Mrk32 – Faith Challenged – Mark 9:14-29

We are **progressively living** in a **world**

<u>Where we have to decide</u> – <u>HOW MUCH FAITH</u> do <u>*I Truly Have*</u> - in <u>Jesus Christ</u> as my <u>LORD</u>

We are called to INCREASING LEVELS of FAITH
in <u>WHO</u> Jesus Christ <u>IS</u>
& in <u>WHAT</u> Jesus Christ Can <u>DO</u>

Let me give you an example of "Increasing Faith"

- 1. <u>I believe</u> there is a <u>higher power</u>
- 2. <u>I believe</u> that power is <u>God</u>
- 3. I believe what the Bible says
- 4. <u>I believe</u> I <u>want</u> to go to <u>heaven</u>, so I'll ask <u>Jesus</u> to be my <u>Savior</u>
- 5. I believe Jesus Christ is LORD over every area of my life
- 6. I believe Jesus can do ANYTHING he wants to, in my life
- 7. I am willing to DIE for my faith in Jesus Christ

Our <u>focus</u> today is <u>Faith Challenged</u> - & <u>Faith Increased</u>

Let's Pray

When our daughter Danielle was 10 yrs old

<u>She & I</u> climbed the <u>back-side</u> of <u>Half-Dome</u> in the <u>Yosemite Valley</u> – with <u>some friends</u>

<u>The 1st day of hiking</u> <u>we were</u> in the <u>beautiful back country</u> & <u>it</u> was all <u>FUN & INSPIRING</u>

maybe like the beginning of a <u>New Christians</u> - <u>Walk</u> with the Lord

But - That night, we (literally) had a bear knock our tent down on top of us, as he rustled around our campsite

& <u>that took</u> some <u>Faith</u> to <u>set</u> our <u>tent back</u> up & <u>get back</u> to sleep

<u>maybe</u> like a <u>New Christian</u> <u>Facing</u> the <u>First Challenge</u> of their <u>Faith in Jesus</u>

But <u>then</u> the <u>next morning</u>, after <u>hiking</u> some <u>more</u> we <u>crested</u> a <u>Rock-Hill</u>

& there it was in front of us

A <u>massive</u>, <u>seemingly</u> <u>straight-up climb</u> to the <u>top</u> - of <u>Half-Dome</u>

To <u>give</u> you <u>an idea</u> of <u>what</u> we were <u>facing</u> I <u>want</u> to <u>put</u> up <u>2 pictures</u>

<u>This</u> – is the <u>View</u> <u>Going UP</u> What is <u>called</u> - the "<u>Cable Trail</u>"

CABLE TRAIL – GOING UP PIC

Notice the safety cables anchored into the rock, & the 2x4's placed every 8 feet or so

& THIS is the view Going DOWN

CABLE TRAIL – GOING DOWN PIC Leave UP until Video

- Notice the death-drop on either side of the trail
- if you were to get out from under those cables
- & <u>notice</u> the <u>height</u> of the <u>cables</u> <u>Perfect</u> for an <u>adult</u> - & <u>Scary enough</u> for an <u>adult</u>

But Danielle was 10 yrs old

& she <u>couldn't really use</u> those <u>cables</u> - <u>they</u> were <u>too high</u> for her

She was tied to me
<u>& I</u> was holding on to the cables

Going up was hard enough

but <u>going down</u> – <u>she had</u> to - <u>sit down</u> on her <u>shoes</u>, & <u>SLIDE</u> from <u>one 2x4</u> to the <u>next</u>

Trusting that I was holding the rope & that I would not let her slide off the trail

Let me just play a quick video for you - < 1 min

& <u>watch toward</u> the <u>end</u> of the <u>Video</u> – for a <u>Picture</u> of <u>Dani & I</u> – at the <u>Top</u> of <u>Half-Dome</u>

PLAY VIDEO

That is an experience - that Danielle & I will never forget

& <u>I believe</u> it's a <u>perfect picture</u> of <u>what</u> it <u>LOOKS</u> like – & <u>what</u> it <u>FEELS</u> like

When Our FAITH in Jesus Christ is CHALLENGED

It is ONLY when our FAITH is CHALLENGED

<u>That we find out</u> – What <u>LEVEL</u> of <u>Faith</u> – we <u>truly have</u>

THAT is **what** this **text** is **about** in **Mark Ch 9**

In our Last Msg in Mark we went up - The Mt of Transfiguration with Jesus

<u>Today</u> – <u>Jesus</u> & the <u>inner-three disciples</u> are <u>coming back down</u> the <u>Mountain</u>

& they're <u>Probably skipping down</u> the <u>mountain</u> <u>after</u> their <u>Mountain-Top</u> experience

<u>Which</u> (btw) is what <u>Danielle</u> and <u>her friend</u> did, as <u>we came down</u> that <u>mountain</u> in <u>Yosemite</u>

But - at the base of that Mountain

The <u>FAITH</u> of the <u>other Disciples</u> & the <u>FAITH</u> of one <u>Desperate Father</u>

Was about to be CHALLENGED

<u>Mark 9:14 (NLT)</u>

14 When they returned to the other disciples, they saw a large crowd surrounding them, and some teachers of religious law were arguing with them.

This - is an intimidating situation for the Disciples

<u>Jesus</u> *isn't there* they <u>have</u> a <u>large crowd</u> around them & <u>there</u> are *instigators* <u>arguing</u> with the <u>Disciples</u>

R. Kent Hughes says of this first Verse

The other nine disciples were being heckled and taunted by a group of leering, self-satisfied scribes . . . the scribes were deriding them for their powerlessness, and were blaspheming Jesus as well.

I'm <u>pretty sure</u> something <u>similar</u> to <u>that</u> <u>happened</u> in <u>PORTLAND</u> last <u>night</u>

So – <u>the crowd</u> is <u>Intimidating</u> the <u>Disciples</u> the <u>instigators</u> are <u>Arguing</u> with the <u>Disciples</u>

& we read in Mark 9:15-16 (NLT)

15 When the crowd saw Jesus, they were overwhelmed with awe, and they ran to greet him. (& Jesus immed. takes control)
16 "What is all this <u>arguing</u> about?" Jesus asked.

This word for ARGUING means Combative Altercation

so <u>maybe</u> the '<u>spirit of Antifa</u>' was <u>around</u> even <u>then</u>

In <u>any case</u> - the <u>Disciples</u> <u>were just glad</u> <u>Jesus</u> <u>showed up</u> <u>when</u> he <u>did</u>

<u>Cont'g - Mark 9:17-18 (NLT) $\rightarrow \rightarrow$ </u>

Mark 9:17-18 (NLT)

17 (The disciples remained silent, But) One of the men in the crowd spoke up and said, "Teacher, I brought my son so you could heal him. He is possessed by an evil spirit that won't let him talk.

18 And whenever this spirit seizes him, it throws him violently to the ground. Then he foams at the mouth and grinds his teeth and becomes rigid. <u>So I asked your disciples</u> to cast out the evil spirit, but they couldn't do it."

For the Disciples things had been going relatively easy - up to this point

Like Danielle & I Hiking in the back country before we got to the <u>Real Challenge</u>

& the <u>other 9 disciples</u> were <u>Continuing</u> the <u>Ministry</u>

while Jesus & the 3 - were on the Mt of Transfiguration

But - here's what happened

the <u>Disciples</u> <u>turned a corner</u> & <u>suddenly</u> what was <u>before them</u> was <u>like nothing</u> they'd <u>ever seen</u>

<u>The Challenge before them</u> was <u>like climbing</u> straight up a <u>treacherous mountain rock</u> <u>& they were trying to climb it</u> but <u>this</u> was <u>NOT</u> a <u>Normal Day</u> or a <u>Normal Path</u> or a <u>Normal Enemy</u>

The situation was getting the best of them & the crowd was jeering & taunting . . .

& <u>they thought</u> – <u>any minute</u> – <u>they</u> were <u>going</u> to <u>slip off</u> that <u>safety cable</u> - & <u>fall to their death</u>

& then Finally, Jesus shows up

& <u>the Disciples</u> probably <u>thought</u> <u>they</u> were "<u>Out of the Woods</u>"

but there was still an important lesson to learn

<u>Mark 9:19 (NLT)</u>

19 Jesus said to them, "You faithless people! How long must I be with you? How long must I put up with you? Bring the boy to me."

Do you sense any *frustration* from Jesus kinda "in-between" the lines there?

Do you think that's pretty Non-Christian-Like

<u>For Jesus</u> to be <u>Frustrated</u> with the <u>Lack of Faith</u> of the <u>People</u>? Do you remember when God

was <u>frustrated</u> with the <u>Israelites</u> – <u>back</u> in the <u>days</u> of <u>Moses</u> in the <u>Wilderness</u>?

Do you think God gets Frustrated with our Lack of Faith? Apparently – He Does . . .

Continuing - Mark 9:20-22 (NLT)

20 So they brought the boy. But when the evil spirit saw Jesus, it threw the child into a violent convulsion, and he fell to the ground, writhing and foaming at the mouth.

21 "How long has this been happening?" Jesus asked the boy's father (I love the calmness). He replied, "Since he was a little boy.

22 The spirit often throws him into the fire or into water, <u>trying to kill him</u> . . .

If you've ever wondered

what the enemy's goal in your life is . . . Here it is

<u>Jesus said in John 10:10 (NLT)</u>

10 The [enemy's] purpose is to steal and kill and destroy

That is the only goal of your spiritual enemy for you

<u>& this particular Demon – had been trying</u> to <u>accomplish</u> his <u>goal</u> in this <u>boy's life</u> <u>since this boy</u> was <u>very young</u>

& his father was **Desperate** to save his son

& <u>so</u> – <u>the father</u> says to <u>Jesus</u> – at the <u>end</u> of v.<u>22</u>

Mark 9:22(b) (NLT)

22 . . . Have mercy on us and help us, if you can."

Then – notice carefully v.23

Mark 9:23 (NLT)

23 "What do you mean, 'If <u>I can</u>'?" Jesus asked. "Anything is possible if <u>a person</u> believes."

<u>Do</u> you <u>see</u> how <u>Jesus</u> <u>TURNS</u> this <u>question</u> into a <u>CHALLENGE</u> of this <u>father's</u> <u>FAITH</u>

Jesus says, "What do you mean 'if I can?" You're kidding me right?

<u>**Do**</u> you <u>think</u> <u>Giving</u> this Demon a <u>*little firm direction*</u> is <u>harder</u> than CREATING the WORLD?

<u>Jesus</u> is saying, *"This is <u>NOT</u> about, <u>if I can"</u> <u>This</u> is <u>about</u> – <i>DO* <u>YOU BELIEVE</u>

This is a Direct <u>CHALLENGE</u> to this <u>*Father's*</u> <u>FAITH</u>

& so <u>then</u> we <u>read</u> – <u>what I think</u> is <u>one</u> of the <u>Greatest Responses</u> to <u>Jesus</u> in the <u>Bible</u>

Mark 9:24 (NLT)

24 The father instantly cried out, "I do believe, but help me overcome my unbelief!"

This Father - seemed to instantly GET IT

His FAITH needed to INCREASE RIGHT THEN - & RIGHT THERE

Let me finish the story about climbing Half-Dome with 10 yr old Danielle

I pointed out the 2x4's every 8 feet in the video

& <u>I mentioned</u> that <u>Danielle</u> <u>could not</u> really <u>USE</u> the <u>safety cable</u> – (too high)

& <u>so</u> - on the <u>way</u> back <u>down</u>

with that "Certain Death-Drop" looming on both sides of the rock

Danielle had to sit on that rock - & SLIDE from One 2x4 to the Next

Being held only by a rope connected to her father

& <u>when</u> it got <u>super steep</u> & <u>scary</u> <u>Danielle</u> <u>FROZE</u> on the rock & <u>she had</u> to decide <u>RIGHT THEN</u> - & <u>RIGHT THERE</u> if <u>she</u> had <u>Enough Faith</u> in her <u>Father</u>

to trust that he would be able to hold onto her

- if <u>she missed</u> that <u>next 2x4</u> & <u>started sliding</u> down that <u>rock face</u>
- & <u>Danielle's Faith</u> in <u>me</u> was <u>CHALLENGED</u> – <u>Right</u> at <u>that POINT</u>
- & partly because of that day Danielle knows Today
- That her Earthly Father will <u>ALWAYS</u> Hold on to her
- & in the years that have passed since then
- Danielle knows EVEN MORE SO that her Heavenly Father will ALWAYS hold on to her

THAT is the **benefit** – of **FAITH** that is **CHALLENGED**

& <u>so</u> – <u>Back to our Text</u>

with the Father's FAITH CHALLENGED
 & with his Prayer to Jesus to INCREASE his Faith

<u>We read in Mark 9:25-27 (NLT) $\rightarrow \rightarrow$ </u>

Mark 9:25-27 (NLT)

25 When Jesus saw that the crowd of onlookers was growing, he rebuked the evil spirit. "Listen, you spirit that makes this boy unable to hear and speak," he said. "I command you to come out of this child and never enter him again!"

26 Then the spirit screamed and threw the boy into another violent convulsion and left him. The boy appeared to be dead. A murmur ran through the crowd as people said, "He's dead."

27 But Jesus took him by the hand and helped him to his feet, and he stood up.

Mission Accomplished

The <u>Demon</u> was <u>GONE</u> from <u>the Boy</u> & the <u>Father's Faith</u> – was <u>Greatly Increased</u>

There's just one more lesson that has to be learned

Mark 9:28-29 (NLT)

28 Afterward, when Jesus was alone in the house with his disciples, they asked him, "Why couldn't we cast out that evil spirit?"

29 Jesus replied, "This kind can be cast out only by prayer."

Jesus had Previously Given the disciples the authority to cast out demons

& <u>so</u> they ask, *why couldn't we do it?*

I can **probably best** explain - from Ministry Life

There are some situations we go into

<u>Where just kinda Walking</u> in the <u>Spirit</u>,
<u>maybe</u> a <u>short prayer</u> <u>thrown up</u> on the <u>way</u> in

Will take care of things spiritually

BUT - sometimes we turn that corner

- & <u>what lies</u> in <u>front</u> of us <u>looks</u> <u>Spiritually Daunting</u> Like <u>climbing straight</u> up a <u>Rock Face</u>
- & <u>at times</u> like that <u>We've got</u> to <u>STOP</u> – <u>We've got</u> to say <u>HOLD ON</u>

This one is going to take some Serious Spiritual Preparation

We <u>can't walk lightly</u> <u>into those</u> <u>Spiritual Situations</u>

Because we know the enemy is especially entrenched in there

& **that** is **when** we **have got** to *Pray Fervently*

We've got to get Fully Prayed Up
We've got to put on The Full Armor Of God
We have GOT to be Full of the Holy Spirit

<u>When Jesus</u> says *This kind can be cast out only by prayer*

He's talking about the <u>Real Thing</u> About <u>Intense Prayer</u> with <u>Real Supplication</u>

He's talking about being Truly Spiritually Ready

& that's exactly HOW we need to approach matters - that CHALLENGE our FAITH

We turn the corner - & we see it ahead

It is DAUNTING & we've GOT to approach it correctly

<u>We need</u> to know – <u>Every move</u> we make - <u>Is Serious</u> & <u>could</u> mean <u>Spiritual Life or Death</u>

<u>& our Spiritual Enemy is THERE</u>
<u>Trying</u> to <u>Discourage</u> us,
<u>& Challenge</u> us,
<u>& trying</u> to <u>throw</u> us <u>Off Balance</u>

so he can get us to "Slip off the path" & Slide Into Oblivion

<u>& So – we've Got to approach these "Faith Challenges"</u> In the *Full Armor of God Full of the Holy Spirit & Fully Prayed Up* ... Ready to meet the enemy

So - <u>Next time</u> you <u>face</u> a <u>Spiritual Situation</u> that <u>looks</u> like the <u>straight up</u> <u>Cable Trail of Half-Dome</u>

Cry out to Jesus - like this father did

Tell him you <u>BELIEVE</u> - & <u>Ask him</u> to <u>INCREASE YOUR FAITH</u> - to <u>match</u> your <u>need</u>

& then know this - for sure

The <u>BIG Spiritual Victories</u> are <u>NOT WON</u> with <u>LITTLE Spiritual Preparation</u>

The **<u>Bigger the Battle</u>** – the <u>Steeper</u> the <u>Spiritual Climb</u> <u>The more</u> we <u>must</u> be <u>PREPARED</u>

We've got to *Trust God* to *Increase our Faith*

& <u>we've got</u> to be <u>Spiritually Ready</u> for the <u>Challenge</u> that <u>lies before us</u>

Let's Pray

Numbers 14:10-12 (NLT)

10 But the whole community began to talk about stoning Joshua and Caleb. Then the glorious presence of the Lord appeared to all the Israelites at the Tabernacle.

11 And the Lord said to Moses, "How long will these people treat me with contempt? Will they never believe me, even after all the miraculous signs I have done among them? 12 I will disown them and destroy them with a plague. Then I will make you into a nation greater and mightier than they are!"
