Col 211 - How Then Should We Live - Col 3:18-4:1

In our Study of Colossians - We've been talking about

the <u>Life-Transforming Power</u> of <u>us</u> being <u>IDENTIFIED</u> with <u>Jesus</u> Christ – <u>thru faith</u> in him

We've **been talking** about the **Radical truth** – that "In Christ"

we have DIED to the Old 'Self' Life
& we have been RAISED to New Life - in HIM

Which leads us to – the "Put-Off" "Put-On" Transformation Process of us Actually LIVING in our New Life in Christ

We <u>PUT OFF</u> the <u>Old Life</u> that we've <u>DIED to</u> - & We <u>PUT ON</u> the <u>New Life</u> that we've <u>been RAISED TO</u>

& so – <u>in that PROCESS</u> – in our <u>Last msg we looked at</u>

the "New Life Traits" that we inherited
When we received Jesus Christ as our Savior & Lord

& we said NOW - With the Power of the Holy Spirit - we need to

"<u>Put On</u>" – "<u>Clothe Ourselves</u>" - "<u>Be Immersed In</u>"

The "<u>New Life Traits</u>" that <u>we've inherited</u> In <u>Christ</u>

So today - we get to the Question

What should our <u>NEW LIFE in Christ</u> look Like - <u>When</u> we <u>begin Living</u> In these <u>New Life Traits</u>?

In other words - HOW THEN SHOULD WE LIVE?

Let's Pray

Today we're going to look at 3-PAIRS of RELATIONSHIPS that God is addressing in Col Ch 3

God is a *Relational God* & so our *New Life Traits* are FOCUSED on

- a **Right VERTICAL Relationship** with **God** & **Right HORIZONTAL relationships** with **others**
- & <u>here</u> are the <u>THREE</u> <u>Horizontal Relationships</u>
 <u>That God deals with</u> in <u>these Vs's</u>

WIVES & HUSBANDS

CHILDREN & PARENTS

EMPLOYEES & EMPLOYERS

So <u>FIRST</u> – <u>God ADDRESSES</u> <u>Wives and Husbands</u> – & <u>God starts</u> . . . with the WIVES

Wives

- 1) Because you've PUT-OFF the OLD LIFE
- 2) Because you've Been Transformed from the Inside/Out
- 3) Because you've PUT-ON the NEW LIFE in Christ

Colossians 3:18 says (NLT)

18 Wives, submit to your husbands, as is fitting for those who belong to the Lord.

In our Marriage Series - "God's Design For Marriage"

You can <u>find</u> the <u>Msg</u> – <u>The S Word is For Everyone</u>

Where we go <u>into detail</u> - on the <u>two uses</u> of the word "<u>SUBMIT</u>"

But for today - let's just go over to Eph 5 - in order to get some "Critical Context"

Eph 4 - 6 is the PARALLEL TEACHING to Col 3

And – <u>in Eph 5</u> – we have a <u>CRITICAL</u> - <u>Summary Verse</u> that <u>kicks off</u> this <u>Exact SAME Teaching</u> in <u>Ephesians</u>

<u>Just like Col Ch 3</u> - <u>Ephesians</u> is <u>teaching</u> what it <u>looks like</u> <u>when</u> we are <u>LIVING</u> in our <u>New Life Traits</u>

Here's the Summary Vs for this Relationship Section in Eph Ch 5

Ephesians 5:21 (NLT)

21 And further, submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.

This is the <u>5th RESULT</u> of <u>being</u>

Continually Filled with the <u>Holy Spirit</u> - that <u>starts</u> in <u>Eph 5:15</u>

AND - it is THE KICK-OFF VS - in Eph Ch 5

for the SAME 3 - Priority Relationships
that we're dealing with here in Col Ch 3

& it's clear - these New Life Traits

<u>Are ALL</u> - an <u>Expounding On</u> – (what it LOOKS LIKE) <u>WHEN</u> we are <u>SUBMITTING to One ANOTHER</u>

let me **SHOW YOU** What **I mean** – in **Eph 5:21-25**

Eph 5:21-22,25 – NLT

21 And further, <u>submit to one another</u> out of reverence for Christ. 22 For wives, <u>this means</u> submit to your husbands as to the Lord .

. .

25 For husbands, this means love your wives, just as Christ loved the church . . .

Eph 5 makes it clear that our RELATIONAL New Life Traits

Are the OUTCOME of the general call to submit to one another

It helps to know that the word SUBMIT has TWO USES (two meanings) in the Bible

The word SUBMIT

<u>HAS</u> a <u>GREATER</u> (Broader) <u>MEANING</u>,
& it HAS a LESSER (more Narrow) <u>MEANING</u>

When **EPH 5:21** says – we are **ALL CALLED** to submit to one another out of reverence for Christ

This is SUBMIT in the GREATER (Broader) SENSE

It MEANS: To Come Under, To Support, To Hold Up one another

THAT is the **Greater** (Broader) **SENSE** of the **word submit**

When the word SUBMIT is used for the Wife –

it is being used in its NARROWER (or personal) SENSE

& its **Definition** is **referring** to **Order**, **Cooperation**, & **Partnership**

It's <u>actually</u> a <u>reference</u> to <u>military structure</u> – <u>Meaning:</u> to *Place in Order*, to *Cooperate in a Structure* or *Partnership*

& **THAT** is the **New Life Trait** God **uses for Wives** in

Colossians 3:18 (again) (NLT)

18 Wives, <u>submit to your husbands</u>, as is fitting for those who belong to the Lord.

The <u>use</u> of the <u>word Submit</u> here – is <u>referring to</u>
<u>Leadership Order</u> – <u>Cooperation</u> - & <u>Partnership</u>

If this concept of "Submitting to One Another" is NEW to you

(again) Go to WBM.com or the WBM Ph App & SEARCH - "The S Word is for Everyone"

So - BACK in Col Ch 3 - Moving on to

HUSBANDS

- 1) Because you've PUT-OFF the OLD LIFE
- 2) Because you've Been Transformed from the Inside/Out
- 3) Because you've PUT-ON the NEW LIFE in Christ

Colossians 3:19 says (NLT)

19 Husbands, love your wives and never treat them harshly.

AGAIN - for context - Let me put Eph 5 back up on the screen

Ephesians 5:21 & 25 (NLT)

21 . . . <u>submit to one another</u> out of reverence for Christ.

. . .

25 <u>For husbands, this means</u> love your wives, just as Christ loved the church . . .

<u>Husbands</u> – <u>How</u> do you "<u>Submit To Your Wife</u>" - <u>Meaning</u> <u>How</u> do you "<u>Come Under her</u>" - "<u>Support her</u>" – "<u>Hold her up ?</u>

All you have to do is Love Her . . . IN the same way, and to the Same Extent as Christ loved the church

Which includes - - - never treating her <u>harshly</u>
or (as CSB says) - never becoming <u>Bitter</u> towards <u>her</u>

because of His love for us

<u>Jesus</u> Christ <u>NEVER</u> treated us <u>Harshly</u> & he **NEVER** became **BITTER** toward **us**

& because Jesus never did with us

we must never become that way with our Wives

LOVE your **Wife** – **AS Christ LOVED** the Church **LEAD** your **Wife** and **Family** – **AS Christ LEADS** the church

& you will be LIVING in your New Life traits

Next is - Children

- 1) **Because** you've **PUT-OFF** the **OLD LIFE**
- 2) Because you've Been Transformed from the Inside/Out
- 3) Because you've PUT-ON the NEW LIFE in Christ

Then Colossians 3:20 says (NLT)

20 Children, always obey your parents, for this pleases the Lord.

The word "Obey" means:

To **heed**, **comply**, & **follow the directions** of another

<u>Children</u> – If <u>you've made</u> <u>Jesus</u> your <u>Lord</u> – <u>One</u> of the <u>ways</u> you <u>begin</u> to <u>LIVE</u> in your <u>New Life Traits</u> – is to <u>OBEY</u> your <u>parents</u>

Because THIS pleases the Lord

Your <u>New Life in Christ</u> – is <u>displayed</u> - in your <u>WILLINGNESS</u> to <u>obey your parents</u>

Next is - Fathers (& by inference - Mothers)

- 1) Because you've PUT-OFF the OLD LIFE
- 2) Because you've Been Transformed from the Inside/Out
- 3) <u>Because</u> you've <u>PUT-ON</u> the <u>NEW LIFE</u> in Christ

Then - Colossians 3:21 says (NLT)

21 Fathers (& Mothers), do not aggravate your children, or they will become discouraged.

This word for "**AGGRAVATE**" means:

"to arouse to wrath or anger, to the point of exasperation"

The **ESV** says here - **Fathers**, **do not provoke your children**, **lest they become discouraged**.

There are 2 Primary ways that we Exasperate our children to the point of discouragement

The FIRST One - is being
Over Controlling & Over Disciplining

If your **Children** can **NEVER do anything RIGHT** in your **eyes**

<u>Then</u> I <u>Guarantee</u> - you are <u>Exasperating</u> your <u>children</u> to the point of them becoming totally discouraged

HOWEVER - the other extremeALSO causes Exasperation & Discouragement

If you **NEVER**, **EVER Guide**, **Direct**, & **Discipline** your **children you** will **ALSO exasperate** them - & they will **become discouraged**

Parents – We must Guide, Direct, & Discipline our Children, In a Balanced - & Consistent Way

So they will not become exasperated or discouraged

& then - Employees

- 1) Because you've PUT-OFF the OLD LIFE
- 2) **Because** you've **Been Transformed** from the **Inside/Out**
- 3) Because you've PUT-ON the NEW LIFE in Christ

Then - Colossians 3:22-23 say (NLT)

22 Slaves (employees), obey your earthly masters (employers) in everything you do. Try to please them all the time, not just when they are watching you. Serve them sincerely because of your reverent fear of the Lord.

23 Work willingly at whatever you do, as though you were working for the Lord rather than for people.

I learned a lot in my time owning & running a decent sized Mortgage business

- & <u>we hired</u> mostly <u>Christians</u>, & <u>many single moms</u>, or <u>moms</u> <u>needing</u> a <u>good job</u> <u>mostly</u> from <u>our own church</u>
- & **one** of the **saddest lessons** I **learned later** was
- these <u>Christian employees</u> (that <u>we</u> were <u>trying</u> so <u>hard</u> to <u>help</u>)
 could hear me or <u>my partner</u> <u>walking down the hall</u>,
- & <u>when</u> they <u>heard</u> our <u>footsteps</u> they <u>would all scramble</u> to <u>LOOK like</u> they were <u>working</u> (because they often weren't)

That is NOT living in your New Life Traits - as an Employee

& <u>I've had</u> the <u>SAME EXACT thing</u> happen with <u>employees</u> in the <u>church</u>

who are MUCH MORE interested in making me
THINK they are working

Than they <u>are interested</u> in Actually WORKING for the Lord

This is Super SAD

Because Living in your New Life Traits MEANS,

Doing your Job <u>WELL</u>
& <u>NOT</u> just <u>when</u> <u>someone is watching</u>,

& it <u>means</u> <u>serving sincerely & willingly</u>
as the you were working for THE LORD & not for people

our <u>New Life Traits</u> deal with Practical Everyday Situations - from an Eternal Perspective

& So, *BECAUSE OF* your *New Life in Christ*

that your Boss should say
"Man, that is the best employee I've got"

If we'll grasp this

it will really "Free Us" in the workplace

& we can just fly in there & do our best job for God

Out Of a Reverence For God

& **ON BEHALF** of our **Employer**

AS V.23 says

23 Work willingly at whatever you do, as though you were working for the Lord rather than for people.

& Then - The END RESULT is;

We give Jesus Christ a GOOD NAME in our workplace

We can be at **peace** as **we** work **FOR** the Lord

The LORD will reward us - because it's Him we're working for

Look at Colossians 3:24 (NLT)

24 Remember that the Lord will give you an inheritance as your reward, and that the Master you are serving is Christ.

If we are truly working for the Lord

then the Lord WILL reward us with an inheritance - not man

There is only One Master above all,

& you can get up & go to work for him TOMORROW

AND THAT is a Great Way to get up & go to work

<u>However - - w/ the Blessing</u> of <u>Working</u> for <u>the Lord</u> <u>also Comes</u> a <u>WARNING</u>

V.25 is **still talking** about **Employees** on **the job**

Colossians 3:25 (NLT)

25 But if you do what is wrong, you will be paid back for the wrong you have done. For God has no favorites.

God will reward us for working well

BUT if we do what is wrong on the job,we will be paid back for the wrong we have done

Because - God has no favorites

& Finally – The "New Life Trait" for All Employers, Bosses, or Overseers in the Church

Employers

- 1) **Because** you've **PUT-OFF** the **OLD LIFE**
- 2) **Because** you've **Been Transformed** from the **Inside/Out**
- 3) **Because** you've **PUT-ON** the **NEW LIFE** in Christ

Colossians 4:1 says (NLT)

1 Masters (employers), be just and fair to your slaves (employees). Remember that you also have a Master—in heaven.

(Again) **Every BOSS** has a **MASTER** – & **For US** – Our **Master is in Heaven**

l've been a Boss (in one way or another) for a long time
& I may not be that good at it

But I know one thing FOR SURE –

I may BE a Boss or Employer – But I am NOT in CHARGE

& He's watching ME Very CLOSELY

& <u>He will</u> either <u>Reward</u> me <u>OR Hold me Responsible</u> – <u>For MY Actions</u>

Just like He will for the people
who I am called to Serve as their Overseer or Employer

& so - Wrapping Up

In these <u>Vital Relationships</u>
THIS THEN - is How We Should Live

BUT - It's NOT - WORK really hard to do these things

INSTEAD it's – If Indeed you have
Surrendered your life to Jesus Christ

Then these are the INHERITED TRAITS
that came with your New Life in Christ

SO . . . With the Power of the Holy Spirit

Put Them On – Clothe Yourself in them

& Begin to Live in accordance with Who you Are In Christ

But always remember – The New Life – COMES FIRST!

& THEN – *ISSUING FORTH FROM* That New Life Your New Life Traits begin to show

My Prayer - is that we would leave here saying;

<u>Because</u> you've <u>PUT-OFF</u> the <u>OLD LIFE</u> <u>Because</u> you've <u>Been Transformed</u> from the <u>Inside/Out</u>

THEN – With the **POWER** of the Holy Spirit

| am going to PUT ON (Clothe Myself in) (Be Immersed in)

THE NEW LIFE that I have inherited in Jesus Christ

THIS THEN IS HOW WE SHOULD LIVE !!
