Rom 206 - The Only Way ! - Rom 3:21-31

Thru the last 4 Msg's - We have been **CONVICTED** of our sin & now we *Stand in Silence* before God - *GUILTY*

For <u>FOUR</u> grueling Msg's we have been Convicted by God's Law

We have seen Clearly - & Repeatedly

In our <u>Nature</u>
In our <u>Actions</u> - &
Even in our <u>Religious Efforts</u> - - <u>WE ARE LOST IN SIN!</u>

In ourselves - We have **NO WAY** to be made **RIGHT** with God

& we <u>MUST</u> come to the place where we stand <u>SILENT</u> before GOD <u>Guilty of our sin</u> - with <u>NO</u> Excuse - & <u>NO</u> Way Out

Has that happened to you yet?

Have <u>you</u> reached that place where <u>you</u> have <u>nothing of yourself</u> to bring God

Has <u>God's Righteous Law</u> Proven to you that you are a <u>Sinner</u>, By <u>Nature</u> & By <u>Choice</u>

& that <u>all your own efforts</u> to <u>be made Right</u> with God are totally useless & worthless?

The <u>PURPOSE</u> of God's Law is to leave us <u>Speechless</u> before the <u>Throne</u> of the <u>Eternal Judge</u>

Because only when we come to the **end** of ourselves are we **fully ready** - to receive the **ONLY WAY** for sinners - to be made **RIGHT** with God

There is **Only ONE WAY** - It is the **ONLY WAY**

& if you will <u>accept the truth</u> - that there is <u>NO WAY</u> for <u>YOU</u> to make yourself <u>RIGHT</u> w/ God

THEN you will be <u>READY</u> to receive the <u>ONLY WAY</u>, for us to <u>be made right</u> with God

<u>Our text</u> today - is Absolutely Incredible it is one of the *KEY CENTRAL TEXTS* in All the **NT**

Donald Barnhouse (Great Preacher & Scholar):

"I am convinced today, after these many years of Bible study, that these verses are the most important in the Bible."

Now **THAT** - is a *HUGE* statement - by a Great Commentator

Then <u>Barnhouse</u> goes on to write <u>193 pages</u> on <u>THIS TEXT</u> - that I have 45 minutes to cover

<u>Today</u> - as Paul begins the <u>2nd section</u> of Romans he lays out for us - <u>THE VERY CORE</u> concepts of Salvation

The <u>1st section</u> of Romans was devoted to - <u>"Man's Sinfulness"</u>
The <u>2nd section</u> (beginning here) is devoted to - <u>"God's Solution"</u>

Let's Pray

There are <u>4 Key Concepts</u> in this Text that deserve a *Lifetime* of Study & Embracing

Here they are - the 4 Key Concepts for our Salvation;

<u>Righteousness</u> - <u>Justification</u> - <u>Redemption</u> - <u>Propitiation</u>

if you've <u>been a Christian</u> for a while you've heard these words

But if you are not in total AWE & WONDER of these incredible truths - then they deserve your careful attention

<u>Let's start</u> - before even reading this text, with <u>simple definitions</u> of the <u>4 KEY concepts</u> found here

1) Righteousness

Most simply = <u>Free from sin</u> (Lit - without sin) it is the absolute state of being 'Right'

In <u>Original Character</u> - or Original <u>State of Being</u>

<u>ONLY</u> God is Truly Righteous (we established that in Rom 3:10)

There are none righteousness, no not one

This **ISN'T** what we would call **MAN'S** Righteousness where we *try hard* to do *our best* for God

This is the Righteousness that God *EXISTS AS* (LIT - Without Sin)

2) Justification (a legal term)

Most simply = <u>To be Declared Righteous</u> it is crediting to the believer, God's Own Righteousness

Maybe you've heard the "play on words"

Just as if I'd never sinned - Which isn't too far off

But more LIT - It is IMPARTING to the Believer The Righteousness that God EXISTS AS

3) Redemption

Most simply = Purchasing back (by ransom) that which was lost

It is the <u>payment of a Ransom</u> which satisfies a debt the full & complete <u>Penalty</u> required to purchase back - **A Slave**

4) Propitiation (also a legal term)

Most simply = An acceptable payment to remove Guilt

Incredibly - this is the same <u>GK word</u> used in the <u>Septuagint</u> for the "<u>Mercy Seat</u>" which covered the Ark of the Covenant

& it was <u>upon the Mercy Seat</u>, blood was sprinkled - on the <u>'Day of Atonement</u>" to <u>'Cover Over</u>" or <u>Atone</u> for the people's sin

Propitiation is - An Atoning Sacrifice - acceptable to remove Guilt

In these Four incredible Concepts

we have the <u>Absolute</u>, <u>Miraculous</u>, <u>**ONLY WAY**</u> for us to <u>be made Right</u> with God

Righteousness - Being Free from Sin

<u>Justification</u> - To be Declared Righteous

Redemption - Purchasing back (by ransom) that which was lost

Propitiation - Acceptable payment to remove guilt

Now - <u>Many Modern Translations</u> (incldg <u>NLT</u>) don't use these words <u>because</u> their definitions are not readily known

However - in regard to our Salvation - these 4 words (& concepts) are the most Comforting & Confident & Powerful words in all the Bible

So - Don't Avoid them - Embrace them

Make sure you <u>understand</u> them

<u>Build</u> your relationship w/ the Lord on them

AND - add to them **One Other** Miraculous Word the Word by Which <u>ALL these Truths</u> come to US

Add to them - the Word - - GRACE

Because it is **ONLY** by God's Amazing Grace that these **4 words** can ever be applied to **US**

GRACE = Unmerited, Undeserved Favor

Grace is God giving to you - what you <u>CANNOT</u>, & <u>WILL NOT</u> ever - <u>Merit</u>, or <u>Deserve</u> NOW - - Only Now - - are we <u>ready to hear</u> God's Incredible, <u>ONLY WAY</u> to our Salvation

Rom 3:21 - ESV

21 But now the <u>righteousness</u> of God has been manifested apart from the law, although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it—

But now the <u>righteousness of God</u> [being free from sin] has been <u>manifested</u> [shown to us] <u>apart</u> from the law, although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it

The <u>Righteousness of God</u> was <u>1st shown</u> <u>IN the law</u> but in the law - <u>God's Righteousness</u> only served to <u>condemn</u> us because we could **NEVER** attain to it

so **NOW** - The *Righteousness of God* has been shown to us **APART** from the law . . .

Guys - We <u>MUST</u> understand - The Righteousness of God is <u>NOT</u> Being <u>Real Good</u> at following <u>MOST</u> of the Law,

THAT'S Man's Righteousness

God's Righteousness is Being WITHOUT SIN - PERIOD

The **ONLY** earthly display of *God's Righteousness* was in the Person of **Jesus Christ**

& as <u>Paul continues</u> to define the <u>Righteousness of God</u> He describes it as coming - *Thru faith in Jesus Christ*

Rom 3:22 - ESV

22 the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all who believe. . . .

The NIV makes this Vs clear - V.22 - NIV

22 This <u>righteousness from God</u> comes through faith in Jesus Christ to <u>all</u> who believe. . .

The <u>Righteousness of God</u> (being free from sin) that has been shown to us <u>APART</u> from the law

is the <u>Righteousness of God</u> that can <u>only</u> be received, THRU faith in Jesus Christ - for all who believe

& the Holy Spirit emphasizes the ALL - in the "all who believe" at the end of V.22 & connecting with - the FAMOUS Vs.23

Rom 3:22-23 - ESV

22 the <u>righteousness</u> of God through faith in Jesus Christ for <u>all</u> who believe. For there is no distinction: 23 for <u>all</u> have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Romans has already proven (beyond any doubt) that ALL have sinned, and ALL fall short of the glory of God

But **the focus here** is now actually *changing* to; the **ONLY WAY** for <u>ALL</u> to be made <u>RIGHT</u> with God

& so the "<u>ALL have sinned</u>" thought flows right into the <u>MAIN Context</u> in <u>Vs.24</u>

Let's **TIP-TOE** into **Vs.24** - by reading again from **V.23**

Rom 3:23-24A - ESV

23 for <u>all</u> have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, 24 and are <u>justified</u> . . . [stop right there]

The focus is on the <u>ALL</u>
<u>All</u> have sinned in the <u>SAME WAY</u> . . .

AND - ALL that Will be Justified - Will be Justified the Same Way

Let's read Vs's 23-24 together - ESV

23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, 24 and are <u>justified</u> by his <u>grace</u> as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,

There are THREE Monumental Words in Vs.24

<u>Justified</u> = To be <u>Declared Righteous</u> <u>Grace</u> = Unmerited, <u>Undeserved Favor</u> (A Gift from God)

Redemption = To be <u>Purchased Back</u> by Ransom

So - all have sinned

& all that <u>will be</u> Justified (be Declared Righteous) <u>will be</u> declared righteous in <u>this manner</u> . . .

BY God's **Grace** - **THRU** the **Redemption** - That is **IN** Christ Jesus

The only way for us to be <u>Declared Righteous</u> before God, is by us Receiving His <u>unmerited gift</u>, of the <u>payment of our Ransom</u> - by Jesus Christ,

That is the **ONLY WAY** - for us to be *made right* with God

It's so <u>clear</u> - it's so <u>powerful</u>, but the Holy Spirit's <u>not done yet</u>

Let's read V.24 - & the 1st half of V.25

Rom 3:24 - 25A - ESV

24 and [we] are <u>justified</u> by his <u>grace</u> as a gift, through the <u>redemption</u> that is in Christ Jesus,
25 whom God put forward as a <u>propitiation</u> [atoning sacrifice] by his blood, to be received by <u>faith</u>. . .

In <u>Grand Theology</u> - This is like <u>SHOCK & AWE</u> <u>One Bomb Shell</u> coming right after another

<u>Justification</u> - <u>Grace</u> - <u>Redemption</u> - <u>Propitiation</u> - <u>Faith</u> . . . **ALL IN Just TWO Vs's**

We are <u>Declared Righteous</u> (Justified) by God's <u>Unmerited Gift</u> (His Grace) of the <u>Ransom</u> paid by Jesus Christ (redemption) which is a <u>Propitiation</u> (Atoning sacrifice) to be received by <u>FAITH</u>!!!!

<u>BAAM</u> - <u>BAAM</u> - <u>BAAM</u> !!! - The Bombshells fall on <u>ALL</u> of man's <u>Self-Righteous</u>, <u>Self-Made</u>, <u>Religious</u> Efforts

This is an <u>incredible display</u> of God's <u>ONLY WAY</u> - to remedy - our sinful condition

We are <u>Declared Righteous</u>
By God's <u>Unmerited Gift</u>
Thru <u>the ransom</u> paid by Jesus Christ
Which is the <u>Atoning Sacrifice</u> that fully pays for our sin - <u>By HIS Blood</u>
And we Receive it - **BY Faith**! (& by faith alone)

Well - if **THAT** is the **ONLY WAY** of Salvation then *what about* the O.T. Saints ?? (*I'm glad you asked*)

Now Paul is going to **CONNECT** - Salvation in the <u>Old Testament</u> **WITH** Salvation in the <u>New Testament</u>

& show that <u>ALL</u> salvation is found - in the <u>SAME WAY</u>, <u>By FAITH</u> in God's <u>Plan of Salvation</u>

Let's re-Read Vs.25

Rom 3:25 - ESV

25 [Jesus Christ (from v.24)] whom God put forward as a <u>propitiation</u> [Atoning Sacrifice] by his blood, to be received by faith. <u>This</u> [this sacrifice] was to show God's righteousness, because in his divine <u>forbearance</u> he had passed over former sins.

<u>Divine Forbearance</u> means - God "<u>Refrained from Judgment</u>" when He "<u>passed over</u>" the sins of the <u>O.T. Believers</u>

Look at the way the **NLT** puts it - in the 2nd half of V.25

Rom 3:25B - NLT

25 . . . This sacrifice shows that God was being fair when he held back and did not punish those who sinned in times past,

HOW?? -- How was God being fair ??

Because salvation in the O.T.
came THE SAME WAY it comes to us today
THRU FAITH in God's Plan of Salvation

The O.T. Believers were "looking ahead in Faith"

to God's Plan of salvation

Just as we Look **BACK** in **FAITH** - to God's **Plan of salvation**

<u>Here's how it works</u> - - - We know that <u>Righteousness</u> was <u>BY FAITH</u> - all the way back to <u>Abraham</u>

Gen 15:6 - ESV

6 And he [Abraham] believed the Lord, and he [God] counted it to him as righteousness.

& then - in the Hall of Fame of Faith - Heb 11 - we read

Heb 11:13 - ESV

13 These all died in faith, not having received the things promised, but having seen them and greeted them from afar, . . .

The <u>O.T.</u> Believers looked <u>FORWARD</u> <u>by Faith</u> - <u>to the Cross</u>
Just as We look <u>BACKWARD</u> <u>by Faith</u> - <u>to the Cross</u>

In fact - the NLT puts a "comma" between V.25 & V.26 to show this connection as one sentence . . .

Rom 3:25B-26A - NLT

25... This sacrifice shows that God was being fair when he held back and did not punish those who sinned in times past, [comma] 26 for he was looking ahead and including them in what he would do in this present time....

& <u>because of this</u> - as <u>Rom 3:25</u> says <u>God's Righteousness</u> is **UPHELD**

when He "Passed Over" the sins of the O.T. Believers

it is **AT the Cross** (for BOTH **OT** & **NT** Believers) that God proves

that He is Perfectly <u>JUST</u> - <u>AND</u> the perfect <u>JUSTIFIER</u> of <u>ALL</u> who put their Faith in Jesus Christ

Let's read again - Rom 3:26 - ESV

26 It [this plan of salvation] was to show his righteousness at the present time, so that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.

God is perfectly **JUST** - in His **ONLY WAY** of Salvation

& He perfectly **JUSTIFIES** ALL who receive His **ONLY WAY** of Salvation

By putting their FAITH in Jesus Christ

OK - Let's Review - IN REVERSE;

Jesus Christ is our **Propitiation** (Acceptable payment to remove guilt)

By His sacrifice - He **Purchased** us back from sin (**Redeemed** Us)

When we put our <u>Faith in Christ</u> - God <u>IMPARTS</u> the Righteousness of Christ - to <u>US</u> - Declaring us Righteous (<u>Justification</u>)

Then, When God looks at us - He sees the <u>Righteousness</u> of His Son Making us <u>RIGHT</u> with God

That <u>doesn't leave</u> us much room to <u>BOAST</u> in our own righteousness - does it?

Rom 3:27 - ESV \rightarrow \rightarrow

Rom 3:27 - ESV

27 Then what becomes of our boasting? It is excluded. By what kind of law? By a law of works? No, but by the law of faith.

We **KNOW** that the "Law of Works" actually Produces **BOASTING** & **THAT** is what **MUST** be Excluded

Which is **Exactly** what the "Law of Faith" does
It **EXCLUDES ALL** boasting in our own Righteousness

& <u>THAT</u> - is the <u>Grand Theme</u> of the Book of <u>ROMANS</u> - that we are <u>Justified BY FAITH ALONE</u> - apart from our works

Some say **Paul** wrote **Galatians** as a "Primer" to Romans . . .

& in Gal 2:16 we read - NLT

16 Yet we know that a person is made right with God by faith in Jesus Christ, not by obeying the law. And we have believed in Christ Jesus, so that we might be made right with God because of our faith in Christ, not because we have obeyed the law. For no one will ever be made right with God by obeying the law."

& THAT - is exactly what our next Vs in Rom Ch 3 says . . .

Rom 3:28 - ESV

28 For we hold that one is justified by faith apart from works of the law.

& it is **THAT** theme - Paul's going to "*Expand* " for most of Romans

That we can <u>ONLY</u> be <u>Declared Righteous</u> before God by God <u>IMPARTING</u> the <u>Righteousness of Christ</u> to us

& that can ONLY be done - THRU FAITH IN CHRIST ALONE

& now - in Vs's 29 & 30
Paul's going to go back - to the "ALL" theme

Since God <u>Justifies</u> (Declares Righteous) by <u>Faith Alone</u> then <u>HOW</u> could He be the God of the Jews <u>ONLY</u> ??

Rom 3:29-30 - ESV

29 Or is God the God of Jews only? Is he not the God of Gentiles also? Yes, of Gentiles also, 30 since God is one. He will <u>justify</u> the circumcised by <u>faith</u> and the uncircumcised through <u>faith</u>.

Faith - is the Conduit - by which we ACQUIRE this Miraculous Salvation from God (it is THRU faith)

& since it is <u>thru Faith</u> - then it's the <u>same</u> for Jews & Gentiles He will justify the <u>circumcised</u> (Jews) by faith and the uncircumcised (Gentiles) through faith.

But then - does that mean that Faith has Overthrown the Law?

Absolutely NOT

In fact - Faith doesn't <u>Overthrow</u> the Law it actually <u>Upholds</u> (or fulfills) the Law

Rom 3:31 - ESV

31 Do we then <u>overthrow</u> the law by this faith? By no means! On the contrary, we <u>uphold</u> the law.

The law spells out God's <u>Requirement</u> for <u>Righteousness</u> (Meaning to be free from sin)

<u>AND</u> the Law proves - beyond a shadow of doubt, that we **CANNOT** meet that Requirement on our own

But <u>Justification</u> means that God <u>Declares us Righteous</u> by <u>IMPARTING</u> the <u>Righteousness of Christ</u> - to us

<u>HOW</u>? - Thru <u>Redemption</u> - which means *Purchasing back (by Ransom) that which was lost*

& HOW can God Declare us Righteous by Christ Paying a Ransom?

Because of <u>Propitiation</u> - which means an acceptable payment to remove guilt -

- & <u>ONLY</u> the <u>sacrifice of Jesus Christ</u> could ever be an "<u>Acceptable Payment</u>" to remove the Guilt of our sin
- & **HOW** do we **ACQUIRE** that <u>acceptable payment</u> for the **Removal** of our Guilt?

THRU our FAITH in Jesus Christ

& by us *placing our Faith* in Jesus Christ HIS Righteousness is <u>imparted</u> to us

Which Perfectly Upholds (Fulfills) the Law of God

SO - Being <u>Justified Thru Faith</u> in Christ does not Set Aside the Law

but instead - It Perfectly Fulfills the Law

- & <u>THAT</u>, my friends, is <u>HOW</u> God can be both Perfectly <u>JUST</u> & the Perfect <u>JUSTIFIER</u>
- of **ALL** who *put their faith* in Christ
- & <u>at the end</u> of all that we should be left in <u>AWE</u> & <u>AMAZEMENT</u> at the <u>ONLY WAY</u> that we can <u>be made Right</u> before God

<u>In closing</u> - let me give you <u>one WARNING</u> <u>Faith</u> is Far from the mere "<u>Acknowledgement</u>" that God exists

Jas 2:19-20 - NLT

19 You say you have faith, for you believe that there is one God. Good for you! Even the demons believe this, and they tremble in terror.

20 How foolish! Can't you see that faith without good deeds is useless?

A few weeks ago - <u>Pastor Jeff</u> said <u>"True Repentance leads to a Changed Life"</u>

& I can assure you - just as well - "True Faith leads to a Changed Life"

What <u>James</u> is saying is - <u>True Faith</u> - <u>WORKS</u> It works to change your life

& we will see **PLENTY** of that truth as we continue to study in **Romans**

Continued . . .

What a <u>Wonderful</u> - Incredible - <u>Miraculous</u> <u>Explanation</u> of <u>HOW</u> God Makes us Righteous while always maintaining *His* Perfect Righteousness

God's Word has Clearly Spelled out the ONLY WAY of Salvation

There can be **No Other Way**Because there is **No Other** Jesus Christ

There is ONLY ONE Son of God

Who is the ONLY One Who could be the acceptable sacrifice

To Redeem us from our sin,

& to **Impart** to us the *Righteousness of God*

Without which, we could never enter into God's Presence

Don't be fooled into thinking

there could some other way to be Made Right with God

<u>Placing</u> your <u>Full & Complete Faith</u> in Jesus Christ - is the **ONLY WAY** - that we can be **saved** from our sin

Rom 1:17 – NIV – "for in the Gospel a righteousness from God is revealed, a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: The righteous shall live by faith"
