Ruth 03 - God Guides & God Provides - Ruth 1:19-2:23

Last Msg we focused on what "True Repentance" LOOKS LIKE

& I was <u>kinda HARD</u> on <u>NAOMI</u> in that Msg because, really, <u>her Repentance</u> was pretty '<u>half-hearted'</u>

NAOMI was certainly NOT <u>Returning to the Lord</u> - <u>ALL IN</u>, Wholehearted, & with a <u>Passion</u> for God

<u>THAT</u> was <u>RUTH</u> - who was <u>Returning</u> (or TURNING) to the Lord with that "<u>All In</u>" "<u>No Matter What</u>" commitment

<u>Unfortunately</u> - we spent <u>SO MUCH Time</u> on the <u>True Repentance</u> concept . . .

That we <u>didn't even</u> get to <u>finish</u> the text of these <u>two women</u> getting <u>back to Bethlehem</u>

So we **have** to **START THERE** this morning

& that will lead us right into the Wonderful Truth that God does GUIDE - & God does PROVIDE

Let's Pray

We left Ruth & Naomi - Walking in SILENCE

RUTH had made that Amazing "Commitment of Faith" (v.16)
& followed it up with a "Till Death do we Part" Oath to God

& then - Ruth 1:18 says (esv)

18 And when Naomi saw that [Ruth] was determined to go with her, she said no more.

NAOMI had been TRYING to talk RUTH OUT of going back to Bethlehem with her

& maybe we can understand NAOMI'S 'Reluctance' a little bit

NAOMI was a PRODIGAL Returning to her Heavenly Father's house . . . & not only was she Returning as a Prodigal

But she was Bringing a FOREIGN Daughter in Law with her that she wasn't supposed to have

& so - we pick it up today - in Ruth 1:19 (ESV)

19 So the two of them went on (in silence?) until they came to Bethlehem. And when they came to Bethlehem, the whole town was stirred because of them. And the women said, "Is this Naomi?"

These two **<u>DUSTY Widows</u>** come **<u>Draggin</u>** back into town & the **<u>town women</u>** are **<u>jostling</u>** & **<u>whispering</u>** to each other

<u>Is this NAOMI</u> ?? She left <u>10 years ago</u> with a <u>full family</u>, & <u>Now</u>, she comes <u>dragging</u> back into town <u>ALONE</u>

But - not quite alone . . . who is that with her?

That <u>isn't family</u>, that <u>isn't even</u> an <u>Israelite</u> . . . wait a minute - that's a <u>MOABITE</u> girl with her

& Moabites were **DESPISED** by Israel

Naomi KNEW that - Which is probably why she was trying to talk RUTH out of coming with her

- & Ruth KNEW that But her commitment & her faith drove her to God, & to God's people in spite of them
- & so after <u>10 years</u> in the <u>Prodigal Wilderness</u> & after <u>losing</u> Her <u>Husband</u> and BOTH <u>her sons</u> . . . we read in

Ruth 1:20-21 (esv)

20 She said to them, "Do not call me Naomi (Pleasant); call me Mara (Bitter), for the Almighty has dealt very bitterly with me.
21 I went away full, and the Lord has brought me back empty.
Why call me Naomi, when the Lord has testified against me and the Almighty has brought calamity upon me?"

Man Naomi, you are indeed PITIFUL
You think you have NO HOPE - But you are So, So WRONG !!

& Notice no mention of her SIN of leaving God's Land to chase prosperity in the World

Naomi - the Lord has NOT brought Calamity upon you Your SIN has brought Calamity upon you . . .

& your God - in His Unending Mercy & Grace - has Prepared an <u>ETERNAL TREASURE</u> of Blessing for you

But in your Depression & Self-Pity
All you can see, is your bitterness, & your circumstances

But - strictly by God's Grace those Circumstances are about to change

Ruth 1:22 (esv)

22 So Naomi returned, and Ruth the Moabite her daughter-in-law with her, who returned from the country of Moab. And they came to Bethlehem at the beginning of barley harvest.

In <u>God's Perfect Timing</u> - These <u>two Women</u> had arrived at the <u>beginning</u> of the <u>Barley Harvest</u>

Which was the perfect time for God to give them HOPE

<u>AND</u> - the <u>perfect time</u> for God to <u>Continue</u> the <u>Scarlet thread</u> that would <u>bring Jesus Christ</u> into the world - <u>According to Plan</u>

NAOMI certainly had NO idea what God was doing in all this RUTH - tho she had Faith, she didn't know what God was doing
BUT GOD knew Exactly what He was doing here . . .

- & God knows Exactly what He's doing in OUR lives TOO
- & we're **going to see** God today **SET RUTH'S** Path & we're **going to see** Him **GUIDE** & **PROVIDE** for her
- <u>AND</u> we're <u>going to see</u> that <u>RUTH</u> <u>DID</u> have a <u>ROLE</u> in <u>FOLLOWING</u> that Path that God <u>MADE</u> for her
- & <u>I pray</u> today that we would <u>TRUST</u> that God <u>knows</u> <u>Exactly</u> what He is <u>doing</u> in <u>OUR Lives</u>
- & <u>I Pray</u> we would <u>understand</u> that we <u>ALSO</u> have a <u>ROLE</u> in <u>FOLLOWING</u> the Path God <u>MAKES STRAIGHT</u> for <u>US</u>

TURN over to Prov 3:5-6 (Dani's life's vs)

I believe these 2 vs's Perfectly Portray the lesson in Ruth today

Prov 3:5-6 (esv)

5 Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding.

6 In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.

THIS is what we're going to see today - in Ruth Ch 2

God Generally does NOT:

- 1) Tell us His Plan
- 2) Make us a Map
- 3) Give us a Neon Sign

We'd <u>like to HAVE</u> those things But <u>very SELDOM</u> does God <u>give them</u> to us

What God DOES Promise is - IF we will:

<u>Trust</u> in the Lord with ALL our heart, & NOT lean on our own <u>understanding</u>, & In ALL our ways <u>acknowledge</u> him, THEN - - - he will <u>make straight</u> our path.

It means that IF we are Truly Surrendered to Him then God will SET our PATH before us

& THAT - is EXACTLY what we're going to see today

So let's get started - Ruth 2:1 (esv)

1 Now <u>Naomi had a relative</u> of her husband's, <u>a worthy man</u> of the clan (family) of Elimelech (Naomi's Husband), whose name was Boaz.

Here the writer introduces BOAZ - Our THIRD Key Character

He's <u>related</u> to <u>NAOMI'S</u> husband - & he is a <u>WORTHY MAN</u> <u>although</u> the word "<u>Worthy</u>" is a bit of an <u>UNDERSTATEMENT</u>

The NLT says he is - "A Wealthy & Influential Man"

& <u>God</u> is going to <u>use him</u> - to <u>CHANGE RUTH'S</u> Life Forever <u>AND</u> - to <u>continue</u> the <u>Blood-Line</u> - of <u>The MESSIAH</u>

Ruth 2:2 (esv)

2 And Ruth the Moabite said to Naomi, "Let me go to the field and <u>glean</u> among the ears of grain after him <u>in whose sight I shall find</u> <u>favor</u>." And she said to her, "Go, my daughter."

GLEANING was a **welfare system** established by the **Mosaic Law**

<u>Landowners</u> were to allow the <u>Poor</u> & <u>Foreigners</u> to <u>go thru</u> the field <u>AFTER</u> the harvest - & <u>pick-up the crop</u> that was left

But **NOT all** Land **Owners** would **follow** this Law So **RUTH** says - *I will LOOK for one in Whose sight I find Favor*

TWO things to NOTICE here:

- 1) RUTH didn't just SIT at home & Wait for God to bring her Food
- 2) She was **looking** for a "Confirmation" of God's leading

She says - "I will GLEAN after him in Whose Sight I find FAVOR"

That <u>doesn't sound</u> like <u>much of a plan</u> - But it was <u>ALL God needed</u> to <u>Lead & Guide RUTH</u> - for His Name's Sake

Ruth 2:3 (esv)

3 So she set out and went and gleaned in the field after the reapers, and she <u>happened</u> to come to the part of the field belonging to Boaz, who was of the clan (family) of Elimelech.

Oh - she <u>HAPPENED</u> to come to <u>the part</u> of the field belonging to <u>BOAZ</u>

RUTH didn't know WHO BOAZ was - & didn't know this was his field

As far as she knows - she just "Happened" into this field

- & guys WHEN WE are Trusting in the Lord, with ALL our hearts
 - & Not Leaning on our Own Understanding
 - & Acknowledging Him in all Our Ways . . .
- <u>THEN</u> From the "<u>Human Perspective</u>" we will just "Happen" onto the Path God has SET for us
- **BUT** From the "*Divine Perspective*" there is NO "Just happened" about it

Here's **how important** it is for **Ruth** to "**Happen**" into this **right field**

The <u>Birth of Jesus Christ</u> being in <u>Bethlehem</u> is <u>Dependent</u> on <u>Ruth</u> just "<u>happening</u>" into the <u>Correct Field</u> here

<u>So</u> - As <u>RUTH</u> is <u>TRUSTING God</u> - <u>Not Leaning</u> on her understanding She just "<u>happens</u>" into the field owned by <u>BOAZ</u>

Ruth 2:4-5 (esv)

- 4 And behold, Boaz came from Bethlehem. And he said to the reapers, "The Lord be with you!" And they answered, "The Lord bless you."
- 5 Then Boaz said to his young man who was in charge of the reapers, "Whose young woman is this?"
- <u>I assure</u> you <u>Boaz did NOT ask</u> this question of <u>every poor widow</u> gleaning in his fields
- & <u>so</u> from this <u>very first</u> moment <u>something</u> is <u>different</u> here <u>Boaz</u> is <u>immediately drawn</u> to ask about <u>RUTH</u>
- & it's <u>not that Ruth</u> is out there <u>looking</u> like a <u>Princess</u>
 She'd be <u>fully covered</u> <u>following</u> the workers as a <u>poor widow</u>
- & so the Manager doesn't catch the GLEAM in Boaz's eye
- & He's **not sure WHY** Boaz is **asking** But he **seems** to be kind of **covering** himself as he **explains** . . .

Ruth 2:6-7 (esv)

- 6 And the servant who was in charge of the reapers answered, "She is the young Moabite woman, who came back with Naomi from the country of Moab. (Moab said with 'disdain')
 7 She said, 'Please let me glean and gather among the sheaves after the reapers.' So she came, and she has continued from early morning until now, except for a short rest."
- The manager knew **Boaz Lived** by the **Mosaic Law** that allowed the **Poor**, & **Foreigners** to **pick up** what the **harvesters** left
- & <u>it seems</u> like he's saying I was <u>just following</u> the Law <u>I know</u> she's a <u>Moabite</u> . . .

& <u>right here</u> - it seems like <u>Boaz</u> just <u>raises his hand</u> & says <u>WHATEVER</u> to his field <u>manager</u>

Ruth 2:8-9 (esv)

8 Then Boaz said to Ruth . . .

He just <u>walks away</u> from his <u>manager</u> & <u>goes directly</u> to this <u>Foreigner Widow</u> in his field

Which would be unheard of - unless it was a ruthless owner trying to run off the poor OFF from their field

But that was hardly the case here - in fact - Just the OPPOSITE

(again) Ruth 2:8-9 (esv)

- 8 Then Boaz said to Ruth, "Now, listen, my daughter, do not go to glean in another field or leave this one, but keep close to my young women.
- 9 Let your eyes be on the field that they are reaping, and go after them. Have I not charged the young men not to touch you? And when you are thirsty, go to the vessels and drink what the young men have drawn."

Whoa !! - OK, that was kinda weird !! - Ruth wasn't expecting THAT

Have you ever had that happen? Someone just singles you out
for kindness - without you doing a thing to deserve it? - (GRACE)

<u>I know</u> - most people <u>develop</u> the <u>love story</u> here (& there is one)

But our **TV image** of a **Beautiful Woman**, **Gliding** across the field, with the **soft back light**, & the "**Marilyn Monroe**" look . . . That is **NOT** what's **happening** here

Ruth is a Despised Foreigner - who feels everyone's staring at her

She's got her head down, & her hands in the dirt, picking up scraps of barley just to have something to eat tonight

& <u>Suddenly</u> - this <u>Wealthy & Powerful</u> man is <u>addressing</u> her <u>like</u> she's <u>long lost family</u>

<u>& so we read in - Ruth 2:10-11 (esv)</u>

10 Then she fell on her face, bowing to the ground, and said to him, "Why have I found favor in your eyes, that you should take notice of me, since I am a foreigner?"

RUTH responds with the appropriate SHOCK "I am a MOABITE, How can I find favor in your eyes?"

But **Ruth's FAITH** - & Her **LOYALTY** - to this **Family**, to **Israel**, & to **God** - Had already **gone before her**

2:11 But Boaz answered her, "All that you have done for your mother-in-law since the death of your husband has been fully told to me, and how you left your father and mother and your native land and came to a people that you did not know before.

RUTH had done what was RIGHT - & stuck to her commitments
WITHOUT regard for WHOEVER might hear about it

& God was Making Sure - the Right Person DID hear about it & that right person was BOAZ - He had heard about it

& he'd also heard of Ruth's FAITH in the God of Israel

Ruth 2:12-13 (esv) - Boaz says

12 The Lord repay you for what you have done, and a full reward be given you by the Lord, the God of Israel, <u>under whose wings</u> you have come to take refuge!"

(a beautiful picture of the covering of the Lord)

13 Then she said, "I have found favor in your eyes, my lord, for you have comforted me and spoken kindly to your servant, though I am not one of your servants."

This is an <u>incredible exchange</u> - occurred in the <u>morning</u>, in the field & <u>by mid-day</u> - <u>BOAZ</u> was having <u>LUNCH</u> with <u>RUTH</u>

& <u>not JUST</u> having <u>lunch</u> with her but <u>beginning</u> to <u>shower her</u> with <u>GRACE</u> (*Undeserved Favor*)

Ruth 2:14 (esv)

14 And at mealtime Boaz said to her, "Come here and eat some bread and dip your morsel in the wine." So she sat beside the reapers, and he passed to her roasted grain. And she ate until she was satisfied, and she had some left over.

Okay - this is <u>EXTREME</u> for <u>Ruth's 1st Day</u> as a <u>Beggar</u> in the fields <u>NONE</u> of this is <u>Normal & Customary</u>

& not only was she treated as a GUEST at the Lunch Table

Ruth 2:15-16 (esv)

15 When she rose to glean, Boaz instructed his young men, saying, "Let her glean even among the sheaves, and do not reproach her.

16 And also pull out some from the bundles for her and leave it for her to glean, and do not rebuke her."

NOW - She was **picking up** Barley **RIGHT WITH** the **harvesters**

<u>AND</u> - the <u>Harvesters</u> were <u>purposefully dropping</u> what they were collecting - <u>right in front</u> of her

Ruth 2:17-18 (esv)

17 So she gleaned in the field until evening. Then she beat out what she had gleaned, and it was about an ephah of barley.

An **Ephah** was a **5-Gallon Bucket** full of **Grain** - **3-4 times** what a normal "**gleaner**" would've **expected**

18 And she took it up and went into the city. Her mother-in-law saw what she had gleaned. She also brought out and gave her what food she had left over after being satisfied.

& Right About NOW - our "Marginally Faithful" NAOMI is about to have a "CHANGE of Heart"

& it's **GOOD** that **NAOMI** is going to **begin to have faith**

But it's Only After SEEING God GUIDING & PROVIDING that her FAITH begins to grow again

In the <u>N.T.</u> - When <u>Thomas</u> said he would <u>believe</u> <u>ONLY</u> when he <u>saw</u> the <u>NAIL</u> holes & the <u>PIERCED SIDE</u> - <u>Jesus said</u> to him in

John 20:29 (NLT)

29... "You believe because you have seen me. Blessed are those who believe without seeing me."

NAOMI'S faith is going to Return - But she would've been much more blessed - to have had that faith all along

So - After seeing the Extreme Blessing of RUTH'S 1st day's efforts

Ruth 2:19-20 (esv)

19 And her mother-in-law said to her, "Where did you glean today? And where have you worked? Blessed be the man who took notice of you." So she told her mother-in-law with whom she had worked and said, "The man's name with whom I worked today is Boaz."

20 And Naomi said to her daughter-in-law, "May he be blessed by the Lord, whose kindness has not forsaken the living or the dead!" . . .

NAOMI'S referring to her <u>husband</u> and <u>sons</u>
again because - <u>BOAZ</u> is <u>RELATED</u> to <u>NAOMI'S</u> husband

But **Even MORE** than "**Just**" Related - the **end of v. 20** says

20 . . . Naomi also said to her, "The man is a <u>close relative</u> (kinsman) of ours, one of our <u>redeemers</u>."

& so we get our <u>FIRST Mention</u> in the <u>Book of Ruth</u> of the <u>Kinsman-Redeemer</u> - The <u>GOEL</u>

This is the 1st of EIGHT times this word is used in Ruth & it is a critically important word

We'll develop the "Kinsman-Redeemer" as we go on But know this . . . THIS is a Picture of Jesus Christ in OUR lives

It is a <u>Picture</u> of <u>OUR REDEMPTION</u>
Of <u>our</u> being <u>Bought Back</u> (Redeemed) by <u>GRACE</u>

<u>It's a picture</u> of what <u>Jesus Christ</u> has done for <u>YOU</u> if you are <u>saved today</u> - or if you <u>WILL BE</u> saved

<u>Jesus Christ</u> has <u>redeemed</u> you - <u>Fully</u> by His <u>Grace</u> <u>Which</u> is what <u>BOAZ</u> is headed to doing - with <u>RUTH</u>

& <u>THAT</u> is why - <u>suddenly</u> - <u>Naomi's FAITH</u> is <u>Restored</u> <u>because *THIS*</u> was Truly an <u>incredible 1st day</u> back in town

So - Cont'g her conversation with Naomi - we read

Ruth 2:21-23 (esv)

21 And Ruth the Moabite said, "Besides, he said to me, 'You shall keep close by my young men until they have finished all my harvest.'

Naomi's Reading Between the Lines - so she encourages Ruth

22 And Naomi said to Ruth, her daughter-in-law, "It is good, my daughter, that you go out with his young women, lest in another field you be assaulted."

23 So she (Ruth) kept close to the young women of Boaz, gleaning until the end of the barley and wheat harvests. And she lived with her mother-in-law.

What a Story of Love & Redemption - A Story about Boaz & RUTH AND - A story about Jesus Christ & YOU
IF you will RECEIVE His Love & Redemption Today

AND - as Our story unfolds - Each Portion has a LESSON

The Lesson for me today is - the Lesson of Prov 3:5-6
5 Trust in the Lord with all your heart,
and do not lean on your own understanding.
6 In all your ways acknowledge him,
and he will make straight your paths.

Ruth was Trusting in the Lord God of Israel
She was Not Leaning on her own understanding
She was Acknowledging the Lord in her actions . . .
& HE Made Straight Her PATH !! - Right to her REDEEMER !!

& that **SAME God** - Will do the **SAME Thing** - For **you & I IF** we will **follow HIS plan**

So, Let me Ask You today . . .

<u>**Do you** REALLY **Trust the Lord**</u> with <u>**All your heart**?

<u>**Not**</u> casual <u>acknowledgement</u> - <u>**Not**</u> church <u>attendance</u></u>

Have you really put your <u>Full & Complete Trust</u> - in <u>GOD ALONE</u> & <u>is it Real</u> Enough - that <u>people</u> around you, can <u>SEE IT</u>?

Have you STOPPED Doing things YOUR Way?
& Have you begun ACKNOWLEDGING HIM in all you do?

Are you **TRUSTING Him** to **SET YOUR PATH** Before You? & **do you have** the **FAITH** - to **Follow Him** as He **Leads**?

I'd like to call us ALL to A RESPONSE TODAY . . . But Not JUST for TODAY

My Question to you today is - WILL YOU;

<u>Trust God</u> with all your heart - <u>TOMORROW</u>?

<u>Not Lean</u> on our Own Understanding - <u>TOMORROW</u>?

<u>Acknowledge</u> Him in all you do - <u>TOMORROW</u>?

<u>Walk in FAITH</u> that He is "<u>Making Straight</u>" you Path?

Will you **commit with me** to do **THAT**? **Not just** for today - but for **Tomorrow** - & **Every day** after that ?
