## Mrk58 – What Will Jesus Cost Me? – Mark 15:1-15

The <u>Last Suppe</u>r Was <u>followed</u> by the <u>Prayer of Agony</u> in <u>Gethsemane</u> <u>Then</u>, the <u>Betrayal</u>, & the <u>Arrest</u> <u>Then</u>, the <u>1<sup>st</sup> Mock Trial</u>, and the <u>1<sup>st</sup> Round of Abuse</u> <u>Then</u>, the <u>Denial of Peter</u>, <u>AS</u> Jesus was <u>being drug</u> back thru the courtyard

It has been a long, dark night

& <u>now</u> – <u>Jesus</u> is <u>bound</u> like a <u>Prisoner</u>,
 & <u>being</u> taken to <u>PILATE</u>, the <u>Roman Governor</u>

& in **PILATE** – we **MAY see a Picture** – of **OURSELVES** 

As PILATE asks the question What Will Jesus Cost Me?

## Let's Pray

The <u>Death</u> of <u>Jesus</u> – <u>was</u> the <u>Goal</u> of the <u>Religious Leaders</u> <u>AND</u> – it was the <u>Plan</u> of <u>God</u> – for <u>OUR Salvation</u>

& Jesus is steadily moving - toward THAT Moment

### <u>Mark 15:1 (NLT)</u>

1 Very early in the morning the leading priests, the elders, and the teachers of religious law—the entire high council—met to discuss their next step. They bound Jesus, led him away, and took him to Pilate, the Roman governor.

The <u>Jews</u> were <u>not allowed</u> to <u>Execute</u> people <u>Only Rome</u> could <u>do</u> that <u>job</u>

& so the <u>Religious leaders</u> <u>took</u> Jesus to <u>PILATE</u>, the <u>Roman Governor</u>

with a plan to have PILATE do their "Dirty Work" for them

& the only charge they could go with was TREASON

which would be Jesus saying
 HE was King – & NOT Caesar

So <u>Jesus</u> is <u>Now</u> – in <u>Front</u> of <u>PILATE</u>

## <u>Mark 15:2-5 (NLT)</u>

2 Pilate asked Jesus, "Are you the king of the Jews?" Jesus replied, "You have said it." (emphasis on You)
3 Then the leading priests kept accusing him of many crimes,
4 and Pilate asked him, "Aren't you going to answer them? What about all these charges they are bringing against you?"
5 But Jesus said nothing, much to Pilate's surprise.

The Gospel of JOHN tells us right here

That **<u>PILATE</u>** took **<u>Jesus inside</u>** – and **<u>Questioned him</u>** 

& Clearly Determined

that **Jesus** was **NOT GUILTY** of **Any Crime** 

### BUT - PILATE saw himself in a *Difficult Predicament*

### PILATE Knew the **RIGHT Decision** to **MAKE**

<u>BUT</u> – With the ANGRY Religious Leaders & the ANGRY People in front of him

PILATE was afraid of WHAT the RIGHT DECISION - WOULD COST HIM

So – <u>PILATE</u> decides to <u>TRY</u> to <u>AVOID</u> making <u>ANY DECISION</u> about Jesus – <u>AT ALL</u>

& He <u>comes up</u> with an <u>IDEA</u> that <u>would FIT</u> in <u>the Culture</u> of the <u>time</u>

AND an Idea that would Allow PILATE to NOT have to TAKE A STAND - for Jesus

# <u> Mark 15:6-7 (NLT)</u>

6 Now it was the governor's custom each year during the Passover celebration to release one prisoner—anyone the people requested.

7 One of the prisoners at that time was Barabbas, a revolutionary who had committed murder in an uprising.

& <u>here MATTHEW</u> <u>tells</u> us that <u>even</u> the <u>WIFE of PILATE</u> <u>warned</u> him

to **NOT condemn** Jesus – **because** of a **Dream** She had

& so <u>Pilate</u> was <u>going</u> to <u>TRY</u> to <u>Use the People</u> - to <u>Make the Decision</u>

So that <u>HE</u> - would <u>NOT HAVE TO</u> make a <u>PERSONAL DECISION</u> - about <u>Jesus</u>

## <u>& so - Mark 15:8 says (NLT)</u>

8 The crowd went to Pilate and asked him to release a prisoner as usual.

& Pilate thought - here's his chance

maybe the people LIKE Jesus
& it's just the leaders that want him dead

& so **Pilate says** to the **people** 

## In Mark 15:9-10 (NLT)

9 "Would you like me to release to you this 'King of the Jews'?" Pilate asked.

10 (For he realized by now that the leading priests had arrested Jesus out of envy.)

#### PILATE IS HOPING

the **people** would **make** his **decision** - **FOR HIM** 

#### HE'S HOPING

he wouldn't have to make - A PERSONAL DECISION

#### **HE'S HOPING**

he could get out of this situation w/o it COSTING him anything

PILATE KNOWS what Decision He SHOULD MAKE

*BUT* . . . what is it going to COST HIM if he makes that Decision – *FOR Jesus?* 

How is his life going to be impacted? What is he going to LOSE?

Pilate is weighing the COST

& he's **trying desperately** to **GET OUT** of having to **make** a **PERSONAL DECISION** about **Jesus** 

<u>Maybe YOU know</u> someone <u>who</u> is <u>trying</u> to "<u>Get Out</u>" of <u>having</u> to <u>make</u> a <u>Personal Decision</u> about <u>Jesus</u>

<u>They don't</u> really <u>want</u> to <u>offend you</u> <u>BUT</u> - they <u>don't want</u> to <u>make</u> a <u>Personal Decision</u> either

They tend to make - general - generic comments

Like "I don't have a problem with Jesus"

Or "I'm a Catholic – My whole family – we're ALL Catholics – so we're good"

in MAT Ch 16 - Jesus took his disciples to Caesarea Philippi

the <u>place</u> where <u>dozens</u> of <u>Different gods</u> were <u>all worshipped</u> in the <u>same place</u>

## <u>& In that place – in Matthew 16:13–14 we read (NLT)</u>

13 . . . [Jesus] asked his disciples, "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?"

14 "Well," they replied, "some say John the Baptist, some say Elijah, and others say Jeremiah or one of the other prophets."

That's how some people talk about Jesus He was Good man, Good teacher, He wrote a Good book

But – <u>when</u> the <u>Disciples of Jesus</u> started <u>that kind of talk</u> <u>Jesus</u> would have <u>NONE OF IT</u>

## Matthew 16:15 (NLT)

15 Then [Jesus] asked them (pointedly, directly), "But who do you say I am?"

Guys - the Bible is VERY CLEAR on this Matter

### YOUR ETERNAL SALVATION Is <u>NOT based</u> on your <u>good works</u>

It's NOT leading a 'pretty good life'

It's **NOT** *what church* you **belong** to

OR what church you got baptized in - (NONE of that is in the Bible)

In the Deepest Place of FAITH & TRUST in your life

Jesus wants to know the answer to this ONE QUESTION

"Who do <u>you</u> say He is?"

### in MAT 16 – Peter answered for the Disciples

& I **would encourage** you to **consider whether** this is **YOUR PERSONAL ANSWER** 

## Matthew 16:16 (NLT)

16 Simon Peter answered, "You are the Messiah (Savior), the Son of the living God."

I <u>pray</u> that <u>IS</u> – or <u>WILL BE</u> – <u>Your Personal Answer</u> – <u>Your Personal Commitment</u>

"Jesus, You are the Messiah (Savior), the Son of the living God."

#### PILATE is NO WHERE NEAR That answer

<u>PILATE</u> is just <u>trying</u> to <u>AVOID</u> <u>having</u> to <u>make</u> a <u>Personal Decision</u> about Jesus <u>AT ALL</u>

He's just trying to make this whole conversation go away - (like some of US have)

### So BACK in MARK 15:9

<u>Pilate</u> offers to <u>Release JESUS</u> - <u>According</u> to the <u>custom</u> -<u>Hoping</u> the <u>CROWD</u> would <u>CHOOSE Jesus</u>

## Mark 15:11 (NLT)

11 But at this point the leading priests stirred up the crowd to demand the release of Barabbas instead of Jesus.

#### This is NOT going like Pilate wanted

<u>Pilate's</u> trying to <u>Get OUT</u> of this situation <u>Without</u> having to make a <u>PUBLIC STAND</u> for Jesus

#### **PILATE is trying**

to <u>kinda</u> make a <u>Subtle Gesture</u> <u>FOR Jesus</u> <u>Without</u> having to <u>actually</u> <u>TAKE A STAND</u> for <u>Jesus</u>?

Can't I just say some "General Good Things" ABOUT Jesus

without actually having to make a Personal Decision for him? – (isn't that enough)

Because . . . <u>If I DO</u> make a <u>Clear Decision</u> for Jesus <u>what</u> will that <u>cost</u> me?

Will it cost me my Lifestyle?

Will it cost me my Friends?

Will I be labeled as a "<u>Christian</u>"

& maybe soon an "Enemy of the State"

Will I be Ostracized at School?

Will I be Un-Friended on Social Media?

<u>What</u> will it <u>COST</u> me to <u>take</u> a Stand <u>FOR</u> Jesus?

### THOSE are the KIND of Questions - PILATE is asking Himself

BUT – He's <u>NOT GETTING</u> the <u>Easy Way Out</u> - he was <u>hoping</u> for

& so – **<u>Pilate</u> throws** the "<u>*Hail Mary Pass*"</u>

One final attempt to get ALL THIS to GO AWAY

## Mark 15:12 (NLT)

12 Pilate asked them, "Then what should I do with this man you call the king of the Jews?"

#### One Last Attempt -

He's just throwing it out there - & hoping for the best

BUT - It Doesn't Work

### Mark 15:13-14 (NLT)

13 They shouted back, "<u>Crucify him</u>!" 14 "<u>Why</u>?" Pilate demanded. "What crime has he committed?" But the mob roared even louder, "<u>Crucify him</u>!"

& **PILATE** is **thinking** 

<u>I know</u> Jesus is <u>innocent</u> <u>I know</u> what <u>decision</u> I should make

But <u>how</u> will the <u>people</u> respond? <u>What</u> will <u>my life</u> look like - <u>IF I CHOOSE JESUS</u>? <u>WHAT WILL IT COST ME ?</u> <u>If I Choose</u> Jesus <u>OVER the World ?</u> <u>If I Choose</u> Jesus <u>OVER</u> what <u>people</u> will <u>think of me?</u>

WHAT will I LOSE – if I CHOOSE Jesus?

#### WAIT A MINUTE – Wait a Minute

What will you LOSE - if you CHOOSE Jesus?

- You'll LOSE the POWER that SIN has over your life
- You'll LOSE the HOPELESSNESS that's come from chasing the things of this world
- You'll LOSE an Eternity Separated from God in Heaven

<u>What</u> do you <u>mean</u> What will I LOSE – if I CHOOSE Jesus?

### Are you SURE that's the RIGHT Question?

- Is <u>there a chance</u> that you are <u>focusing</u> on the <u>TEMPORAL</u>, <u>FLEETING</u> things of <u>this world</u>?
- Is **there** a **chance** that **you may** be **MORE CONCERNED about** a **life** that **May End Tonight**

than you are about a life
that God Promises will Last For Eternity?

#### What will Jesus COST ME?

The **right question** is

### What will it COST YOU - if you TURN your BACK on Jesus?

Ultimately - THAT'S what Pilate did

## Mark 15:15 (NLT)

15 So <u>to pacify the crowd</u>, Pilate released Barabbas to them. He ordered Jesus flogged with a lead-tipped whip, then turned him over to the Roman soldiers <u>to be crucified</u>.

To pacify the crowd - - To Pacify the Crowd??

You turned your back on Jesus in order to "Pacify the Crowd"

Have you ever turned your back on Jesus in order to "Pacify the Crowd"?

Have you chosen the "Barabbas" of this World

& turned your back - on the Only One

who can WASH your SIN AWAY & Give you ETERNAL LIFE? THAT is what Pilate is doing

#### BECAUSE he is AFRAID of what CHOOSING Jesus might COST HIM

#### PILATE turned his back on Jesus to try to save his own life

- & instead he LOST BOTH THIS Life - AND - His ETERNAL Life
- <u>Historians say</u> the <u>years following</u> <u>for Pilate</u> were <u>filled</u> with <u>continual</u> <u>CONFLICT</u> & <u>UPHEAVAL</u>
- & <u>within</u> just a <u>few years</u> <u>Pilate</u> was <u>called</u> to <u>ROME</u> to <u>answer</u> for the <u>Chaos in his life</u>
- & **knowing** what was **waiting** for him **there Instead** of **Facing Rome** - *Pilate took his own life*

ALL For WHAT? To <u>PACIFY the Crowd?</u> To <u>APPEASE the World?</u> To <u>Try</u> to <u>MAINTAIN the Life</u> he Built for himself?

### Jesus said – in Luke 9:23–26 (NLT) $\rightarrow \rightarrow$

Luke 9:23–26 (NLT)

23 . . . "If any of you wants to be my follower, <u>you must give up</u> <u>your own way</u>, take up your cross daily, and follow me. 24 If you try to hang on to your life, you will lose it. But if you give

up your life for my sake, <u>you will save it</u>.

25 And what do you benefit if you gain the whole world but are yourself lost or destroyed?

26 (& then, the hammer) *If anyone is ashamed of me and my message, the Son of Man will be ashamed of that person when he returns in his glory and in the glory of the Father and the holy angels.* 

Those are words that PILATE needed to hear - that day

Maybe those are words that WE need to hear - today

<u>1Tim 2:4</u> says God wants ALL people to be Saved

<u>1 John 2:2</u> says

Jesus died to atone for the sins of the World

<u>2 Cor 5:19</u> says

God was, in Christ, reconciling the World to Himself

& <u>Yet</u> – we can <u>STILL CHOOSE</u> To <u>Turn</u> our <u>Backs</u> on <u>Jesus</u>

<u>We</u> can <u>STILL CHOOSE</u> <u>This World</u> - <u>Over Jesus</u> We **CAN CHOOSE** to be **ASHAMED of Him** 

& <u>We</u> can <u>REFUSE</u> to <u>STAND UP for him</u>

But - IF we do - Jesus says

He will be <u>ASHAMED of US</u> When He <u>RETURNS in His Glory</u>

& at **that moment** – **we** will **not think** for **ONE Second about** what it **COST US** - to **STAND UP for Jesus** 

Instead we will KNOW

BECAUSE we STOOD UP for Jesus - HERE

JESUS will STAND UP for <u>us</u> – <u>In ETERNITY</u>

Will You take that Stand for Jesus today?

Will You make that Personal Decision for Jesus today?
