Spc187 – Direction Setting Decisions (2020) Judges 13-16

<u>I'm teaching</u> up at <u>C.B.I.</u> – <u>& I LOVE it</u>

<u>Justo</u> is <u>there</u> – & the <u>class</u> is <u>incredible</u> this year

& I see these students at the Bible College

MAKING <u>Determined Decisions</u> to <u>MOVE THEMSELVES</u>
<u>TOWARD God's Plan</u> for them

& it blesses me SO MUCH – to see them Committing their lives to SEEK GOD & Follow HIS Great PLAN for their Lives

But <u>today</u> – I want to <u>Look</u> at the <u>OPPOSITE EXAMPLE</u> of <u>what I see</u> - in the <u>Lives</u> of the <u>Bible College Students</u>

I <u>think MAYBE</u> the <u>BEST Example</u> in Scripture of <u>Direction Setting Decisions</u> – Would be <u>SAMSON</u>

SAMSON made <u>Decision</u>, after <u>Decision</u>
That <u>ultimately led</u> to the <u>Destruction of his life</u>

So – <u>Let's look</u> at <u>SAMSON'S</u> <u>Decision Making</u> – for us to know - *How NOT to do it* – in our own lives

Let's Pray

In <u>Judges 13:5</u> - The <u>Angel of the Lord</u> appeared to Samson's <u>Mother</u>

& told her to Dedicate Samson to the Lord from his birth - AS a NAZIRITE

The NAZARITE VOW included

Avoiding Alcohol & Dead Bodies

& Allowing your Hair to grow

Which were all SYMBOLS – of Samson being SET ASIDE - for God's USE

Now – the "Lesson within a Lesson" - in Samson's life Is about God's SOVEREIGNTY

& <u>about</u> How <u>God Worked</u> - <u>FOR Israel's GOOD</u> <u>IN THE MIDST</u> of <u>SAMSON'S</u> <u>Bad Decisions</u>

& the First Vs about Samson – actually POINTS to God's Sovereignty in SAMSON'S Life

The END of Judges 13:5 (NLT)

5... He will begin to rescue Israel from the Philistines."

Even tho we will see Samson

Destroy his life by his own choices

God will STILL BE "At Work" in it all

To BEGIN to Rescue Israel from the Philistines

Samson Becomes the **LAST** of the **Judges of Israel**

Who were to be

The **Deliverers** & **Leaders** of **the Nation**

& the <u>Time</u> that <u>Samson</u> was a <u>Judge</u> of Israel was <u>Especially Difficult</u>

The <u>Philistines</u> (arch enemies) had <u>CAPTURED the ARK</u> & they had <u>totally DISARMED</u> the <u>Nation</u> of <u>Israel</u>

- & <u>Israel</u> was <u>Living in Subjection</u> to the <u>Enemy</u>
 They were <u>Oppressed & Dominated</u> by the <u>Philistines</u>
- & <u>SAMSON</u> was <u>Called by God</u> & given <u>Miraculous Strength</u> – From God

In order to **DELIVER Israel** - **FROM** the **Philistines**

BUT – instead of **Delivering Israel FROM the Philistines**

Samson got himself Deeply Entangled
WITH the Philistines

In Judges Ch 14

we see Samson begin

to Make the **Decisions**

That **would** ultimately **Set the Direction** of his **LIFE**

Judges 14:1 (NLT)

1 One day when Samson was in Timnah, one of the <u>Philistine</u> women caught his eye.

If you know ANYTHING about Samson

You know he was ABSOLUTELY CONTROLLED by his desire for women

But Pls - don't turn this into <u>JUST</u> a <u>lesson</u>
About <u>LUST & SEXUAL Sin</u> – (altho it is great for that)

Women ARE what Caused Samson to make the <u>Decisions</u> that <u>SET THE DIRECTION</u> of His <u>Life</u>

BUT . . . **WHAT** is it for you?

What <u>causes YOU</u> to Make <u>Decisions</u> that MIGHT **Set the** Direction of **YOUR** Life?

I Promise - Whatever it is

it has **something** to do with **What YOU WANT** it has **something** to do with **What YOU THINK** is **BEST** for **YOU**

So - the <u>OBJECT</u> May <u>Be Different</u> <u>But</u> believe me – the <u>LESSON</u> is <u>The Same</u>

Cont'g - Judges 14:2 (NLT)

2 When he returned home, he told his father and mother, "A young <u>Philistine woman</u> in Timnah caught my eye. I want to marry her. <u>Get her for me</u>."

Samson SAW what he Wanted

& He DEMANDED to HAVE what he Wanted

With **ZERO consideration** - of **what God Wanted**

So – Samson's Parents try to Nudge him in the right direction

Judges 14:3 (NLT)

3 His father and mother objected. "Isn't there even one woman in our tribe or among all the Israelites you could marry?" they asked. "Why must you go to the <u>pagan</u>

<u>Philistines</u> (who are the enemy) to find a wife?" But Samson told his father, "Get her for me! She looks good to me."

It seems that Samson had a BIT of "Spoiled-brat-itis" on top of his other problems

The <u>Israelites</u> were <u>FORBIDDEN</u> by <u>GOD</u> to <u>MARRY</u> the <u>Philistines</u>

<u>AND</u> Samson had been "<u>Set-Apart</u>" by <u>God</u>
to be A DELIVERER of God's People – FROM the Philistines

But Samson WANTED

To SET the Direction of His Own Life

& so <u>he says</u> to his <u>Father</u> "Get her for me! She looks good to me."

<u>Then</u> – in the <u>God's Sovereignty Lesson</u> <u>that</u> is <u>inter-woven</u> here

IN the <u>Very Next Vs</u> (v.4) it says <u>God</u> was <u>AT WORK</u> <u>WITHIN</u> Samson's <u>Selfish Demand</u>

BUT – this is **STILL the beginning** – of the **Decisions** that **set the Direction** of Samson's Life

So - **Cont** in **Ch 14**

Samson & His parents head to TIMNAH

(Philistine Territory) - to "GET" this woman for Samson

& Along the Way (in V.6)
Samson KILLS a Lion with his bare hands
(Due to the Miraculous Strength God had given him)

Then <u>Samson's Dad</u> works out this <u>Marriage with the Enemy</u> for <u>Samson</u>

& when they're headed back later - for the Wedding

Samson finds the Lion he'd killed
& some BEES were making HONEY
INSIDE the Carcass of the LION

So <u>Samson scoops out</u> some of the <u>HONEY</u> & <u>eats</u> it

WHICH was AGAINST

His **NAZIRITE Vow** to God - to **not touch** a **corpse**

But **Samson wanted** some **Honey** from his **Trophy**

So he set aside his Vow to God & makes Another Decision - FOR HIMSELF

Then – still in <u>Judges 14</u> - <u>Samson</u> throws a <u>Big Party</u>

That <u>V.10</u> says – "was the custom for Elite young men"

& <u>this party</u> would have <u>certainly included</u> - <u>Good WINE</u>

<u>Which</u> was also <u>AGAINST</u> Samson's <u>Vow to God</u>

& so - just knowing what we know about Samson so far

It's <u>highly likely</u> - <u>Samson</u> <u>Set Aside</u>
his <u>commitment</u> to <u>God</u> - for <u>this Decision</u> as well

- & <u>then</u> The <u>Bride's Father</u> sent <u>30 Philistine Men</u> to <u>join Samson</u> in his Party
- & so <u>Now</u> Samson is <u>Partying</u> with the <u>Enemy</u>, before <u>Marrying</u> the <u>Enemy</u>

Here's the MATH for what we've seen so far

One Decision + One Decision + One Decision = ONE DIRECTION (not the Boy Band)

& so (in <u>Judges 14:12</u>) <u>Samson decides</u> to tell these 30 Philistine men a RIDDLE

<u>Designed</u> to get <u>Samson</u> <u>30 SETS</u>
of <u>FINE Linen Garments</u> (1 from ea of the men)

Because what person DEDICATED & SET APART to God Doesn't want 30 sets of Fine WORLDLY Garments

So He <u>tells</u> the men a <u>Riddle based</u> on his <u>Lion & Honey</u> & he <u>gives</u> them <u>7 days</u> of <u>Partying</u> to <u>figure</u> it out

But <u>instead</u> - they <u>go</u> to the <u>Bride-to be</u> (<u>who</u> has <u>ZERO Commitment</u> to <u>Samson</u>)

& they tell her they'll BURN her alive if she doesn't get the answer for them

So she **goes to WORK** on **Samson** to **get the answer** to the **Riddle**

& in - Judges 14:17 we read (NLT)

17 So she cried whenever she was with him and kept it up for the rest of the celebration. At last, on the seventh day he told her the answer because she was tormenting him with her nagging. Then she explained the riddle to the young men.

EVERY Decision the **Bible Records** for Samson

Shows him <u>Setting the Direction</u> of his life toward **DESTRUCTION**

So – the Philistine men ANSWER the Riddle (Thanks to his Bride-To-Be)

Which <u>Brings On</u> another <u>Direction Setting Decision</u> for <u>Samson</u>

<u>Remember</u> – <u>God</u> had given <u>Samson</u> <u>Miraculous STRENGTH</u>

To be <u>USED</u> to <u>FREE Israel</u> <u>from the Oppression</u> of the <u>Philistines</u>

& so we read in Judges 14:19-20 (NLT)

19 Then the Spirit of the Lord came powerfully upon him. He went down to the town of <u>Ashkelon</u> (Philistine town), killed thirty men, took their belongings, and gave their clothing to the men who had solved his riddle. But Samson was furious about what had happened, and he went back home to live with his father and mother.

20 So his wife was given in marriage to the man who had been Samson's best man at the wedding.

So – <u>Even tho</u> God is <u>AT WORK</u> <u>IN</u> Samson's <u>SELFISH Decisions</u>

Samson's Decisions are STILL setting the Direction of his life – toward Destruction

In <u>Judges 15</u> - Samson <u>decides</u> to <u>go back</u> to the <u>Philistine</u>

Woman & Give her a GOAT to make up with her

But when He gets there

She's <u>already Married</u> to the <u>Best man</u> from <u>Samson's Wedding</u>

Which <u>again</u> – <u>KICKS IN</u> Samson's <u>Direction Setting Decision</u> – of <u>ANGER</u>

Judges 15:3 (NLT)

- 3 Samson said, "This time I cannot be blamed for everything I am going to do to you Philistines."
- & this time Samson takes 300 Foxes
 ties their tails together in pairs
 & puts a torch between each pair
- & has them run thru the Philistines Grain Fields
- & <u>Samson</u> also <u>destroyed</u> their <u>Vineyards</u> & their <u>Olive Groves</u>

But . . . Vengeance BEGETS Vengeance

- & so (Judg 15:6) the Philistines take this woman & her father
- & this time they **DO BURN** them both to death
- & <u>then</u> <u>THAT Vengeance</u> Which <u>came from</u> the <u>PREVIOUS Vengeance</u>

Brings - MORE VENGEANCE from Samson

So - Here's another MATH Equation

<u>Vengeance + Vengeance + Vengeance = Vengeance</u>

Judges 15:7-8 (NLT)

- 7 "Because you did this," Samson vowed, "I won't rest until I take my revenge on you!"
- 8 So he attacked the Philistines with great fury and killed many of them. <u>Then</u> he went to <u>live in a cave</u> in the rock of Etam.

Now - the <u>Leader of Israel</u> is <u>Living in a CAVE</u> - <u>Nursing</u> his <u>Pride</u>

- & again Vengeance BEGETS more Vengeance
- & so the **Philistines RETALIATE** to **Samson's Retaliation**
- & they set up camp in Judah & begin attacking Israel

& they're <u>making life miserable</u> for Israel UNTIL <u>Israel</u> Turns Over Samson to them

Then we read in Judges 15:11 (NLT)

11 So 3,000 men of Judah went down to get Samson at the cave in the rock of Etam. They said to Samson, "Don't you realize the Philistines rule over us? What are you doing to us?" But Samson replied, "I only did to them what they did to me."

You have GOT to be KIDDING me

Really BIG of you - Oh Deliverer of Israel . . .

I only did to them what they did to me - (which is not true)

Samson is a man

Who had been dedicated to God

But was ENSLAVED by His Own Desires

AND by His Own VIEW of things

- & Even tho God "Still Worked" IN his Dysfunction
- & We can learn a TON from him
 About how NOT to Set the Direction of OUR Life
- & so (V.12) the <u>Israelites</u> convince Samson to <u>allow them</u> to <u>turn him over</u> to the <u>Philistines</u>

But when the Israelites bring Samson to the Philistines

Again - His Miraculous Strength - KICKS IN

& then we read in Judges 15:15–16 (NLT)

15 Then he found the jawbone of a recently killed donkey. He picked it up and killed 1,000 Philistines with it.

16 Then Samson said, "With the jawbone of a donkey, <u>I've</u> <u>piled them in heaps!</u> With the jawbone of a donkey, <u>I've killed</u> <u>a thousand men!</u>"

Notice Samson gives NO CREDIT to the Lord - AT ALL

Samson is Consumed with "I"

"I" have piled them in heaps

"I" have killed a thousand men

Samson is **CONSUMED** with **Himself**

He WANTS what he WANTS

He **DOES** what he **WANTS**

He **SEES** Himself as **ALWAYS RIGHT**

& He ALWAYS Gives Himself All The CREDIT

As a Side-Note - in the King James Version

This Vs says Samson killed 1,000 men with the Jaw Bone of an Ass

& there's a saying in the Ministry

Samson killed 1,000 men with the Jaw Bone of an Ass - & many more churches than that - have been destroyed by the same thing

So Then - At the Beginning of Ch 16 Samson goes the Philistine town of GAZA

(still to this day - home of the Enemies of Israel)

- & he **spends the Night** with a **Prostitute** (another "Decision" of Lust)
- & The **Philistines try** to **KILL** him **there**But **Samson** makes a **Dramatic escape (16:3)**
- & then, Finally Samson Falls in love with DELILAH Who is ALSO a Philistine woman (16:4)

He's Following the SAME - Direction-Setting Path

- & so the <u>Philistines</u> offer <u>Delilah</u> a <u>ton</u> of <u>money</u> to <u>Devise</u> a <u>Plan</u> to <u>take Samson down</u>
- & Samson manages to put her off 3 Times

But eventually we read in Judges 16:16–17 (NLT)

16 She tormented him with her nagging day after day until he was sick to death of it.

17 Finally, Samson shared his secret with her. "My hair has never been cut," he confessed, "for I was dedicated to God

as a Nazirite from birth. If my head were shaved, my strength would leave me, and I would become as weak as anyone else."

Samson's hair was NOT actually his strength His VOW to God was

But his hair was a symbol of his VOW

& so - While Samson sleeps - Delilah Cuts his hair

& Judges 16:20 says (NLT)

20 . . . When he woke up, he thought, "I will do as before and shake myself free." <u>But he didn't realize the Lord had left him.</u>

He didn't realize the Lord had LEFT HIM

Samson had been Making Decisions
However HE wanted - for so long

That He thought the Lord would ALWAYS Put UP with it

But the Lord will NOT ALWAYS Put up with it

& It is **only** by **God's GRACE** that He **puts up** with it at all

& Eventually - God WILL Make things - RIGHT

& <u>So (16:21)</u> the <u>Philistines Capture Samson</u> & <u>then</u> they <u>GOUGE</u> His <u>EYES OUT</u>

& they <u>Turn him</u> into a <u>HUMAN OX</u> to <u>Grind GRAIN</u> in their <u>Prison</u>

Then - Before Long
The Philistines held a Great Festival

to **celebrate** their **idol god DAGON** & **MAKE FUN** of the **God of Israel**

& they **brought Samson** out for **SPORT**- to **make fun** of **him** - & of **His God**

& it's here we see the closest thing to a Prayer of Repentance that ever comes from Samson

& <u>Actually</u> – it's the <u>First REAL PRAYER</u>
Recorded in <u>Samson's Life</u>

Judges 16:28 (NLT)

28 Then Samson prayed to the Lord, "Sovereign Lord, remember me again. O God, please strengthen me just one more time. With one blow let me pay back the Philistines for the loss of my two eyes."

Samson asks God to Remember him & give him strength one more time

But <u>notice</u> - it's <u>NOT</u> for <u>God's Glory</u> it's <u>actually</u> for <u>MORE REVENGE</u>

But God does give Samson strength 1 more time

& <u>Samson</u> pushes over <u>Two Pillars</u> that <u>held the Temple</u> up

Killing HIMSELF & 3,000 Philistines

What a LIFE !!

<u>Dedicated to God</u> - <u>But</u> constantly <u>SERVING Himself</u>

Called by God - to Care for God's People

But Consumed with Care **ONLY for Himself**

& **Ultimately**

The <u>Decisions</u> that <u>set the Direction</u> of Samson's life <u>Led</u> to His <u>Shameful Destruction</u>

Our Decisions DO SET the Direction of Our Life

BUT - That <u>Direction</u> CAN BE CHANGED

By us <u>Changing our DECISIONS</u>

God - is the AUTHOR - of U-TURN'S

Jesus <u>Christ</u> – <u>Lived</u> & <u>Died</u> on this <u>Earth</u> So that YOU could CHANGE the <u>Direction of your LIFE</u>

BUT - For that to happen

We've got to <u>TURN FROM</u> the <u>Decisions</u> THAT <u>Take us AWAY</u> - from <u>God's Plan</u>

& <u>TURN TO</u> the <u>Decisions</u> <u>THAT Take us TOWARD</u> - <u>Gods' Plan</u>

& the Words that Start it all are REPENT & BELIEVE

To **REPENT** is to make a **U-TURN** in **The Direction** your **life is going**

To <u>BELIEVE</u> means to <u>put</u> your <u>Full FAITH</u> & <u>TRUST</u> in <u>Jesus Christ</u>

<u>AND</u> in <u>GOD'S PLAN</u> for <u>your life</u>

& both Faith & Trust in Jesus Christ
Are NOT One-Time Decisions

Faith & Trust in God's Plan for your life is One DECISION - after Another - after Another

& those DECISIONS will SET the Direction of your Life

Let's **MAKE** our Decisions **FOR CHRIST** – **One** at a **Time**

AS EACH Decision COMES to you MAKE that Decision for Christ

& Don't Worry about what might happen

Don't Worry that you **can't see**what **might come** from **that Decision**

2 Corinthians 5:7 (ESV)
7 for we walk by faith, not by sight.

The word WALK means to Set the Direction of your life

Set the Direction of your Life BY FAITH – NOT by Sight

Set the Direction of your Life
TOWARD God

By <u>Making your Decisions</u>
<u>TOWARD God</u> – <u>BY FAITH</u>

Because

Your Decisions Will Set - The Direction Of Your Life

Let's Pray
