Mrk31 - The Hope of Glory - Mark 9:1-8

Today we look at the Transfiguration

One of the most understated - & yet, one of the **most powerful** events – in the N.T.

This event may be **2nd ONLY** to the **RESURRECTION** for putting on display – the Glory of Jesus Christ

But – the **Transfiguration** – it's not **JUST** about The Glory of Jesus

It's also about - US having confidence That WE will sharing - in the Glory of Jesus

When WE are **identified** with Jesus Christ **THRU FAITH** We have This HOPE OF GLORY

Let's Pray

The Apostle Peter writes - in 2 Peter 1:16 & 18 (NLT)

16 For we were not making up clever stories when we told you about the powerful coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. We saw his majestic splendor with our own eyes . . . 18 We ourselves heard that voice from heaven when we were

with him on the holy mountain.

That's **Peter** writing **ABOUT** the **Transfiguration**

& the **Apostle John** was with him

& John wrote in John 1:14 (NLT)

14 So the Word (LOGOS – God in expression) became human and made his home among us . . . And we have seen his glory, the glory of the Father's one and only Son.

Peter & John are <u>writing about</u>
Seeing the <u>GLORY</u> of <u>Jesus</u> Christ

They saw his **Glory** in other ways

But – <u>on that day</u> – at the <u>Transfiguration</u>
They saw the <u>Glory of Jesus Christ</u> - <u>REVEALED</u> (manifest)

Jesus is going to Pull back the VEIL of his humanity

& We are **going** to get a **glimpse** of **The HOPE of Glory**

But - Biblical Hope - is NOT wishful thinking

Biblical Hope – is a Confident Expectation based on Solid Certainty

Mark Ch 8 was so big - it's hard to review

But in that <u>entire Chapter</u>

<u>Jesus is trying to explain</u>

- 1) the Path he must take FOR our Salvation
- 2) & Path to the Kingdom of God

& so we read - in Mark 9:1 (NLT)

1 Jesus went on to say, "I tell you the truth, some standing here right now will not die before they see the Kingdom of God arrive in great power!"

Now - **people** have **ALL KINDS** of **Ideas** about **what** Jesus is **referring** to here

But – please <u>hear me</u>

<u>CONTEXT determines Interpretation</u>

So – if **someone** starts **talking** about something **crazy**

Just <u>LOOK</u> – at the <u>Actual Context</u> because the <u>context</u> - is <u>where</u> the <u>true meaning</u> is

& the Context here <u>MEANS</u>

<u>Jesus</u> is almost <u>certainly referring</u> - to <u>the Transfiguration</u>

So - we continue in Mark 9:2 (NLT)

2 Six days later Jesus took Peter, James, and John, and led them up a high mountain to be alone . . .

These 3 were the inner-circle – those Jesus kept closest to him

But - there may also be something to the fact

that <u>thru-out the Bible</u> – <u>God</u> says the <u>truth</u> must be <u>confirmed</u> by <u>2 or 3 Eyewitnesses</u>

& V.2 continues - Mark 9:2(b) (NLT)

2... As the men watched, Jesus' <u>appearance was</u> <u>transformed</u>,

One commentator said

This is the most understated description - of the most astonishing event - that had yet occurred in the life of Jesus

This event - is **So Incredible** - & **So Awe-Inspiring** & **yet** - **So Simply Stated** by mark

& <u>notice</u> – the NLT says "Jesus' APPEARANCE was Transformed"

That is the **traditional** word "**Transfigured**"

"Transfigured" comes from Two GREEK Words:

META – which means – <u>Change</u> MORPHE – which means - <u>Form</u>

Metamorphe = Change Form

But the **NLT helps** make it clear

That **ONLY** Jesus' **Outward Appearance changed nothing** on the **inside changed**

Jesus pulled the veil of his humanity back

to <u>allow</u> the <u>Disciples</u> to see <u>A PORTION</u> of his <u>GLORY</u>

& then - Mark 9:3 says (NLT)

3 and his clothes became <u>dazzling white</u>, far whiter than any earthly bleach could ever make them.

The <u>word</u> translated <u>DAZZLING</u> - <u>would</u> be like <u>looking</u> at a <u>giant sparkler</u>

This was a **PORTION** of the **Glory** of **Jesus**That we **see** in **Rev Ch 1**

Where Rev 1:16 says

his face was like the sun in all its brilliance.

& this <u>Glory</u> - was <u>always IN Jesus</u> - <u>Jesus</u> refers <u>to</u> it <u>himself</u> in <u>Jn 17</u>

But **here** – **Jesus REVEALS** – just a **little bit** of it

to give the **Disciples** a **Confident Expectation** of The HOPE of His Glory

& THIS is the Glory - Jesus will Return to Earth IN

Matthew 25:31 (NLT)

31 "But when the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit upon his glorious throne.

This is the confident expectation we have of the coming GLORY of Jesus Christ

<u>BUT</u> – (this is the <u>good part</u>) it <u>Wasn't JUST Jesus</u> <u>Who</u> was <u>Glorified</u> in the <u>Transfiguration</u>

Mark 9:4 says (NLT)

4 Then <u>Elijah</u> and <u>Moses</u> appeared and began talking with Jesus.

<u>Luke adds – In Luke 9:31 (NLT)</u>

31 They (Moses & Elijah) were glorious to see. And they were speaking about his (Jesus') exodus from this world, which was about to be fulfilled in Jerusalem.

If anyone could give the disciples Confident HOPE in the Glory of Jesus Christ

it <u>would</u> be <u>Israel's greatest Leader</u> - <u>Moses</u> & <u>Israel's greatest Prophet</u> – <u>Elijah</u>

& Notice – they were speaking about the Cross

Because the Cross – is at the CENTER of God's Plan of Salvation

This is an incredible - Awesome - Heavenly Moment

& <u>so</u> – The <u>Apostle Peter</u>

<u>MUST</u> – <u>Stick his foot</u> in his <u>mouth</u> (it's what he does)

Mark 9:5-6 (NLT) \rightarrow

Mark 9:5-6 (NLT)

5 Peter exclaimed, "Rabbi, it's wonderful for us to be here! Let's make three shelters as memorials—one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah."

6 He said this because he didn't really know what else to say, for they were all terrified.

<u>Stammering</u> - <u>Must-Speak</u> - <u>Mind-Spinning Peter</u> – <u>talking</u> because he <u>doesn't know</u> what <u>else</u> to do

Some people try to figure out WHY Peter says what he says

But Vs. 6 tells us why . . .

6 He said this because he didn't really know what else to say, for they were all terrified.

But – <u>there's no time</u> for the <u>other disciples</u> to <u>even question</u> his <u>crazy response</u>

Because Mark 9:7 says (NLT)

7 Then a cloud overshadowed them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my dearly loved Son. Listen to him."

God The Father

Who dwells in Unapproachable LIGHT

COVERS his **BEING** – *in a CLOUD* - & **SAYS** to **us**

This is my dearly loved Son. Listen to him

In The <u>first Ch of John</u> – <u>Jesus</u> is called the <u>LOGOS</u> (Grk) <u>IN English</u> – he is <u>The WORD</u>

The <u>Grk word</u> means – <u>God In Expression</u> Or – <u>the Express image of God</u>

John 1:1 (NLT)

1 In the beginning the Word already existed. The Word was with God, and the Word was God.

This **Indescribable**— **seemingly Unknowable** God — **Speaks**

& he WANTS us to KNOW HIM THRU his Son, Jesus Christ

Who IS: God in Expression

This is the **CORE** - of the **Revelation of God** in the **NT**

John 1:18 (NLT)

18 No one has ever seen God. But the unique One, who is himself God, is near to the Father's heart. He has revealed God to us.

Jesus himself said in John 14:9 (NLT)

9... Anyone who has seen me has seen the Father!

& again Jesus says in John 10:30 (NLT) 30 The Father and I are one."

Hebrews 1:3 (NLT)

3 The Son radiates God's own glory and expresses the very character of God . . .

_& <u>Here</u> – at the <u>Transfiguration</u> <u>God overwhelms</u> the <u>scene</u> in a <u>CLOUD</u> - & Says

"This is my dearly loved Son (God in expression to you). Listen to him!"

& then - Mark 9:8 (NLT)

8 Suddenly, when they looked around, Moses and Elijah were gone, and they saw only Jesus with them.

WHAM – Jesus is Transfigured – Showing a portion of his Glory

Moses & Elijah show up – Also Glorified

& then God the Father – who dwells in UNAPPROACHABLE LIGHT

COVERS his *unapproachable Glory* – in a **CLOUD** & God - **SPEAKS**

Listen to Jesus – who is God in Expression

& then - As Suddenly as it all happened - it's OVER

& the <u>Disciples have to be</u> – in <u>absolute Shock</u> – & <u>Finally</u> – <u>Peter is Speechless</u>

Now – I just want to Finish – with three Incredible TRUTHS we see in the Transfiguration

I <u>want</u> to thank <u>Pastor Colin Smith</u> (Unlocking the Bible) - I've <u>ADAPTED his OUTLINE</u> here – (credit to him)

#1) You Will Be YOU After Death

Moses died 1200 years before this day Elijah died 800 years earlier

& yet - <u>Here</u> they <u>are <u>Alive & Well</u> - in <u>Relationship with</u>, and <u>Working alongside</u> <u>Jesus</u></u>

They are **NOT Gone** – They are **NOT asleep** as **some mis-interpret** the **KJV language** for **death**

& <u>Yes</u> - <u>they</u> were <u>Heroes</u> of the <u>Bible</u> But they <u>were still</u> – <u>JUST MEN</u>

& they are with Jesus to Represent the Law & The Prophets

But <u>they GOT There</u> – <u>By FAITH in God</u> <u>Just like</u> we <u>get</u> there

& (most importantly)
They are STILL – Who they Were on Earth

- They are <u>NOT Reincarnated</u> as something <u>else</u>
- They are <u>NOT Angels</u>
- They are <u>NOT floating</u> on a <u>cloud</u> with a <u>Harp</u>

& they are **NOT any** of that other **crazy stuff** we **come up with** about **death**

They are STILL - Who they WERE - In Life

Guys - when God created you he created YOU - AS YOU - For Eternity

This is clear in **Gen 1:27** when **God** created Mankind

There will never be a time

when you <u>CEASE to be you</u> – or **become** some-thing else – rather than you

& more importantly – God created you to BE in RELATIONSHIP with Him – for Eternity

BUT – the **Bible** also **makes clear**

The **relationship** you **have** with God in **THIS LIFE**

will be the basis of your Relationship with God for ETERNITY

& this is true for BOTH

Those who **Believe and Receive**AND – for those who **Reject and Rebel**

Ecclesiastes 11:3 (ESV)

3... in the place where the tree falls, there it will lie.

So - #1) You Will Be YOU After Death

& #2) You Will Be KNOWN After Death

The disciples **immediately KNEW** that this was **Moses** & **Elijah** –

We don't know HOW they knew

But – <u>if</u> the <u>HOW</u> was the <u>important</u> part God would've told us HOW they knew

The <u>important part</u> is <u>Moses & Elijah</u> – <u>WERE KNOWN</u>

AND they were 'in relationship' with the Glorified Jesus

& so will YOU BE - IF you put your Faith in Him!!

You <u>will be KNOWN</u> in <u>Heaven</u>

Because your <u>Identity Goes with you</u> into <u>Heaven</u>

But **also** because - **God** is a **RELATIONAL God**

God *Exists IN Relationship* – in the **Trinity**

& <u>We</u> were <u>created</u> *IN & For Relationship* with <u>God</u>

<u>Jesus</u> Christ <u>DIED for you</u> – <u>SO THAT</u> you <u>could be</u> in <u>Relationship</u> with <u>God</u>

God made us - IN & FOR - Relationship - Both with HIM - & with OTHERS

& he made us that way - for Eternity

& we **SEE THAT** here

in the Relational interaction

Between Moses, Elijah, & Jesus

So - #1) You Will Be YOU After Death #2) You Will Be KNOWN After Death

& # 3) If you are in Christ, you will share His Glory After Death

The Bible says - when we put our Faith in Jesus Christ

We **become so Identified** with him
That we are "IN Christ" - (identified w/ him by faith)

& so - we see here - NOT ONLY the glory of Jesus

but ALSO <u>Moses</u> & <u>Elijah</u> - <u>Sharing</u> the <u>Glory of Christ</u>

IN Eternity - it will not ONLY be Jesus
who will be Glorified -

But WE – thru Faith in HIM – will ALSO be glorified – WITH HIM – (Rom 8)

& here – The Disciples get the slightest glimpse of that - & it had to blow their minds

2 Thessalonians 2:14 (NLT)

14 He called you to salvation when we told you the Good News; now you can share in the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.

<u>1 John 3:2 (NLT)</u>

2... we do know that [when he appears] we will be like him, for we will see him as he really is.

We **need to KNOW** - the Bible says –**THRU our Faith**

We will **SHARE** his **GLORY** – & in his **INHERITANCE** - for **eternity**

& we need to allow that promise - to drive us toward him

God BECAME a Man – in the person of Jesus Christ – all so that YOU CAN KNOW God

Jesus Christ IS - God "In Expression" to you

& **not only** can we **KNOW God** thru **Jesus** Christ

But we can <u>also STAND</u> in the <u>presence</u> of the Almighty God – *thru Jesus Christ*

2 Corinthians 5:21 (NLT)

21 For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ.

Which is what it takes - to Stand in his Presence

Thru Faith in Jesus Christ

We can be **MADE RIGHT** with **God**

We can have a **REAL RELATIONSHIP** with **God**

& we can live for **ETERNITY** in the **Glory** of **God's Presence**

Today - By God's Grace & thru Your Faith in Jesus

You can KNOW God - & you can freely receive
Right Standing with God

& you can look forward to

a very <u>REAL LIFE</u>
in a very <u>REAL ETERNITY</u>
in very <u>REAL RELATIONSHIPS</u>
Sharing <u>THE GLORY</u> – of Jesus Christ

Let's Pray
