Dan02 - When do you Commit? - Dan Ch 1

When do you COMMIT - To Really Go ALL IN with God?
When do you COMMIT - To Truly Follow Him - To do things His Way?

When do you COMMIT - To TRUST Him - & SERVE Him NO MATTER What your Circumstances look like

When do you Make a Rock-Solid Commitment to Follow Jesus Christ - No Matter What?

When - Meaning **During** what **Circumstance** or **Situation** in your <u>life</u>?

I've had the <u>Great Blessing</u> - of seeing <u>people</u> make <u>All-In Commitments</u> to <u>Follow God</u> - <u>No Matter What</u>

& I've been <u>Greatly Disturbed</u> - By seeing <u>people</u> so easily <u>Turn away</u> from God - <u>Because something</u> didn't <u>go quite right</u>

My question today is - WHEN do YOU get DECISIVE, DETERMINED, INTENT, & RESOLVED To Serve God no matter what?

Under <u>WHAT Circumstance</u> or <u>Situation</u> do you <u>Make Your</u>

<u>Commitment</u> to <u>Follow Jesus Christ</u> & Serve Him

with <u>NO Doubt</u> - & <u>NO Wavering</u>

The Question today is - WHEN do you COMMIT?

Let's Pray

- In our <u>last msg</u> We <u>reviewed 350 years</u> of <u>lsrael's</u> History & a <u>Bunch</u> of the <u>greatest Historical</u> & <u>Prophetic</u> books of the <u>O.T.</u>
- & we <u>finished</u> with King <u>Nebuchadnezzar</u> <u>STORMING</u> <u>Jerusalem</u> <u>BY</u> the <u>Hand of God</u> & <u>in response</u> to Israel's <u>sin</u>
- & <u>Nebuchadnezzar</u> <u>Ultimately Destroyed</u> not only <u>the city</u> but even the <u>Great Temple</u> of God
- & in <u>3 WAVES</u> <u>Nebuchadnezzar</u> took the Israelites as <u>Prisoners</u> back to <u>Babylon</u> to make them <u>servants</u>
- & <u>we learned</u> that (probably) in the <u>FIRST WAVE</u> of those <u>P.O.W.'s</u> was a <u>Young Boy</u> Who is the <u>Main Character</u> in <u>Book of Daniel</u>

Today - we want to put ourselves in that Young boy's shoes we want to try to SEE what he SAW & FEEL what He FELT

& we <u>want</u> to <u>ask ourselves</u> - <u>would we</u> make the <u>SAME Commitment</u> that <u>Daniel</u> Made - <u>WHEN</u> He made it

Let's set the stage - By again reading

Daniel 1:1–2 (NLT)

- 1 During the third year of King Jehoiakim's reign in Judah (southern tribes, last in the land), King Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon came to Jerusalem and besieged it.
- 2 <u>The Lord gave him victory</u> (notice) over King Jehoiakim of Judah and <u>permitted him</u> (God permitted him) to take some of the sacred objects from the Temple of God. So Nebuchadnezzar took them back to the land of Babylonia and placed them in the treasurehouse of his god.

- & <u>During</u> this <u>SIEGE</u> (in 3 waves) <u>MOST</u> of the Israelites were <u>Brought Back</u> as <u>CAPTIVES</u> to Babylon
- But Nebuchadnezzar had SPECIAL Plans for Israel's "Best & Brightest"
- & <u>as I read</u> these next <u>2 Vs's</u> think a <u>little bit</u> about the <u>HITLER YOUTH CAMPS</u> of <u>WWII</u>

Daniel 1:3-4 (NLT)

- 3 Then the king ordered Ashpenaz, his chief of staff (esv chief Eunuch), to bring to the palace some of the young men of Judah's royal family and other noble families, who had been brought to Babylon as captives.
- 4 "Select only strong, healthy, and good-looking young men," he said. "Make sure they are well versed in every branch of learning, are gifted with knowledge and good judgment, and are suited to serve in the royal palace . . .

These vs's let us know - Daniel was from a ROYAL family of Israel
He (& his friends) - we're Strong, Healthy, & Good looking
They were Well Educated - Gifted w/ Knowledge & Good Judgment
AND they knew HOW to ACT in the Royal Palace

& <u>Notice</u> - the <u>word</u> translated <u>YOUNG MEN</u> here <u>Refers</u> to <u>boys</u> Just Before - <u>Puberty</u>

Which means Daniel would've been 13-15 years old - at the MOST

& back home in Israel - He had it ALL going on part of the Royal Family
Strong - Healthy- Good Looking - Educated

AND he had MANNERS - (he had it ALL)

Now - Are you familiar w/ the Nazi "YOUTH CAMPS"

In <u>these Camps</u> The "<u>Hitler Youth</u>" were <u>Indoctrinated</u> in <u>every way</u> into the **NAZI** "World View"

Hitler took the best & brightest youth & he transformed them into the Future NAZI Machine

He took them from their families - YOUNG & IMPRESSIONABLE

- & <u>Everything</u> in those <u>Camps</u> were <u>Designed</u> to <u>transform</u> those <u>Young Boys</u> into the <u>PURE NAZI</u> Culture
- & THAT is EXACTLY what is going on here with DANIEL

Nebuchadnezzar took Israel's BEST & BRIGHTEST

& in Daniel 1:4(b)-5 we read (NLT)

- 4... Train these young men in the language and literature of Babylon (Chaldeans same thing)."
- 5 The king assigned them a daily ration of food and wine from his own kitchens. They were to be <u>trained for three years</u>, and then they would enter the royal service.

You see - we can't just say - Well Daniel was taken Captive to Babylon - & here is what happened to him

it's far too easy - to just say that - & continue on w/ the Story

Because - These are REAL people - with REAL Families

& Daniel is a REAL TEENAGER - experiencing REAL Trauma

Not only the Trauma of WAR

- But <u>seeing</u> his <u>home destroyed</u>, & <u>all</u> that he <u>knows destroyed</u> & <u>Being Dragged Away</u> from his <u>family</u> as a <u>P.O.W.</u>
- & **very possibly** seeing **the death** of **many** of **those** he **loved**
- & <u>if</u> his <u>Family DID</u> remain <u>alive</u> it was <u>most likely</u> the <u>LAST Time</u> he <u>SAW</u> them
- Daniel was 15 yrs old & being forcibly torn away from his family & taken as a P.O.W. into a foreign land
- & then <u>Put into</u> a <u>Babylonian</u> <u>Brain-Washing</u> "<u>Re-Education</u>" Camp
- the **purpose** of which was to **MAKE** young **Israelites Think** & **Act** & **Feel** Like **Babylonians**

Because it was Important Politically for Nebuchadnezzar to have the BEST & the BRIGHTEST of Israel - SERVING HIM

& THEN - there is one more thing that Daniel & his friends were about to Experience

After being TAKEN from their Families & their homes & made SLAVES in a Foreign Land

The <u>Bible implies</u> it - but <u>Historians</u> Tell Us - <u>Nebuchadnezzar</u> would've made these Young <u>Teenage Boys</u> - <u>EUNUCHS</u>

Now - Right there - all the men should be WINCING

Not only did they experience all the TRAUMA leading UP to Babylon

But <u>almost Certainly</u> - As <u>part</u> of their <u>Re-Education</u> these 15 yr old boys - would've been - CASTRATED

& for a 15 year old boy - who had EVERYTHING Going for him - to LOSE it ALL - INCLUDING His Manhood

THAT - is what you call - an UNIMAGINABLE SITUATION

& my question to you today is - When do YOU Decide For God?

When do you make your All-In - No-Matter-What - Decision to Follow God & Serve him ALONE?

Is it on the heels of God DOING something Great for you . . .

Oh God, if you'll just Do THIS for me If you'll just make my life BETTER . . . Then I'll SERVE YOU FOREVER !!

THAT is our <u>Selfish Human Nature</u> - & it's the <u>Exact OPPOSITE</u> of <u>Everything</u> the <u>Bible Teaches</u> us

We're about to see Daniel

Make an Incredible Commitment to God

& **Take** an **Incredible STAND** for God

Right in the Middle of the MOST Traumatic string of events a young boy could ever experience

For **Daniel** - it's **NOT** - God **I'll Serve you** - **IF** you do **this** or **that**

For Daniel it's - God I'll Serve You - NO MATTER what's happening

NO MATTER Where I'm At - Or WHAT My Situation is I will Serve you - All-In - No-Matter-What

Because YOU, God,

Are **GREATER** than my **TRIALS**You are **GREATER** than my **CIRCUMSTANCES**You are **GREATER** than my Present **DIFFICULTY**

& <u>So</u> - I will <u>TAKE A STAND</u> for you God in the Middle of My <u>TRIALS</u>

NOT - IF you'll do this or that for me
But because of WHO you ARE - in my Life

Do you get it?

It MATTERS - WHAT Daniel's Background is

Because when we see him <u>TAKE HIS STAND</u> for God We <u>HAVE</u> to know <u>the circumstances</u> he <u>MAKES</u> that <u>Decision</u> in

Otherwise - we'll have the tendency to think - Well sure, Daniel took a Stand for God - But Me - I'm in a REALLY hard situation

Really? - Have you found yourself as a Castrated P.O.W. in an enemy "Re-Education Camp" Lately??

Because THAT is where Daniel is AT - When we see Him Make the Commitment that STARTS the Book of Daniel

So - as we <u>read</u> the <u>rest</u> of <u>Ch 1</u> - Allow it to <u>COME ALIVE</u> within the <u>Picture</u> we've just <u>painted</u>

First We have the NAMES of Daniel & His 3 Friends

Daniel 1:6 (NLT)

6 Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah were four of the young men chosen, all from the tribe of Judah (ruling families).

But - as PART of their "Re-Education" - Their names are going to be CHANGED to Babylonian Names

Daniel 1:7 (NLT)

7 The chief of staff (ESV - Eunuchs) renamed them with these Babylonian names: Daniel was called Belteshazzar. Hananiah was called Shadrach. Mishael was called Meshach. Azariah was called Abednego.

Notice the **New Names** the **Israelite boys** were **given**

<u>Daniel - Belteshazzar</u> = comes from the name "<u>BEL</u>" which was the <u>chief BABYLONIAN GOD</u> (means: Bel protect)

<u>Hananiah - Shadrach</u> = Comes from the <u>SUN god</u> - <u>Shad</u> (means: <u>Inspired by Shad</u> - the sun god)

<u>Mishael - Meshach</u> = Means: *Who is like Shach* (Not B.Ball player) <u>Shach</u> is another <u>Lunar god</u> of <u>Babylon</u>

Azariah - Abednego = means: Servant of the shining one a ref to the Babylonian god - NEBO

No Hebrew Names - No references to the Hebrew GOD
Only Babylonian Names - w/ Ref to all Babylonian gods

Now - Here it is - right here

The Question is - WHEN do YOU Make Your Commitment?

When do You decide to take a stand for God?

<u>Is it</u> - <u>When</u> things are <u>going great</u> & God is <u>blessing you</u>? <u>Or is it</u> - <u>When</u> you are in the Midst of <u>Great Difficulty</u>?

<u>Daniel</u> - as a <u>Young boy</u> Had been <u>Traumatized</u> by <u>WAR</u>, <u>DEATH</u>, & <u>DESTRUCTION</u>

& <u>Taken</u> as a <u>P.O.W</u>. - <u>Put</u> into a <u>Brain-Washing</u> - <u>Re-Education</u> Camp - & <u>CASTRATED</u>

Right THERE - is where <u>Daniel</u> Makes <u>HIS COMMITMENT</u>

Right THERE is where <u>Daniel</u> becomes <u>RESOLUTE</u>

Right THERE is where <u>Daniel</u> <u>DECIDES</u> - He is <u>going</u>

to <u>Serve God</u> - <u>No Matter What</u> comes his way

Right THERE is where <u>Daniel</u> Makes the <u>Decision of his LIFE</u>

Right THERE is where the <u>Direction</u> of <u>Daniel's Life is SET</u>

NOT in Blessing - & NOT Conditioned Upon God doing ANYTHING for Him

But Right - in the Midst of TRIAL - & TRAUMA - & DIFFICULTY

& RIGHT THERE is where WE Must
Make The Commitment of our LIFE
To Follow & Serve Jesus Christ - No Matter WHAT

LOOK at the First FEW WORDS - of Daniel 1:8 (NLT)

8 But Daniel was determined . . . - - [repeat]

Look at how the other translations put it

But Daniel **RESOLVED**

But Daniel PURPOSED IN HIS HEART

But Daniel **DETERMINED IN HIS HEART**

But Daniel MADE UP HIS MIND

Right THERE - IN the THICK of IT - THAT is where Daniel Made His Decision to Serve God Alone - NO MATTER WHAT

Would YOU??

Is **THIS** where **you would Make** your **COMMITMENT** ??

Or - When things get Difficult - do you turn:

to your **OWN** Course of Action?

to your **OWN Ideas** - To Your **OWN** Feelings?

to your **OWN Plan**?

Can I just tell you something please . . .

ANYONE can make an ALL-IN Decision to follow God - when everything is going great - & their life is on cruise control

The Question that Daniel's Life SCREAMS out to us is - WHAT Commitment will you make "In The Fire"

Will you take your stand to serve God "No Matter What"

When everything looks bleak

& **NOTHING** is **going Right** for you??

& <u>Listen</u> - Our <u>Commitment</u> to <u>Serve God</u> - <u>No matter</u> what <u>ALWAYS</u> starts in the <u>SMALL</u> things!!

It **ALWAYS** starts in the **SMALL** things - **NOT** the **Big things**

The commitment these boys made didn't start with the Fiery Furnace - It started with a CHEESEBURGER !!

Their <u>ALL-IN Commitment</u> to God <u>didn't start</u> with the <u>big</u> - <u>public</u> <u>heroic</u> "<u>Fiery Furnace</u>" Day

It **STARTED** - **When** they were **offered** their **First CHEESEBURGER**!

& <u>their Decision</u> about that <u>CHEESEBURGER</u>

<u>Prepared</u> them for <u>their Decision</u> about the <u>FIERY FURNACE !!</u>

Let's re-read all of DANIEL 1:8 (NLT)

8 But Daniel was determined <u>not to defile himself</u> by eating the food and wine given to them by the king. He asked the chief of staff (eunuchs) <u>for permission</u> not to eat these <u>unacceptable</u> foods.

You see - the Cheeseburger of the World
Was Unacceptable - according to the Law of Moses

- & Daniel Grew Up Serving God THRU the Law of MOSES & his EATING was PART of His SERVICE to God AND part of His WORSHIP of God
- & So Daniel **BEGAN** His **All-In Commitment** to God **RIGHT THERE** Over a **Cheeseburger**

Daniel - Buddy - Come ON . . . Don't get all worked up over a CHEESEBURGER - Have you SEEN the situation your in ?

God just let you get CASTRATED - & Now you don't want to eat a CHEESEBURGER - Cause you're afraid you'll OFFEND God

Get over man, Have a Cheeseburger & DEFILE yourself a little bit

WHAT'S the Cheeseburger in YOUR Life right now??

What **Small thing** are you **Allowing** to **DEFILE** your life **because** you've **convinced** yourself - it's **NO BIG DEAL**

after all - God's not doing anything Great for you right now - so you ought to be able to Defile your life a little bit

What's the Cheeseburger in your life Right Now?

In the Midst of an Extremely Traumatic Situation

<u>NO MATTER</u> What the <u>Situation</u>
<u>NO MATTER</u> how <u>Seemingly SMALL</u> the <u>issue</u> was

Even if it was JUST - About the Food

<u>NEXT</u> - & <u>I think</u> it's <u>VITALLY Important</u> - that we see <u>HOW</u>
<u>Daniel</u> Went About <u>Keeping</u> His <u>Commitment to God</u>

He didn't start w/ some Offensive, Dramatic, Look-At-Me - action

Look at V.8 again - it says Daniel asked the chief of the Eunuchs for permission not to eat these unacceptable foods

<u>Daniel</u> wasn't <u>making a scene</u> - He wasn't <u>throwing a Fit</u> - He <u>didn't</u> start a <u>FaceBook Campaign</u> or call a <u>Christian Rights Attorney</u>

HE made an All-In Commitment to God - & then He Respectfully approached the guy who recently made him a EUNUCH

& he <u>simply ASKED Him</u> for <u>permission</u> to <u>not eat</u> the <u>Cheeseburgers of Babylon</u>

& God MOVED - On Daniel's Behalf

Daniel 1:9 (NLT)

9 Now God had given the chief of staff both respect and affection for Daniel.

BUT - it also presented a Problem for the Chief of Staff

Daniel 1:10 (NLT)

10 But he responded, "I am afraid of my lord the king, who has ordered that you eat this food and wine. If you become pale and thin compared to the other youths your age, I am afraid the king will have me beheaded."

Nebuchadnezzar's Primary motivation for his people was the threat of DIVORCE

As in - "I'm gonna Divorce your head from your body"

I saw a cartoon - about a High Office in our country & the question was asked - What do you think about Be-Heading - & the answer was - Well, right now I think I Be-Heading out to play some GOLF

Well - that's not how Nebuchadnezzar felt about it

He <u>would DISPATCH</u> your head <u>SO FAST</u> You <u>wouldn't know it</u> till you <u>SNEEZED</u>

- & the **Chief Eunuch** was **well aware** of that
- & so **Daniel Proposed a Plan** that would **Bring God Glory**

Daniel 1:11–14 (NLT)

- 11 Daniel spoke with the attendant who had been appointed by the chief of staff to look after Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah.
- 12 "Please test us for ten days on a diet of vegetables and water," Daniel said.
- 13 "At the end of the ten days, see how we look compared to the other young men who are eating the king's food. Then make your decision in light of what you see."
- 14 The attendant agreed to Daniel's suggestion and tested them for ten days.

Guys - when we make a Commitment to Serve God ALL-IN - No Matter what

We <u>don't have</u> to be <u>JERKS</u> - & we don't <u>have to Start</u> <u>Intentionally OFFENDING</u> People around us

Like Daniel - We can Respectfully Suggest a Plan that is Designed - to Ultimately Bring God GLORY

- In the Midst of the most <u>Trying</u> & <u>Difficult circumstances</u> <u>Daniel</u> Made his <u>Commitment</u> to <u>Serve God ALONE</u>
- & he **BEGAN** his **commitment** in the **SMALL THINGS the things** that **others didn't** even **think MATTERED**
- & God KNEW One Thing FOR SURE
- If **Daniel** would **KEEP** His **Commitment** in the **SMALL** things He would **KEEP** His **Commitment** in the **LARGE** Things
- & it's **EXACTLY The SAME** For **you & I**

& God **BLESSED** the **COMMITMENT** of **Daniel** (& friends)

Daniel 1:15–16 (NLT)

15 At the end of the ten days, Daniel and his three friends looked healthier and better nourished than the young men who had been eating the food assigned by the king.

16 So after that, the attendant fed them only vegetables instead of the food and wine provided for the others.

<u>Daniel's First Commitment Test - PASSED with Flying Colors</u>

<u>Daniel</u> - & His <u>Friends</u> - <u>Committed</u> to <u>Serve God ALONE</u> In the <u>Midst</u> of the most <u>Trying Circumstances</u>

& God's Blessing - & God's Protection - FOLLOWED

Daniel 1:17 (NLT)

17 God gave these four young men an unusual aptitude for understanding every aspect of literature and wisdom. And God

gave Daniel the special ability to interpret the meanings of visions and dreams.

GOD Gave them - **UNUSUAL Aptitude** - & **SPECIAL Ability**

Which was God's DESIGN - to Give these young boys BOTH His Blessing & His Protection as they GREW

Which we Immediately Begin to see

Daniel 1:18-21 (NLT)

18 When the training period ordered by the king was completed, (3 yrs) the chief of staff brought all the young men to King Nebuchadnezzar.

19 The king talked with them, and no one impressed him as much as Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah. So they entered the royal service.

20 Whenever the king consulted them in any matter requiring wisdom and balanced judgment, he found them ten times more capable than any of the magicians and enchanters in his entire kingdom. (the beginning of God's Blessing)

21 Daniel remained in the royal service until the first year of the reign of King Cyrus. (referring to a time when Daniel was - 80 yrs old)

What an incredible START - For Daniel - & his Friends

What an Incredibly Difficult set of circumstances
To Make your ALL-IN - No Matter What - Commitment to God

So . . . What about YOU?

When DID You Make your
ALL-IN - No Matter What - Commitment to God?

Or . . . have you??

Are you struggling - to MAKE that commitment - Right NOW?

<u>Are you</u> in a <u>Situation</u> right now - <u>Where</u> it <u>makes PERFECT SENSE</u> (<u>To You</u>) - to <u>BEND</u> A Little - to just <u>DEFILE</u> your life - <u>a LITTLE</u>

& do you think you Deserve it - Because you've had it - Pretty ROUGH?

Please - SEE the Critical Crossroad that you are AT

SEE what HANGS in the Balance

SEE that God is **Watching**, & **KNOW** He will **Respond** Accordingly

& then - Take a DEEP BREATH - & MAKE YOUR COMMITMENT
Your ALL-IN - No Turning Back - No Matter What - Commitment

<u>Don't Vacillate</u> - Don't <u>Negotiate</u> - Don't <u>Rationalize</u> - <u>Justify</u> - <u>Defend</u> - or <u>Excuse</u>

Just MAKE Your COMMITMENT !!

Make your Commitment:

To Follow Jesus Christ - No Matter What

To **Serve** Him - **No Matter What**

To **Choose** His Way - **No Matter What**

& NO MATTER What your Circumstance or Situation

God will MEET you there

God will BLESS you there

God will USE your life - for His GLORY - RIGHT THERE

Let's Pray
