ROM 211 - Our Position "IN CHRIST" - Rom 6:1-14

We've been looking at our <u>Justification</u> by faith alone for the past <u>10 MSG'S</u>

& now (finally) **it's time** to put that **Justification** by Faith Alone **TO WORK**

Justification - is being Declared Righteous before God

- & we are <u>Declared Righteous</u> before God <u>because of our <u>Identification</u> with Christ</u>
- & our <u>Identification</u> with Jesus Christ that brings our <u>Justification</u> before God is actually the <u>Foundation</u> for <u>everything else</u> in the Christian Life
- & if we will Grasp <u>THAT</u> miraculous <u>KEY</u> <u>everything else</u> in the Christian Life will <u>fall in place</u>

Today - we are going to **BUILD** on the **Foundation** of our **Identification** that brings **Justification**

& today we're going to add - Sanctification

Sanctification is a **Big Bible word** that means; **Our NEW LIFE in Christ**

& the reason I'm using all these Big Bible words is to make it clear - →

that **EVERTHING** in our Christian Life **BEGINS**with the *Foundation* - of our *Identification* **IN CHRIST**Including - all the way up to - our **Glorification**

I know I'm <u>making you crazy</u> with all these <u>BIG WORDS</u>
But the <u>BIG POINT</u> of the message today is

Our <u>Salvation</u> & Our <u>Sanctification</u> - <u>ARE INSEPERABLE</u>

<u>because</u> they both come from our <u>IDENTIFICATION</u> with Jesus Christ

& Jesus Christ does not offer one without the other

If we <u>truly surrender</u> our Life to Jesus Christ as Savior & Lord then that <u>ONE ACT</u> of <u>Identification</u> with Him

BOTH Saves us from the Judgment of God

AND replaces our old life of Sin & Death with HIS New Life of Peace & Righteousness

We are <u>dead to Sin</u> thru our <u>Identification</u> with Christ

& thru that SAME identification we are ALSO raised to New Life In Christ!

Let's Pray

Romans has made the truth of Justification by faith alone so completely clear - there has been No Room for doubt

In Fact - Paul has made this case so strong that he "senses" a crazy argument growing in his listeners

& the fact that he would have to even deal w/ this type of argument is PROOF

of how hard he has addressed Justification by FAITH ALONE

Here's the "anticipated argument" - in Rom 6:1

Rom 6:1 - ESV

1 What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin that grace may abound?

Because Paul has made it SO CLEAR that NO Works can merit Salvation
He anticipates this crazy response

<u>if Paul</u> had taught even <u>a mixture</u> of Faith & Works this **crazy question** would never be asked

But it's such a BIG anticipated response that Paul addresses it 3 times in this context

In <u>Ch 3</u> – he dealt with it the first time & he <u>condemned</u> those who would even <u>think</u> like this Here – <u>in 6:1</u> - he <u>begins</u> our text with it & again <u>in 6:15</u> – He <u>begins</u> next week's text the same way

So - He <u>anticipates</u> this <u>crazy question</u>

& THAT sets up the beginning - of the building of our NEW LIVES on the firm foundation

of our **Identification**

that brings <u>BOTH</u> Justification - & - Sanctification

ROM CH 6 is about to permanently connect

the <u>truth</u> of our <u>Justification</u> - TO the <u>truth</u> of our <u>Sanctification</u>

& these **TWO TRUTHS** can **NEVER** be separated

if ONE TRUTH is TRUE - then the OTHER TRUTH must be TRUE

& **the beginning** of this Truth - **is seen** in Paul's answer to the ridiculous question of **V.1**

Again Rom 6:1 said

1 What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin that grace may abound?

<u>& then Rom 6:2 - ESV</u>

2 By no means! How can we who died to sin still live in it?

Remember - - If **ONE TRUTH** is **TRUE**, then the **OTHER TRUTH** must be **TRUE**

& Here is the FIRST TRUTH

How can we who died to sin still live in it?

<u>Thru your Identification</u> with Jesus Christ When **He died** to sin - **You Died** to Sin "**IN HIM**"

<u>This</u> is the <u>Federal Headship</u> Theology that we just **HAMMERED HOME** in our msg last week

Your Faith in Christ - caused you to be so Identified with Him that when He died to Sin - You died to Sin with Him

& so now - Paul says

How can we who died to sin still live in it?

<u>If</u>, in fact, you have <u>died to</u> sin "<u>IN CHRIST</u>"
Then - <u>HOW</u> can you still be "<u>LIVING IN SIN</u>"

Col 3:3 - ESV

3 For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God.

If you have surrendered your life to Jesus Christ then your old life of sin - HAS DIED - SO . . .

how can you live any longer in it? (as v.2 says)

But <u>maybe your question</u> today is <u>OK</u>, <u>HOW</u> can I put that into <u>PRACTICE</u> in my life

How can I live day-to-day in Victory Over Sin How can I live day-to-day Glorifying God

Well - Honestly - The HOW question is going to take THREE CH'S to answer - so stay with me

<u>Today</u> we begin with our <u>identity</u> (our position) in Christ

& then we're going to build all the way up, to the POWER of Walking in the Spirit - in Rom Ch 8

... oh, it's going to be good

The First Step - After Justification by FAITH ALONE is we must KNOW who we are "IN CHRIST"

We <u>MUST</u> come to know our "<u>Identity</u>" (Position) <u>IN CHRIST</u>

<u>THAT</u> is the <u>first layer</u> in building our <u>NEW LIFE</u> in Christ

I promise you - <u>if the enemy</u> can keep you <u>ignorant</u> of who you really are <u>in Christ</u>

Then he can keep you **Defeated & Enslaved** to your sin

Understanding our Position in Christ - is actually the **Secret Weapon**

to Overcoming Sin

& Living in the New Life to God

Again - the Foundation is our Salvation by Faith in Christ ALONE

THEN comes the **FIRST STEP** in our New Life in Christ which is **understanding our Position** (Identity) *in Christ*

Vs's 3 & 4 - Perfectly Explain our Identification with Christ

We'll start with Rom 6:3

Rom 6:3 - ESV \rightarrow \rightarrow

Rom 6:3 - ESV

3 Do you not know that all of us who have been <u>baptized</u> into Christ Jesus were <u>baptized</u> into his death?

If you've been <u>Baptized</u> into Christ Jesus you've been <u>Baptized</u> into His Death

But <u>this word Baptize</u> - doesn't <u>just mean</u> <u>being dunked in water</u> - **it means sooo much more**

There are **2 Greek words** for our word 'baptize'

'bapto' = to immerse & remove quickly

That would be **the word used** for what **physically** happens **when we** get baptized in water - **it means LIT - TO DIP**

However - Water Baptism is a physical picture of a spiritual event

It's a <u>picture</u> of what happens <u>spiritually</u> when we are <u>united to Christ</u> thru faith

"bapto" (to DIP) is NOT the word used for what happens spiritually

The 2nd word for baptize is . . .

'baptizo' = to be so Identified - as to bring on a permanent change

'baptizo' means - a permanent change has taken place

The picture is that of a Cucumber becoming a Pickle;

The Cucumber is <u>IMMERSED</u> into the Vinegar until a <u>Permanent Change</u> is brought on - <u>THAT</u> is <u>BAPTIZO</u>

& that New Pickle - can NEVER become a CUCUMBER again !
It can't go back

The word used here - is BAPTIZO

it <u>means</u> we have been <u>so Identified</u> with Christ that a <u>Permanent Change</u> has occurred

When you <u>truly surrender</u> your life to <u>Jesus Christ</u> as your Lord . . .

You become so identified with Jesus - that His Life IN YOU brings about a permanent change - In your life

You become **so identified** with Christ that when **Christ died** to SIN - - You died with Him

So Positionally – **IN CHRIST** - you are **dead to sin** !!!

Gal 3:27 - ESV

27 For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

You have been **SO IDENTIFIED** with Christ that you've **PUT ON** *HIS* Identity

THAT is your **POSITION** in Christ & it's the Beginning of your New Life in Christ

Now - the pieces really start to come together in V.4

Rom 6:4 - ESV \rightarrow \rightarrow

Rom 6:4 - ESV

4 We were buried therefore with him by baptism [baptizo/identification] into death, in order that [so that], just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life.

When you Surrender your life to Jesus Christ
You become so identified with Him . . .
that whatever happened to Christ - - has happened to you

When <u>He died</u>, <u>you died</u> in Him When <u>He rose</u>, you rose in Him - to Walk in <u>Newness of Life</u>

& in fact - You are ALREADY seated with Him in the heavenlies!

All because you have been United to Christ - BY FAITH

Look at Eph 2:6 - NLT

6 For he raised us from the dead along with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms <u>because</u> we are <u>united</u> with Christ Jesus.

THAT is your *position* "**IN CHRIST**"

- & **because of** this **incredible union** with **Jesus Christ** you **now have** a totally **new relationship** to **SIN**
- & THAT new relationship is based on our being UNITED to Jesus Christ
- & we see that in Rom 6:5 \rightarrow \rightarrow

Rom 6:5 - ESV

5 For if we have been <u>united</u> with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be <u>united</u> with him in a resurrection like his.

"united" - in Greek - literally means "grown together"
Like two branches that have become "One Life"

We have been <u>grafted into</u> Jesus Christ -In God's eyes we are <u>joined to Christ</u> (United with Him)

- & <u>When</u> He <u>overcame</u> the <u>power of sin</u>
 <u>We overcame</u> the <u>power of sin</u> "in Christ"
- & THAT is exactly HOW the New Life in Christ is lived IN US

Look at Gal 2:20 in the NLT

20 My old self has been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. So I live in this earthly body by trusting in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

It is No longer I who live - But Christ Lives in me!!

What does this mean practically?

It means: we are no longer slaves to sin
because we have DIED to Sin - In Christ - &
we are ALIVE to God - In Christ

This is our **POSITION** in Christ **DEAD TO SIN** - **ALIVE TO GOD**

Now - Paul is going to really drive home this truth - in Vs's 6 & 7

Rom 6:6-7 - ESV

6 We know that our old self was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be <u>brought to nothing</u>, so that we would no longer be enslaved to sin.

7 For one who has died has been set free from sin.

Our "Old Self" - Our Sin Nature - Our Old Life was crucified with Christ

in order that our **Body of Sin** might be **brought to nothing**

When it says **brought to nothing** here The **most literal** translation is "**rendered inoperative**"

It means - that Sin's Dominance (Power) has been broken

We are <u>not slaves</u> to sin any more <u>We are freed</u> from the power of sin – "<u>in Christ</u>"

Look at how the NLT translates V.7

Rom 6:7 - NLT

7 For when we died with Christ we were set free from the power of sin.

Let's make this clear once & for all

<u>If you</u> have been <u>Identified</u> with <u>Jesus Christ</u><u>by</u> putting your <u>full faith & Trust in Him</u> . . .

Then - You have been SET FREE from the Power of sin

Now - <u>That doesn't mean</u> you have <u>become sinless</u> it means that Sin no longer has POWER over you

<u>Altho</u> - unfortunately - <u>You still have</u> the <u>Free Will</u> to <u>CHOOSE SIN</u> <u>But the Power</u> of Sin <u>no longer</u> has <u>DOMINANCE</u> over you

Because when you died with Christ (v.7) you were SET FREE from the Power of Sin

& Remember

There are **TWO TRUTHS** that are **Inseparably connected**

One Truth CANNOT be true without the other Truth ALSO being true

If it's True that we <u>Died with Christ</u> to our sin - then It is ALSO true - that <u>we will Live with Him</u> - A life to God

That's what our next 3 vs's say

If we've been identified with Christ in His Victory over Sin & Death

Then we've also been identified with Christ in the life He lives to God

Let's look at Rom 6:8-10

Rom 6:8-10 - ESV \rightarrow

Rom 6:8-10 - ESV

8 Now if we have died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him.

If <u>one truth</u> is <u>True</u> - the <u>other truth</u> <u>MUST</u> be <u>True</u>

<u>If we've died</u> with Christ to sin - then we will <u>also live with Him</u>

9 We know that Christ being raised from the dead will never die again; death no longer has dominion over him.

<u>Death</u> no longer has <u>dominion</u> over <u>CHRIST</u>& <u>IN CHRIST</u> - <u>death</u> no longer has <u>dominion</u> over <u>US</u>

10 For the death he died he died to sin, once for all, but the life he lives he lives to God.

& If **One TRUTH** is **TRUE** the **Other TRUTH** *MUST* be **TRUE**

Jesus Christ <u>Died to Sin</u> - Once - For <u>ALL</u> & the Life He now lives - he lives to God

& if we are Identified with Him in His Death to SinWe must also be Identified with Him in His Iife to God

In other words - we can't say;
I'll take the DEATH TO SIN part
but I'll PASS on the LIVE TO GOD part

It <u>doesn't</u> work <u>like that</u> - because it is a <u>Single identification</u> with a <u>Single Life</u> - The <u>Life of Jesus Christ</u>

& in <u>True Identification</u> with his Life - <u>BOTH</u> Truths are <u>TRUE</u> we have <u>Died to Sin</u> - - & we <u>LIVE to God</u>

OK - Now we come to the *practical application* of this *Great Truth*

Rom 6:11 - ESV

11 So you also must consider yourselves [underline] dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus.

The <u>NKJV</u> says - <u>Reckon Yourselves</u>
(I think because the <u>Translators</u> were from <u>Texas</u>)

Reckon Yourselves - Dead to Sin & Alive to God (NKJ)
Consider Yourselves - Dead to Sin & Alive to God (ESV)
(NIV) Count yourselves - Dead to Sin & Alive to God

The <u>most literal translation</u> is "<u>put to your account</u>" the fact that you are <u>dead to sin</u> - & <u>alive to God</u> in Christ Jesus

We have got to **accept BOTH** of these truths as **absolute reality** in our lives

IN CHRIST - we are Both - Dead to Sin - & - Alive to God

This is the beginning of the supernatural power that God has provided for us to live a Victorious life over sin

We need to <u>believe it</u> – <u>accept it</u> – <u>put it to our account</u> – PERIOD!

We are <u>dead to sin</u> - & <u>alive to God</u> in Christ Jesus our Lord

& then Finally today - we must yield to our position in Christ

Rom 6:12 - ESV

12 Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal bodies, to make you obey their passions.

We now (obviously) have a CHOICE;

to Let Sin reign in our lives or NOT

to Obey Sin - or NOT

We <u>have a choice</u> because the <u>Dominance</u> (power) of <u>Sin</u> <u>has been broken</u> by our <u>Identification</u> with Jesus Christ

But the obvious question is . . . How do we do this ?

Yielding to our *Position in Christ* is a **2 step process**

Step #1) DO NOT - offer your body to sin

Rom 6:13A - ESV

13 Do not <u>present</u> your members to sin as instruments for unrighteousness, ...

"Present" means "To Offer"

DO NOT "Offer" the members of your body - to sin

Are you offering sin the use of your **hands**, your **feet**, your **mind**, your **mouth**?

If so – <u>stop it</u> - If you are "<u>In Christ</u>"

<u>Sin No longer</u> has <u>POWER</u> over you

you must **NOT** - **OFFER** sin the <u>use of your body</u> **to be used** as an <u>instrument of unrighteousness</u>

That's step one

Step #2) DO offer your entire being - to God

Rom 6:13B - ESV

... but <u>present</u> yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life, and your members to God as instruments for righteousness.

The word translated "yourself" means; the totality of your entire being

Offer the <u>Totality of your entire</u> being to God as those who have been brought from death to life

AND - Offer your members (your body) to God, as **instruments** of **righteousness**

If you are "Living in Christ" today The power of Sin has been broken . . . SO -

SO - as Rom 6:12-13 says - from the NLT \rightarrow

SO - as Rom 6:12-13 says - from the NLT

12 Do not let sin control the way you live; do not give in to sinful desires.

13 Do not let any part of your body become an instrument of evil to serve sin. Instead, give yourselves completely to God, for [because] you were dead, but now you have new life. So use your whole body as an instrument to do what is right for the glory of God.

Guys - **NONE** of this is **to EARN** anything with God

This is ALL - a Natural Outcome

of our True Identification with Jesus Christ

Paul ends this section - with Rom 6:14

Rom 6:14 - ESV

14 For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under law but under grace.

<u>Living</u> under <u>God's Grace</u> <u>DOESN'T</u> give you <u>license to sin</u> it <u>destroys</u> the <u>power of sin</u> in your life

so that - you can Live a NEW LIFE - to GodFree from the bondage of sin

Let me close - with 2Cor 5:17 - out of the NLT

17 This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!
