Abide 09 - Abide in Fellowship - PT 2 - 1Cor 12:12-27

Let's Pray Right up front

Well - It seems like forever since I've been here -Remember – we're studying our Critical Need – TO ABIDE !! Today is our **9th msg** in this very cool study But it's been a while since we began it – So LET'S REVIEW 1) Abide to Thrive We looked at WHAT ABIDING in Christ - IS 2) Our Need to Abide We looked at **WHY** it's so important we *LEARN* to **ABIDE** 3) Top Priority – A Love Relationship We made it clear - Our Love Relationship with God is the Single Most Important, Top Priority, in our lives. 4) If I Rest, Will God Work? We asked the Question - If I will FOCUS on ABIDING **WILL** God really Work Out the details of my life? (YES) 5) The Holy Spirit in Abiding Where we looked at Holy Spirit's Critical ROLE in Abiding Then **we switched** to the **PRACTICAL** Msg's 6) HOW to Abide in Prayer 7) HOW to Abide in the Word

8) HOW to Abide in Fellowship - PT 1 . . .

But - I just couldn't do "Abiding in Fellowship" in just ONE Msg

Really - I <u>couldn't do</u> justice to <u>Abiding in PRAYER</u> or <u>Abiding in the WORD</u> - in One Msg either

But when it came to <u>Abiding in FELLOWSHIP</u> (Last Msg) I <u>got to share</u> with you - a <u>Huge Burden</u> I have

& that is - that we live in a <u>Consumer Christian Culture</u> -& that culture is very <u>Detrimental</u> to <u>ABIDING</u> in Fellowship

Because we are <u>trained</u> by the culture - to always be <u>looking</u> for something <u>bigger</u>, <u>better</u>, or <u>different</u>

& when that Consumer Mentality comes to CHURCH

It does <u>Tremendous Damage</u> to what <u>God</u> wants to do <u>IN</u> <u>US</u>, & <u>THRU</u> <u>US</u> - <u>AS A BODY</u>

& so <u>we took</u> (basically) the <u>ENTIRE</u> last message & looked at <u>ONE KEY Word</u> - in the <u>KEY</u> Fellowship <u>Text</u>

The KEY Fellowship Text is ACTS 2:42 ff - which says;

Acts 2:42 (ESV)

42 And they <u>devoted</u> themselves to the apostles' teaching and the <u>fellowship</u>, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.

The <u>KEY</u> <u>Word</u> we focused on in the last Msg was - <u>DEVOTED</u> they <u>devoted</u> themselves to . . . the <u>fellowship</u>

& we looked carefully at <u>WHAT IT MEANS</u> to be <u>DEVOTED TO</u> a specific group of believers

That is a really important subject

I hope you heard that Msg - or will pick it up at W-B-M

<u>There is</u>, however - the <u>Possibility</u> of a <u>Misunderstanding</u> that <u>could come</u> out of <u>these</u> <u>messages</u>

These Msg's COULD BE Misunderstood as

"You need to <u>WORK</u> more, or <u>DO</u> more, For the <u>Benefit</u> of a specific church"

& that would be a really unfortunate misunderstanding

Because the Spiritual Truth of ABIDING in Fellowship

is <u>SO MUCH DEEPER</u> than just <u>WORKING MORE</u> or <u>DOING MORE</u> - for the benefit of <u>One Specific Church</u>

These Messages are About the Fact that . . .

If you are <u>SAVED</u> today then God says <u>YOU</u> are <u>PART</u> of the <u>Body of Christ</u>

<u>God says</u> that He has made <u>EACH</u> of us to be <u>FUNCTIONING MEMBERS</u> of the <u>Body of Christ</u>

1 Corinthians 12:27 (NLT)

27 <u>All</u> of you together are Christ's body, and <u>each of you</u> is a part of it.

<u>EACH</u> of us - <u>who</u> have <u>put our FAITH</u> in Jesus Christ Have been <u>MADE</u> to be a <u>Functioning PART</u> of the Body of Christ

The Problem is . . .

Our <u>church culture</u> has made us <u>SPECTATORS</u> & <u>CONSUMERS</u> so we're <u>always looking</u> for what we can <u>GET</u> from church But that is the <u>total complete</u> <u>OPPOSITE</u> of <u>EVERYTHING</u> Biblical about <u>HOW</u> the the <u>Body of Christ</u> <u>has been made</u> to operate

If you belong to Christ today - Then He has <u>made you</u> to be a <u>FUNCTIONING PART</u> of <u>HIS Body</u>

& So - Our heart's DESIRE should be to <u>BECOME</u> what God has made us <u>TO BE</u> - & to be <u>DOING</u> what God has made us <u>TO DO</u>

AMEN ??

- Now that **MIGHT** mean *for a time* that **God** has made you, to <u>Sit</u> Perfectly Still, <u>Absorbing</u> His Truth, & <u>Learning</u> to Love Him
- & In fact IF we would <u>all</u> do <u>THAT</u> - <u>FIRST</u> & <u>ROUTINELY</u> <u>The Rest</u> of what we try to do for Christ - Would go <u>MUCH BETTER</u>
- So <u>YOUR</u> Functioning <u>Role</u> in the Body <u>MIGHT BE</u> <u>Simply Learning</u> <u>How</u> to <u>Follow Jesus</u> as a <u>Disciple</u>
- Or <u>YOUR ROLE</u> in the Body might be <u>Serving</u> the Lord <u>OUTSIDE</u> of a <u>specific church</u>

That is **ALSO** being an **ESSENTIAL PART** of the **Body of Christ**

TOM & CHERYL REES are an essential, integral, functioning part of THIS group of believers

But they live & serve the Lord, on the Other Side of the World

So - <u>Whether</u> in your <u>PERSONAL</u> life, <u>FAMILY</u> life, <u>WORK</u> life, <u>CHURCH</u> life, or <u>MISSIONARY</u> life . . .

These msg's are about

1) Being a **FUNCTIONING PART** of the Body of Christ - **AND**

2) About ABIDING in (being Devoted to) FELLOWSHIP (Koinonia)

(again) Acts 2:42 (ESV)

42 And they <u>devoted themselves</u> to the apostles' teaching and <u>the</u> <u>fellowship</u>, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.

Let's Look at One More KEY THING about this Key Vs.

The GREEK Word for FELLOWSHIP here - is KOINONIA

& one of the <u>Most Interesting</u> things about the word <u>FELLOWSHIP</u> (<u>Koinonia</u>)

Is that - at <u>the ROOT</u> of this word is the <u>clear picture</u> - of <u>DOING</u> things <u>TOGETHER</u>

it means <u>NOT ONLY</u> to <u>Share in Common</u>, or to <u>Have things in Common</u>

But at *its ROOT* - it's a picture of *DOING things in Common*, *Participating in Common*

<u>HOWEVER</u> - it's <u>not</u> about <u>DOING</u> the things <u>WE'VE</u> come to know as <u>fellowship</u> - - meaning <u>Recreational Activities</u>

KOINONIA is about doing the <u>Things of God</u> - <u>TOGETHER</u> as the <u>Body of Christ</u> The Word <u>KOINONIA</u> is used <u>19 times</u> in the NT But <u>NOT</u> just as "*Fellowship*" - <u>ALSO</u> as;
Making <u>Contribution</u>
Joining in <u>Participation</u>
Taking <u>Part</u> in - &

Sharing your faith, & your stuff

Notice - <u>ALL</u> these uses of the Word - <u>KOINONIA</u> have to do with <u>ACTION</u> - <u>BEING PART</u> of something <u>happening</u>

[REPEAT LIST]

KOINONIA is <u>NOT</u> the <u>Greek</u> word for - <u>POT LUCK</u> <u>KOINONIA</u> is being <u>PART</u> of what <u>the BODY of Christ</u> is <u>DOING</u>

& <u>THAT</u> - brings me to the <u>BIG HOW</u> of this Msg

In each of these Practical Messages I've tried very hard to say; Here is one - <u>HOW</u>... Here's <u>One Way</u> that you can actually <u>DO THIS</u>

& so - if you ask me - <u>HOW Dave ??</u> <u>HOW</u> do I <u>Begin</u> to <u>ABIDE in Fellowship</u>

I can easily tell you - <u>FELLOWSHIP Means</u>; <u>TAKING PART</u> in what the Body of Christ is <u>DOING</u> !!

Abiding in Fellowship MEANS; Being <u>PART</u> of what the <u>Body of Christ</u> is <u>DOING</u> - & then; Being <u>DEVOTED</u> to <u>that</u> Group of Believers & that doesn't mean that you can never leave a church

<u>it means</u> that you are <u>Devoted</u> to being a <u>productive part</u> of what <u>God is doing</u> in a <u>certain group</u> of believers <u>until</u> God moves you

it means you're <u>NOT</u> a <u>Consumer Christian</u> <u>Spectating</u> - & Waiting to <u>RECEIVE</u> instead of to <u>GIVE</u>

It means you <u>Seek God</u> for the <u>specific</u>, <u>unique place</u> that <u>He</u> has made <u>YOU</u> to <u>FIT</u> in the <u>Body of Christ</u>

& <u>then</u> you <u>Commit</u> to <u>FUNCTION</u> in that place in a <u>POSITIVE</u> way

THAT guys - is True Koinonia !! (Sharing in what God is doing)

& <u>Being DEVOTED</u> to <u>THAT</u> is <u>ABIDING IN FELLOWSHIP !!</u>

I know that doesn't sound very SPECIFIC

but <u>becoming part</u> of the <u>Body of Christ</u> is <u>NOT</u> <u>SPECIFIC</u> it's a very <u>INDIVIDUAL</u> thing for <u>EVERY BELIEVER</u>

Let's see how it looks in Scripture - -

I'm going to **<u>read</u>** a **<u>LONG TEXT</u>** - from <u>**1Cor 12**</u> - From the <u>**NLT**</u>

Let's <u>try to Grasp</u> the <u>BIG PICTURE</u> Here Try <u>NOT</u> to <u>Dissect</u> the Text - Let's <u>Read it</u> for the <u>BIG PICTURE</u>

<u>1 Corinthians 12:12–27 (NLT) $\rightarrow \rightarrow$ </u>

1 Corinthians 12:12–27 (NLT)

12 The human body has many parts, but the many parts make up one whole body. So it is with the body of Christ.

13 Some of us are Jews, some are Gentiles, some are slaves, and some are free. But we have all been baptized into one body by one Spirit, and we all share the same Spirit.

14 Yes, the body has many different parts, not just one part. 15 If the foot says, "I am not a part of the body because I am not a hand," that does not make it any less a part of the body. 16 And if the ear says, "I am not part of the body because I am not

an eye," would that make it any less a part of the body? 17 If the whole body were an eye, how would you hear? Or if your whole body were an ear, how would you smell anything? 18 But our bodies have many parts, and God has put each part just where he wants it.

19 How strange a body would be if it had only one part! 20 Yes, there are many parts, but only one body.

21 The eye can never say to the hand, "I don't need you." The head can't say to the feet, "I don't need you."

22 In fact, some parts of the body that seem weakest and least important are actually the most necessary.

23 And the parts we regard as less honorable are those we clothe with the greatest care. So we carefully protect those parts that should not be seen,

24 while the more honorable parts do not require this special care. So God has put the body together such that extra honor and care are given to those parts that have less dignity.

25 This makes for harmony among the members, so that all the members care for each other.

26 If one part suffers, all the parts suffer with it, and if one part is honored, all the parts are glad.

27 All of you together are Christ's body, and each of you is a part of it.

Man, I <u>Hope</u> you <u>SEE IT</u> Because <u>THAT</u> - is <u>TRUE Koinonia</u> !!

That's **THE BODY** - Working Together - **AS ONE** !! That's **Koinonia** !!

FUNCTIONING Together - In **Unity** - **AS** the Body of Christ **<u>& THAT</u>** - is a **Beautiful Thing** !!

The Question is . . . ARE YOU A PART OF IT ??

In <u>the BIG PICTURE</u> - Can you say I am a <u>FUNCTIONING Part</u> of the <u>Body of Christ</u>??

<u>Don't get me wrong</u> - I'm not asking if you serve in the <u>Children's Ministry</u>, or the <u>Ushers Ministry</u> (tho I'd appreciate it if you would)

I'm <u>asking</u> you - if you <u>consider yourself</u> Part of the <u>Body of Christ</u>

<u>Can you say</u> - "I have an idea what it is God has made <u>ME</u> to be at least AT <u>THIS TIME</u>, & IN <u>THIS PLACE</u>"

Do you have <u>SOME SENSE</u> that you <u>KNOW</u> (to some extent) <u>what</u> it is God would have you <u>DOING</u> Right Now (as part of His Body)

What is it that your ROLE in the Body might be - RIGHT NOW ??

Let me give you some ideas/suggestions & you see if the Holy Spirit causes any of these to JUMP OUT

1) Becoming a Disciple

Greatest Role - Prerequisite Role - OK as SOLE Role

2) Becoming a Christian to Your Spouse, Children, Family

If you bypass this Role & try to move on - you become a Hypocrite

3) <u>Becoming a Christian to Friends & Co-Workers</u> God disguises Christians as co-workers to spread the Gospel

4) Helping/Supporting other Believers

Gal 6:2 (NLT) - Share each other's burdens, and in this way obey the law of Christ. - Help out those that are next to you

5) Becoming a Discipler

Helping others become followers of Jesus -Generally those who God puts in your life

6) Serving in a Specific Role in the church

Helping make church happen - physically and/or spiritually dozens of options - everything you can think of

7) Becoming an Evangelist, Pastor, Administrator The price is high, and so are the rewards

8) Becoming a Giver

Since the days of Abraham, God's ministry has required Givers

I put it last, because it's usually the last thing Christians figure out, even tho it's one of our greatest possible blessings

EIGHT General Categories

of where you might **FUNCTION** in the Body of Christ

<u>& Notice</u> - <u>All</u> the Roles are about <u>BECOMING !!</u>

It's funny to me how people say;

Well I <u>can't</u> really <u>do</u> anything -So I <u>guess</u> I'll <u>never</u> do anything . . .

<u>Just think</u> if your <u>child</u> had <u>that attitude</u> <u>when</u> they were learning to <u>WALK</u>

Well, I can't really do that - so I guess I never will

Guys - If you <u>feel DRAWN</u> to <u>something</u> in the <u>Body of Christ</u> It's <u>Very Possibly</u> because God has <u>COMPLETELY</u> <u>EQUIPPED</u> you for it

<u>Unfortunately</u> - sometimes people <u>desire</u> certain <u>positions</u> out of <u>PRIDE</u> & <u>EGO</u>

But God has a WAY - of "Working that Out"

So as long as it's **NOT** your **PRIDE** drawing you to a **certain position**

Then it is **PROBABLY** the **Holy Spirit** Who has **<u>Gifted</u>** You, Is **<u>Drawing</u>** You, & Will <u>Equip</u> You

1 Corinthians 12:11 (NLT)

11 It is the one and only Spirit who distributes all these gifts. He alone decides which gift each person should have.

The <u>Holy Spirit</u> <u>ALONE</u> <u>Decides</u> where <u>you</u> should <u>be functioning</u> in the <u>Body of Christ</u>

Then He puts THAT Desire in your heart to Match the Gift that He's given you

<u>**THAT**</u> is how you are "<u>*Drawn*</u>" to a <u>**particular Role**</u> in the Body

The <u>ONLY</u> Role that is <u>NEVER</u> given by the <u>Holy Spirit</u> is the <u>ROLE</u> of <u>SPECTATOR</u> !!

If you got <u>Saved</u> <u>YESTERDAY</u> - then your <u>ROLE</u> is to <u>learn</u> how to <u>Follow Jesus</u> as His Disciple

So **EVERY** Believer has **SOME Role** in the Body

Amen??

So - <u>WHY</u> is this <u>SO IMPORTANT</u> - - -Why is "<u>Abiding in Fellowship</u>" <u>So Important</u> ??

<u>WHY</u> is it <u>SO IMPORTANT</u> that we become a <u>FUNCTIONING PART</u> of a Local <u>Body of Believers</u> ??

Let's <u>turn over</u> to <u>EPH CH 4</u> & we're going to <u>answer</u> that <u>question</u> - <u>TWICE</u>

In <u>EPH CH 4</u> - we see <u>TWO HUGE REASONS</u> Why we must <u>Abide in Fellowship</u> with other Believers

I'm using the NLT a lot today

<u>Because</u> we're doing a <u>BIG PICTURE</u> / <u>SURVEY</u> style study - which the <u>NLT</u> is <u>so good</u> for

<u>So</u> - To <u>GET</u> to the <u>FIRST</u> Reason - - We've got to <u>1ST SEE</u> <u>WHAT</u> the <u>JOB</u> of the Church <u>LEADERSHIP</u> <u>IS</u> . . . Ephesians 4:11–12 (NLT)

11 Now these are the gifts Christ gave to the church: the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, and the pastors and teachers. (in general, the leaders)

12 <u>Their responsibility</u> is to equip <u>God's people</u> to do <u>his work</u> and <u>build up the church</u>, the body of Christ.

This <u>often comes</u> as a <u>shock</u> to people -<u>But</u> the <u>Job</u> of the <u>LEADERS</u> - is to <u>Equip</u> <u>YOU</u> - to do <u>GOD'S</u> Work

<u>Look</u> carefully at <u>Vs 12</u> <u>OUR Responsibility</u> is to Equip <u>YOU</u> to do God's Work

But our Responsibility doesn't end there

Not only are we **<u>Responsible</u>** to Equip you to do <u>**GOD'S WORK**</u> We're also <u>**Responsible**</u> to Equip you to <u>**BUILD UP**</u> the <u>**CHURCH**</u>

Do you see it ??

Our JOB - is to Equip YOU - to FUNCTION together For YOU to ACCOMPLISH God's <u>Purposes</u> For YOU to BUILD UP the <u>Church</u>

& <u>THAT</u> - is True <u>KOINONIA</u>

- <u>THAT</u> is the <u>True Meaning</u>, of <u>Koinonia</u> . . . To Share together, in <u>DOING</u> God's Work
- & <u>THAT</u> is Truly <u>HOW</u> God <u>DESIGNED IT</u> In order to <u>MAKE</u> <u>DISCIPLES</u> of all the Nations
- & <u>THAT</u> is the <u>FIRST Reason</u> why <u>EACH</u> of us have <u>GOT to be PART</u> of the <u>Body of Christ</u>

<u>Now</u> - I said the <u>FIRST REASON</u> why <u>Abiding in Fellowship</u> is so important - <u>often</u> comes as <u>SHOCK</u> to people

Well - the SECOND REASON

Sometimes comes as even MORE of a SHOCK

Why is it so important to be a functioning part of the BODY of Christ ??

<u>The 2nd Reason is because;</u> *True Spiritual Growth CANNOT happen OUTSIDE of being a functioning part of the Body of Christ*

Now - <u>Everybody</u> who <u>refuses</u> to be a <u>FUNCTIONING PART</u> of the Body of Christ would quickly <u>Disagree</u> with me . . .

Which **Further Substantiates** my claim

Guys - True Spiritual Growth CANNOT occur in a VACUUM

Our <u>Spiritual Maturity</u> Requires that we <u>be CONNECTED</u> with <u>other Christians</u>

Because anybody can be <u>Christ-Like</u> in a <u>MONASTERY</u> It's a <u>little harder</u> around a bunch of <u>sinners</u> in the <u>CHURCH</u>

Look at the continuation of our <u>Eph 4</u> Passage Let's <u>start over</u> at <u>Vs.11</u> - Again from the <u>NLT</u> Ephesians 4:11–15 (NLT)

11 Now these are the gifts Christ gave to the church: the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, and the pastors and teachers. 12 Their responsibility is to equip God's people to do his work and build up the church, the body of Christ.

13 This will continue until we all come to such unity in our faith and knowledge of God's Son that we will be mature in the Lord, measuring up to the full and complete standard of Christ.

14 Then we will no longer be immature like children. We won't be tossed and blown about by every wind of new teaching. We will not be influenced when people try to trick us with lies so clever they sound like the truth.

15 Instead, we will speak the truth in love, growing in every way more and more like Christ, who is the head of his body, the church.

This is such a GREAT PASSAGE !!

The **<u>REASON</u>** we are ALL called to <u>**Abide in Fellowship**</u> together

Is because THAT is how we ALL will GROW;

In <u>UNITY</u>

In **KNOWLEDGE**

In MATURITY

& then we will **NO LONGER** be **Immature** like Children (vs.14)

We <u>won't</u> be <u>tossed</u> & <u>blown</u> about by <u>every wind</u> of teaching We <u>won't</u> be <u>influenced</u> when <u>people</u> try to <u>trick</u> us

INSTEAD - We'll <u>Speak the Truth</u> in Love <u>Growing</u> in every way, more & more like Christ

Who is the HEAD of His Body - the church - - AMEN !!!

THAT is the FINAL REASON WHY - - We MUST become a Functioning Part of the Body of Christ

Our **TRUE** Spiritual Growth - **VITALLY** Depends on it

Guys - <u>God designed</u> the <u>Body of Christ</u> so that it <u>NEEDS</u> - <u>EVERY PART</u>

- & God WILL make us "Fit Together" even perfectly
- & <u>IF</u> we will <u>EACH</u> do our <u>PART</u> then we will <u>HELP</u> the other parts <u>GROW</u>

Until the Whole Body is Healthy & Growing & Full of Love

Doesn't sound like a <u>GOOD</u> Idea ?? Doesn't that sound like a <u>GOD</u> Idea ??

Let's read the LAST VS of this Passage in Eph 4 - to close

Ephesians 4:16 (NLT)

16 He makes the whole body fit together perfectly. As each part does its own special work, it helps the other parts grow, so that the whole body is healthy and growing and full of love.

THAT'S what happens - when we are ABIDING in Fellowship

- & <u>if you need</u> <u>HELP getting</u> started -<u>start talking</u> to <u>people</u> about it,
- & <u>don't stop</u> until you're <u>IN</u> the position God <u>created you</u> to be in
