## 1Jn 04 - Disciples Follow The Word - 1Jn 2:3-6

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Let's Pray - right up front today

#### The topic of <u>"The Assurance of our Salvation"</u> runs all thru <u>1John</u>

The Apostle John tells us <u>WHY</u> he's writing - at the end of his letter

#### (turn over to) 1Jn 5:13 - ESV

## 13 I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God <u>that you may know</u> that you have eternal life.

But look at the 2 Vs's just before V.13

<u>These</u> are the Vs we are really <u>more used</u> to hearing than what we'll be <u>studying</u> today

& these <u>Vs's</u> are absolutely <u>TRUE</u>

## <u>1Jn 5:11-12 - ESV</u>

11 And this is the testimony, that God <u>gave us eternal life</u>, and this life is <u>in his Son</u>.
12 <u>Whoever has the Son has life</u>; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life.

That is **absolutely**, **undeniably**, 100% **TRUE** without adding 1 thing at all

#### God gave us eternal life - IN HIS SON & Whoever <u>HAS</u> the Son - <u>HAS</u> Eternal Life - PERIOD

There is <u>NOTHING</u> that we can ever <u>add to</u> or <u>take away from</u> that Eternal Life is **IN Jesus Christ** 

& whoever **HAS** Jesus Christ - **HAS** Eternal Life (*right ?*)

#### But then - look again at 1Jn 5:13 I write these things to you who believe . . . that you may know that you have eternal life.

- So <u>still</u> there was <u>some question</u> in the churches about the "*Assurance of Salvation*"
- We <u>can assume</u> John taught them the Believer's <u>Assurance</u> that's recorded so well in the <u>Gospel of John</u>

& we teach that Exact Same assurance

## John 10:28-29 - ESV

28 I give them eternal life, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of my hand. 29 My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all, and

no one is able to snatch them out of the Father's hand.

We believe <u>**THAT**</u> We know that <u>**THAT**</u> is absolutely - a TRUE fact

#### But <u>something</u> had happened in the <u>churches</u> that <u>caused</u> John to write this letter about how we can <u>KNOW</u> that we have eternal life

- & it's something we see happen in our own churches
- & that is people **INSIDE** the church (probably even leaders) had shown themselves to be **False Teachers**

They had caused **Division** & **Dissention** & had ultimately had **drawn many** away from Christ

#### & <u>THAT</u> had caused the <u>questions</u>

about the Assurance of these False Teachers Salvation

Because it <u>APPEARED</u> - they <u>HAD</u> salvation in Christ <u>at one point</u> & <u>then</u> - it appeared - they had . . . <u>LOST IT</u>

& before <u>Ch 2</u> is over

Paul is going to directly address these False Teachers

## He says in 1Jn 2:19 - ESV

19 They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would have continued with us. But they went out, <u>that it might become plain</u> that they all are not of us.

Those are <u>Pretty Strong words</u> for those <u>INSIDE</u> the church (probably even leaders)

These <u>False teachers</u> knew about Salvation by <u>FAITH</u> in Christ <u>ALONE</u>

But they distorted what True Faith meant

<u>They claimed you could have TRUE FAITH even if you were;</u> <u>Walking</u> in Darkness <u>Disobeying</u> God, & <u>Hating</u> your brother

& <u>John</u> makes it clear - that those who <u>SEEMED</u> to "Fall Away" <u>did not</u> actually <u>HAVE</u> True Faith at one point, & then <u>LOSE IT</u> But <u>instead</u>, it just eventually became <u>apparent</u>, that they <u>NEVER HAD TRUE FAITH</u> to begin with

& <u>so</u> the <u>question</u> among the believers Must Have Been . . . What about <u>ME</u> - How do <u>I KNOW</u> - if I have <u>TRUE FAITH</u>

If **they claimed** to have True Faith - & **DIDN'T** . . .

How can I be <u>Assured</u> that My Faith is <u>Genuine</u> & that <u>MY</u> Salvation is <u>Guaranteed</u> & Assured

& <u>so</u> - in essence - <u>John</u> says Let me <u>tell you</u> how you can <u>KNOW</u> that you <u>KNOW</u>

that <u>your Faith</u> - is a <u>Genuine Faith</u> that <u>Absolutely Guarantees</u> your Eternal Salvation

Does that make sense?

<u>I need</u> to make sure no one <u>misunderstands</u> these very <u>direct teachings</u> of 1John

John is <u>NOT</u> saying that if you <u>work really hard</u> to <u>MEET</u> these <u>requirements</u> - that you will <u>EARN</u> eternal life

He's saying - IF you truly HAVE Eternal Life in Jesus Christ

Then, <u>as a RESULT</u> of your Genuine Faith you will <u>HAVE</u> these <u>Marks</u> (signs) in your life John says - he is writing that <u>WE MAY KNOW</u> that <u>we HAVE</u> Eternal Life

& <u>so</u> he says - These are the <u>LITMUST</u> tests - that <u>PROVE</u> that we <u>Truly HAVE</u> Eternal Life

& <u>so</u> - when we <u>see these MARKS</u> (signs) in our life

we can have <u>absolute</u> confident <u>assurance</u>, that we are <u>IN CHRIST</u> - & that He is Truly <u>our LORD</u>

THAT is the primary purpose of 1John We all understand that now - right ?

Let's dive in then

### 1Jn 2:3 - ESV

3 And by this we <u>know</u> that we have come to <u>know</u> him, if we keep his commandments.

[REPEAT]

Let's start with one of my favorite GK words - GINOSKO

The word used here for <u>KNOW</u> is <u>FAR MORE</u> - than <u>intellectual knowledge</u>

This word means An Intimate, Relational, Being One type knowledge

This word is the OPPOSITE of "Knowing ABOUT" someone

<u>I know ABOUT George Bush</u> (for instance, I know George Bush was <u>NOT</u> on a personal mission to <u>insure</u> the free <u>murdering</u> of innocent human life <u>like our current</u> President is)

I know <u>ABOUT</u> George Bush, & some other Presidents But I <u>KNOW my wife</u> in a much different way - *right* ?

The <u>Demons</u> <u>KNOW ABOUT</u> Jesus Christ just like <u>most people</u> in America <u>KNOW ABOUT</u> Jesus Christ

But a Christian KNOWS Jesus - in a Much Different way

We know Him *Intimately*, *Relationally* As in - *being <u>ONE with Him</u>* 

THAT is the Level of <u>KNOWING</u> Jesus that <u>brings</u> Eternal Life

The <u>Apostle Paul</u> stated his ultimate life's goal in <u>PHIL 3:10</u> which is <u>my</u> life's verse, & <u>this church's</u> foundational verse

## Phil 3:10 - THAT I MAY KNOW HIM

& THAT is the level of KNOWING Jesus - John is talking about here

& this is <u>the same</u> level of <u>KNOWING</u> Jesus that <u>many</u> will ultimately find out - they <u>DID NOT HAVE</u>

## In Mat 7:22-23 Jesus says - ESV

22 On that day many will say to me, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and cast out demons in your name, and do many mighty works in your name?' 23 And then will I declare to them, 'I never <u>knew</u> you (ginosko);

depart from me, you workers of lawlessness.'

So - <u>remember</u> - the point of <u>1John</u> is How can we <u>KNOW</u> - that we <u>KNOW</u> Jesus in <u>THIS</u> way

#### 1John 2:3 tells us

# 3 And by this we <u>know</u> that we have come to <u>know</u> him, if we keep his commandments.

We can <u>KNOW</u> - that we have come to <u>KNOW</u> Him *in this way* <u>IF</u> we <u>keep</u> His commandments

Now - does that mean we have to be Absolutely perfect? - NO

<u>Remember</u> - we talked about that <u>last week</u> A Christian is not sinless - but he does Sin Less!

Meaning, one of the <u>MARKS</u> of Salvation - is an <u>increasing desire</u> to <u>follow Jesus MORE</u>, and <u>follow Sin LESS</u>

& <u>V.3</u> says - by this we <u>know</u> that we have come to <u>know</u> him, if we keep his commandments.

Not *perfectly*, But *increasingly* 

## as 2Cor 3:18 says - ESV

18 And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another . . .

So guys - let's <u>keep following Jesus</u> closer & closer which is a <u>CLEAR SIGN</u> - that we truly <u>KNOW HIM</u> Now - What about the "Other Side" of this Equation

If we now <u>KNOW</u> - the <u>SIGN</u> - of <u>KNOWING JESUS</u> with a <u>*True Saving Faith*</u>

<u>Then</u> - how can we <u>KNOW</u> - if we <u>DON'T KNOW Jesus</u> with a <u>*True Saving Faith*</u>??

& our <u>Next Vs</u> - answers <u>THAT</u> question

## <u>1Jn 2:4 - ESV</u>

# 4 Whoever says "I know him" but does not keep his commandments is <u>a liar</u>, and the truth is not in him,

*OUCH* - man, that is definitely <u>NOT</u> "Politically Correct" You could <u>OFFEND</u> some people with a statement like that !!

MAYBE offend them enough to cause them to <u>actually get saved</u>

<u>People</u> who say - they have their "*OWN THING*" with God Who think they're "*OK*" with God - *while living in sin* 

The Bible has one very clear word for them - - LIAR !!!

In <u>Vs 3</u> we made it clear - a <u>Saving Knowledge</u> of Jesus Christ is <u>much different</u> than an <u>Intellectual Knowledge</u>

& then - <u>V.4</u> <u>describes</u> the person who has <u>ONLY</u> an <u>intellectual knowledge</u>

This is the person who thinks they're <u>a Christian</u> because they

<u>Live in America</u> - Eat <u>Apple Pie</u> & Go to <u>Church</u> a few times a year & they say - **"Yeah, I know Jesus"** But <u>really</u> what they mean is - **They know ABOUT Jesus** 

### At the **<u>SAME LEVEL</u>** - that the **<u>Demons</u>** know <u>ABOUT</u> Jesus

But they **Don't know Him** with that *Intimate, Relational, Saving Knowledge* 

Because <u>IF</u> they <u>KNEW</u> Him - <u>that way</u> It would have a <u>Direct Effect</u> on their <u>Actions</u>, & their <u>Choices</u>

<u>John's</u> saying - if you have this <u>True Love Relationship</u> with Jesus you won't <u>BE ABLE</u> to go on sinning

Because the Love you have for Christ - Constrains You

& the <u>Love of God</u> that fills your life will actually <u>change</u> - your <u>Actions</u>, & your <u>Choices</u>

Which is exactly what our next verse says

## 1Jn 2:5(A) - ESV

5 but whoever keeps his word, in him truly the love of God is <u>perfected</u> . . .

The word "Perfected" here - means BROUGHT TO COMPLETION

It doesn't mean the person - has <u>become perfect</u> - it means the <u>Love of God</u> has been <u>brought to completion</u> - in them

meaning The Love of God has *FINISHED* (completed) *its saving work* in them To give you an idea of <u>the EMPHASIS</u> John is making here

This Word "<u>PERFECTED</u>" here in <u>V.5</u> - is the <u>same word</u> recorded as the <u>last word</u> of Jesus Christ <u>on the CROSS</u>

When His <u>Work of Love</u> was finished on the cross the <u>last thing</u> Jesus spoke was - <u>TETELESTAI</u>

<u>Which</u> we translate - <u>It Is Finished</u>, meaning - the <u>Work</u> of Christ on the Cross - *Had been Completed* 

& that's the same thing John's saying here

that we can KNOW <u>whether</u> the Love of God has <u>*FINISHED*</u> it's saving work in us - <u>or not</u>

By <u>WHETHER</u> - we are <u>keeping</u> His Word - or <u>not</u>

So - <u>keeping</u> God's Word - is a <u>SIGN</u> that the <u>Complete</u> (True) <u>Love of God</u> - is in us

Because that <u>Perfected Love of God</u> - causes us, to increasingly <u>Follow God</u>, <u>MORE</u> than we <u>Follow Sin</u>

The Perfect Love of God <u>CONSUMES YOU</u> - & <u>CHANGES YOU</u>

& <u>the person</u> who is <u>Keeping</u> God's Word because of the Love of God in them . . .

Has a <u>**Real**</u>, Rock Solid, <u>**Guaranteed**</u> Assurance of their Eternal Life - <u>**IN CHRIST**</u> Which is exactly what V.5(B) & V.6 say

The <u>Best Translators</u> say - the end of V.5 can <u>EITHER</u> apply to what has gone <u>BEFORE it</u> - or to what <u>FOLLOWS it</u> (*but either way the meaning doesn't change*)

The *ESV* connects <u>V.5(B)</u>, to V.6 *with a COLON* So we'll use *THAT sense* to study it

## 1Jn 2:5(B)-6 - ESV

5... By this we may know that we are <u>in him</u>: 6 whoever says he <u>abides</u> in him ought to walk in the same way in which he walked.

It <u>seems to me</u> - John is trying to <u>make his point</u> - Extremely <u>CLEAR</u> (which he often does)

& he says - THIS is how we can know we are truly IN CHRIST

#### If we SAY we abide in Him - we OUGHT to WALK in the same way HE walked

The word "ABIDE" means - to settle down, to remain

Whoever says he is "<u>Abiding in Christ</u>" ought to be walking in the same way He walked

Jesus said the same thing in John 15:5 - ESV 5... Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, ...

<u>Meaning</u> - there is a pretty <u>easy way</u> to <u>tell</u> if we are "<u>Abiding</u>" in Christ - & He is "<u>Abiding</u>" in us You know, <u>one way</u> you can tell if <u>someone</u> truly has the <u>NEW LIFE</u> in Christ in them. . .

is to **just WAIT** - just give it a **little time** 

& you will <u>be able to see</u> - if they're "<u>Abiding</u>" in Christ & <u>HE</u> - in <u>THEM</u>

If you just wait long enough - you can always find out how AUTHENTIC a person's words are

It's really <u>NOT</u> so much - what you say in the <u>MOMENT</u> It's where you <u>REMAIN</u> for the long run

Are we **ABIDING** in Christ - Are we REMAING in Him

& <u>V.6</u> very clearly says - If we <u>SAY</u> we are "<u>ABIDING</u>" in Him <u>THEN</u> - we will be <u>Walking</u> the way He Walked

The word <u>WALK</u> means to <u>ORDER YOUR STEPS</u> the same way <u>He Ordered</u> His Steps

It **DOESN'T** mean living a **SINLESS** life - like His

It means <u>Ordering your Steps</u> - by <u>the Will</u> of the Father <u>just like</u> Jesus did

It <u>means</u> having your <u>heart</u> turned toward <u>Heaven</u> & <u>Living</u> your life <u>Accordingly</u> - Just like Jesus Did

It means being willing to <u>Lay down</u> the pleasures of this world <u>Pick up</u> your cross And Follow Jesus & IF you are willing to do that

<u>THEN</u> - you have a <u>Guaranteed MARK</u>, a Guaranteed <u>SIGN</u>, that you are <u>ABIDING IN CHRIST</u>

& that your Eternal Life is Absolutely Secured in Heaven

& THAT - is when we can have True ASSURANCE of our Salvation

Guys, <u>Please Listen</u> very carefully to me let's apply this to <u>our church</u> - right here in <u>Nuevo</u>

#### The PROOF

that God is Truly AT WORK in a CHURCH

The <u>ONLY PROOF</u> . . . is <u>CHANGED LIVES</u> for Jesus Christ & that is the <u>ONLY PROOF</u>

It's not - "*is there good worship* " It's not even - "*is there good teaching*" It's certainly NOT - are *we making friends* & *having some fun* 

IT IS ONLY - - Are <u>lives</u> being <u>changed</u> for Jesus Christ at Calvary Chapel Nuevo?

If they are - then God IS at work

if they are NOT - then God is NOT at work

The <u>GOOD NEWS</u> is - <u>we can</u> list many people whose <u>lives</u> have been <u>radically changed</u> by Jesus Christ

**SINCE** they started coming to **this church** 

<u>Many people</u> - we can name - who are <u>radically different</u> <u>BECAUSE</u> of the Love of God - in their lives

- We <u>get to see</u> many of you who have the <u>TRUE MARKS</u> - of Salvation
- & THAT absolutely THRILLS US
- & <u>THAT</u> is the proof that God is <u>AT WORK</u> in this <u>CHURCH</u>
- & <u>THAT</u> is the proof that God is <u>AT WORK</u> in your <u>LIFE</u> . . . AMEN ?
- So . . . <u>if your life</u> has <u>changed</u> for Jesus Christ <u>since</u> you started <u>coming</u> to this church

then you are **OUR PROOF**, that God is **<u>at work</u>** here

but if your life has <u>NOT BEEN</u> significantly <u>changed</u> <u>since</u> you started <u>coming</u> to this church (or any other church)

Please, KEEP COMING - - But please don't think the Love of God has <u>been COMPLETED</u> in you

Because when the Love of God has done its Saving Work in you your life will be Measurably Changed

& <u>if your life</u> has not been <u>Measurably Changed</u> <u>TOWARD</u> following <u>God</u> - & <u>AWAY</u> from following <u>Sin</u>

Then you really need to hear the challenge - in 2Cor 13:5

I'm going to **read** from the **PARAPHRASE** called "*The Message*"

## 2Cor 13:5 - MSG

5 Test yourselves to make sure you are solid in the faith. Don't drift along taking everything for granted. Give yourselves regular checkups. You need firsthand evidence, not mere hearsay, that Jesus Christ is in you. Test it out. If you fail the test, do something about it.

- Guys THAT is the message to us today
- Let's <u>**TEST OURSELVES</u>** to make sure we have <u>**the MARKS**</u> of True Salvation</u>
- & if we FAIL the test - Let's DO SOMETHING ABOUT IT
- & for that **TEST** We need **EVIDENCE** that <u>Jesus Christ</u> is Living in us & that we are <u>ABIDING</u> in Him
- & <u>we've seen</u> today some very <u>KEY EVIDENCE</u> - that we can use
- to **<u>determine</u>** if we are **<u>PASSING</u>**, or **<u>FAILING</u>**, this test

To Close - Let's Re-Read our Vs's today

& <u>I think</u> - the <u>EVIDENCE</u> necessary for this <u>TEST</u> is <u>Very Apparent</u> in our Vs's today

## <u> 1Jn 2:3-6 - ESV</u>

3 And by this we know that we have come to know him, if we keep his commandments. 4 Whoever says "I know him" but does not keep his

commandments is a liar, and the truth is not in him, 5 but whoever keeps his word, in him truly the love of God is perfected. By this we may know that we are in him: 6 whoever says he abides in him ought to walk in the same way in which he walked.
