## bait09 - Offense in Communion - 1Corinthians 11:17-34

This msg is PART of our "Bait of Satan" series but this one IS NOT following the book – by that name

#### Today is Communion Sunday

So - <u>I thought</u> we'd <u>dig</u> into this <u>topic</u> of <u>Offense</u> - <u>as it relates</u> <u>to Communion</u>

Communion is a <u>Wonderful</u>, <u>Glorious</u>, <u>Beautiful</u> thing for us to <u>EMBRACE</u> - and be <u>in AWE of</u>

<u>AND</u> - Contrasting <u>Offense AND Communion</u><u>AND</u> Looking at the <u>Possibility</u> of <u>Offense IN Communion</u>

Is a <u>great way</u> for us to <u>continue learning</u> how to <u>AVOID</u> "Taking the Bait of Satan" in <u>OFFENSE</u>

#### **Let's Pray**

<u>Jesus</u> instituted <u>Communion</u> at the <u>Last Supper</u> <u>on</u> the <u>night</u> <u>before</u> his <u>death</u>

<u>Communion</u> was a <u>PART OF</u> the <u>Last Supper</u> - it <u>came</u> at the <u>END OF</u> the <u>Last Supper</u>

& <u>One Thing</u> for <u>SURE</u> – <u>That First</u> Communion "<u>Put on Display</u>"

# Was The UNITY & SHARING of LIFE of EACH of the Disciples With JESUS

& The <u>UNITY</u> & <u>SHARING of LIFE</u> the <u>Disciples had</u> with <u>each other</u> – <u>THRU</u> the <u>Life</u> of <u>Jesus</u>

# Let's start by reading thru the institution of Communion By Jesus

## Matthew 26:26-29 (NLT)

26 As they were eating, Jesus took some bread and blessed it. Then he broke it in pieces and gave it to the disciples, saying, "Take this and eat it, for this is my body."

27 And he took a cup of wine and gave thanks to God for it. He gave it to them and said, "Each of you drink from it, 28 for this is my blood, which confirms the covenant (new) between God and his people. It is poured out as a sacrifice to forgive the sins of many. (meaning all who would receive it) 29 Mark my words—I will not drink wine again until the day I drink it new with you in my Father's Kingdom."

There is Such HUGE Significance in this ACT

that it has become ONE of only <u>TWO Sacraments</u> in the Church – (with <u>BAPTISM</u> being the other one)

& <u>BOTH</u> – <u>Communion</u> & <u>Baptism</u> – are <u>SO SIGNIFICANT</u> <u>because</u> they are <u>BOTH</u> described as the <u>VISIBLE GOSPEL</u>

<u>Meaning</u> - The <u>Gospel Message</u> is "<u>Put on Display</u>" – it is <u>DRAMATIZED</u> - in <u>BOTH</u> of these <u>Sacraments</u>

## **Communion - Is The Visible Gospel**

#### **Communion puts ON DISPLAY**

Our **SHARING IN** the Very Life of Jesus AND Our **SHARING IN** His Payment for our sins

## **Communion puts ON DISPLAY**

Our <u>UNITY</u> (Oneness) – with the <u>Life</u>, <u>Death</u>, & <u>Resurrection</u> of <u>Jesus</u>

#### & Communion puts on DISPLAY

what **UNITES** us - as the **BODY of Christ** 

#### Because we have been MADE ONE

by our **Common SHARING** – in the **LIFE** of **JESUS** 

#### **SHARING** in the **LIFE** of **Jesus** – **BOTH**

<u>UNITES us</u> to <u>Jesus</u> – & - <u>UNITES us</u> to <u>One Another</u>

#### & THAT is what the Act of Communion Puts on Display

The **Biblical concept** of **KOINONIA plays** a **huge roll** 

in <u>BOTH</u> - the <u>Communion MEAL</u> <u>AND</u> the <u>Sacrament of COMMUNION</u>

The **GREEK Word** - **KOINONIA** 

is **most often** Translated **FELLOWSHIP** in the **Bible** 

# **BUT** – The meaning of Koinonia – Also includes Sharing in Common, & Communion."

As in <u>COMMUNING</u> with <u>God</u>
& COMMUNING With One Another

In <u>1 COR 10</u> – <u>We</u> are clearly <u>instructed</u> <u>TO COMMUNE</u> with <u>Jesus</u> and <u>NOT TO COMMUNE</u> with the <u>Demonic spirits</u>
that are behind *IDOL Worship* 

## 1 Corinthians 10:16 (NLT)

16 When we bless the cup at the Lord's Table, aren't we <u>sharing</u> (Koinonia, sharing in common) in the blood of Christ? And when we break the bread, aren't we <u>sharing</u> (Koinonia, sharing in common) in the body of Christ?

The **CONTEXT** of **1 Cor 10** – is actually an **Awesome example** of **how** to **AVOID causing OFFENSE** in the **church** 

<u>But</u> – For <u>Time's Sake</u> <u>We'll</u> have to <u>Save that</u> for another <u>Day</u>

#### & so, the ACT of Communion

- Is **Us Sharing** in the **Life of Jesus**
- & <u>Us Sharing</u> the <u>Life of Jesus</u> <u>in Common</u> <u>with one another</u>
- & so (obviously) the words DISCORD, DIVISION, & OFFENSE

  Are 180 Degrees OPPOSITE

  of EVERYTHING Communion is meant to convey By God

# WITHIN Good Bible believing churches - There are many different VIEWS on the How's & When's & Who's of Communion

But - <u>Isn't</u> it <u>interesting</u> – <u>how</u> all these <u>different VIEWS</u> on <u>Communion</u>

Tend to cause more <u>DIVISION & OFFENSE</u>
than they <u>cause UNITY?</u> – (When Communion is all about UNITY?)

So – <u>Let's look</u> at how we can AVOID *BRINGING OFFENSE* - INTO COMMUNION

In <u>1 COR CH 11</u> – <u>Paul</u> is <u>addressing</u> <u>Instructions For Public Worship</u>

## & we'll pick it up in - 1 Corinthians 11:17-18 (NLT)

17 But in the following instructions, I cannot praise you. For <u>it</u> sounds as if more harm than good is done when you meet <u>together</u>. (this can totally be true in church)

18 First, I hear that there are <u>divisions</u> among you when you meet as a church, and to some extent I believe it.

<u>Paul's</u> beginning <u>most awesome</u> <u>display</u> of <u>UNITY & ONENESS</u> <u>BOTH</u> with <u>The Lord</u> & with <u>Each Other</u> – <u>being Communion</u>

& he <u>starts</u> with this <u>unbelievable statement</u> – that <u>instead</u> of coming <u>together</u> in <u>UNITY</u> and <u>COMMON GOOD</u> – <u>Paul</u> says

I hear that there are <u>divisions</u> among you when you meet as a **church** – (there's our <u>1st sign</u> of <u>Offense in Communion</u>)

#### & then we read in - 1 Corinthians 11:19 (NLT)

19 But, of course, there must be divisions among you so that you who have God's approval will be recognized!

I LOVE the ESV's Translation here

## 1 Corinthians 11:19 (ESV)

19 for there must be factions among you in order that those who are genuine among you may be recognized.

<u>MEANING</u> – <u>those</u> who are <u>Genuine</u> will <u>NOT BE INVOLVED</u> in the <u>divisions</u> and <u>factions</u> in the church - (I love that)

#### & So – Paul comes to THIS conclusion

## 1 Corinthians 11:20 (NLT)

20 When you meet together, you are not really interested in the Lord's Supper. (those are pretty hard words)

This "Lord's Supper" is what the "Last Supper" was – It came

BEFORE Communion – Which was at the END of this Meal

This MEAL became known as the AGAPE Feast – & it was meant to SHARE LIFE & COMMUNION in the church

But – Vs.20 says - <u>some</u> are coming – <u>NOT INTERESTED</u> in the *REAL MEANING* or *PURPOSE* of this <u>Communion MEAL</u>

**THESE** are the **people** who are **causing** – **Offense IN Communion** 

## 1 Corinthians 11:21 (NLT)

21 For some of you hurry to eat your own meal without sharing with others. As a result, some go hungry while others get drunk.

The <u>Communion meal</u> was about <u>KOINONIA</u>
It <u>was</u> about <u>Sharing Life in Common</u> – <u>WITH One another</u>

It was <u>NOT</u> about <u>Gluttony</u>, & <u>Drinking</u>, & <u>getting</u> the <u>BEST food</u> before <u>anyone else</u> could

## & so - 1 Corinthians 11:22 says (NLT)

22 What? Don't you have your own homes for eating and drinking? Or do you really want to disgrace God's church (bring offense) and shame the poor? (do you really WANT to offend others) What am I supposed to say? Do you want me to praise you? Well, I certainly will not praise you for this!

Paul is <u>LIGHTING</u> The <u>Corinthian</u> church <u>UP</u> –

For <u>bringing OFFENSE</u> – <u>INTO</u> the <u>Communion MEAL</u>

BY being ONLY Interested in THEMSELVES
& their DESIRES - & their DIVISIONS - & their FACTIONS

& <u>NOT being interested</u> at <u>all</u>
The <u>MEANING & PURPOSE</u> of the <u>Communion Meal</u>

& so then – we get to the famous Communion Passage

Where <u>Paul</u> is <u>REMINDING</u> this <u>Self-Centered church</u> <u>WHAT Jesus instituted Communion AS</u>

## 1 Corinthians 11:23-24 (NLT)

23 For I pass on to you what I received from the Lord himself. On the night when he was betrayed, the Lord Jesus took some bread 24 and gave thanks to God for it. Then he broke it in pieces and said, "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

<u>Paul</u> is <u>saying</u> – Remember <u>WHAT</u> <u>Jesus said</u> <u>ABOUT Communion</u>

Remember WHY Jesus GAVE his Life for us

- & Remember that WE SHARE
  IN The LIFE of the Lord Jesus
- & <u>WE SHARE the Life</u> of the <u>Lord Jesus</u> <u>WITH one another</u>

## <u>& then – in 1 Corinthians 11:25 (NLT)</u>

25 In the same way, he took the cup of wine after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant between God and his people—an agreement confirmed with my blood. Do this in remembrance of me as often as you drink it."

Remember - This is about SHARING IN
The Life of Jesus, that was POURED OUT for us

& <u>SHARING IN</u> the <u>New Covenant</u> of <u>Salvation</u> between <u>God</u> & His <u>People</u>

& <u>Paul</u> is saying <u>Remember</u>, <u>Remember</u>, <u>Remember</u> <u>WHAT</u> the <u>Communion Meal</u> & the <u>ACT</u> of <u>Communion</u> is <u>ABOUT</u>

## It is a SOLEMN Display - of WHAT it COST Jesus Christ

To **SAVE US** from our **sins** - &

For us to be able to COMMUNE with him - in a Real Relationship

#### <u>AND</u> – <u>Communion</u> is a <u>VISUAL GOSPEL</u> to <u>those</u> around <u>you</u>

## 1 Corinthians 11:26 (NLT)

26 For every time you eat this bread and drink this cup, you are announcing (proclaiming) the Lord's death until he comes again.

# Communion is the <u>ACTING OUT</u> of the <u>Wonderful Plan</u> of <u>Salvation</u> – <u>Every time</u> we do it

- & <u>when</u> we <u>take communion</u> we are <u>Announcing our UNION</u> <u>with Jesus</u> – <u>And</u> with ONE ANOTHER as Believers
- & All of THAT is what makes Communion SO AWESOME !!!

So Then – <u>WHO</u> is bringing <u>OFFENSE INTO COMMUNION??</u>

#### 1 Corinthians 11:27 (NLT)

27 So anyone who eats this bread or drinks this cup of the Lord <u>unworthily</u> is guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord.

WHOA - THAT is **Definitely** an **OFFENSE**To **those** in **the Church** - **AND** to **Jesus** 

So, what does this word UNWORTHILY - Mean?

Well – First – The Context here - is Directed at BELIEVERS

## **UNBELIEVERS** are **NOT** the **Primary Context**

Tho **there** is **certainly application** to **Unbeliever's** here as well

The <u>Word</u> - <u>UNWORTHILY</u> is an <u>ADVERB</u> – It <u>DESCRIBES HOW</u> you are <u>Partaking of Communion</u>

Remember – the CONTEXT is BELIEVERS coming to the Communion Meal with Divisions - & Factions - & Self-Interest

#### **Coming to the Communion MEAL**

with **NO thought** of **Sharing** in the **Life of Christ OR Sharing** the **Life of Christ** with **Others** 

#### & So 1 Corinthians 11:28 (NLT)

28 That is why you should <u>examine yourself</u> before eating the bread and drinking the cup.

#### **BEFORE** taking **Communion**

JUST . . . Slow Down - Take a Minute - & Examine Yourself

#### **BEFORE** taking **Communion**

**Slow Down** - & **DEAL with God** for a **minute** 

**BEFORE** you **TAKE PART** - in this **Solemn** & **Significant Act** 

TAKE a MINUTE - TO Examine Yourself & Deal with God

& <u>then</u> comes – <u>THE HAMMER</u>
Which <u>clearly IMPLIES</u> the <u>seriousness</u> of <u>Communion</u>

## 1 Corinthians 11:29 (NLT)

29 For if you eat the bread or drink the cup without honoring the body of Christ, you are eating and drinking God's judgment upon yourself.

WHOA!! - - & Again, the CONTEXT here is BELIEVERS – or at least - "Assumed Believers"

& the Scholars Are in AGREEMENT here
the Judgement here is NOT REFERRING to
a Believer LOSING their Salvation

But <u>INSTEAD</u> – This Judgment is referring to <u>God's Disciplinary Judgment</u> – (which I'd rather avoid as well)

Paul is talking about Believers
coming to this Solemn Communion Act

WITHOUT Examining their OWN Heart & OWN Lives before God

& <u>Thereby</u> – <u>DISHONORING the Lord</u> By <u>just</u> "<u>Going Thru The Motions</u>"

#### Psalm 86:15 says (NLT)

15 But you, O Lord, are a God of compassion and mercy, slow to get angry and filled with unfailing love and faithfulness.

**THAT** is **SO TRUE** of **God** 

HE IS a God of compassion and mercy, slow to get angry and filled with unfailing love and faithfulness

<u>AND</u> . . . . <u>Living</u> in a <u>Life of Sin</u> - <u>HAS Consequences</u> <u>Including For Believers</u>

& **some** of those **consequences** are **SERIOUS** 

As the next vs says - 1 Corinthians 11:30 (NLT)

30 That is why many of you are weak and sick and some have even died.

<u>WHAT???</u> - <u>YEAH</u> - <u>BUT???</u> - <u>HOW</u> do you <u>EXPLAIN</u> this Vs?

I think – the BEST way to Explain it is

We should probably Approach
COMMUNING with the LORD

AND our COMMUNING with other believers
MORE SERIOUSLY

**Remember** – the **CONTEXT** here

Is <u>BELIEVERS</u> - <u>Causing OFFENSE</u> to <u>other Believers</u> <u>AND</u> thereby <u>OFFENSE to the Lord</u> . . .

BY HOW they APPROACH the Communion Meal
And the Sacrament of Communion

## The GOOD NEWS is in 1 Corinthians 11:31 (NLT)

31 But if we would examine ourselves, we would not be judged by God in this way.

#### WHEW!! - There's the ANSWER

#### **EXAMINE** Yourself -

so **you** will **NOT be Judged** by **God** in this Way

#### & then – there is MORE Good News

# THIS Judgment of God - IS DISCIPLINE SO THAT we will NOT Be Condemned

# THIS Judgment of God - is INTENDED to DRAW US BACK to HIM

## As 1 Corinthians 11:32 says (NLT)

32 Yet when we are judged by the Lord, we are being disciplined so that we will <u>not be condemned</u> along with the world.

#### THAT is ACTUALLY - Really GOOD NEWS

#### King David says in Psalm 32:3-4 (NLT)

- 3 When I refused to confess my sin, my body wasted away, and I groaned all day long.
- 4 Day and night <u>your hand of discipline</u> was heavy on me. My strength evaporated like water in the summer heat.

# That is the kind of judgment Paul is talking about in 1 Cor 11 God's Hand of Discipline Heavy Upon us

#### & then - King David says in the Next Vs's

## **Psalm 32:5-6 (NLT)**

5 Finally, I confessed all my sins to you and stopped trying to hide my guilt. I said to myself, "I will confess my rebellion to the Lord." And you forgave me! All my guilt is gone.

6 Therefore, let all the godly pray to you while there is still time . . .

#### There is STILL TIME!

There is STILL TIME for US - TODAY

& <u>we</u> are <u>about</u> to <u>TAKE THE TIME</u> to <u>get</u> our <u>hearts right</u> – <u>BEFORE</u> we <u>Take Communion</u>

#### FINALLY – in 1 Cor 11

Paul RETURNS to the ORIGINAL Subject
To CONFIRM he is STILL in the SAME CONTEXT

## 1 Corinthians 11:33-34(a) (NLT)

33 So, my dear brothers and sisters, when you gather for the Lord's Supper, wait for each other.

34 If you are really hungry, eat at home so you won't bring judgment upon yourselves when you meet together . . .

#### WHOA !! - ALL of this - Really IS About

**HOW** we **APPROACH** The **COMMUNION Meal** 

& <u>HOW</u> we <u>APPROACH</u>
SHARING IN the Life of Jesus - IN Communion

# Guys - <u>The MEANING</u> - <u>& the SIGNIFICANCE</u> of <u>Communion</u> Is <u>SO BIG</u>

## That we MUST – Take a Minute

- to **EXAMINE** ourselves
- to Get out HEART RIGHT
- to Truly **DEAL WITH GOD**

## **BEFORE we Take Communion**

**Let's Do that NOW** 

## **Let's Pray**
