God</u>, why are there <u>starving</u> children in Africa? <u>If God loves me</u>, why is He <u>allowing this</u> to happen to me?

While those **MAY BE** appropriate questions for *the right time & place*

They are <u>usually used</u> - as a <u>Smoke-Screen</u> to <u>avoid</u> the real issue - of <u>SIN</u>

If you are a believer today
& you really want to know the answers to those questions

Call one of the **Elders** or **Ministry Leaders** & ask them

But if you are an <u>Unbeliever</u> - & you're <u>using questions</u> like those to justify <u>NOT</u> <u>dealing with God</u> on a <u>PERSONAL LEVEL</u> . . .

Then those "<u>Objections</u>" are probably just a <u>smoke-screens</u> to keep you from <u>honestly dealing</u> with God - about your <u>OWN SIN</u>

- & that's exactly how the Apostle Paul treats them
- & in <u>V.9</u> Paul turns this <u>Imaginary Religious Debate</u> right back to the <u>Real</u>, <u>Central</u> Issue - <u>SIN!</u>

if we get caught in <u>Esoteric</u>, <u>Head in the Clouds</u>, <u>Religious Debates</u> it's <u>very hard</u> to get back to the <u>real issue</u> - which is <u>SIN</u>

Paul has **spent 2 Ch's** proving - we are all <u>under the Curse</u> of **SIN**

& now he's **going to prove** to His Jewish Debater

that we must deal with the Central Issue of PERSONAL SIN

<u>ALL Debates</u> about God <u>must come down</u> to this; <u>What</u> are you going to do about your <u>PERSONAL SIN</u>?

& Paul **brings it down** to that Central Point - **V.9**

Rom 3:9 - ESV

9 What then? Are we Jews any better off? No, not at all. For we have already charged that all, both Jews and Greeks, are <u>under sin</u>, [means - under the power of sin]

Rom 3:9 - NLT

9 Well then, should we conclude that we Jews are better than others? No, not at all, for we have already shown that all people, whether Jews or Gentiles, are under the power of sin.

Whatever the "<u>Debate</u>" is - It <u>MUST</u> come down to this "all people, Religious or Not, are under the power of sin"

& when we get caught up in these "Religion Debates"

We've **got to** be able to say - **Yeah But, What about SIN ? Because** we know **all people** are under the **power of Sin**

Paul's **NOT** talking about *individual acts* of sin here **he's talking** about the **Sin Nature** of the entire Human Race

Someone has said;

If <u>Sin</u> were the Color <u>RED</u> then we would <u>ALL</u> be some shade of <u>RED</u>

Just as the Famous next Vs says

Out of the NKJV - Rom 3:10

10 As it is written: "There is none righteous, no, not one; Rom 3:10 - NLT

10 As the Scriptures say, "No one is righteous— not even one.

- & <u>w/ this vs</u> Paul begins possibly the <u>most explicit description</u> of the <u>Depravity of Mankind</u> in the NT
- & he <u>does it</u> with what is called (in Hebrew) a <u>Charaz</u> which means <u>A string of Pearls</u>
- & Paul is going to <u>string together</u> some <u>awful truths</u> about Mankind <u>designed</u> to leave us <u>speechless</u> before God

Whatever **Excuse**, **Debate**, or **Argument** we may've had before - this **Charaz** (String of Pearls) is designed to **stop us** in our tracks

It goes from <u>V.10 - to V.18</u>

Rom 3:10-18 - ESV

10 as it is written: "None is righteous, no, not one;

11 no one understands; no one seeks for God.

12 All have turned aside; together they have become worthless; no one does good, not even one."

13 "Their throat is an open grave; they use their tongues to deceive." "The venom of asps [snakes] is under their lips."

14 "Their mouth is full of curses and bitterness."

15 "Their feet are swift to shed blood:

16 in their paths are ruin and misery,

17 and the way of peace they have not known."

18 "There is no fear of God before their eyes."

These String of Judgments is taken from the **Psalms**, **Proverbs**, & **Isaiah**

<u>& maybe</u> - after a 1st read you <u>may think</u> - well, those <u>DON'T ALL</u> apply to <u>ME</u>

<u>But remember</u> - Paul is teaching about the <u>SIN NATURE</u> & <u>here</u> my friends - is <u>the truth</u> of the <u>Sin NATURE</u>

Jer 17:9 - NLT

9 "The human heart is the most deceitful of all things, and desperately wicked. Who really knows how bad it is?

<u>later</u> in his life - Paul <u>wrote</u> to his "<u>Pastoral Disciple</u>" <u>Titus</u> these words about Himself & Titus - in <u>Titus 3:3</u>

Titus 3:3 - ESV

3 For we ourselves were once foolish, disobedient, led astray, slaves to various passions and pleasures, passing our days in malice and envy, hated by others and hating one another.

WOW

Paul the Apostle acknowledging such sins - how can it be ?

But what Paul is saying to young Titus is;
"Hey we were just as bad a sinners as anyone else"

Whether Paul **specifically** committed **each** of those sins - **or Not**

he was <u>acknowledging</u> - that his <u>SIN NATURE</u> was <u>capable</u> <u>because</u> it was the <u>same sin nature</u> as Every Other Sinner

Either way - Paul knew - that when God said NO ONE is Righteous, No Not ONE

So - Back in Rom Ch 3

the <u>Charaz</u> - the <u>String of Pearls</u> Leaves <u>NONE</u> of us "<u>RIGHTEOUS</u>" before God

By <u>BOTH</u> Sin Nature - & <u>Sinful Choices</u> we really have <u>NO DEFENSE</u> before God

- & Again <u>as soon as</u> we get to <u>that</u> point <u>THEN</u> we are <u>ready</u> for the <u>Free Gift of Salvation</u>
- & THAT'S exactly how Paul is going to wrap up this section

by leaving **NO DEFENSE** for the guilt of the world

Rom 3:19 - ESV

19 Now we know that whatever the law says it speaks to those who are under the law, so that every mouth may be stopped, and the whole world may be held accountable to God.

Let me read <u>Rom 3:19</u> - out of the <u>NLT</u> & pls <u>watch closely</u> - for <u>THE PURPOSE</u> of the Law

Rom 3:19 - NLT

19 Obviously, the law applies to those to whom it was given, for <u>its purpose</u> is to keep people <u>from having excuses</u>, and to <u>show</u> that the <u>entire world</u> is guilty before God.

The purpose of God's Law is;

"to keep people from having excuses, & to show that the entire world is guilty before God"

THIS is the point to where our Religious Debates must come

When it comes down to SIN - We are ALL GUILTY!

- & <u>can we</u> be made <u>right</u> by <u>following the Law</u>? <u>NO</u> <u>not</u> because the law is <u>Faulty</u> but because we are <u>Sinful</u>
- & <u>as soon</u> as we accept the fact that <u>God's Law PROVE'S</u> our <u>GUILT</u>

Then we have come - to the <u>END of ourselves</u> to <u>the end</u> of all our own "<u>Human Thinking</u>" to the end of all our "Human Effort" to be made right with God

& Paul brings us - to the **End of Ourselves** - in **V.20 Again - in the NLT**

Rom 3:20 - ESV

20 For by works of the law no human being will be justified in his sight, since through the law comes knowledge of sin.

Rom 3:20 - NLT

20 For no one can ever be made right with God by doing what the law commands. The law simply shows us how sinful we are.

For those "Religious Debaters"

Who believe they can "Cover themselves" with God

For those who think their "*Human Reasoning*" will somehow correctly "*CLOTHE*" them before God . . .

I'd <u>like to tell</u> a <u>short</u> <u>children's story</u>

There is a classic children's story called The *Emperor's New Clothes*

The Emperor was very fond of his appearance
& he always loved to look "Fairer" than all the rest

- & some very "Crafty" Tailors heard of this & came into town
- & **they offered** to weave the King the most rare garment ever made

They promised it would be invisible to all but the wise & pure in heart

So he commissioned them at great cost & they sat down before *empty looms*

<u>The Emperor</u> sent his chief minister to ck the progress <u>Who didn't want</u> to be thought unwise & impure

& though he saw nothing he returned with a <u>fabulous report</u> of great beauty

<u>& after</u> the Tailors asked for more money – the emperor sent a <u>second chief minister</u> in to check

Though also seeing nothing - he returned with an even grander report

Then the emperor went in himself

& when the emperor himself saw <u>nothing</u> he proclaimed <u>even higher beauty</u> & gave out medals

<u>A Parade</u> was set – Emperor dressed <u>au naturel</u> by the Tailors who then quietly <u>skipped town</u>

By now - the whole town knew the story
So they *all praised* the incredible *unseen* clothing

<u>Until</u>, in a moment of silence, a chi<u>l</u>d stripped away all the <u>hypocrisy & pretense</u>

& <u>Yelled out</u> - "The emperor has no clothes!" which caused everyone (incldg emperor) to finally <u>admit the truth</u>

Guys - <u>this</u> well describes <u>the condition</u>
of <u>those who think</u> they've come up with
their own "<u>WAY</u>" to cover themselves with God

They imagine themselves clothed with some <u>Human Understanding</u>
Generally with a "<u>Cloak</u>" of some <u>misled religious confidence</u>

They think their <u>works</u> & their <u>good deeds</u> will somehow <u>cloth them</u> in Righteousness

But the Word of God has "Cried Out" the Truth about their Clothing

& one day - on Parade before God they will realize that they are actually - Naked before Him

Have <u>WE</u> yet understood - that <u>without Jesus Christ</u> we also stand "<u>Un-Clothed</u>" in our <u>own efforts</u> to please God ??

Skip ahead w/ me - just 2 Vs's

Rom 3:22 - NLT

22 We are made right with God by placing our faith in Jesus Christ. And this is true for everyone who believes, no matter who we are.

We - Emperors - <u>Are we</u> clothed with the righteousness the <u>comes only</u> by faith in Jesus Christ ??

Or are we preparing to enter that Eternal Parade;

<u>Thinking</u> we are <u>Clothed</u> in our Human Understanding When <u>really</u> we are <u>Unclothed</u> before the God of Heaven

It may seem easier to put on the Emperor's New Clothes & parade around in our own Human Understanding

But it will be an Eternal Shame to realize not only is our Self-Righteousness as Filthy Rags But it is actually - NO Clothing at all

Let's Pray

When drawn into a Religious Debate be <u>very careful</u> when you choose to speak

If you choose to "<u>Spar</u>" with a "<u>Debater</u>" based on human intellect you will <u>NEVER</u> accomplish God's Will in that Debate

<u>Man's Wisdom</u> is foolishness to God so <u>be careful</u> not to compare <u>man's wisdom</u> w/ <u>man's wisdom</u>

<u>Instead</u> - I encourage you to <u>bring the debate</u> to the subject of <u>SIN</u>

Whatever the person's background or beliefs are

try to **bring the debate** to the subject of **SIN**

Because **THAT** is exactly what Paul has done here

They will **Squirm** - & they will **Duck** & **Weave** to Avoid it

But try to **get to the fact**;

that a <u>Perfectly Holy</u> & <u>Perfectly Righteous</u> God can <u>Never</u> overlook - Even <u>one sin</u>

Because If He were to **overlook** even one sin He could not be <u>Perfectly Holy</u> & <u>Perfectly Righteous</u>

<u>Here</u> in Romans - Paul has spent a <u>HUGE</u> amount of time convicting us <u>ALL</u> - of our <u>Sinful Condition</u>

& Now that we are **Truly Convicted** of our Sinful Condition We are **Truly Ready** - to Hear *God's Miraculous plan of Salvation*

Remember - the ONLY Profitable Debate is one that ends with an understanding of SIN - & - SALVATION
