1Jn 13 - Love is Perfected in Disciples - 1Jn 4:13-21

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Another Msg on LOVE ?? Are you kidding ?? How important is this subject to God anyway ?

Here are the Msg's we've already had on Love:

Disciples Genuinely Love - 1Jn 2

Disciples Pick One To Love - 1Jn 2

Disciples Love One Another - 1Jn 3

Disciples Love Because God Is Love - 1Jn 4

- & Now Love is Perfected in Disciples
- & we're <u>not done</u> cause we're going to <u>revisit</u> the subject of love - *next message*

AGAPE - the GK word for God's Love

- & in its Noun & Verb forms it occurs <u>32 times</u> in this section (last wk, this wk, nxt wk) & almost <u>300 times</u> in the NT
- & so I thought Maybe I'd try to remind us WHAT this Agape Love of God LOOKS LIKE (as we get started)

There are so many ways to describe & illustrate God's Agape Love

But I just wanted to get the <u>General Picture</u>
Of <u>Agape Love</u> in our minds again – as we begin

Here is my favorite description - of God's Agape Love;

Sacrificing <u>Self</u>
For the Benefit of <u>Another</u>
To the Glory of <u>God</u>

Really – that is the example <u>Jesus</u> set for us

He willingly became a Sacrifice
For Our Benefit
To the Glory of God

So - When we are Living in God's Love - It means;

We are <u>setting aside</u> our SELF interest, & our SELF focus
We are <u>doing what's best</u> for another person
We are doing it to the Glory of God

The Bible says SOOO MUCH about what God's Love looks like But that definition – is one of my favorites

If you still <u>want to study</u> – <u>What</u> God's Love <u>Looks Like</u> maybe the best place to start - is in <u>1Cor Ch 13</u>

Now – Let's talk about **The TITLE**

Love is Perfected in Disciples

First - The Word Perfected
Suggests *an ONGOING FULFILLMENT*

So **THAT'S Good News** – Right ??

& Literally – the word means :

Brought to Maturity, or to Completion, or

Brought to a Planned Goal !!!

& THAT is what God wants to do In Every Disciple's Life

He wants to **BRINGS US** to His "Planned Goal"

Of *His Love* being *PERFECTED* in us -

Being brought to <u>Maturity</u> – Even <u>Completion</u> <u>In</u> our Lives

Isn't that Incredible – that THAT is what God wants to do
with His Love – in our Lives ?

& not only – are we going to see HOW God's Love is PERFECTED in our Lives . . .

But we're going to see another wonderful Benefit Of that occurring in us - & to us

Let's Pray

We have to **go back** to **V.12** to start today Because it **introduces** the next section

1Jn 4:12 - ESV

12 No one has ever seen God; (But) if we love one another, God abides in us and his love is perfected in us.

Again - that term <u>perfected in us</u> MEANS; progressive brought to maturity, completion So it means - IF we are Loving One Another . . .

Then <u>GOD</u> is <u>abiding</u> in us & <u>HIS LOVE</u> is being <u>brought to maturity</u> <u>in us</u>

Now – we <u>start</u> today With <u>John</u> telling us

HOW we **KNOW**

that WE Abide in God - & GOD Abides in Us

1Jn 4:13 - ESV

13 By this (what's coming up) we know that we abide in him and he in us, because he has given us of his Spirit

The little word "OF" - denotes origin - the source of something

What it means is

We know that we live in Him & He lives in us

BECAUSE we see **FRUIT** in our lives that <u>can only come</u> **FROM** the Holy Spirit – <u>as its Source</u>

ROM 5:5

So when we **see that fruit** – of the *Love of God*That can **ONLY** Grow from **God Abiding in us**

Then we **KNOW** that HE IS **ABIDING** in us & **We** ARE **ABIDING** in Him

The Loose Paraphrase – The Message – puts it like this

1Jn 4:13 The Message $\rightarrow \rightarrow$

1Jn 4:13 The Message

13 This is how we know we're living steadily and deeply in him, and he in us: He's given us <u>life from his life</u>, from his very own Spirit

& the **RESULT** of His Life - - **REPLACING** Our Life is

The fruit of <u>HIS LOVE</u> - will begin to <u>GROW</u> out of <u>His Life</u> in us . . . *AMEN* ??

John is talking about **God's Love**Being **Evidence** or **PROOF**

of **Us** Abiding in **God** – and - **God** Abiding in **us**

But in **Vs's 14-15** – He wants to remind us

that it's <u>not LOVE ALONE</u> that <u>assures us</u> that God is <u>Abiding</u> in us

But it's also our **CONFESSION** - of Who Jesus Christ is

1Jn 4:14-15 - ESV

14 And (NLT - Furthermore) we have seen and testify that the Father has sent his Son to be the Savior of the world.
15 Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God, God abides in him, and he in God.

These Vs's remind us – that we cannot say

Everyone who is loving – is from God

So John TIES together (as evidence) - BOTH

- 1) The FRUIT of God's Love in our lives AND
- 2) The <u>CONFESSION</u> that <u>Jesus</u> is the <u>Son of God</u> & <u>Savior of the World</u>

So there is **no conflict** between God's **LOVE** - & God's **TRUTH**

We talked <u>last week</u> – about those who say "If God is a Loving God then He would only do this & this, etc"

But – <u>Contrary</u> to man's opinion God is <u>BOTH</u> Perfect <u>LOVE</u> – and – Perfect <u>TRUTH</u>

& so - God <u>LOVE</u> - & God's <u>TRUTH</u> about Jesus Christ <u>MUST</u> Go together

BECAUSE – They **BOTH** come from **God's Life Abiding in us**

Now – John <u>goes back</u>
To the <u>Assurance</u> of God's Love (& a very encouraging vs)

<u>1Jn 4:16 - ESV</u>

16 So (because of these things) we have come to know and to believe the love that God has for us. God is love, and whoever abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him.

The word "ABIDE" means <u>WAY MORE</u> than "To develop a <u>compartment</u> – a <u>part</u> – a <u>portion</u> of your life"

The Word ABIDE its **Best Illustrated** by Jesus Himself – in **Jn Ch 15**

What does it <u>MEAN</u> – that we <u>ABIDE</u> in Love <u>BY</u> - Abiding in God – and – He in Us ??

I <u>could</u> give you the <u>Technical Definition</u>
But Jesus used an <u>Illustration</u> – so let me do that

Jn 15:4-5 – ESV

4 <u>Abide</u> in me, and I (abide) in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it <u>abides</u> in the vine, neither can you, unless you <u>abide</u> in me.

5 I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever <u>abides</u> in me and I (<u>abide</u>) in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing.

<u>SIX TIMES</u> in Two Vs's - Jesus says (or implies) – The concept of <u>ABIDING</u>

& **the PICTURE** of the branch **ABIDING** in the Vine Is a **Perfect** Picture - & a **Familiar** One

& it's <u>VERY IMPORTANT</u> that we <u>see this picture</u>
As we <u>move</u> to our <u>KEY Vs's</u> today

So - Here's what 1John has been telling us;

When - We are Abiding in Him

Then - His Life PRODUCES the fruit of His Love in our lives

Do you See it ??

OK - Now - <u>FINALLY</u> - We're ready to see <u>HOW</u> God's Love - Is <u>PERFECTED</u> - <u>MATURED</u> - in our lives

We have to start w/ the 2nd half of V.16 & just the 1st half of V.17

1Jn 4:16(B)-17(A) - ESV

16 . . . God is love, and whoever <u>abides</u> in love <u>abides</u> in God, and God <u>abides</u> in him.

17 By this is love perfected with us, . . .

Remember – the word <u>Perfected</u> means; *Mature, Completed, Brought to the Planned Goal*

So - **HOW** is God's Love **PERFECTED** (Completed) *in our Lives* ??

By <u>Us</u> <u>Abiding in God</u> & <u>God</u> <u>Abiding in Us</u> - - <u>RIGHT ??</u>

Which "Looks Like" - How Jesus illustrated it in Jn Ch 15

As the **Branch** Can **ONLY** Produce Fruit
As it is **Permanently Connected** to the Vine

In the <u>SAME MANNER</u> – that is the <u>only way</u> we can see - <u>the Fruit</u> of the <u>Love of God</u> – <u>Produced</u> in our lives

As we remain **Permanently Attached** to the Vine

With the <u>Life</u> of the Vine – <u>Constantly Flowing</u> thru our lives to <u>Produce</u> the <u>Fruit</u> of God's Love

THAT is how God's Love – is **PERFECTED** in our lives

But what else do we see here ??

WHAT else does V.17 say is <u>Accomplished</u>
BY God's Love being Perfected in US ??

Let's read all of 1Jn 4:17 - ESV

17 By this (abiding in God) is love perfected (mature, complete) with us, so that we may have confidence for the day of judgment, because as he is so also are we in this world.

By Abiding in God & He is us – His Love is **PERFECTED** (brought to maturity, full expression)

SO THAT – The result of which is –
That **we** may **have confidence** for the <u>Day of Judgment</u>

As we **Abide in God** – His Love is **PERFECTED** in us

& one of the <u>great rewards</u> of that is That we will have <u>CONFIDENCE</u> on the <u>Day of Judgment</u>??

WHY??

Because we've Earned something- NO!!

Because His Love perfected in us – is the ASSURANCE that we are **Living** - in the **Righteousness** of Jesus Christ

If **God's Love** is Growing **toward Maturity** in your life

Then **YOU CAN KNOW**

That <u>AS HE IS</u> - - <u>SO also ARE WE</u> - - in this World (end of V.17)

That can be a tuff sentence - - But it's referring back to

The <u>SIGN</u> (Mark) of God's Love in us <u>BEING OUR ASSURANCE</u>

That we are **IN CHRIST**

& so we presently **HAVE** His Righteousness "Positionally"

Eph 2:4-6 - NLT

4 But God is so rich in mercy, and he loved us so much, 5 that even though we were dead because of our sins, he gave us

life when he raised Christ from the dead. (It is only by God's grace that you have been saved!)

6 For he raised us from the dead along with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ

Jesus.

THAT is what John is **saying** at the End of **V.17**

<u>As</u> Jesus Christ <u>IS</u> (Raised & Seated with God)
So Are <u>WE</u> – because we are <u>UNITED</u> with Him (One with Him)

& the **EVIDENCE** of that – Is us **SEEING** God's Love Perfected in us

The **Evidence** is **not** because we <u>say so</u> – or <u>demand</u> so

The **Evidence** is that we see the **FRUIT** of the *Life of God* Growing, Maturing, **BEING PERFECTED** – in our lives

Here's how <u>John Bunyan</u> put it in **Grace Abounding to the Chief of Sinners** (without olde english)

Quote → →

John Bunyan

"Sinner, you think that because of your sins and infirmities I cannot save your soul, but behold my Son is by me, and upon Him I look, and not on you, and I will deal with you according as I am pleased with Him."

& to THAT – we can say Praise God!!

& 1John is saying - <u>As we see</u> more & more of the Love of God <u>PERFECTED</u> in our lives

We can have <u>absolute confidence</u> about that day when we will <u>meet Him</u> face to face

& so - we have **NO NEED** to **FEAR** that day We can have Complete **Confidence**

WHY no fear? Because <u>as</u> the Love of God <u>Matures</u> in us it <u>CASTS OUT</u> all fear

look at the **next vs**.

<u>1Jn 4:18 - ESV</u>

18 There is no fear in love, but perfect (mature) love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not been perfected (brought to maturity) in love.

As the Love of God is <u>Perfected</u> (Matured) in us By us <u>Abiding</u> in Him & He <u>Abiding</u> in us . . .

As we allow this to happen in our lives this Mature (perfected) Love - Casts Out ALL FEAR

The NLT writes the beginning of V.18 this way

18 Such love has no fear, because perfect (mature) love expels all fear.

This **FEAR** that is being **cast out** by God's Love in us This is **not Fear** as in *Reverence* or *Awe*

This is **Fear of punishment**, it refers to <u>dread</u>, or <u>terror</u>

& God doesn't want you (His child) to have this kind of fear

If you are <u>Abiding</u> in Him - & He is <u>Abiding</u> in you
He wants you to have <u>Peace</u> & <u>Confidence</u> – That EXPELS fear

HE wants us to <u>come</u> to Him as our <u>ABBA</u> Father <u>Knowing</u> we've been adopted (<u>Rom 8:16</u>)

He wants us to come **Boldly** to His **Throne of Grace**To receive exactly what you need (**Heb 4:16**)

& if you will <u>ABIDE</u> in Him more & more then **His Love** will be more & more "**Perfected**" in you

& when you <u>see</u> His Love <u>Growing</u>, <u>Maturing</u>, Being <u>Perfected</u> in you

The more & more **confident**you can be – for that day when you **face Him**

But again – Remember
We **DO NOT** Love in order to **EARN** Something with God

WHY DO WE LOVE ??

Let's look at the Next Vs - -

<u>1Jn 4:19 - ESV</u>

19 We love because he first loved us.

We Love <u>in RESPONSE</u> – <u>NOT</u> to <u>Earn</u> – <u>Not</u> to <u>Deserve</u> But - In Response

We love because he first loved us.

We love – because Love is **the Fruit** that **His life** produces in us

Because **GOD IS LOVE** - & He ABIDES in us **THAT** is why we love !!

& That is <u>why</u> – the <u>TEST</u> of whether God's Love <u>SHOWING</u> in our Lives

is such a Clear & Absolute Test

1Jn 4:20 - ESV

20 If anyone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen cannot love God whom he has not seen.

The <u>final test</u> in this section is the test of <u>Religious Hypocrisy</u>

If we are <u>claiming</u> to <u>Love</u> God while <u>holding</u> <u>hate</u> (extreme hostility) <u>toward</u> a fellow Christian

then the Bible has a <u>Title</u> for us – We are a <u>LIAR</u>

A more <u>polite word</u> would be - <u>Hypocrite</u>, right?

We've **seen it** over & over again in **1John**

<u>If</u> we Truly Love God
We <u>MUST</u> Love One Another

Why is this such an absolute truth ??

Because in **Jn 14:15** - Jesus said

If you love me, you will keep my commandments.

And **then** – Look at our **last Verse** today

1Jn 4:21 - ESV

21 And this commandment we have from him: whoever loves God must also love his brother.

So – for us to CLAIM to <u>Love God</u>
But to hold on to <u>Extreme Hostility</u> toward another Christian

<u>Causes</u> a Real <u>Conflict</u> – with <u>whether</u> the Life of God Is <u>truly Abiding</u> in our Lives

Because <u>IF</u> the <u>Life of God</u> is living in you – Abiding in you Then you <u>WILL LOVE</u>

Because the *Life of God* in you – **IS LOVE**

So – again - <u>if</u> this message <u>causes</u> you to be <u>concerned</u>

about <u>whether</u> God is truly <u>Abiding</u> with <u>free reign</u> in your Life

Don't get defensive - Just **Cry Out** to God

& so - I'm going to ask us right now

to <u>Bow</u> our hearts before God – <u>Humble</u> ourselves <u>Surrender</u> our Pride

& Pray that God would Forgive us

That He would <u>take over our life</u> & that He would <u>Create</u> in us a <u>Clean Heart</u>

Let's Pray – you can pray this prayer with me

Dear God, please forgive me of my sin.

I have been blinded by my sin.

And I am helpless to change, without you taking over my life.

Please, take over my life. Create in me a clean heart.

Please fill me with your Holy Spirit, please live in me & thru me.

Please crush my Selfishness & Pride, so that I can see your love living thru my life

I commit my full life, to you. From this day forward, my life is not my own.

I surrender myself to you Jesus, as my Savior, and my LORD. In your own name, Amen.
