1Jn 10 - Disciples Have Assurance - 1Jn 3:19-24

Let's Pray

1Jn is about **ASSURANCE**

It's about <u>GIVING</u> us <u>Assurance</u> <u>NOT</u> taking our <u>Assurance</u> away

It's about giving us <u>Real Tangible Assurance</u> & it's about <u>REMOVING</u> any <u>False Assurance</u> we may have

But what 1John is **NOT** about - is "**HOW TO BE SAVED**"

We Have **tons of Msg's** at Word By Mail about <u>HOW to be Saved</u>
The **Gospel of John**, **Romans**, **Galatians**, etc

& we know - & we <u>try to teach</u> very clearly - Salvation is BY <u>God's Grace Alone</u> & <u>THRU Our Faith Alone</u>

We can Never **EARN** or **DESERVE** our Salvation

So pls hear me - & pls tell someone who's not here

1John is NOT about what we have to do to BE Saved

It's about HOW we can know we ARE Saved

Salvation comes **BY** God's Grace & **THRU** Your Faith - *ALONE* Get our *Galatians* & *Romans* series for that

But if you have truly **put your Faith** in Jesus Christ & if you are truly **following Him** as LORD

It will SHOW . . . & THAT is what 1John is about

- 1John is dealing with <u>what</u> it should <u>look like</u>
 <u>AFTER</u> we've <u>given our lives</u> to Jesus Christ as our <u>LORD</u>
- & it is <u>SO appropriate</u> Because (maybe) in our emphasis on Salvation <u>By Grace</u> & <u>Thru Faith</u> alone
- maybe <u>we've forgotten</u> to make it clear that <u>True Faith</u> in Christ "<u>WILL</u> actually <u>CHANGE</u> your life too"
- So We **DON'T** want to **imply there is** something you **have to DO** to be saved

But we <u>don't want</u> you to <u>think</u> you're <u>OK</u> with God <u>IF</u> you just went thru the <u>motions</u> of salvation but <u>NOTHING</u> ever <u>changed</u> in your life

BOTTOM LINE - True faith is not a <u>passive acknowledgment</u> of the gospel; True faith is an <u>active response</u> to the gospel

True faith shows itself - in HOW we live!

& God <u>HAS</u> Given us <u>Absolute Assurance</u> of our Salvation that comes **THRU** our Faith **ALONE**

But the **question is**

How do we know His **Absolute Assurance** - applies to **US**

<u>Listen</u> to these vs's of <u>incredible assurance</u> from <u>ROM Ch 8</u> - <u>from the NLT</u>

Rom 8:29-37 - NLT → →

Rom 8:29-37 - NLT

- 29 For God knew his people in advance, and he chose them to become like his Son, . . .
- 30 And having chosen them, he called them to come to him. And having called them, he gave them right standing with himself. And having given them right standing, he gave them his glory.
- 31 What shall we say about such wonderful things as these? If God is for us, who can ever be against us?
- 32 Since he did not spare even his own Son but gave him up for us all, won't he also give us everything else?
- 33 Who dares accuse us whom God has chosen for his own? No one—for God himself has given us right standing with himself.
- 34 Who then will condemn us? No one—for Christ Jesus died for us and was raised to life for us . . .
- 35 Can anything ever separate us from Christ's love? . . . 36 . . .
- 37 No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us.

There are Powerful **Vs's of Assurance** like these **ALL THRU** the NT

BUT (again) - the question is - **HOW** can we be assured that these **Great Promises** - Apply to **US**, personally ??

The only way for us to really know that this
Guaranteed Assurance of Salvation applies to US

is for us to **look** - at our **ACTIONS** (the **FRUIT**) of our lives

Guys - 1John is simply exhorting us to <u>MAKE SURE</u> that our <u>Faith</u> is <u>BEARING FRUIT</u> in our lives

Which is **the same thing** we see thru-out the N.T. - - & the same thing **Jesus Himself** said in **Mat Ch 7**

In <u>Mat 7</u> Jesus is talking about <u>how to know</u> if someone was <u>from</u> God, or <u>NOT</u>

<u>& He says in **Mat 7:15-21 - NLT**</u>

- 15 "Beware of false prophets who come disguised as harmless sheep but are really vicious wolves.
- 16 You can identify them by their fruit, that is, by the way they act. Can you pick grapes from thornbushes, or figs from thistles?

 17 A good tree produces good fruit, and a bad tree produces bad fruit.
- 18 A good tree can't produce bad fruit, and a bad tree can't produce good fruit.
- 19 So every tree that does not produce good fruit is chopped down and thrown into the fire.
- 20 Yes, just as you can identify a tree by its fruit, so you can identify people by their actions.
- 21 "Not everyone who calls out to me, 'Lord! Lord!' will enter the Kingdom of Heaven. Only those who actually do the will of my Father in heaven will enter.

Our Actions **IDENTIFY** who we are

- & so our <u>Actions</u> are what give us <u>Real</u>, <u>True Assurance</u> of our <u>Salvation</u> in Christ
- & so if you would say well . . . I see one little itty-bitty fruit hanging on the tree of my life

I'd say well, **Praise the Lord**, that's a good sign

But - <u>AS</u> we continue to <u>ABIDE</u> in Christ (see <u>John 15</u>) . . . We should be seeing <u>More & More fruit</u> growing, right?

As we've said a dozen times in this study

the question is **NOT** Are we **PERFECTLY** bearing Fruit **BUT** are we **INCREASINGLY** bearing Fruit?

Amen?

Alright - Let's get to it!

This can be a <u>somewhat difficult passage</u> at first reading but the **focus** - the **M.I.P.** here - is the **Assurance of our Salvation**

Six Points of Assurance in Six Vs's

- 1) True "love in action" Assures us v.19
- 2) God's true knowledge of us Assures us v.20
- 3) A cleansed conscious Assures us v.21
- 4) Obedience Assures us v.22
- 5) Faith with love Assures us v.23
- 6) The Holy Spirit in our lives Assures us v.24

These are the **practical evidences** in our lives that give us **solid assurance** of our Salvation

AND (as always in 1John) - the **implication** here is if these things are **NOT evident** in our lives

then we should definitely & immediately DO SOMETHING about it

But (again) John's overriding goal here is to **GIVE US** True Assurance

that we are "Walking in the Light" & that we are "Of the Truth"

In our last message John had made it clear that <u>Loving One Another</u> was an absolute requirement for the Christian Life

- & in <u>the last vs</u> of that msg (v.18) John said this requirement to Love One Another is NOT "Love in <u>TALKING</u>" - but "Love in <u>WALKING</u>"
- & today he's going to <u>TIE</u> that command from the last message to our <u>First Assurance</u> in today's message

Assurance #1) True "Love in Action" Assures us

Repeating v.18 from last week - leading into our 1st Assurance

1Jn 3:18-19 - ESV

18 Little children, let us not <u>love</u> in word or talk but in <u>deed</u> and in truth.

19 By this we shall know that we are of the truth and reassure our heart before him;

If we are Loving One Another - as Jesus commanded us to

then we can KNOW *that we are of the truth* & *we can reassure our hearts before God* (Praise the Lord)

- When we are **Loving** with a Love that is **NOT our own**We can **KNOW** that **GOD'S SPIRIT** is living in us (**Rom 5:5**)
- & (again) we can **KNOW** that we are of the truth & we can reassure our hearts before God (as v.19 says)
- So **LOOK** for the Love of God in your life & when you see it **reassure your heart** that Jesus Christ lives in you

& then - <u>V.20</u> continues the thought from <u>V.19</u> & gives us our 2nd Assurance

Assurance #2) God's true knowledge of us Assures us

1Jn 3:19-20 - ESV

v.19 (again) <u>By this</u> (loving one another) we shall know that we are of the truth and reassure our heart before him; 20 for whenever (if) our heart condemns us, God is greater than our heart, and <u>he knows everything</u>.

V.20 is written to give us Assurance when we doubt ourselves,

Which is something we all do& so THIS is an Assurance we REALLY need

The flow of thought is like this;

- by examining our <u>ACTIONS</u> (especially Love)
 we can <u>KNOW</u> that we are "of the truth
 we can <u>REASSURE</u> our heart before God (in His presence)
- 2) & then when our own heart (conscience) condemns us - when the enemy starts throwing those fiery darts accusing us (Rev 12:10 he accuses us day & night)
- & even when our <u>own conscience</u> starts saying "hey, you're NOT saved, God's not going to forgive YOU"
- If we have **EVIDENCE** in our life that we've been **Transformed** (Born Again) by our Faith in Christ

Then we can say to our own deceitful conscience - BACK OFF

God knows everything about me

He has completely **FORGIVEN** me

He has **TRANSFORMED** me

He has **ADOPTED** me as His child - &

HE is **GREATER** than my own "self-doubting" conscience!!

If there's **TANGIBLE EVIDENCE** in your life of the Lordship of Christ **THEN** - when your own heart (conscience) **condemns** you

you can stand firm on WHO God is

on how **COMPLETELY** He knows you - & on How much **GREATER** He is than your own *deceitful doubts*

AMEN?

& then <u>next</u> - John gives us <u>the great place</u> of Assurance that <u>each of us</u> must constantly be <u>returning</u> to

Assurance #3) A cleansed conscious Assures us

1Jn 3:21 - ESV

21 Beloved, if our heart <u>does not condemn</u> us, we have confidence before God;

Man, <u>that's where</u> we need to be - isn't it? a heart (conscience) that <u>DOES NOT</u> condemn us

BUT does that mean we have to be **SINLESS** for our heart to not condemn us?? - - *Of course NOT*

What it means is ... \rightarrow \rightarrow

We Must Be constantly washed - cleansed - forgiven of our sin

Having the Great Confidence that 1Jn 1:9 is totally & absolutely TRUE

1Jn 1:9 - ESV

9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

The greatest **Assurance** we can have before God The greatest **Confidence** we can have before God

Is the confidence of **knowing** that we are walking with Jesus Daily in **confession** & **repentance**

& that there is **no hidden sin** separating us from Him

We're <u>not trying</u> to pull something <u>over</u> on God <u>thinking</u> (ridiculously) that we could actually <u>hide</u> our sin

But <u>instead</u> - we're walking in <u>total honesty</u> with God <u>turning away</u> from sin & <u>turning toward</u> God (repentance)

& <u>confessing</u> our sins when we fall coming to Him for **forgiveness** & **cleansing** from our sin

Isa 59:2 says our sin SEPARATES us from God

BUT - **How GREAT** a confidence *can we have*

when there is <u>NO separation</u> from God due to <u>unconfessed</u> or <u>un-dealt-with</u> sin

When we are in <u>THAT</u> place with God We have the <u>GREATEST Assurance</u> possible

& so - if there IS <u>unconfessed</u> or <u>un-dealt-with</u> sin separating you from God - <u>FIX IT !</u>

Confess that sin - Repent of it (turn away)
& be cleansed of the separation that sin is causing

& <u>then</u> - the Holy Spirit will <u>reassure</u> you that you can <u>walk in Confidence</u> with God

AND - this Great assurance (talked about in V.21)

is **NOT JUST** Assurance in our **SALVATION** but it is also - an Assurance in our **PRAYERS**

Assurance #4) Obedience Assures us

Vs's 21 & 22 go together - so let's read them together

1Jn 3:21 (again) & 22 - ESV

21 Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence before God;

22 and whatever we ask we receive from him, because we <u>keep</u> his commandments and <u>do</u> what pleases him.

Whoa - now that's a Vs that could be easily taken out of context & used for

let's say a "Prosperity Doctrine" - - as in, I can force God to give me whatever I want

But listen - because we read the whole Bible
We know that prayer is NO MAGIC WAND

& we know that we **cannot** somehow **FORCE** God's hand to give us anything

That is **NOT** what this is a picture of

But <u>instead</u> - there is such an <u>incredible picture</u> here of the most <u>powerful relationship</u> we can have with Jesus Christ

& it has <u>nothing to do</u> with getting whatever we want thru prayer Look carefully at the <u>OUR PART</u> here:

#1 - (v.21) Our heart does not condemn us

So were walking with no separation from God because of unconfessed sin

#2 - (v.22) We keep His commandments

So we're certainly not walking in any SELF-CENTERED motivation

#3) - (v.22) We do what pleases Him Meaning we are walking in His will

<u>THIS</u> is a picture of the most <u>wonderful</u> - <u>powerful</u> <u>incredible</u> <u>relationship</u> - you & I can <u>have</u> with the Lord

When we are <u>walking</u> & <u>praying</u> in <u>UNITY</u> with God We will be praying <u>HIS WILL</u> - as we're led by the Holy Spirit

& <u>as we do</u> - we will be <u>receiving</u> what we ask for !! THIS is where we should <u>ALL DESIRE</u> to be - Amen? it's a picture of <u>walking</u> & <u>praying</u> in total **UNITY** with the will of God

& that the **Greatest Assurance** there is !

Now - <u>maybe</u> because John has said "We keep His commandments" in <u>v.22</u>

He seems to want to <u>clarify</u> <u>WHICH</u> commandment He's talking about

Assurance #5) Faith with Love Assures us

1Jn 3:23 - ESV

23 And this is his commandment, that we <u>believe</u> in the name of his Son Jesus Christ and <u>love</u> one another, just as he has commanded us.

The SINGLE command that John Clarifies is;

<u>Faith</u> in the name of Jesus Christ <u>AND</u> <u>Love</u> of the brethren

John So ties together the **#1 Vertical Command** & the **#1 Horizontal Command**

that He writes them as **ONE command**

FIRST HALF - that we believe (put our faith) in THE NAME of Jesus Christ

"The NAME" of Jesus Christ means that we believe (put our faith) in the FULL character & nature of all that Jesus Christ IS

& **if** we have done that ... \rightarrow \rightarrow

then LOVING One Another will be the **natural outflow** of our faith in Christ

- & then <u>John says</u> (at the end of <u>V.23</u>)
 this commandment is just as he has commanded us"
- & this takes us back to the Commandment Jesus gave the disciples

The commandment John already said (<u>in Ch2</u>) is the <u>OLD</u> command <u>AND</u> the <u>NEW</u> command

It's the **Command** Jesus gave at *the last supper* in **John Ch 13**

John 13:34-35 - ESV

34 A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another.
35 By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

True FAITH in Jesus Christ - **MUST** bring **LOVE** for one another

Because - **BY THIS** all people will know that we are His disciples

- & by our <u>FAITH</u> & by our <u>LOVE</u> for One Another we can have <u>Great Assurance</u> of our salvation - <u>AMEN?</u>
- & <u>finally</u> John talks about the <u>assurance</u> that comes from <u>US ABIDING</u> in Him, & <u>HE ABIDING</u> in us

AND - he tells us HOW we can KNOW God is Abiding in US

Assurance #6) The Holy Spirit in our lives Assures us

1Jn 3:24 - ESV

24 Whoever keeps his commandments abides in God, and God in him. And by this (\rightarrow) we know that he abides in us, by the Spirit whom he has given us.

Keeping God's commandments is **the WAY** that we **ABIDE** in God, & God **ABDIDES** in us

& we know **these commandments** are **summarized** by;

LOVING One Another (Her

LOVING One Another (Horizontally)

& then <u>v.24</u> says - we'll <u>KNOW</u> that God is abiding in us <u>BY</u> the presence of the Holy Spirit in our lives

But <u>HOW does</u> "Keeping God's Commandments" & the Presence of the Holy Spirit in us - <u>Go Together?</u>

Because the Greatest commands of Loving God & Loving One Another

<u>CAN NOT be kept</u> - <u>without</u> the Holy Spirit <u>Ruling</u> & Reigning in our lives

it is **ONLY** by the **Power** of the Holy Spirit in our lives

that <u>we CAN</u> - Love <u>God</u> <u>Supremely</u> - & Love <u>Others</u> <u>Sacrificially</u>

& so keeping <u>THESE Commands</u> - are actually the <u>ultimate evidence</u> of the Holy Spirit in our lives

& **THAT Evidence** gives us **Absolute Assurance** that we are **ABIDING** in God - & He is **ABIDING** in US

By the Holy Spirit whom he has given us.

& so - Here is the **Absolute Assurance** of our Salvation

Do we see the **Evidence** of the Holy Spirit at work in our lives - **enabling us to**;

- # 1) Put our Full Faith & Trust in the Name of Jesus Christ
- #2) Obey His Commands
- #3) Love One another as Christ loves us

If we <u>see these evidences</u> in our lives then we can <u>know 100%</u> absolutely - for sure

That we have **God's Guaranteed Assurance** of our **Eternal Salvation**

& **IF** - while we are **growing** in these Evidences . . .

if our <u>wicked & deceitful heart</u> ever begins to <u>condemn us</u> & cause us to doubt

Then we can <u>STAND</u> on <u>God's WORD</u> knowing that <u>God is greater</u> than the <u>doubts</u> of our own heart

Knowing that He knows everything

& <u>Knowing</u> - that He has <u>ASSURED US</u> that He will <u>bring His work</u> of salvation <u>in us</u> - to completion
