- & We have **just BLAZED thru** the **O.T.**
- <u>Today</u> in only our <u>9th Msg</u> we've <u>Surveyed God's Plan of</u>
  <u>Redemption</u> From <u>Genesis</u> to the <u>End of the OT</u>
- We've <u>had</u> to <u>leave out A LOT</u> as we've <u>Followed God's</u> "<u>Thread of Redemption</u>" thru <u>39 Books</u> (incld'g today)
- But <u>our Goal</u> in this <u>study</u> has been to <u>Specifically</u> "<u>Connect The Dots</u>" . . .
- To see the One Single Scarlet Thread of Redemption Running from Beginning to End of the Bible
- & so <u>Today</u> we <u>CONTINUE</u> '<u>Connecting the Dots'</u> & <u>Seeing</u> that <u>THREAD of Redemption</u> . . .
- **EVEN tho** our **Focus** today is on the **CONSEQUENCES** of Israel's **Repeated REJECTION of GOD**
- & we're going to see a very difficult 'Double Truth" today
- 1) God *WILL* bring His **Promise** & His **Plan To Pass**
- 2) There **ARE** Consequences for Rejecting God

#### Here's how it's worked out So Far

God Made a Covenant with Abraham, Isaac, & Jacob

The Nation of Israel Grew in Egypt - under Slavery

God **Delivered Israel** from Egypt - & that Slavery

God Made a Covenant with Moses - called The Law

God **Enabled Israel** to Conquer the Promised Land

God Made a Covenant with King David - an Eternal Covenant

That's an <u>Incredible History</u> of God's <u>COVENANTS</u> with Israel Some <u>UN-CONDITIONAL</u> - Some <u>CON-DITIONAL</u>

& looking at THE BIG PICTURE - Here's how it worked out

<u>Time</u> & <u>Time</u> & <u>Time</u> again - <u>GOD WAS FAITHFUL</u> to <u>keep</u>
<u>His Promise</u> to the <u>People of Israel</u>

Everything God promised to do - He was Doing (& still is)
God was keeping His Side of ALL The Covenants

<u>Israel however</u> - was <u>doing</u> Just the <u>OPPOSITE</u>

When we look at Israel - Sometimes we wonder if they EVER kept up THEIR SIDE - Of ANY of their Conditional Covenants w/ God

<u>Israel's Rebellion</u> & <u>Unbelief started</u> when the <u>Bodies</u> of the <u>Egyptians</u> were <u>still floating</u> to the <u>surface</u> of the <u>Red Sea</u>

AS SOON as Israel was across the Red Sea they began Grumbling, Complaining & Rebelling against God

At <u>Mt Sinai</u> - they had a <u>campfire</u> <u>one night</u> & <u>ended up</u> <u>creating</u> a <u>Gold Calf</u> to <u>Worship</u> instead of God

& it seems like it all goes DOWNHILL from there !!!

- That <u>Generation</u> <u>Rebelled SO MUCH</u>
  God <u>couldn't allow</u> them <u>into</u> the <u>Promised Land</u>
- But God <u>STILL Remained Faithful</u> to them <u>Even while</u> they <u>Wandered</u> in the <u>Wilderness</u> till they Died
- & <u>After God DID</u> deliver the <u>Promised land</u> to Israel <u>AS SOON</u> as <u>Joshua Died</u> the <u>People immed</u> began <u>turning</u> form <u>the Lord</u>
- <u>Thru-out Israel's History</u> They were <u>Constantly Rebelling</u>
  <u>Against God</u> & Joining <u>With</u> the <u>Pagan nations</u> around them
- <u>Israel DID</u> have <u>Times</u> of <u>Repentance</u> & <u>Returning</u> to the Lord <u>Generally</u> whenever <u>God</u> would <u>Raise up a DELIVERER</u>
- But <u>time</u> after <u>time</u> The <u>people</u> would <u>Again REJECT God</u> & <u>Embrace</u> the <u>Idols</u> & the <u>Ways of the World</u> around them

#### AND SO (pls hear me) - God Brought A DOUBLE TRUTH to Pass

- #1) God Remained FAITHFUL to Israel
- # 2) Israel Experienced the CONSEQUENCES of their Sin

When the People of God - Experience CONSEQUENCES of Sin It Does Not Nullify the FAITHFULNESS of God

PLUS - God had PROMISED ISRAEL - <u>UP FRONT</u>
EXACTLY What would happen IF they Did - What they DID

Back in <u>Deuteronomy</u> (<u>2nd Giving</u> of the Law)
When <u>Israel</u> was on the <u>Edge</u> of the <u>Promised Land</u>

In <u>DEUT 27</u> - God had <u>Moses split Israel</u> on <u>two sides</u> of a <u>Valley</u> 6 tribes on <u>Mt Gerizim</u> & 6 Tribes on <u>Mt Ebal</u>

The Valley Formed a Natural Amphitheater - & Strong Visual Aide for God's Promises of EITHER - BLESSING or CURSING

So - w/ HALF Israel on One Side - & HALF on the Other . . .

in Deut 27-28 - God makes Some Guaranteed Promises
He Promises BLESSING if Israel will FOLLOW Him
He Promises CURSING if Israel REJECTS Him

Remember - this was BEFORE Israel even Crossed the Jordan into the Promised Land

God <u>TOLD</u> them - Very <u>Vividly</u> - What <u>would happen</u> to them if they <u>REJECTED</u> God - & <u>Followed</u> after the <u>World</u>

One of the **KEY Promises** of God - That **WOULD** come to pass **if Israel Rejected God** - is found in

**Deuteronomy 28:36 - & v's 47-48 (FROM NLT)** 

36 "The Lord will exile you and your king to a nation unknown to you and your ancestors. There in exile you will worship gods of wood and stone!

. . .

47 If you do not serve the Lord your God with joy and enthusiasm for the abundant benefits you have received, 48 you will serve your enemies whom the Lord will send against you. You will be left hungry, thirsty, naked, and lacking in everything. The Lord will put an iron yoke on your neck, oppressing you harshly until he has destroyed you.

# God was Faithfully Fulfilling His Unconditional Covenant with Israel AND - God was Promising Consequences - if Israel Rejected Him

& <u>Israel DID Reject God</u> - <u>Over</u>, & <u>Over</u>, & <u>Over</u> Again & God <u>DID Fulfill His Promise</u> of <u>Consequences</u>

#### **HERE'S HOW IT WENT DOWN**

God <u>had firmly established</u> Israel in the <u>Promised Land</u> <u>Under King David</u> (we saw that last week)

King David's son - SOLOMON had built the Temple of the Lord

In the <u>NEXT Generation</u> - The <u>Generation</u> of <u>Solomon's Son</u> <u>Israel Fully</u> & <u>Completely REJECTED God</u> - Period!

TWO Generations from the Rule of King David

Israel had Completely Turned from God (it started w/ Solomon)

Read 1KINGS 11 - to see this Prophesied

#### Israel's Demise begins with a CIVIL WAR

10 Tribes Break Away from 2 Tribes

10 Tribes in the north called ISRAEL

2 Tribes in the South Called JUDAH

Read about their Constant WAR with each other in 1Kin 12-15

The <u>Northern Kingdom</u> (10 Tribes) <u>immediately</u> became <u>Godless & Pagan Worshippers</u>

- The <u>Southern Kingdom</u> (2 Tribes) had a <u>few Godly Kings</u> but <u>ultimately ALSO</u> became <u>Completely Godless</u>
- This was an <u>Awful</u> & <u>Terrible Time</u> (Spiritually) for <u>Israel</u> & it <u>Iasts so long</u> it's <u>Mind-Boggling</u>
- You <u>can read</u> all the <u>UGLINESS</u> from <u>1KINGS 12</u> ALL the way to <u>2KINGS 17</u> that's <u>28 CHPTRS !!!</u>
- & even tho <u>Israel</u> <u>as a whole</u> had <u>completely turned</u> from God God was <u>STILL WITH THEM</u>
- The Most <u>FAMOUS</u> <u>Prophets</u> for <u>God</u> during this time were <u>ELIJAH</u> & <u>ELISHA</u>
- & **they**, & other **Prophets**, were *constantly* **Calling Israel** Back to God **ALL** during this time of **Civil War** & the **Divided Kingdom**

But Finally - God's Promise of CONSEQUENCE - HAD to come

God Promised Israel - Way Back in Deut 28 - If they Rejected Him & Turned From Him - He would send them into Exile . . .

That they would again be Slaves to their Enemies

That God would REMOVE THEM from the Promised Land

& COMPLETELY CRUSH them as a Nation

& <u>Ultimately</u> - God <u>KEEPS</u> His Promises . . .

<u>But</u> - - <u>During</u> that <u>time</u> - The <u>Book</u> of <u>HOSEA</u> was written & we <u>see God's</u> Unbelievable <u>COMPASSION</u> For His <u>people</u> who're <u>BENT</u> on <u>Rejecting Him</u>

## Hosea 11:8-10 (NLT)

- 8 "Oh, how can I give you up, Israel? How can I let you go? . . . My heart is torn within me, and my compassion overflows.
  9 No, I will not unleash my fierce anger. I will not completely destroy Israel, for I am God and not a mere mortal. I am the Holy One living among you, and I will not come to destroy.
  10 For someday the people will follow me . . .
- & in <u>that last line</u> is a <u>HINT</u> of <u>HOW</u> God's <u>Unconditional Covenant</u> <u>LASTS</u> - <u>even</u> thru His <u>people's rejection</u> of Him
- But Now in 2KIN 17 It was Finally TIME for the Consequences to FALL For Israel's Rejection of God
- Turn to **2Kin 17** This is the **Beginning** of **God's Judgment Finally FALLING** on **Israel** (read the Ch later)
- **2Kin17** explains so much that it's hard to SKIM thru . . . I'm going to read portions from ESV so you can follow

## 2 Kings 17:6-23 (ESV)

- 6 In the ninth year of Hoshea, the king of Assyria captured Samaria (North), and he carried the Israelites away to Assyria . . . 7 And this occurred because the people of Israel had sinned against the Lord their God, who had brought them up out of the land of Egypt from under the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and had feared (worshipped) other gods
- 8 and walked in the customs of the nations whom the Lord drove out before the people of Israel . . .
- 9 And the people of Israel did secretly against the Lord their God things that were not right. They built for themselves high places in all their towns, from watchtower to fortified city.
- 11 (end of v.11) . . . And they did wicked things, provoking the Lord to anger,

- 12 and they served idols, of which the Lord had said to them, "You shall not do this."
- 13 Yet the Lord warned Israel and Judah by every prophet and every seer, saying, "Turn from your evil ways and keep my commandments and my statutes . . .
- 14 But they would not listen, but were stubborn, as their fathers had been, who did not believe in the Lord their God.
- 15 They despised his statutes and his covenant that he made with their fathers and the warnings that he gave them. They went after false idols and became false (themselves) . . .
- 16 And they abandoned all the commandments of the Lord their God . . .

. . .

18 Therefore the Lord was very angry with Israel and removed them out of his sight . . .

. .

23 (End of 23) . . . So Israel was exiled from their own land to Assyria until this day.

This is the **Beginning of the Exile** 

First - The Northern Tribes were taken into Captivity into Assyria

& Then - <u>100 yrs later</u> - The <u>Southern Tribes</u> were taken into <u>Captivity</u> into <u>BABYLON</u>

The <u>Final Fall of Jerusalem</u> & the <u>Southern Tribes</u>
Being <u>Taken</u> into <u>Captivity</u> - Occurs in <u>2Kin 25</u>

If <u>You've heard</u> of the "<u>The Babylonian Captivity</u>"

<u>This is it</u> - & <u>THIS</u> is <u>WHY</u> - *Israel Continually REJECTED God* 

#### Now - Here is what is MIND-BLOWING

- MOST of the Remaining Books of the O.T. from 1Chronicles to the END of the OT (NOT incld'g Job to S.O.S)
- But <u>MOST</u> of the <u>other remaining books</u> in the <u>O.T.</u> were written either <u>Just BEFORE</u> <u>DURING</u> or <u>AFTER</u> . . .
- this MASSIVE Judgment of God of Throwing His People
  OUT of the Promised Land & INTO Captivity in Babylon
- That's about **20 BOOKS** of **the O.T. Written during** this **intense time** of **Judgment from God** for **Israel's Disobedience**
- & **EVERY ONE** of those Books **IN Some way Speaks** of **God's Faithfulness** to Israel !! . . .
- Written IN THE MIDST of God's Justly Due Judgment upon Israel for their Rejection of Him
- God <u>still showed</u> His <u>Steadfast Love</u> to them (<u>Hesed</u>) He <u>still</u> <u>Pursued</u> them He <u>called them back</u> into <u>Relationship</u> w/ Him
- <u>Israel</u> had <u>completely</u> <u>Turned from God</u> <u>Abandoned God</u>
  & they were <u>Living in the Consequences</u> of that
- But **God Always remained FAITHFUL** to His **People**
- & <u>Israel's Rebellion</u> & <u>Rejection of God</u> Did NOT Sway God's Plan - *ONE BIT*
- It Was As If He Already Knew They Were Going To Do It

## **EZE 36-37** are **Great Chapters** for you to see **God's Continued Faithfulness** to His people - **read them**

In EZE 36 God makes it clear: It's NOT because Israel DESERVES it

But <u>it's because</u> of God's <u>HOLY NAME</u> - Because of <u>Who God IS</u> - <u>that God</u> is <u>going</u> to <u>bring His Plan</u> to <u>Pass FOR</u> (<u>& Thru</u>) <u>Israel</u>

## **Ezekiel 36:22 (ESV)**

22 "Therefore say to the house of Israel, Thus says the Lord God: It is not for your sake, O house of Israel, that I am about to act, but for the sake of my holy name, which you have profaned among the nations to which you came.

NOT because THEY (or we) Deserve it - But because of WHO God is THAT is why - God WILL bring His plan to PASS !!

& SO - Because of HIS NAME'S Sake - because of WHO God is

## God says to Israel in - Ezekiel 36:24-28 (ESV)

- 24 I will take you from the nations and gather you from all the countries and bring you into your own land.
- 25 I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean from all your uncleannesses, and from all your idols I will cleanse you.
- 26 And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.
- 27 And I will put my Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to obey my rules.
- 28 You shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers, and you shall be my people, and I will be your God.

THAT is God - Being Faithful to His people - Even In the Midst of their Disobedience & Rebellion

#### **GOD'S PLAN IS STILL ON TRACK!!**

In <u>SO MANY</u> of the <u>Prophetic passages</u> (like <u>this one</u> in <u>EZE 36</u>) <u>God REAFFIRMS</u> His <u>Covenant</u> with His <u>people</u>

**EVEN** in the **Midst** of them Rejecting Him **AND Suffering** the **Consequences** 

**LST WK** we read from **EZE 37** (the Nxt Ch) - (should read it all)

## **Ezekiel 37:24–28 (NLT)**

24 "My servant David (metaphor for Jesus) will be their king, and they will have only one shepherd . . .

25 They will live in the land I gave my servant Jacob, the land where their ancestors lived. They . . . will live there forever . . . And my servant David (metaphor) will be their prince forever.

26 And I will make a covenant of peace with them, an everlasting covenant . . . and I will put my Temple among them forever.

27 I will make my home among them. I will be their God, and they will be my people.

28 And when my Temple is among them <u>forever</u>, the nations will know that I am the Lord, who makes Israel holy."

But here's the POINT for TODAY . . .

As we CLOSE the O.T. - THAT Had not happened

For <u>600 Years</u> - From the <u>Captivity in Babylon</u> & <u>Even Thru</u> a <u>Mediocre Return</u> to the <u>Promised Land</u> . . .

For <u>600 yrs</u> of <u>Hearing</u> the <u>Prophets</u> - For the <u>Entire REST</u> of the <u>the O.T.</u> - <u>THIS had NOT YET happened</u>

Israel was WAITING, WAITING . . .

## & While they were waiting - the Prophets were telling them exactly WHAT was going to happen

#### Turn BACK 2 Books to JEREMIAH

## <u>Jeremiah 31:31–33 (ESV)</u>

- 31 "Behold, the days are coming, declares the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah,
- 32 not like the covenant that I made with their fathers on the day when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, my covenant that they broke, though I was their husband, declares the Lord.
- 33 For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the Lord: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

#### WHAT (WHO) ARE ALL THE PROPHETS POINTING TO ???

#### As we close out GOD'S PLAN in the O.T.

In our last Two Msg's - We've Seen these Two Things;

- 1) (lst wk) God would SEND a MESSIAH An Eternal King in the Line of David
- 2) (this wk) God will MAKE a NEW COVENANT with His People that would truly enable them to serve Him
- & <u>from the moment</u> of the <u>BIRTH</u> of <u>Jesus Christ</u> <u>Jesus Demonstrated</u> that <u>He</u> was <u>God's Messiah</u>

Jesus Proved He was Israel's True Eternal King

- & <u>then</u> the <u>night before</u> He was <u>Crucified</u> <u>Jesus gathered</u> His <u>Disciples together</u> to <u>celebrate</u> the <u>Passover</u> . . .
- & Remember the Passover was the Picture of God's Ultimate Redemption in Jesus Christ (blood of lamb)
- & on this Passover Night Jesus took the Bread & the Wine . . .
- & He <u>Made it clear</u> <u>These elements</u> of the <u>Passover</u> <u>actually Represented</u> His <u>Body</u> & <u>Blood</u>
- & when Jesus took the cup He said "This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood."

#### For 600 years

**Israel** had been **Promised TWO things** by **the Prophets**:

- #1) God would send them a Messiah, an Eternal King in the Line of David
- #2) God would make a New Covenant with them that would enable them (& us) to truly SERVE HIM

### & God KEPT those Promises

God <u>DID</u> send a <u>MESSIAH</u> - His name is <u>Jesus</u> God <u>DID</u> send a <u>NEW COVENANT</u> - *in His Blood* that <u>enables us</u> to truly <u>Serve God</u>

JUST AS He Promised Israel He would DO

PIs - REMEMBER this Vs - About the God who LOVES YOU

## 2 Timothy 2:13 (NLT)

13 If we are unfaithful, he remains faithful, for he cannot deny who he is.

& Remember this - About the New Covenant in Jesus Christ

Jesus Himself said in Matthew 5:17 (ESV)

17 "Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them.

As we enter the N.T. Part of God's Plan of Redemption Let's be CLEAR on ONE Thing . . .

JESUS hasn't CHANGED Anything
He has FULFILLED Everything
