Mrk42 - Hypocrite Religion - Mark 11:12-21

In our <u>Last msg</u> in <u>Mark</u>
The <u>Triumphal Entry</u> had just <u>occurred</u>

& we <u>looked</u> at Jesus <u>CLEANSING the Temple</u> In the <u>message</u> called - "<u>A House of Prayer</u>"

& in that msg

I said we were **skipping over** the "Fig Tree Section"

Because I explained the "Cleansing of the Temple" was inside a "Sandwich Teaching" – that Mark is Famous for

So <u>Today</u> – we're <u>looking</u> at - that "<u>Sandwich Teaching</u>"

That occurs on **BOTH SIDES** of the "House of Prayer" teaching from our last msg

Make any sense? (it will)

Let's Pray - & we'll see it

So – <u>we're</u> actually <u>starting</u> today
The <u>morning AFTER</u> – the <u>Triumphal Entry</u>

& the <u>Cleansing of the Temple</u> (last msg) Has **NOT YET** Occurred

So Mark 11:12-13 start it off (NLT)

12 The next morning (after the Triumphal Entry) as they were leaving Bethany, Jesus was hungry.

13 He noticed a fig tree <u>in full leaf</u> a little way off, so he went over to see if he could find any figs. But <u>there were only leaves</u> because it was too early in the season for fruit.

Notice - Vs 13 Says - this Fig Tree was in FULL LEAF

<u>THAT</u> - is what a <u>Fig Tree</u> <u>LOOKS LIKE</u> <u>When</u> it <u>HAS fruit</u> on it (in Full Leaf)

So – <u>even tho</u> it was <u>TOO Early</u> in the <u>Season</u> - <u>This Fruit tree</u> had all <u>the SIGNS</u> – of <u>Bearing Fruit</u>

& <u>since</u> it <u>HAD all the signs</u> of actually <u>BEARING FRUIT</u>
It <u>attracted</u> the <u>attention</u> of <u>Jesus</u>

It <u>looked SO MUCH</u> like it <u>would have</u>

<u>Real Fruit – under it's "Perfect Looking"</u> <u>Leaves</u>

but **when** it was **inspected** by **Jesus** IT **actually HAD** – **NO FRUIT**

There was ONLY - the outward appearance of Fruit

This Fig Tree had ALL the Right LOOK – From a distance

But when Jesus GOT CLOSE - & inspected it it actually had NO Real Fruit

& <u>so</u> – <u>judgment falls</u> from the <u>lips</u> of the <u>one</u> <u>Who has</u> been <u>given</u> all <u>Judgment</u>

Mark 11:14 (NLT)

14 Then Jesus said to the tree, "May no one ever eat your fruit again!" And the disciples heard him say it.

Now - This is NOT Jesus getting ANGRY at the tree because he was hungry

which (unbelievably)
some 'supposed scholars' actually say

Remember – this is **NOT Jesus** writing – this **is Mark**

If this WAS Jesus writing – Jesus would say, "Of course I knew there was no fruit on that tree – but it LOOKED SO MUCH like there SHOULD BE fruit under those Leaves, that this tree provided an awesome Example to my Disciples - and to every person who reads & understands what I'm about to do"

This is a DRAMATIC LIVING-PARABLE

Meaning – It's a Parable – ACTED OUT by Jesus

R. Kent Hughes says:

The reason Jesus cursed the barren fig tree was because he wanted it to become a visual parable of what was happening to Israel. In actuality he honored that tree, making it the most useful tree that ever grew! It was, and is, a tree from which thousands have learned about themselves and turned back to God. If one

soul has been made to consider its life through that tree, it did not wither in vain.

Jesus was teaching – a DRAMATIC LIVING-PARABLE

In order to TEACH US – a Very Critical Lesson

So - <u>Let's catch up</u> the <u>Timeline</u> <u>Leading up</u> to - the <u>Fig Tree Moment</u>

3 years ago (beg of his ministry - Jn Ch 2)

Jesus made a whip of cords & cleansed the Temple of the Worldly Business Venture - it had become

<u>Then</u> – <u>Just Yesterday</u> – was <u>The Triumphal Entry</u> with <u>everyone</u> <u>Singing Hallelujahs</u>

& **SEEMING** like they were **Receiving Jesus AS** the **Messiah** *he was*

But at the end of the <u>Triumphal Entry</u>

Jesus went into the <u>Temple</u> – to <u>check</u> things <u>out</u>

& he found it exactly the same - as it was - 3 years ago

There were obviously - BIG SIGNS of Spiritual FRUIT - in the Temple

Everything about the <u>Temple</u> was <u>Magnificent</u>
It was <u>Glorious</u> – It <u>Awed</u> and <u>Enamored</u> people

People LOVED to be there

& they loved to say - they attended there

<u>AND</u> – the <u>best part</u> was you <u>didn't even</u> have to <u>bring</u> your <u>own sacrifice</u> anymore

you could just come - & BUY a pre-approved sacrifice
WHILE you're walking in to worship

You <u>didn't have</u> to <u>go</u> <u>out of your way</u>
You <u>didn't have</u> to be <u>inconvenienced</u> at <u>all</u>

the **Religious System** had **provided everything** you **need in fact**, it had **provided** for your "**FELT NEEDS**"

ALL you had to do was COME - with your money

& you could have a wonderful Religious Experience& you could leave feeling very, very good about yourself

The Religious System
that attracted so many to Jerusalem

had **BIG**, **beautiful Leaves** - **Just like** the **FIG TREE**

& it <u>SEEMED</u> <u>So Fruitful</u> – <u>So Attractive</u> <u>Anybody</u>, and <u>Everybody</u> – <u>wanted</u> to <u>be there</u>

On the Surface – it all seemed SO RIGHT But – when Jesus came in close – to inspect it

He KNEW there was Actually - ZERO Real Spiritual Fruit

That inspection of the Temple - was YESTERDAY

So <u>now</u> (next day) – <u>Jesus</u> & the <u>Disciples</u>
LEAVE the Living-Parable of the Fig Tree

& **Head BACK** to the **Temple** – for **Part-Two** of **the Lesson**

Mark 11:15-17 (NLT)

15 When they arrived back in Jerusalem, (after leaving the fig tree) Jesus entered the Temple and began to drive out the people buying and selling animals for sacrifices. He knocked over the tables of the money changers and the chairs of those selling doves, 16 and he stopped everyone from using the Temple as a marketplace. 17 He said to them, "The Scriptures declare, 'My Temple will be called a house of prayer for all nations,' but you have turned it into a den of thieves."

We <u>dug DEEP</u> into <u>these vs's</u> in our <u>last msg</u> in <u>Mark</u>

If **you didn't ge**t that **msg** – it was **really** a **CRITICAL ONE** – Called - **"A House of Prayer"**

You can *Watch*, *Listen*, or *Read* at <u>EITHER website</u> – or <u>on</u> the Word By Mail <u>phone App</u>

& then - Mark 11:18 tells us

The **ZEAL of the Lord** that was **eating Jesus up**

Kept Jesus perfectly on the Path to the Cross In the Next Few Days

Mark 11:18 (NLT)

18 When the leading priests and teachers of religious law heard what Jesus had done, they began planning how to kill him. But they were afraid of him because the people were so amazed at his teaching. (in the next few days, they'd figure it out)

But - today - we are focused on

How the Fig Tree & the Cleansing of the Temple
Go together in this "Sandwich Teaching" of Mark

The **FIG TREE** - **Looked Really Good But** had **NO FRUIT**

& THE TEMPLE - Looked Really Good
But had NO SPIRITUAL FRUIT

& So - The FIG TREE - was the LIVING-PARABLE

for what the <u>Disciples</u> would <u>Witness</u> as <u>Jesus cleansed</u> the <u>Temple</u> - of its <u>Worldly Influence</u>

Jesus prepared the Disciples with the Fig Tree

NOW - Jesus is trying to SHOW his disciples there is NO SPIRITUAL FRUIT

in what is Supposed To Be the Most Holy Place on Earth

& <u>We</u> have <u>GOT TO Understand</u> <u>What Jesus</u> is <u>trying</u> to <u>do here</u>

Because Jesus has gone to Great Lengths
to make sure this truth hits us RIGHT between the EYES

DO we **LOOK LIKE** we have **Spiritual Fruit**?

OR Is there ACTUAL Spiritual Fruit in our lives?

I don't mean to be too dramatic

But – the answer to that Question
could be a matter of Spiritual LIFE or DEATH

It <u>Certainly was</u> for <u>The Fig Tree</u>
& <u>Ultimately</u> it <u>was</u> for <u>The Temple</u> in Jerusalem

We see it – on the other side of the sandwich teaching

Mark 11:19-21 (NLT) → →

Mark 11:19-21 (NLT)

19 That evening (after cleansing the temple) Jesus and the disciples left the city.

20 The next morning as they passed by the fig tree he had cursed, the disciples noticed it had <u>withered from the roots up</u>.

21 Peter remembered what Jesus had said to the tree on the previous day and exclaimed, "Look, Rabbi! The fig tree you cursed has withered and died!"

This is where it gets DRAMATIC

Because this Fig Tree that LOOKED like it had Real Fruit – but had NONE

Has now been <u>CURSED</u> - & <u>DIED</u> - from the <u>ROOTS UP</u>

& so - To Me - This Sandwich Teaching

of the <u>Judgment</u> of <u>the Fig Tree</u> & the <u>Judgment</u> of <u>the Temple</u>

Jesus is saying ONE THING - Very Clearly

There is a Judgment – for LOOKING SPIRITUAL but having NO REAL SPIRITUAL FRUIT

There is NOTHING in the Word of God

that **puts any Value** – or **Priority** on "**LOOKING SPIRITUAL**"

No-where – in No-way - Does God ever tell us to LOOK like we have Spiritual Fruit in our lives

<u>I Believe</u> - This <u>entire Teaching</u> is <u>meant</u> to *WARN us* - & *SCARE us* – of *ONE THING*

HYPOCRITE RELIGION

Which is - Looking Spiritual
but having NO REAL Spiritual Fruit in your life

Between the Judgment on the Fig Tree & the Judgment on the Temple

The Disciples were being CONFRONTED

By this Truth

There is a Judgment - for HYPOCRITE RELIGION

& that truth - Is meant to be As SHOCKING to US
As it was to them

So - we **CANNOT look** at **this SHOCKING Teaching** - about **HYPOCRITE RELIGION**

Without Applying it in a very REAL & PRACTICAL way – to our own lives

<u>IF</u> our <u>Spiritual Life & Death hangs</u> in the <u>balance</u> <u>like it did</u> for the <u>Fig Tree</u> - <u>AND</u> for <u>the Temple</u>

Then we have GOT to Examine Our Lives in light of this text – Right?

So First - What IS Spiritual Fruit?

Fruit is a Frequent Metaphor for Spiritual Growth in the Bible

<u>Used</u> over <u>150 times</u> – to <u>describe</u> *The Transformation* - God produces in our lives

So - QUESTION

Is a **big wealthy church** - with **massive attendance Considered Spiritual Fruit?**

If it is – then <u>Jesus</u> - <u>NEVER bore</u> any <u>Spiritual Fruit</u> & <u>neither did any</u> of the <u>original Disciples</u>

Because **Spiritual Fruit**is **NOT Measured** - **by Worldly Success**

in any Church - or - in any Person

Spiritual Fruit is Measured - by Jesus Christ

HE was THE JUDGE of BOTH the Fig Tree - & the Temple

But Fortunately – what God calls Spiritual Fruit is super easy to define from the Bible

<u>In a sentence</u> – we can say, "Spiritual Fruit is anything in our lives that REFLECTS the True Character and Nature of God"

Spiritual Fruit is the <u>EVIDENCE</u> to <u>those</u> around <u>us</u> that <u>Jesus Christ</u> is <u>Living IN US & THRU US</u>

<u>& THAT – is the Whole Point</u>

Spiritual Fruit comes ONLY from

Jesus Christ Truly Living IN US & THRU US

You & I cannot produce "Spiritual Fruit"

No matter how <u>BIG the leaves</u> of our "<u>Fig Tree</u>" get No matter how <u>Impressive</u> the <u>outside</u> of our "<u>Temple</u>" is

Without Jesus Christ Truly IN our lives

We can <u>LOOK LIKE</u> there <u>SHOULD BE</u> fruit <u>Under our "Good Looking</u>" <u>Surface</u>

But One Day - Jesus is going to JUDGE US
For what is TRULY - UNDER that Surface

& this "<u>Hard Teaching</u>" today
is Jesus helping us get ready – for THAT day

The **GOOD NEWS** is

Since ONLY the Life of Jesus
Can PRODUCE Spiritual Fruit in us

Then we know exactly what we need to do

To BEGIN to have Jesus – Produce that Spiritual Fruit

TURN OVER to John Ch 15

<u>Some time</u> ago – we <u>did</u> a <u>TEN-PART series</u> called <u>ABIDE</u>

<u>That series</u> came from <u>these vs's</u> in <u>Jn 15</u>

John 15:4-8 (ESV)

4 Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch <u>cannot bear fruit</u> by <u>itself</u>, <u>unless it abides</u> in the vine, <u>neither can you</u>, <u>unless</u> you <u>abide in me</u>.

5 I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing.

6 If anyone does not abide in me he is thrown away like a branch and withers; and the branches are gathered, thrown into the fire, and burned. (a motivational warning)

7 If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. (a motivational encouragement)
8 By this my Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit and so prove to be my disciples. (Spiritual Fruit is the proof of being a disciple)

We've **got to learn** – **HOW** to **Abide in Jesus** & **HOW** to **have Jesus Abide in us**

& <u>then</u> – The <u>Life of Jesus</u> will <u>produce</u>

<u>TRUE Spiritual Fruit</u> - <u>IN US</u> & <u>THRU US</u>

Learning to <u>ABIDE in Christ</u> - Is the Beginning of having Jesus Produce - Spiritual Fruit - in our lives

There is so much more
about what Spiritual Fruit – LOOKS LIKE

But – I only have time to suggest some Further Study

<u>But remember</u> – <u>YOU can't produce</u> - <u>True Spiritual Fruit</u> - <u>Only the Life of Jesus in you can</u>

So - <u>To close today</u> – We've <u>got</u> to <u>TURN this INSPECTION</u> On our <u>own lives</u>

Spiritual Fruit

is an ATTITUDE or an ACTION - in our lives

That has been Transformed

by Jesus Christ Living IN US & THRU US

<u>Spiritual Fruit</u> - is <u>US</u>, <u>in some way</u> - <u>becoming MORE</u> like <u>Jesus</u> - & <u>LESS</u> like <u>Ourselves</u>

AND - Spiritual Fruit is something

that **IS SEEN** By the people around us

& brings GLORY to God in our lives

I Know those are **HUGE TESTS**

But – Listen carefully to 2 COR 13:5 from the Paraphrase called "The Message"

2 Corinthians 13:5 (The Message)

5 Test yourselves to make sure you are solid in the faith. Don't drift along taking everything for granted. Give yourselves regular checkups. You need firsthand evidence, not mere hearsay, that Jesus Christ is in you. Test it out. If you fail the test, do something about it.

Let's Pray
