ROM 213 - There's not enough 'Try' in you - Rom 7:1-25

We've got a <u>**HUGE text**</u> to cover (twice normal) So - <u>**No**</u> Jokes, <u>Tangents</u>, <u>Imitations</u> . . .

Let's Pray - right up front today

In our <u>last Msg</u> - Paul made it <u>clear</u> as believers, we are to be <u>SLAVES</u> <u>TO</u> <u>CHRIST</u>

Well - <u>to be slaves</u> <u>TO</u> Christ We <u>must be RELEASED</u> <u>FROM</u> being <u>SLAVES</u> to the <u>LAW</u>

& THAT'S where Paul begins today - in ROM 7:1

Rom 7:1 - ESV

1 Or do you not know, brothers—for I am speaking to those who know the law—that the law is binding on a person only as long as he lives?

Be careful - because Paul is setting you up

The law is binding on a person as long as he lives →

<u>BUUUTTT</u> - <u>*IF*</u> you have been <u>identified</u> with Christ (CH 6), do you live ?? (at least in the way you used to)

Or - have you died & been Raised to New Life in Christ?

Paul's going to use the <u>Analogy of Marriage</u> to <u>Demonstrate</u> our <u>New Relationship</u> to the <u>LAW</u>

<u>Rom 7:2-3 - ESV</u>

2 Thus a married woman is bound by law to her husband while he lives, but if her husband dies she is released from the law of marriage.

3 Accordingly, she will be called an adulteress if she lives with another man while her husband is alive. But if her husband dies, she is free from that law, and if she marries another man she is not an adulteress.

This is **a simple truth** that we obviously **still follow** today

If a **husband dies**, his **wife** is **no** longer **bound by marriage** & she is **free to marry** another husband

So - Paul says in V.4

<u>Rom 7:4 - ESV</u>

4 Likewise, my brothers, <u>you</u> also have <u>died to the law</u> through the body of Christ, so that you may belong to another [bondservant], to him who has been raised from the dead, in order that we may bear fruit for God.

thru our identification with Jesus Christ we died to the law . . .

SO THAT we **may be free** to permanently **marry JESUS CHRIST** in order that we may **bear fruit for God**

That's all review ...

& in <u>Vs's 5-6</u> we see - <u>THRU</u> our <u>identification</u> with Christ

We <u>NO LONGER</u> Serve the <u>Old Written CODE</u> We <u>SERVE</u> in the <u>New Life of the SPIRIT</u>

Rom 7:5-6 - ESV

5 For while we were living in the flesh, our <u>sinful passions</u>, <u>aroused by the law</u> [notice - sinful passions aroused by the law], were at work in our members to bear fruit for death.
6 But now we are released from the law, <u>having died</u> to that which <u>held us captive</u>, so that we serve not under the <u>old</u> written code but in the <u>new life of the Spirit</u>.

Instead of <u>despair</u> under the law - we have <u>Joy</u> in the Spirit Instead of <u>bondage</u> under the law -we have <u>Freedom</u> in the Spirit Instead of <u>death</u> under the law - we have <u>Life</u> in the Spirit!

We <u>No Longer</u> <u>Serve</u> the old written code We <u>Serve</u> in the New Life of the Spirit

Now Again - BECAUSE Paul has <u>Re-iterated;</u>

Our <u>FREEDOM</u> from the LAW to become BOND-SLAVES to CHRIST

He again <u>anticipates</u> another <u>CRAZY Question</u> - in fact - this is the <u>THIRD Crazy question</u> in this Context

In <u>6:1</u> the question was *"can we sin that grace may abound?"* In <u>6:15</u> it was *"can we sin since we are not under the law?"* Here, in <u>7:7</u> the question is: *"Is the Law actually sinful?"*

EXCUSE ME !!!!

<u>Rom 7:7A - ESV</u>

7 What then shall we say? That the law is sin? By no means! . .

Paul answers <u>all these Crazy Questions</u> - with the <u>same response</u> CERTAINLY NOT !! - BY NO MEANS !!

We are **NOT** freed from the law **because** the law was **bad**

We're **freed** because **the penalty** of the law has been **paid** on our behalf - "<u>by Christ</u>"

But the law is NOT bad - & it's certainly NOT sin !

in fact - <u>the LAW</u> is what made us <u>AWARE</u> of <u>sin</u> & ultimately - <u>The LAW</u> made us <u>AWARE</u> of our <u>need for a Savior</u>

Rom 7:7B - ESV

7...Yet if it had not been for the law, I would not have known sin. I would not have known what it is to covet if the law had not said, "You shall not covet."

Here's how it works . . .

<u>At the time</u> of his <u>**Bar Mitzvah**</u> ("son of the commandment - or law") when Paul was <u>13</u>...

Paul was expected - to begin keeping the law of Moses

- & so <u>leading up</u> to his <u>Bar Mitzvah</u> he would've begun <u>seriously study</u> the <u>scriptures</u>
- & <u>when he came</u> to *"Thou shall not covet"* he <u>began to realize</u> that <u>his life</u> was <u>filled with coveting</u>

Just as Rom 3:20 says "through the law comes knowledge of sin"

But there's more that the LAW was used to do in Paul's Life

In fact - <u>The Law</u> - was actually <u>Used</u> <u>BY</u> the <u>Sin Nature</u> to bring <u>death</u>

I'm going to switch to the NLT translation for Vs's 8-13

As we <u>read V.8</u> - <u>WATCH</u> for how <u>Sin</u> <u>actually USES</u> the <u>LAW</u> - *Against US !* (already saw in <u>V.5</u>)

Rom 7:8 - NLT

8 But <u>sin used</u> this command to <u>arouse</u> all kinds of <u>covetous</u> <u>desires</u> within me! If there were no law, <u>sin</u> would not have that <u>power</u>.

Look at how <u>Paul</u> begins to <u>refer</u> to <u>sin</u> as <u>kinda</u> a "<u>separate</u>" <u>part</u> of him

<u>Kinda like</u> a separate "<u>FORCE</u>" within him with its <u>own will</u> & it's <u>own agenda</u>

Again - Paul says in V.8 (NLT)

8 But <u>sin used this command</u> to <u>arouse</u> all kinds of <u>covetous</u> <u>desires</u> within me! If there were no law, <u>sin</u> would not have that <u>power</u>.

& then in <u>Vs's 9-10</u> - Paul <u>explains</u> that the <u>LAW</u> <u>actually gave Sin it's POWER</u> - to <u>bring Spiritual Death</u>

<u>Rom 7:9-10 - NLT</u>

9 At one time I lived without understanding the law. But when I learned the command not to covet, for instance, the <u>power of</u> <u>sin</u> came to life,

10 and I died. So I discovered that <u>the law's commands</u>, which were <u>supposed</u> to bring <u>life</u>, <u>brought</u> spiritual <u>death</u> instead.

When Paul realized (by the law) that he was coveting . . .

it <u>seemed like</u> - it was the <u>Commandment against Coveting</u> that was <u>actually making</u> him <u>covet</u> - bringing <u>Spiritual Death</u>

There's an experiment you can try yourself to prove this truth . . .

If you have a **<u>big window</u>** on the front of your <u>house</u>

Put <u>a sign</u> in your yard; ATTENTION TEENAGE BOYS -DO <u>NOT</u> THROW ROCKS AT THIS WINDOW

& see how long it takes before you have to replace your window

Pls Lstn Carefully

Our <u>Sin Nature</u> actually causes us <u>to do</u> <u>that</u> which we are told <u>not to do</u>!

that's the way the sin nature works

<u>& THEN</u> - <u>that sin nature</u> actually <u>uses</u> the law to <u>bring spiritual death</u> into our <u>lives</u>

<u>Which is exactly</u> what Paul's saying in <u>ROM 7:11</u> \rightarrow \rightarrow

<u>Rom 7:11 - NLT</u>

11 Sin took advantage of those commands and deceived me; it used the commands to kill me.

Again - notice how Paul is referring to sin

as kind of a "separate force" within his life - in fact AN ENEMY !

But now - Paul Reiterates

this is **NOT** the **Law's** fault - this is **Sin's** fault

God's Law is Holy, Right, & Good

Rom 7:12 - NLT

12 But still, the law itself is holy, and its commands are <u>holy</u> and <u>right</u> and <u>good</u>.

<u>So</u> - if the Law is <u>Holy</u>, <u>Right</u>, & <u>Good</u> <u>how is it</u> that it brought <u>DEATH</u> - - & not <u>LIFE</u> to me ??

V.13 explains this *perfectly*

also in V.13 - we begin to see where Paul is really GOING in all this

We need to begin to see - How Terrible & Evil Sin really IS

Rom 7:13 - NLT

13 But how can that be? Did the law, which is good, cause my death? Of course not! <u>Sin used</u> what was good to <u>bring about</u> my <u>condemnation</u> to death. So we can see how <u>terrible</u> sin really is. It <u>uses</u> God's good commands for its own <u>evil</u> purposes.

<u>Do you see it ??</u> - This <u>Enemy Force</u> called <u>SIN</u> <u>USES</u> what was <u>Good</u> (the Law) to <u>Condemn us</u> to <u>Death</u>

Which is the GOAL - & the END RESULT - of Sin

So again - we MUST SEE how Terrible Sin really IS →

that <u>it can</u> even use <u>God's Good Commands</u> for its <u>Own EVIL PURPOSES</u> !

Guys - as we grow in Christ - there comes a growing revelation

1) of the radical "TERRIBLENESS" of our Sin Nature - &

2) of the true extent - of Sin's EVIL PURPOSES

Which is what V.13 has just said

SO - <u>WHERE</u> IS THE PROBLEM ???

The problem - is NOT with the LAW - - The Problem is with US !

You & I - By Nature - Are Slaves to SIN

& that <u>Slave-ship</u> to SIN <u>CANNOT</u> be <u>Managed</u> or <u>Balanced</u> IT MUST BE CONSTANTLY CRUCIFIED !!!

<u>Rom 7:14 - NLT $\rightarrow \rightarrow$ </u>

<u>Rom 7:14 - NLT</u>

14 So the trouble is <u>not</u> with the <u>law</u>, for it is spiritual and good. <u>The trouble is with me</u>, for I am all too human, <u>a slave to sin</u>.

Now - <u>at this point</u> - we should be <u>feeling</u> a bit <u>overwhelmed</u> by the "<u>TERRIBLENESS</u>" of our <u>Sin Nature</u>

It's Important because - - the First Step to Conquering SIN

is <u>understanding</u> we are <u>HOPELESS</u> *in ourselves* to <u>ever</u> <u>conquer</u> <u>Sin</u> *On Our Own*

JUST LIKE the 1st step to <u>Salvation</u> is to <u>recognize</u> our <u>HOPELESSNESS</u> <u>without Jesus Christ</u>

The 1st step to Living for Christ

is to **recognize** our **HOPELESSNESS** - *in our own strength* of ever <u>overcoming</u> *Sin* - *On Our Own*

& THAT is what Paul has been building up to

<u>What follows</u> in Rom Ch 7 - <u>is</u> Paul's autobiography

The words: *I*, *me* and *myself*; are used **47 times** in this chapter

Paul's writing in the <u>first-person singular</u>, & in the <u>present tense</u>

<u>I believe</u> this is the <u>greatest Apostle</u> of the N.T. <u>revealing to us</u>, that <u>he was made</u> just like <u>we are</u>

He wasn't born - a super-Christian

He was born with the same sin nature you & I have & he fought the same battle you & I are fighting

What we're about to read

is **Paul** describing his **personal battle** against his *own sin-nature*

<u>& HERE</u> - the Apostle <u>Paul</u> comes to the <u>same Conclusion</u> that <u>each of us</u> <u>MUST COME TO</u>

that there is - **NOT ENUF TRY IN HIM** to live the Christian Life **on his own**

There's **NOT ENUF TRY IN HIM** to overcome sin with just MORE of *<u>His Own EFFORT</u>*

There's **NOT ENUF TRY IN HIM** to **Live out** the truth of who he is "**IN CHRIST**"

In & of himself - There's just NOT ENUF TRY IN HIM !

Paul's <u>describing himself</u> as a Christian <u>trying</u> to live for God <u>*in his own strength*</u>

& that proves that he really is just like us

because <u>every Christian</u> in this room has - *at some level* - done this <u>exact same thing</u>

It's in our Nature - to TRY to do it ourselves

& <u>ROM CH 7</u> is written - to <u>CRUSH</u> that <u>false confidence</u> in our <u>OWN ABIILITY</u> to Live for God Paul starts his "Crisis of Hopelessness" in V.15

<u>Rom 7:15 - ESV</u>

15 I do not understand my own actions. For <u>I do not do</u> what I want, but <u>I do</u> the very thing I hate.

How many of us have made this exact statement to God ?

Lord, I don't understand I know what I should do, but I keep NOT doing it instead, I'm doing the very thing I HATE

<u>THAT</u> is the cry of <u>EVERY</u> believer who's trying to <u>Live for God</u> - *in their* <u>own strength</u>

<u>& THAT</u> was exactly <u>Paul's</u> struggle <u>before</u> he found - <u>The Secret Power</u> - of <u>ROM CH 8</u>

- & <u>maybe you've</u> been <u>trying</u> so hard (<u>in your own strength</u>) to <u>Live for God</u> - - but meeting only <u>frustration</u>, & <u>failure</u>,
- Well *take hope* . . .

because **NEXT WEEK** we'll begin to look

at the <u>Supernatural Power</u> that's been <u>given to us</u> to live a <u>Victorious Christian life</u>

But . . . that's for next week

Today - Paul <u>MUST</u> Recognize his <u>ENEMY WITHIN</u> & it is <u>NOT</u> the <u>LAW</u> - it <u>is SIN</u>

Rom 7:16-17 - ESV

16 Now if I do what I do not want, I agree with the law, that it is good. 17 So now it is no longer I who do it, but sin that dwells within me.

WHAT POWER is causing Paul to <u>NOT DO</u> what is <u>Right</u> & instead <u>TO DO</u> what is <u>wrong</u>?

It's the **Power of SIN** - That's **STILL Dwelling** within him

It's been <u>Conquered</u> - It's Been <u>Beaten</u> - But it's <u>Still IN THERE</u> still <u>looking</u> to bring <u>Destruction</u> & <u>Death</u>

<u>**Paul's saying</u>** - it's <u>not</u> the <u>New Man</u>, the <u>New Creation</u> <u>that's doing</u> these things</u>

But it's the OLD MAN - The OLD Creation

Paul - - - is in a <u>Battle to the Death</u> it's "the <u>New Nature</u> vs. the <u>Old Nature</u>"

& THAT is the <u>same battle</u> - that <u>you & I</u> are in today & the <u>first step to Victory</u> - is to <u>Recognize</u> the "<u>ENEMY WITHIN</u>"

$\underline{\text{Rom 7:18}} - \underline{\text{ESV}} \rightarrow \rightarrow$

<u>Rom 7:18 - ESV</u>

18 For I know that <u>no-thing good</u> dwells in me, that is, in my flesh. For I <u>have the desire</u> to do what is right, but <u>not the</u> <u>ability</u> to carry it out.

NO - THING good dwells in our **original nature** that is, **in our Flesh**

Have you found this out yet?

<u>Jn 3:6 says</u>

6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

It is better for you to be fully, completely surrendered to Christ Walking in the Spirit - & doing nothing

<u>Than</u> to be doing <u>every possible thing</u> in the flesh trying to <u>please</u>, or <u>earn</u> something - from God

Because <u>God says</u> : "no-thing good dwells in your flesh"

Then - in the <u>2nd half of V.18</u> is the <u>FIRST STEP</u> to actually <u>being able</u> to <u>Live FOR Christ</u>

<u>Rom 7:18B - ESV</u>

18... For I have the desire to do what is right, but not the ability to carry it out.

I want to live for Christ but I don't have <u>the ability</u> to carry it out!

I don't have <u>the strength</u> – I don't have <u>the power</u> There's just <u>NOT ENUF TRY IN ME</u>

<u>This</u> is the <u>EXACT PLACE</u> that we <u>MUST</u> <u>get to</u> before the <u>power</u> of <u>Ch 8</u> will <u>really sink in</u>

18... For I <u>have the desire</u> to do what is right, but <u>not the ability</u> to carry it out.

In vs's 19-20 Paul reiterates the <u>HOPELESSNESS</u> of <u>trying to serve God</u> in his <u>own strength</u>

& <u>AGAIN</u> - He <u>NAMES</u> - <u>The Enemy Within</u>

Rom 7:19-20 - ESV

19 For I do not do the good I want, but the evil I do not want is what I keep on doing.20 Now if I do what I do not want, it is no longer I who do it, but sin that dwells within me.

The <u>Old Sin Nature</u> is still dwelling in me even tho it's been <u>Conquered</u> - <u>Overcome</u> by Jesus Christ

it's <u>STILL CROUCHING</u> like a <u>Lion</u> always <u>poised</u> - <u>close at hand</u> - <u>ready</u> to <u>attack</u> <u>at any moment</u>

especially if I'm trying to live for God in my own strength

Which is what Rom 7:21 says \rightarrow \rightarrow

<u>Rom 7:21 - ESV</u>

21 So I find it to be a law that when I want to do right, evil lies close at hand.

Have you found that's true in your own life

When you <u>WANT</u> to do what is right <u>SIN</u> is <u>Crouching</u> close by - <u>like a LION</u>

just waiting for the right moment - TO POUNCE !

Paul understands exactly <u>what's happening</u> to us & <u>he addresses</u> it in <u>these 3 verses</u>

Rom 7:21(again) thru V.23 - ESV

21 So I find it to be a law that when I want to do right, evil lies close at hand.
22 For I delight in the law of God, in my inner being,
23 but I see in my members another law waging war against the law of my mind and making me captive to the law of sin that

dwells in my members.

We have within us - TWO WARRING natures

<u>Our OLD nature</u> - which has been <u>Conquered</u> & <u>Defeated</u> but we <u>still drag it around</u> with us

Our NEW nature - which <u>delights</u> in the <u>law of God</u> which is our <u>True Inner Being</u> - Our <u>True NEW NATURE</u> But in <u>this Life</u> we are subject to the <u>TWO NATURES</u> <u>simultaneously</u>

& there is a <u>WAR</u> going on between the <u>OLD NATURE</u> & the <u>NEW NATURE</u>

This is "The War Within" - The battle between the TWO NATURES

& we're going to see in Ch 8 that THERE IS a clear VICTROY

a <u>Super-Natural VICTORY</u> that comes <u>IN</u> - <u>BY</u> - & <u>THRU</u> - <u>the Holy Spirit</u>

But still, we must prepare for this life-long battle

- <u>Although</u> the <u>closer</u> we <u>walk with Jesus</u> the <u>farther</u> away we get from the <u>dominance of sin</u> . . .
- <u>Still</u> the struggle <u>will exist</u> <u>day-by-day</u> ... It did for Paul ... & it does for us
- <u>So</u> - Paul's <u>BRUTAL REALIZATION</u> that there's <u>Not Enuf TRY in him</u> to Live for God

brings on the <u>CRY</u> of v.24 <u>& THIS is the CRY</u> - that <u>each</u> one of us <u>MUST get to</u>

 $\underline{\text{Rom 7:24}} - \underline{\text{ESV}} \rightarrow \rightarrow$

<u>Rom 7:24 - ESV</u>

24 Wretched man that I am! <u>Who</u> will deliver me from this body of death?

NOT - <u>HOW</u> do I deliver myself ? BUT - <u>WHO</u> will deliver me ?

This Must be the cry of every Christianwho ever desiresto truly Walk with God[REPEAT V.24]

The word <u>wretched</u> means "<u>miserable condition</u>" it carries <u>the picture</u> of <u>exhaustion after a struggle</u>

<u>Paul</u> has come to <u>the end of himself</u> he has <u>nothing left</u> to <u>fight this battle</u>

& when WEcome to that same place

then <u>God knows</u> we are <u>READY</u> to <u>Receive the POWER</u> to <u>Live the Victorious Life</u> in Him

<u>When</u> we become <u>wretched</u>, <u>exhausted</u>, <u>miserable</u> in our <u>own efforts</u> <u>THEN</u> we're <u>ready</u> for <u>the power</u> that's coming in <u>Ch 8</u>

& in <u>v.25</u> Paul introduces <u>the SOURCE</u> of that power

<u>Rom 7:25A - ESV</u>

25 Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord! . . .

Rom 7:25A - NLT

25 Thank God! The answer is in Jesus Christ our Lord. . .

Paul came to the end of himself & he knew exactly to WHOM he must look - to be rescued

25 Thank God! The answer is in Jesus Christ our Lord. . .

Then he <u>closes CH 7</u> with a summary of <u>the battle</u> that rages in <u>every</u> Christian life

<u>Rom 7:25B - ESV</u>

25... So then, I myself serve the <u>law of God</u> with my mind, but with my flesh I serve the <u>law of sin</u>.

There <u>IS a Battle</u> - in <u>EVERY</u> Christian's Life Between the <u>Law of GOD</u> - & the <u>Law of SIN</u>

that Battle - can <u>ONLY</u> be <u>WON</u> <u>BY & IN</u> <u>Jesus Christ our Lord</u>

& <u>Next Week</u> we'll begin to see <u>the Power</u> - to <u>WALK in that VICTORY</u>

But right now . . .

if you're ready to give up trying to live for God
in your own strength

If you would cry out with Paul;

"Oh, wretched man that I am "Who will deliver me from this body of death"

Then I'd like to give you a <u>chance</u> to <u>make that cry</u> to God right now

Let's Pray
