Abide 02 - Our Need to Abide - Jn 16:33

credit to Andrew Murray, "Abiding in Christ"

- At the beginning of the year I taught a message called "Abide to Thrive"
- & in that Msg <u>I promised</u> to further <u>develop</u> the Great Truth of <u>ABIDING</u> in Christ
- & **not only develop** this Great & 'Much Needed' truth but also **talk about** the **Big HOW** . . .
- Not just <u>WHAT</u> "Abiding in Christ" is But <u>HOW</u> do we "Abide in Christ" in the midst of this crazy world
- & so we're going to <u>take a few msgs</u> (between books) & <u>work</u> on this critical subject
- <u>If</u> you <u>didn't hear</u> the New Year's Msg called "*Abide to Thrive*" you should prob <u>Get That</u> to lay the foundation for these msgs

Let's Pray

Some of the **Motivation** - & some of the '**Concepts'** in these Msg's on **Abiding**

Come form a Pastor & Missionary from the 1800's named Andrew Murray - & his book called "Abiding in Christ"

Let me start – by sharing with youWHY this is such a HUGE SUBJECT for me

It has to do with **TWO truths** – **BOTH** found in **Jn 16:33**

<u>After</u> spending <u>FOUR Ch's</u> teaching his Disciples how to <u>Live Victoriously</u> in the midst of this world (<u>Jn 13-16</u>)

<u>AND</u> – after teaching our <u>KEY lesson</u> on <u>ABIDING</u> (<u>Jn 15</u>)

After **ALL** that teaching – the **last thing** Jesus said in **Jn Ch 16** – was;

John 16:33 (ESV)

33 I have said these things to you, that <u>in me you may have</u> <u>peace</u>. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; <u>I have overcome the world</u>."

& in this <u>FINAL</u> – Summary Vs There are <u>TWO</u> Huge <u>Promises</u>

<u>Right</u> in the <u>middle</u> there – is the <u>FIRST PROMISE</u>; In the world you will have tribulation

I have <u>SEEN</u> this promise <u>come true</u> (in varying degrees) in <u>every Christian's</u> life that I know

But in the opening & closing of this Vs – is the SECOND PROMISE

& this <u>SECOND PROMISE</u> – I have <u>NOT SEEN</u> come true in **every Christian's life** that I know

The **SECOND PROMISE** comes in **TWO Parts** - at the **beginning** & **end** of the verse

in me you may have peace . . . I have overcome the world

Maybe we can better **understand** this promise - by **turning it around**

I have overcome the world – so - in me you may have peace

- <u>This</u> is a very <u>clear PROMISE</u> <u>Meant</u> to Give us <u>PEACE</u> – in the <u>MIDST</u> of the world's Tribulation
- The Reason I have seen the FIRST PROMISE in EVERY Christian I know is because it is UNCONDITIONAL
- <u>The Reason</u> I have <u>NOT</u> seen the <u>SECOND PROMISE</u> in <u>EVERY</u> <u>Christian</u> I know – is because it is <u>CONDITIONAL</u>

The **CONDITION** – that separates

Christians who **HAVE** that **Overcoming Peace** from Christians who **DON'T** have it . . .

is in those TWO Critically KEY words - - "IN ME"

- <u>Coming out</u> of <u>Ch 15</u> We <u>know</u> Jesus is <u>referring</u> to the <u>Foundational Need</u> in the Christian Life To <u>"Abide In Christ"</u>
- & at the end of this teaching Jesus summarizes WHY it is so critical that we learn to Abide in Him;
- #1) Because In the world you will have tribulation
- #2) By "ABIDING in Christ" you can have HIS peace & HIS victory over the world
- The **PROBLEM** is The **Overcoming Peace** Jesus Offers us is **CONDITIONAL** on us "**Abiding in Him**"
- **THAT** is **WHY** you can see **Two Christians** Respond & React SO **Differently** to similar **Tribulations** in this world

There is a very **SAD truth** in the **Christian Church** -- & that is;

MOST Christians <u>respond</u> to difficulties – <u>pretty much</u> the <u>same way NON-Christians</u> do

This is the <u>same</u> shocking <u>truth</u> as the <u>similar comparison</u> we <u>hear</u> all the time

that the **<u>DIVORCE</u>** rate **<u>INSIDE</u>** the church, is sadly the **<u>SAME</u>** as it is **<u>OUTSIDE</u>** the church

WHY are these Sad Comparisons SO TRUE ?

BECAUSE Most Christians
Have never learned **HOW** to **Abide in Christ**

They don't **HAVE** the **OVERCOMING PEACE** - Christ offers so they **RESPOND** & **REACT** the **SAME** way **NON**-Christians do

Which is <u>heart-breaking</u>

On the other hand – I HAVE seen - & AM seeing right now in this *Incredible Crisis* in Michael Fattaruso's life

I <u>HAVE Seen</u> Christians <u>RESPOND</u> & <u>REACT</u> & <u>LIVE</u> Radically Different than Non-Christians

they **GO THRU** their Circumstances **Differently** - & they **COME OUT** Of their Circumstances **Differently**

It's **NOT** that their **CIRCUMSTANCES** are Different It's that they **COME THRU** their **Circumstances** Different

& THAT - is exactly what Jesus is referring to in Jn 16:33

In the world you <u>WILL</u> have tribulation – <u>HOWEVER</u>
In Christ you <u>CAN</u> have <u>PEACE</u> that <u>OVERCOMES</u> this world

This **GREAT NEED** – For Christians to **learn** how to **HAVE** this overcoming Peace – BY "**Abiding in Christ**"

was the **<u>Driving Force</u>** of the previous msg "<u>**ABIDE to THRIVE**</u>" – & <u>is the motivation</u> for these additional <u>msg's</u>

<u>But before</u> we move on – **<u>I believe</u>** it is Critically Im**p**ortant

That We <u>FIRST</u> get this Foundational <u>NEED</u> (to Abide) <u>Firmly implanted</u> in our <u>hearts & minds</u>

& THEN - - - We can get – to the BIG HOW!!

<u>HOW</u> – do we <u>ABIDE in CHRIST</u> – so we can <u>Respond</u> & <u>React</u>, & <u>Come Thru</u> the <u>Tribulation</u> of this world - <u>Differently</u>?

THAT IS – the Primary Purpose of these msg's – & we will eventually get - to the BIG HOW !!

But <u>FIRST</u> – Let's make sure we <u>really understand</u> our **VITAL NEED** – to **Abide in Christ**

You know . . . <u>During</u> Jesus' <u>life on earth</u>
the phrase He used most often was – "Follow Me"

<u>We're</u> very <u>familiar</u> with the Phrase – It's <u>used</u> all the time in Church - & it's a **GOOD** phrase

The problem is . . .

Almost every time Jesus said "Follow Me"
He was speaking to unbelievers

& <u>when we use</u> that phrase - "<u>Follow Jesus</u>" we're generally <u>referring</u> to <u>Salvation</u>

Which is obviously THE Big Deal - - Especially for Unbelievers

HOWEVER – when **Jesus** was about to **leave** this earth

He gathered His <u>Disciples</u> together – <u>those</u> who had <u>already made</u> a <u>permanent commitment</u> to Follow Him

He <u>gathered them</u> together, in an <u>intimate setting</u> - & He <u>said</u> something <u>different</u> to them - He said – "<u>Abide in Me</u>"

Our Key Vs's for this Entire Study are Jn 15:4-5

4 Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me.

5 I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing.

When <u>Jesus said</u> this to His <u>disciples</u>
He was <u>preparing them</u> to go out into a <u>treacherous world</u>

where there would be tribulation, & difficulty where there would be persecutions & heartbreaks

All thru the <u>upper room discourse</u> (Jn 13–16) – Jesus was <u>preparing</u>
His <u>Disciples</u> to live <u>Victoriously</u> in a world of <u>Tribulation</u>

& during this intense preparation – The FOCUS of Jesus was NOT on "Following Him" but on "Abiding in Him"

Because it is **ONLY** by **"Abiding in Him"** – that **WE** (as Christians) can live **VICTORIOUSLY** in this world

But here's the problem . . .

<u>Unfortunately</u> – many of us <u>live</u> our entire Christian Lives Having made the choice to <u>FOLLOW</u> Christ

but <u>never understanding</u> The <u>GREAT NEED</u> or the <u>GREAT POWER</u> - - of <u>ABIDING</u> in Christ

We put our <u>Faith in Christ</u> initially – because we <u>recognize</u> our <u>need</u> to be <u>SAVED</u>

The need for Salvation is pretty easy to grasp;

we know we're <u>sinners</u>, & so sepa<u>r</u>ated from God – we hear & <u>believe</u>, Jesus <u>died</u> to pay the <u>penalty</u> for our sin, & we <u>come</u> to the conclusion – *Man, WE NEED THAT*

& <u>when</u> we put our <u>Faith in Christ</u> - we generally <u>HEAR</u> – that Receiving Christ as our Savior also means "Following Him" as Lord

& so we <u>make a commitment</u> to <u>DO THAT</u> – to the <u>best</u> of our ability & <u>then</u> - <u>Unfortunately</u> – <u>many</u> Christians <u>stop</u> right there

We **receive Christ** as our Savior

& we make **some level of Commitment** to "**Follow Him**" often in **OUR OWN STRENGTH** (which, is actually worthless)

- & then we **STOP** right there
- & by stopping there Many, Many Christians NEVER experience

the <u>JOY</u> & the <u>POWER</u> of the <u>ABUNDANT LIFE</u> which is actually <u>PART</u> of the <u>SALVATION LIFE</u>

<u>Maybe</u> – it's because we <u>really just wanted</u> our "<u>Forgiveness Ticket</u>"

& then we wanted to just get back to living for ourselves at the pleasures of sin (if that's you - please be afraid)

Maybe it's because no one ever told us that Following Jesus was MORE than a raise of the hand & a quick prayer

Or <u>MAYBE</u> - we actually do <u>LONG FOR</u> the <u>JOY</u> & the <u>POWER</u> of the <u>Abundant Life</u>

We've <u>just never learned</u> <u>HOW</u> to "<u>Abide in Christ</u>" in order to <u>Experience</u> it

John MacArthur – in his commentary on Jn 15 says

Abiding in Christ is the source of the abundant life Jesus speaks of in John 10:10, "I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly."

Abiding in Christ is the source of the abundant life!!

Please hear me

The ABUNDANT Life COMES - ONLY - by ABIDING in Christ !!

It <u>BEGINS</u> with Salvation

Responding to Jesus' call to "Follow Him"

But then it <u>MUST GROW</u> – into <u>ABIDING</u> in Christ – which is the <u>SOURCE</u> of the <u>Abundant Life</u>

Jesus' Call to <u>FOLLOW HIM</u> – Was actually a <u>CALL</u> to; <u>COME</u> to Him - & then <u>REMAIN</u> (<u>ABIDE</u>) in Him

Our <u>church culture</u> has done a <u>pretty good job</u> with the <u>COME to Jesus</u> part

But far too few Christians are actually experiencing the ABUNDANT LIFE that comes from "ABIDING in Him"

This truth is seen really well in Mat 11:28-30

Matthew 11:28–30 (ESV) \rightarrow \rightarrow

Matthew 11:28-30 (ESV)

28 Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.
30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light."

FIRST – Jesus says – Come to me, & I will give you REST

<u>THEN</u> – Jesus says – *Take my yoke upon you, & learn of me,* & *you will find REST for your souls*

<u>We want</u> to be <u>VERY CAREFUL</u> – <u>NOT</u> to <u>imply</u> there is something **ADDITIONAL** to our **Salvation** here – there is **NOT**

But there <u>IS</u> - (here & all thru scripture)
a <u>Deepening Experience</u> of "<u>ABIDING IN CHRIST</u>"

The FIRST "Come to Me" here - is like the call of Salvation

Jesus says: <u>COME TO ME</u> – w/ <u>NO Prerequisites</u>, <u>NO Requirements</u> & I will give you Rest – in your **SALVATION** (forgiveness of sin)

But then look closely at V.29 . . . Jesus says

Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, . . . and you will find rest for your souls

This <u>SECOND</u> "Rest for your soul" (V.29) is actually <u>CONDITIONAL</u> – It comes with <u>TWO requirements</u>

Take my yoke upon you - and learn from me, . . .

THIS - is "Abiding in Christ"

Take my yoke upon you – is easiest explained as
Relax & Submit to my will for your life

STOP demanding your own way - & receive the LIFE that Jesus has made - to FIT YOU Perfectly

& Vs 30 (next Vs) says
30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light."

The word "**EASY**" means Literally – **Well Fitting**

The life Jesus has for us - FITS US perfectly
And BECAUSE it fits us Perfectly - it makes our Burden LIGHT

That **DOES NOT** mean – there will be **NO BURDEN**

<u>It means</u> Jesus - <u>Fits US</u> to the <u>TASK</u> & He <u>Fits the TASK</u> - to <u>US</u>

& so – when we surrender to that Perfect Fit it seems like NO BURDEN at all

& <u>V.29 says</u> - <u>not only</u> Take my yoke upon you, but also - and <u>learn</u> from me,

The **GK word** for **LEARN** here – is **from** the same word that we get the word **DISCIPLE**

Jesus says – <u>ALLOW</u> Me to <u>FIT your Life</u> to <u>YOU</u> & <u>Become my DISCIPLE</u>

& <u>THEN</u> - you will Find <u>REST</u> for your <u>SOUL</u>

Jesus is talking about GROWING INTO the ABUNDANT LIFE that He has promised YOU

- & <u>The SOURCE</u> of that <u>Abundant Life</u> is <u>Abiding in Christ</u>
- & <u>CONTRARY</u> to what many of us <u>think</u> this is <u>not HARD WORK</u> or <u>TREMENDOUS EFFORT</u>

Learning to **Abide in Christ** is really Mostly – About **SURRENDER**

Our Job is to Surrender, & Abide in Him

<u>& then HIS JOB – is what Phil 2:13 says (ESV)</u>

13 for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure.

When we are Surrendered to Christ - & "Abiding in Him" It is GOD Who is Working in us . . .

& THAT is why we can be AT REST

& this REST that Jesus is promising us here in Mat 11 is NOT ABSENCE of ACTIVITY it is ABSENCE of CONFLICT

(again) Mat 11:29-30 (ESV)

29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me (Abide in Me), for I am gentle and lowly in heart (so you can trust me), and you will find rest for your souls (absence of conflict).

30 For my yoke is easy (it fits perfect), and my burden is light (it's not a struggle)."

So – <u>there is</u> an Initial <u>REST</u> in "Coming to Jesus" from the <u>Forgiveness of sin</u> & being <u>made right</u> with God

& then there is a REST for our Soul – that comes from

Abiding in CHRIST

Surrendering to His Life for you

Growing in your Knowledge of Him

Let me give you ONE MORE Example

Just to make sure I've totally Over-Stated my point

This truth - is very similar to the

"Peace WITH God" - vs. - "Peace OF God" truths

Rom 5:1 (ESV)

1 Therefore, since we have been <u>justified by faith</u>, we have peace <u>with</u> God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

By putting our **FAITH** in Christ – **ALONE we have** Peace **WITH** God

as in "we are no longer an enemy of God in our sin"

& this Peace come **UNCONDITIONALLY** – By **FAITH** alone

But then - after we have Peace WITH God . . .

Philippians 4:6–7 Says \rightarrow \rightarrow

Philippians 4:6-7 ESV)

6 do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.

7 And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

The <u>First Peace</u> – Peace <u>WITH</u> God - is <u>UNCONDITIONAL</u> it is "By Faith Alone"

But the Peace **OF** God – which <u>surpasses understanding</u>, & <u>guards your heart & mind</u> . . . is **CONDITIONAL**

It is **conditioned** upon An **Intimate Communion** with God

Where we are **Casting our Cares** upon Him

Rolling our Burdens over to Him

Communing with Him in Prayer & Supplication

& **Being Thankful** in all our **requests** to Him

The <u>Peace OF God</u> that Surpasses understanding – is something that is <u>DEVELOPED</u> in our lives

BY "Abiding in Christ"

Does all that **make sense** ??

What we need to understand (in our "Quick Salvation" culture) is;

the **ABUNDANT LIFE**

the **PEACE** that Passes Understanding

& **VICTORY** in the Midst of our Trials

DOES NOT automatically **come** simply by us **SAYING** that we are **now a Christian**

<u>AND</u> – it <u>DOES NOT</u> automatically <u>come</u> by us <u>ATTENDING CHURCH</u> once a <u>week</u> (or even twice)

It comes by us **LEARNING** (as Disciples) **HOW** to **ABIDE IN CHRIST**

Psalm 16:11 (ESV)

11 You make known to me the path of life; in your presence there is fullness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore.

The Blessings of <u>LIFE</u> & <u>JOY</u> & <u>True PLEASURE</u> **ALL COME** - from **Abiding in the Presence** of the Lord

Alright - Maybe some of you are saying about now . .

OK – Let's Get on with the HOW

Just tell me HOW I can get this - & how I can get it FAST

If you're saying that (or thinking it) – then maybe . . .

You <u>MIGHT BE</u> looking for the same "<u>Microwave</u>" approach to <u>ABIDING</u> in Christ – as we <u>TEND TO</u> apply to <u>Salvation</u>

We want to get people SAVED by the end of a 45 min message & maybe we want to get people ABIDING by the end of a 45 min msg

& <u>MAYBE</u> – Therein lies the problem !!!

If I told you – that <u>LEARNING</u> to <u>ABIDE</u> in Christ is the <u>ultimate goal</u> of the <u>FOREVER school</u> of being a <u>Disciple</u>

Would you still want to JOIN ??

Do we want the "**Abiding in Christ**" prayer to look like the "**Salvation**" Prayer . . .

30 seconds, repeat after me - & baam, you're ABIDING ??

Guys, <u>Listen</u> – the <u>REASON</u> I am taking so long going over the <u>NEED to ABIDE</u> in Christ

is **Precisely BECAUSE** we want everything **quick**, **fast** & in a **hurry**

& <u>If we try</u> to <u>BRING</u> our <u>American Culture</u> of <u>DEMANDING</u> it <u>ALL</u> & <u>DEMANDING</u> it <u>NOW</u>

If we bring that "Microwave" approach to Abiding in Christ – I promise - we will get frustrated, and disillusioned,

& we'll **end up** running **right back** to the **sins** of the flesh that **DO GIVE US** that "**Microwave**, **instant Pleasure**"

So – <u>Let's remember</u> one very <u>critical thing</u> as we <u>begin LEARNING HOW</u> to Abide in Christ

In the days of Christ (& I believe still today) In a Vineyard

it was <u>normal</u> - to <u>PREVENT</u> a vine-branch from <u>producing</u> Fruit – <u>For 3 years</u>

In the FOURTH Year – after 3 Yrs of Careful Pruning
the Branch was Ready to Produce Quality Fruit (& still be pruned)

We think **MICROWAVE** – God thinks **CROCK-POT**

We say - - I said the 30 Sec prayer 30 days ago
WHY don't I have PEACE & JOY & VICTORY in my life yet

Jesus says – Come to Me, Abide in Me, Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, . . . and <u>THEN</u> you will find rest for your soul (Mat 11:29)

We're **going to spend** some weeks **talking** about the **Critical Need EVERY** Christian has – to **ABIDE in CHRIST**

& I Promise – we will get to the BIG HOW

But I wonder if Right Now – You would make a Commitment to JOIN the Life Long School of Abiding in Christ

The HOW will come

But FIRST must come – the "All-In" Commitment

1 John 2:28 (ESV)

28 And now, little children, <u>abide in him</u>, so that when he appears we may have confidence and not shrink from him in shame at his coming.
