We are NOT in Joshua today . . .

Spc141 - Do You Want To Be Made Well? - John 5:1-15

Questions – to **start** today

That <u>THING</u> – that's <u>Gnawing</u> at you – even this <u>Morning</u>
That <u>Deep-Seated</u> – <u>Lingering Issue</u> in your life . . .

The **question Jesus** has for you **today** is **Do You Really Want To Be Made Well?**

Or – has that "<u>Thing</u>" become <u>such a part</u> of your life That <u>you've just</u> learned to "<u>live with it</u>"?

If Jesus were to offer today – to Make You WELL
To HEAL you – in that area of your Life

Would you be READY – To RESPOND
In Complete FAITH?
& in Complete OBEDIENCE?

That's where we're going to today

Let's Pray

In the gospel of John a lot of ministry has occurred before we get to Ch 5

& as we open up Jn 5 today

Jesus is heading BACK to Jerusalem

& we **FIND OUT** as we **continue** to **READ** that Jesus is **headed there** with a very clear **purpose**

Jesus was going to PROVE that he is God in the flesh
Co-Existent God in nature, in power, and in authority

& the text we're looking at today is actually the 'kick off' of that purpose

& so we start in - John 5:1 (NLT)

1 Afterward Jesus returned to Jerusalem for one of the Jewish holy days.

<u>Jesus</u> is <u>going UP</u> to Jerusalem - for <u>One</u> of the <u>Three</u> <u>Jewish</u> Holy Days – All <u>Jewish males</u> are <u>req</u> to attend

WHICH Holy Day is not important to John's context right now

But <u>we know</u> Jesus is <u>going to begin</u> – what is <u>ultimately</u> the <u>FINAL show-down</u> with the <u>Pharisees</u>

In the <u>northeast corner</u> of the <u>Wall</u> Surrounding the <u>Old City</u> of <u>Jerusalem</u> was the <u>Sheep Gate</u> (same area as <u>Lion's Gate</u> today)

This is <u>where the animals</u> for <u>sacrifice</u> were <u>brought</u> in to be <u>prepared to go</u> to the temple.

- & <u>Near this gate</u> was a natural <u>spring pool</u> called the <u>Pool Of Bethesda</u> (or Bethsaida)
- & there were <u>five great porches</u> built around this <u>pool</u> with <u>large steps</u> going down to the <u>water</u>

& <u>the masses</u> of <u>Broken & Needy</u> people would <u>gather</u> at this pool – <u>Because</u> of its '<u>Healing Legend'</u>

The <u>Pool Of Bethesda</u> still <u>exists</u> today
It's <u>one</u> of our <u>favorite</u> stops when we go to Jerusalem
& it is always very powerful

(Dani's Testimony)

& so we read in John 5:2-3 (NLT)

2 Inside the city, near the Sheep Gate, was the pool of Bethesda, with five covered porches.

3 Crowds of sick people—blind, lame, or paralyzed—lay on the porches.

Now - in some of your Bibles

the <u>explanation</u> of <u>the LEGEND</u> is in <u>V.3 & V.4</u>
But the <u>NLT</u> & the <u>ESV</u> put this <u>explanation</u> in a <u>FOOTNOTE</u>

The NLT footnote says: [the crowds of sick people were] waiting for a certain movement of the water, for an angel of the Lord came from time to time and stirred up the water. And the first person to step in after the water was stirred was healed of whatever disease he had.

We don't know if this ever really happened or if it was just a legend

Because Bethesda was a natural spring

so **periodically** the **water** would **bubble up** from **underground**, which **would've looked like** the **legend describes**

<u>Either way</u> - There was a <u>great multitude</u>
of <u>suffering</u> - <u>hurting</u> - & <u>pitiful people</u> here

watching and waiting for their lives to be somehow
magically made better by the "stirring of the water" (the legend)

their <u>hopes reduced</u> to <u>whatever</u> their <u>chance</u> was to <u>knock someone else</u> over - to <u>get</u> to the <u>water first</u>

It was a Microcosm - of a Broken, & Hopeless World

& into this very depressing scene
Steps - The Lord Jesus

& He <u>apparently</u> comes <u>alone</u>, <u>possibly</u> so he <u>can</u> <u>move easily</u> thru the <u>crowd</u> of <u>hurting people</u>

& as **He surveys** this **Depressing Scene** of **Needy People He SEES . . . YOU!**

He picks <u>YOU out</u> of the Crowd & he makes his way thru the masses – to <u>YOU!</u>

<u>BTW</u> - You are being <u>represented</u> today
by a <u>middle-aged</u>, <u>invalid</u> man – <u>STUCK</u> in his <u>illness</u>

John 5:5 (NLT)

5 One of the men lying there had been sick for thirty-eight years.

The ESV says this man is an Invalid

Meaning; in some way – Paralyzed by his illness

The AMPLIFIED Bible says

John 5:5 (AMP)

5 There was a certain man there who had <u>suffered</u> with a <u>deep-seated</u> and <u>lingering disorder</u> for thirty-eight years.

Do you see why this man **MAY represent YOU** today?

Many of US – Have <u>struggled</u> with a <u>deep-seated</u> and <u>lingering disorder</u> – for a <u>very long time</u>

<u>I don't know</u> how <u>long</u> this man had <u>been</u> at the <u>Legend Pool</u>

But we know that he had <u>carried</u> this <u>deep-seated</u> and <u>lingering disorder</u> – for <u>38 years</u>

& <u>after 38 years</u>, our <u>deep seated</u> & <u>lingering disorders</u> tend to <u>kinda</u> become – <u>WHO we are</u>

After an Extended time – our Struggles - & our Difficulties can end up DEFINING who we are

& <u>this man – Paralyzed</u> by his <u>deep-seated & lingering disorder</u> had <u>all</u> but <u>given up</u> - on any <u>real hope</u>

He laid at the "healing pool" – because that is what he did that is who he had become

and Jesus came looking for YOU! - I mean - HIM

Jesus came into the Mass of human suffering

& he came looking - for YOU

And **the question** Jesus **asks** this **helpless** & **hopeless man** is the **same question** He wants to **ask you today**.

John 5:6(a) (NLT)

6 When Jesus saw him and knew he had been ill for a long time . .

ONE of the <u>Definitions</u> for the <u>ROOT Word</u> translated "<u>SAW</u>" - Is: to <u>perceive</u> or <u>discern</u>, to <u>turn the mind</u>, or <u>attention</u> to a thing

Jesus steps into the MASS of humanity

- & he "Perceives" he "Discerns" YOU
- & he **turns** his **full attention** to **YOU**

& then Jesus asks YOU the same question he asks this man

Again - John 5:6 (entire) (NLT)

6 When Jesus <u>saw</u> him and <u>knew</u> he had been ill for a long time, he asked him, "<u>Would you like to get well</u>?"

[ESV: Do you want to be healed?]

[NKJV: Do you want to be made well]

The <u>Grk word</u> for "<u>Well</u>" means <u>To be Healthy - in body or mind</u>

It seems like a strange question, doesn't it?

Can you see this guy saying to Jesus Uhhh, isn't that a little OBVIOUS?

You know - If you see a man stopped on the side of the road with his head under the hood of his car

You <u>really SHOULDN'T</u> <u>ask</u> him if he's <u>having Car Trouble</u>
You <u>SHOULD</u> be able to <u>figure that one out</u>

And <u>I've never walked</u> into a <u>hospital</u> room and <u>asked</u> a person if they <u>want</u> to <u>get well</u>

because it **seems** to be a **pretty good assumption**

But Jesus doesn't work on assumptions.

He is looking at the Deepest Places of our Heart's

And <u>here</u>, in <u>verse 6</u>, Jesus asks <u>YOU</u> the Most Important Question

"DO YOU WANT TO GET WELL? ... & DO YOU WANT TO GET WELL, <u>TODAY</u>?"

This QUESTION - - & our Honest RESPONSE to it

May be behind more of our "Paralysis in Life"

than we might be willing to admit.

Remember, this invalid man
Who represents you and me . . .

After so long - he's actually grown accustomed to his deep-seated and lingering disorder (amp)

I doubt he even tries to be first to the water any more

- So <u>Jesus SEES</u> He <u>Perceives</u>, He <u>Discerns</u> <u>US</u> & <u>He turns</u> his full <u>attention</u> to <u>US</u>
- & then he asks us Do You WANT to be made well?
- & IF, in the <u>deepest place</u> in our <u>heart</u>, he <u>SEES</u>
 That <u>we are actually</u> saying "<u>Uh, no, not really</u>"

then <u>He will leave us</u> in the <u>same condition</u> He <u>found us</u>
<u>He will not force</u> His <u>healing on us</u>

Is it possible to **say** on the **outside** that we **want to be made well**, **but** on the **inside** for **us to be** (in some way) →

kinda nursing and protecting that <u>lingering disorder</u> - that is paralyzing us.

Do you **think Jesus** is **asking** this man for a **casual**, **superficial response**? -- **NO!**

Jesus is looking for a brutally honest response from the deepest part of this man's heart, & that is a place that only Jesus can SEE into

<u>Sometimes</u> – Our "<u>Surface" Response</u> - to this <u>question</u> "<u>Uncovers</u>" our "<u>True" Response</u>

What if this man would've responded with Anger & Defensiveness?

"What are You talking about? I'm here, aren't I
I'm doing what I can! What do you want from me?"

Then Jesus would say "I want TRUTH, from the deepest place of your heart" - I want truth at that level.

"Do you REALLY want to be Made WELL?

Or are you (for some reason) Protecting your "Lingering Disorder" or the sin that is paralyzing your life

The FIRST STEP to Jesus Making you well

is an honest answer - at the <u>deepest level</u> of our hearts to the <u>question</u> from Jesus "Do you (really) want to be made well?"

The <u>SECOND STEP</u> is an <u>honest recognition</u> of our own INABILITY to <u>Make OURSELVES</u> Well.

John 5:7 (NLT)

7 "I can't, sir," (I can't do it, I can't make myself well) the sick man said, "for I have no one to put me into the pool when the water bubbles up. Someone else always gets there ahead of me."

Now – <u>Jesus Doesn't Respond</u> to this statement -But <u>He SEES</u> the <u>TRUTH</u> in this <u>man's heart</u>

& I believe he sees <u>TWO key ingredients</u> in this man For <u>our HEALING</u> - & <u>our NEW LIFE</u> in Christ

He sees SURRENDER - & He sees BROKENNESS

This man truly <u>DID want</u> to be <u>healed</u>, & he <u>truly recognized</u> <u>His Inability</u> to make <u>HIMSELF</u> <u>well</u>

It may have taken him 38 years

But he <u>finally accepted</u> the fact <u>that he</u> could <u>NEVER</u> make <u>himself well</u> – <u>on his own</u>

Maybe you've reached STEP ONE, where you've truly and honestly said, "I really do want to be made well"

But then you've made the monstrous mistake of saying

"<u>I'm</u> going to <u>REALLY</u> start <u>working</u> on it." "<u>I'm</u> going to <u>really</u> try hard."

Sometimes we really do want to be made well but we want to do it our way

The **Problem is** - this is **not Burger King**

& the **King of Kings** is **NOT** that **awkward** little "**Burger King**" who **lets you** have it '**your way**."

The reason you can't have it your way is because your way doesn't work

& **that** is what this **Invalid man** finally **realized** & **Jesus** - **SAW** his **heart**

This Man realized the utter hopelessness of his condition,

He was <u>Truly Ready</u> to be <u>Made Well</u>

& He **realized** he **could NEVER** do it **on his own**

STEP 1 – Honestly want to be made well;

STEP 2 – Honestly believe you cannot do it your way

<u>STEP 3</u> – <u>Exercise Total FAITH and Total OBEDIENCE</u>

As far as the Bible is concerned there is no other way to Victory

In <u>verses 8-9</u>, <u>Jesus</u> gives this man <u>opportunity</u> to exercise <u>STEP THREE</u>. – <u>Faith</u> & <u>Obedience</u>

John 5:8 (NLT)

8 Jesus told him, "Stand up, pick up your mat, and walk!"

It's a <u>Simple Command</u> from <u>Jesus</u>

But it takes a <u>FULL MEASURE</u> of <u>two things</u> from <u>the man</u>

It takes *FULL FAITH* - & it takes *FULL OBEDIENCE*

This man really <u>DID want</u> to be <u>made well</u> and he <u>really KNEW</u> he <u>could not do it</u> his <u>own way</u>

& there was something different about this Teacher who had just SEEN him (personally) in the crowd

So he put his FULL FAITH in Jesus (tho he didn't yet know his name) & he put his FULL OBEDIENCE in the Command

And (Istn Pls) the instant this man Fully Believed,
Jesus gave him the Power to Fully Believe

And the instant he Fully Obeyed,

Jesus gave him the power to Fully Obey

And as he <u>Began To Stand</u> - <u>BY FAITH</u>, <u>suddenly</u> he had the <u>Power To Stand</u>

& <u>after 38 years</u>, in <u>an instant</u>, this <u>man</u> was <u>made whole</u>, and <u>he found</u> himself <u>standing on his feet</u>

So - John 5:9(a) (NLT)

9 Instantly, the man was healed! He rolled up his sleeping mat and began walking! . . .

After 38 years of pitiful 'wishful-thinking' at the "legend pool,"

This man <u>jumped up</u>, <u>grabbed</u> his <u>cot</u>, and <u>went</u> <u>walking</u> and <u>leaping</u> and <u>praising God</u>, just as <u>Jesus</u> told him to

Unfortunately, WHILE he was

walking & leaping & praising God - with his cot, he ran into the religious leaders - just as Jesus knew he would

So - John 5:9(b)-13 (NLT)

9... But this miracle happened on the Sabbath,

10 so the Jewish leaders objected. They said to the man who was cured, "You can't work on the Sabbath! The law doesn't allow you to carry that sleeping mat!" (never mind he had been healed)

11 But he replied, "The man who <u>healed</u> me told me, 'Pick up your mat and walk.' "

12 "Who said such a thing as that?" they demanded.

(still no response to the healing) \rightarrow \rightarrow

13 The man didn't know, for Jesus had disappeared into the crowd.

<u>Immediately</u> – this <u>man's healing</u> was <u>Ignored</u> - & it was <u>Challenged</u>
& he was <u>given reason</u> to <u>fall away</u> & <u>be discouraged</u>

Suddenly he had to HOLD on to his Faith & CONTINUE his Obedience
In the face of difficulty & persecution

Remember at the <u>beginning</u> I said <u>Jesus</u> Had <u>a PURPOSE</u> for going to <u>Jerusalem</u>?

Well - THIS is IT

<u>Jesus Healed</u> this <u>Man</u> in order <u>to USE him</u> <u>He</u> was <u>Healed</u> to be an <u>Instrument of God</u>

& what this man & this healing
BEGINS here with the Pharisees
ENDS with Jesus on the Cross

& <u>you heard</u> in <u>Danielle's Testimony</u>
from the Lord speaking to her on this same exact spot

Dani said "He healed me for a purpose, and made me new"

Not <u>JUST Made Well</u>

Made Well for the <u>Glory of God</u>

& Then we finish - with a bit of a Scary Note

John 5:14 (NLT)

14 But afterward Jesus found him in the Temple and told him, "Now you are well; so stop sinning, or something even worse may happen to you."

I don't know if this man's infirmity had something to do with his sin

but I do know a warning when I hear one & this is a warning

Jesus Tracks **this man** down – **In** the **Temple**

& <u>Jesus says</u> to him, "Now you are WELL - You've been delivered. You've been healed. Do not go back to the sin from which you were saved,"

There are Numerous Warnings in the N.T.
About NOT returning to our sin once we've been healed

If you want to check a Scary One - Chk 2 Pet 2:20-22

It seems clear to me - that Jesus is Saying here

The FAITH - & OBEDIENCE that MADE you Well
You Must Continue to WALK IN

OR You will easily FALL BACK into whatever Paralysis - Jesus Healed you from The <u>Pool of Bethesda</u> represents <u>our</u> <u>feeble</u> and <u>hopeless attempt</u> at <u>making ourselves</u> well

We say, "I'm going to get there, I'm going to fix this and then everything's going to be OK"

NO IT'S NOT! You're going to remain spiritually paralyzed - until the day you:

- 1) Stop protecting your sin, and truly want to get well
- 2) Recognize that you can't make yourself well
- 3) Exercise Total FAITH and Total OBEDIENCE in Jesus Christ alone

Which must be done with a Continual Commitment

To - Moment-BY-Moment - Be Walking in the Spirit

& - Moment-by-Moment - Be Crucifying the Flesh

THEN you will find yourself WELL

& you will go walking and leaping and praising God!

Let's Pray
