Jsph 14 - The Blessings of Integrity - Gen 46:31 - 47:27

Webster's Defines Integrity **THREE Ways** - but here's my favorite

Integrity: The quality or state of being <u>undivided</u>

I think that may be Warren Wiersbe's favorite Definition also

Warren Wiersbe (as Quoted by Chuck Swindoll);

A person with integrity is not divided (that's duplicity) or merely pretending (that's hypocrisy). He or she is whole; life is "put together," . . People with integrity have <u>nothing to hide</u> and <u>nothing to fear</u>. Their lives are open books.

Prov 10:9

9 Whoever walks in integrity walks securely, but he who makes his ways crooked will be found out.

& Jesus Christ explained Integrity this way . . .

Luk 16:10-13 - ESV

10 "One who is faithful in a very little is also faithful in much, and one who is dishonest in a very little is also dishonest in much.

11 If then you have not been faithful in the unrighteous wealth, who will entrust to you the true riches?

12 And if you have not been faithful in that which is another's, who will give you that which is your own?

13 No servant can serve two masters, for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and money."

Integrity is; The quality or state of being undivided

If we bear the <u>Name of CHIRST</u> - We are <u>called</u> to a <u>Life of Integrity</u> in <u>Church</u> - at <u>Work</u> - & most importantly - at <u>Home</u>

But <u>we cannot</u> attach <u>different priorities</u> to these <u>different areas</u> of our lives (that's Duplicity or Hypocrisy)

& it's a TRAP so many Christians have fallen into

We COMPARTMENTALIZE our lives

We act one way at **Church**We act another way at **Work**& then yet another way at **Home**

But we <u>need to understand</u> - <u>GOD</u> is <u>NOT</u> <u>Compartmentalized</u> & He <u>did NOT</u> give us <u>Compartmentalized</u> lives

We are **ALWAYS** living before God & God is the **ONLY ONE** Who knows our <u>True Integrity</u>

Our TRUE INTEGRITY - is ONLY seen By GOD

Because True Integrity
Is what you do - When NO ONE Else is Looking

Joseph lived a life that was Right before God when no one else was looking

& today - we see the <u>Immeasurable Blessings</u> of Joseph's life - lived in *True Integrity*

& <u>I Pray</u> it <u>challenges</u> our hearts to be <u>Totally Undivided</u>
Especially <u>When No One else is looking</u>

Let's Pray

Since the beginning of our study Joseph has modeled - True Integrity

& today - we're going to see the Results of his Life of Integrity

There are **NO** "*Defining Moments*" in today's text **Those moments** have **already happened** . . .

They've been happening since Joseph was 17 yrs old

The Defining Moments happened when;

Joseph was **sold into slavery**

He became **Manager of Potiphars** house

He Refused to be duped by **Sexual Temptation**

He became **Manager of the prison** he was thrown into

He was **Left Forgotten** when he deserved to be released

He became the **Prime Minister** of Egypt

He orchestrated the **Divine Forgiveness** of his brothers

& today we see the **RESULTS** of all those **Defining Moments** put together . . .

Today we see - The Blessings of Integrity

But <u>pls be careful</u> . . . <u>don't be sayin'</u>

"Well I've already blown it, I guess it's too late for me"

It is **NEVER Too Late**

Thru out scripture Men & Women w/ No Integrity
have been Transformed into Godly Men & Women WITH Integrity

& so <u>If we can't relate</u> to Joseph's <u>Life Long integrity</u>

<u>Take hope</u> - <u>Stand strong</u> - & <u>Start today</u>

Start Living in *True Integrity* today

& God will transform you - by the renewing of your mind

Put on Jesus Christ - Really, Truly, Totally, Put On Jesus Christ & He will Radically change your life - STARTING TODAY!

& If we'll <u>start walking</u> with God in <u>True Integrity</u> today

He'll wash away the Past - & He'll give us a new Future (AMEN?)

<u>Remember</u> - Last msg <u>Joseph</u> was <u>reunited w/ his father</u> Jacob in an incredible family reunion

& now - we pick it up in the very Nxt Vs - w/ Joseph preparing the Family - to meet the Pharaoh

Gen 46:31-34 -ESV

31 Joseph said to his brothers and to his father's household, "I will go up and tell Pharaoh and will say to him, 'My brothers and my father's household, who were in the land of Canaan, have come to me.

32 And the men are <u>shepherds</u>, for they have been <u>keepers of livestock</u>, and they have brought their flocks and their herds and all that they have.'

33 When Pharaoh calls you and says, 'What is your occupation?'

34 you shall say, 'Your servants have been <u>keepers of livestock</u> from our youth even until now, both we and our fathers,' in order that you may dwell in the land of Goshen, <u>for every shepherd</u> is an abomination to the Egyptians."

- Right off the bat we see <u>Joseph</u>
 using the Wisdom his <u>life has taught him</u>
- & he gives his family counsel on what to say to the Pharaoh
- Some commentators make a pretty big deal about the fact that two different Hebrew words are used here for the family's occupation
- 1) "Keepers of Livestock"
- 2) "Shepherds"
- But actually The HEB word for "Livestock"

 can refer to any domestic animal, including sheep

 so we can't make too big a deal out of that
- The <u>real insight</u> is <u>Joseph knew</u> the land of <u>Goshen</u> would be <u>the best land</u> for his family
- & <u>explaining to Pharaoh</u> that they are <u>shepherds</u> (tho despised) would be the <u>best way</u> to get them to <u>Goshen</u>
- The <u>land of Goshen</u> was somewhat <u>separated</u> from the "<u>Mainstream</u>" <u>Egyptian</u> culture
- & <u>Joseph knew</u> his family could <u>live there</u>
 <u>& not</u> be <u>totally absorbed</u> by Egypt
- & this Insight by Joseph is <u>actually the key</u> to <u>Israel growing</u> so incredibly huge <u>over the next 400 years</u>

So Joseph **gets his Family prepared**, & then - he **gets Pharaoh prepared**

Gen 47:1-6 - ESV

- 1 So Joseph went in and told Pharaoh, "My father and my brothers, with their flocks and herds and all that they possess, have come from the land of Canaan. They are now in the land of Goshen."
- 2 And from among his brothers he took five men and presented them to Pharaoh.
- 3 Pharaoh said to his brothers, "What is your occupation?" And they said to Pharaoh, "Your servants are <u>shepherds</u>, as our fathers were."
- 4 They said to Pharaoh, "We have come to sojourn in the land, for there is no pasture for your servants' flocks, for the famine is severe in the land of Canaan. And now, please let your servants dwell in the land of Goshen."
- 5 Then <u>Pharaoh said to Joseph</u>, "Your father and your brothers have come to you.
- 6 The land of Egypt is before you. Settle your father and your brothers in the best of the land. Let them settle in the land of Goshen, and if you know any able men among them, put them in charge of my livestock."
- It is **absolutely incredible** what Joseph's **life of Integrity** before Pharaoh has **brought him**
- <u>Pharaoh says</u> Give them <u>the best</u> Do what you think <u>is best</u> & if you want put them <u>in charge</u> of my Livestock too
- & notice in <u>V. 4</u> they ask to only <u>SOJOURN</u> in the land - They just need to stay <u>awhile</u> They're just <u>passin thru</u>
- Which is kinda true if you consider 400+ yrs Just passin thru!

Now - in <u>V.7</u> - <u>Joseph</u> brings his father <u>Jacob</u> to Pharaoh - & <u>as is Appropriate</u> - The <u>Greater</u> blesses the <u>Lesser</u>

The only <u>strange thing</u> here is <u>JACOB</u> blesses <u>PHARAOH</u>

Gen 47:7-10 - ESV

7 Then Joseph brought in Jacob his father and stood him before Pharaoh, and <u>Jacob blessed Pharaoh</u>.

8 And Pharaoh said to Jacob, "How many are the days of the years of your life?"

9 And Jacob said to Pharaoh, "The days of the years of my sojourning are 130 years. Few and evil [or hard] have been the days of the years of my life, and they have not attained to the days of the years of the life of my fathers in the days of their sojourning."

10 And <u>Jacob blessed Pharaoh</u> and went out from the presence of Pharaoh.

It has always been correct for the GREATER to bless the LESSER

Pharaoh knew - <u>Jacob</u> was the <u>Patriarch</u> of Joseph's people & <u>Pharaoh</u> undoubtedly knew of <u>Joseph's God</u>

& <u>incredibly</u> - <u>Jacob</u>, this <u>now Homeless Hebrew Shepherd</u>
<u>Displays</u> a greatness <u>OF GOD</u> even the <u>Pharaoh</u> recognizes

& JACOB the Greater - blesses PHARAOH the ruler of Egypt

& so - in doing ALL THIS . . .

Joseph makes sure everything is <u>taken care of</u> both in his **FAMILY** - & in his **WORK**

& then the fledgling Nation of Israel settles in Egypt's most fertile land

Gen 47:11-12 - ESV

11 Then Joseph settled his father and his brothers and gave them a possession in the land of Egypt, in the best of the land, in the land of Rameses, as Pharaoh had commanded. 12 And Joseph provided his father, his brothers, and all his father's household with food, according to the number of their dependents.

It is <u>**BECAUSE**</u> of his <u>**Life of Integrity**</u> that Joseph could <u>**orchestrate**</u> this <u>incredible blessing</u>

& it is the <u>Direct Result</u> of <u>Joseph's Integrity</u>
that keeps the nation of Israel ALIVE during this Famine

& <u>now it's time</u> for Joseph to <u>go back</u> to <u>saving</u> the nation of <u>Egypt</u>

& again we see Joseph's Integrity

both in his **POSITION** of serving Pharaoh, & with the **PEOPLE** he is charged with *overseeing*

Gen <u>47:13-14 → →</u>

Gen 47:13-14 - ESV

13 Now there was no food in all the land, for the famine was very severe, so that the land of Egypt and the land of Canaan languished by reason of the famine.

14 And Joseph gathered up <u>all the money</u> that was found in the land of <u>Egypt</u> and in the land of <u>Canaan</u>, in exchange for the grain that they bought. And Joseph brought the money into Pharaoh's house.

Joseph lived in absolute Integrity -

Right in the midst of what could really be called "ALL THE MONEY IN THE WORLD" - (V.14)

& there is **NO indication** that "All the Money in the World" ever **Affected** - or **Infected** - Joseph

Joseph Lived out a Life of Integrity

& he already knew - what Jesus said in Mat 6:24

Mat 6:24 - ESV

24 "No one can serve two masters, for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and money.

No Matter <u>How much</u> money you have (whether Little or Much) You <u>MUST CHOOSE</u> whether to Serve <u>God</u> - or Serve <u>Money</u>

Joseph chose well - & he passed ALL that money on to Pharaoh

But then **eventually** - Joseph collected **ALL the money** there was & the people were **still hungry** . . .

Gen 47:15-17 - ESV

15 And when the money was all spent in the land of Egypt and in the land of Canaan, all the Egyptians came to Joseph and said, "Give us food. Why should we die before your eyes? For our money is gone."

16 And Joseph answered, "Give your livestock, and I will give you food in exchange for your livestock, if your money is gone."

17 So they brought their livestock to Joseph, and Joseph gave them food in exchange for the horses, the flocks, the herds, and the donkeys. He supplied them with food in exchange for all their livestock that year.

ALL the money is now Pharaoh's

So Joseph says . . . Bring me ALL your livestock

& that **kept the nation fed** for another year

& ALL the Livestock went - To Pharaoh!

But then eventually

ALL the **Money** was Pharaoh's ALL the **Livestock** was Pharaoh's

and the People were **STILL hungry...**

Gen 47:18-22 → →

Gen 47:18-22 - ESV

18 And when that year was ended, they came to him the following year and said to him, "We will not hide from my lord that <u>our money is all spent</u>. The <u>herds of livestock</u> are my lord's. There is nothing left in the sight of my lord but our bodies and our land.

19 Why should we die before your eyes, both we and our land? Buy us and our land for food, and we with our land will be servants to Pharaoh. And give us seed that we may live and not die, and that the land may not be desolate."

20 So <u>Joseph bought all the land</u> of Egypt <u>for Pharaoh</u>, for all the Egyptians sold their fields, because the famine was severe on them. The land became Pharaoh's.

21 As for <u>the people</u>, he made <u>servants</u> of them from one end of Egypt to the other.

22 Only the land of the priests he did not buy, for the priests had a fixed allowance from Pharaoh and lived on the allowance that Pharaoh gave them; therefore they did not sell their land.

Wait a minute . . .

FIRST Joseph collects ALL the Money in Egypt - FOR PHARAOH
THEN Joseph collects ALL the Livestock in Egypt - FOR PHARAOH
THEN Joseph collects ALL the Land in Egypt - FOR PHARAOH
THEN Joseph collects ALL the PEOPLE in Egypt - FOR PHARAOH

Joseph has pretty much <u>collected everything</u> there is for the <u>benefit of his BOSS</u>!!

& there is <u>NEVER</u> an indication that Joseph ever had <u>Negative feelings</u> about his <u>Job</u> - or <u>Boss</u>

- I don't care <u>where you are</u> <u>in the Workplace</u> <u>or the Ministry</u> there is <u>very probably a time</u> when you have said . . .
- HEY <u>They don't deserve</u> all that it was <u>my work</u>, <u>my effort</u>, <u>my idea</u> that got them all that
- & they just <u>sit there</u> like a big <u>fat cat</u>
 & <u>l'm</u> doing <u>all the work</u> around here
- That sin of <u>Jealousy</u> & <u>Envy</u> & <u>Self-Centeredness</u>

 Exists in <u>EVERY</u> Workplace <u>EVERY</u> Ministry <u>EVERY</u> Heart
- & in a <u>Pure Display</u> of the <u>Sin Nature</u> We cry out - *It's Not Fair to ME . . .*
- I Deserve More I Deserve Better I Deserve to be Appreciated . . . I know you do . . .
- But **do you understand** that your **Sin Nature** is **causing** you to **LASH out** like that?
- **Do you understand** that **whatever else** is going on that those feelings in **YOU ARE SINFUL** !!
- We must commit to "Do what is RIGHT before the Lord" no matter what the circumstances are . . .
- & then Let God be God Let Him Decide how it all works out
- Over & over we've said:

Joseph did what was right before the Lord - Regardless of the circumstance or situation

& we've got to **do the same thing**& then we'll **let God** sort out all the rest - **OK?**

So - Joseph basically <u>accumulates</u> <u>EVERYTHING in Egypt</u> <u>for the benefit</u> of the Pharaoh - *including the people*

But he **NEVER** - **NEVER** takes <u>unfair advantage</u> of any <u>person</u> - or any <u>situation</u>

In fact - look back at Gen 47:21

Gen 47:21 - ESV

21 As for the people, he made servants of them <u>from one end</u> of <u>Egypt to the other</u>.

Gen 47:21 - NKJ

21 And as for the people, <u>he moved them</u> into the cities, <u>from</u> one end of the borders of Egypt to the other end.

What <u>Joseph</u> actually did was <u>spread</u> the <u>people</u> out <u>evenly</u> over <u>ALL of Egypt</u> - in order to <u>save their lives</u>

Remember - That's what he told his brothers that God had sent him there to do

& now that he oversees ALL the Land - & ALL the People he spreads the people out evenly - to SAVE THEM

Look at this **Win-Win** plan from Joseph

Gen 47:23-26 - ESV

23 Then Joseph said to the people, "Behold, I have this day bought you and your land for Pharaoh. Now <u>here is seed</u> for you, and <u>you shall sow</u> the land.

24 And at the harvests you shall give a fifth to Pharaoh, and four fifths shall be your own, as seed for the field and as food for yourselves and your households, and as food for your little

ones."

25 And they said, "You have saved our lives; may it please my lord, we will be servants to Pharaoh."

26 So Joseph <u>made it a statute</u> concerning the land of Egypt, and it stands to this day, that Pharaoh should have the fifth; the land of the priests alone did not become Pharaoh's.

Wow - talk about the chance to take some credit . . .

The people of Egypt say to Joseph - "You have saved our lives"

But instead of Taking any Credit, or showing any Animosity toward Pharaoh (his boss)

Instead - he <u>makes it a statute</u> (decree) that <u>Pharaoh</u> should get <u>20% of everything</u> the <u>entire land</u> of Egypt produces

& so - <u>TWO Nations</u> are <u>saved from Starvation</u> & <u>Pharaoh</u> gets <u>20%</u> of everything grown!

ALL of the benefits of Joseph's Integrity went TO others;
The Pharaoh - Joseph's Family - All of Egypt . . .

<u>WHEN</u> does this guy <u>ever do Anything</u> - for <u>HIMSELF</u> !!! <u>Let me think</u> NEVER !!!

Joseph is a **Type of Christ** - He is a **Picture of Christ**

AND he is a living example of what we are called to as Christians

So don't blow Joseph off - & say "oh that's too high an example "

We are called to **be Like CHRIST**

& Joseph's life paints a picture of exactly what that looks like

OK - to close, let's get one more look at Joseph's family

Gen 47:27 - ESV

27 Thus Israel settled in the land of Egypt, in the land of Goshen. And they gained possessions in it, and were fruitful and multiplied greatly.

& by the time <u>this Season</u> is over <u>Israel</u> will become a <u>nation</u> of over <u>2 Million</u> strong . . .

Trained in the hardships of Egypt
& then Brought Out - to the Promised Land

And in the end - The Nation of **EGYPT** - & The Nation of **ISRAEL** were **both saved** - Thru the **Integrity** of the *Life of Joseph*

Yes **Joseph** is a **Picture of Christ** (*especially in this salvation*)

But <u>he is also</u> a picture - <u>of the integrity</u> we are <u>called to have</u> - both in our **families** & in our **work**

<u>Joseph</u> was responsible for a <u>country</u> on the verge of <u>starvation</u>
& he made <u>all the money in the world</u> for his boss

But <u>he still</u> put his <u>family</u> first - he still took care of his <u>family</u> - right in the midst of "<u>saving the world</u>"

How about us - **Dads** - I'm **talking especially** to you right now

We **come home** from working for **8 hours** not hardly saving the world

& <u>our wives ask</u> us to minister to our children & we <u>snap back</u> - "don't you know what I've been doing,
I've worked all day"

<u>MEN</u> - pls listen to me - <u>STOP WHINING</u> get your <u>priorities</u> straight

Do your best at work make your boss money - make the Co. successful

& then come home & do the REAL MINISTRY

Come home & have Integrity with your family
do what's right for them - Serve them with all you have

& <u>when you</u> lay your <u>head down</u> on your <u>pillow</u> at night - you <u>must know</u> you've <u>given</u> your all - <u>IN INTEGRITY</u> . . .

& if you will **Confirm that** Every Night **in your heart**I Promise You . . .

God will **Bring Blessings upon Blessings** thru your Integrity **to those** God has called you to serve
