Giv06 - Divine Forgiveness - Mat 18:33

We're in our 6TH MSG in the Give Up Series

- <u>We started</u> by explaining how in the <u>Christian Life</u> we must **GIVE UP**, **GIVE IN**, & **GIVE OVER**
- & then we've been doing TWO Msgs on each of those areas
 We did 2 Msgs on Giving UP our PRIDE
 Then 2 Msgs on Giving IN to the LORDSHIP of Jesus Christ
- & <u>Today</u> we <u>start TWO Msgs</u> (maybe 3) on <u>GIVING OVER</u> what we <u>CAN'T CONTROL</u> in our lives
- How many of you know We HOLD ON to stuff that God calls us to GIVE OVER to Him
- & often we HOLD ON w/ a VULCAN GRIP

 This is MINE, I DESERVE to hold on to this,
 this is what DRIVES me
- & very often These things we HOLD ON to

 Not only Negatively Affect our Lives But CAN bring real DESTRUCTION into our lives
- There are **PLENTY** of things we **DEMAND** to **HOLD ON** to that we **must learn** to **GIVE OVER** to God
- But <u>today</u> I want to <u>talk about</u> one of the <u>Big Ones</u> - that is <u>HOLDING ON</u> to the <u>SIN</u> of <u>UNFORGIVENESS</u>
- <u>Unforgiveness & All the SINS that Go WITH IT:</u>
 <u>Anger, Bitterness, Malice, Resentment, Jealousy</u>
- Can **Very Easily Destroy** your **life** (from the inside out)

<u>BUT</u> - <u>God</u> has <u>Made</u> a Way - to <u>SAVE</u> You from <u>Self-Destruction</u> & It is <u>thru</u> the <u>MIRACLE of DIVINE FORGIVENESS</u>

Let's Pray

Many of the Greatest LESSONS in the Bible - are taught thru ILLUSTRATION

& One of those GREAT Lessons - is found in The Book of HOSEA
- - - So - FIND Hosea - (After Daniel, 1st of Minor Prophets)

Hosea was God's Prophet to Israel
Just before the FALL of the Northern Kingdom

lsrael had so badly turned their back on God
& were living for the gods of this world - & for themselves

Israel had HUMILIATED God - & DISGRACED God & were living in open DEFIANCE of God

& <u>God wanted</u> His people to <u>SEE</u> - His <u>level</u> of Love & <u>DIVINE FORGIVENESS</u> - toward them

& so God made - a Living Illustration

Remember - Hosea Is the Prophet of God - God's Spokesman - God's Representative to Israel

Hosea 1:2 - (READING FROM THE NLT)

2 When the Lord first began speaking to Israel through Hosea, he said to him, "Go and marry a prostitute, so that some of her children will be conceived in prostitution . . .

Now <u>THAT</u> doesn't seem Quite Right for <u>GOD'S REPRESENTATIVE</u> to His people, <u>does it?</u>

So **God explains WHY** - in the **2nd half** of the **Vs**

2... This will <u>illustrate</u> how Israel has acted like a prostitute by turning against the Lord and worshiping other gods."

Israel had turned their backs on God - AGAIN
They had Rejected Him, & Rebelled against Him - AGAIN

& God wanted Israel to know;

that He was <u>FULLY AWARE</u> of their Sin against Him & that His "<u>Offer of Forgiveness</u>" - had not changed

& WE are those SAME people of God

We have <u>SINNED</u> against <u>God</u>
We have <u>TURNED</u> away from <u>God</u>
We have been <u>LOVERS</u> of this <u>World</u> (& self) <u>instead</u> of God

& <u>God</u> wants <u>US</u> - <u>You & I</u> - to <u>Know</u> the <u>Full Extent</u> of His <u>WILLINGNESS</u> to completely <u>FORGIVE US</u>

So <u>He</u> has a <u>PROPHET of God</u> - Marry a <u>Prostitute</u> - to be a <u>Living Illustration</u> to each of us

Hosea 1:3 (NLT)

3 So Hosea <u>married Gomer</u>, the daughter of Diblaim, and she became pregnant and gave Hosea a son.

Now - You KNOW this girl's gonna have a ROUGH LIFE the MINUTE her parents named her GOMER

- Gomer was also an Israelite & most probably worked at one of the Pagan SHRINES (places of worship)
- Because Israel had Fully EMBRACED one of the Pagan World's favorite WORSHIP Practices
- That was to go to a house of "Worship" (for a Pagan god) where you would make a "Donation" to that god then "Consummate" your worship with a Shrine "Priestess"
- So it was Prostitution in the Name of Worship
 & Suddenly all the MEN in Israel
 were very interested in worshipping the pagan Gods
- & so Gomer was a Pagan Shrine Prostitute
- & The <u>Prophet of God</u> Walks in & asks this <u>Prostitute</u> named <u>GOMER</u> to <u>Marry Him</u>
- & he Rescues her from that lifestyle
 AS a PICTURE of God's Desire
 to RESCUE His People from their SPIRITUAL ADULTERY
- So after Hosea **RESCUED GOMER** from **her life of Prostitution** what did **GOMER** Do ?
- Well She went **BACK** to being a **Prostitute**
- JUST LIKE God's people so often GO BACK to their Spiritual Adultery with the World
- So **NOW WHAT**? well, **NOW** we see the **Illustration** of the **DEPTH** of God's **Divine Forgiveness**

In Ch 2 - there are CONSEQUENCES for Gomer's sin . . .

But then in Hosea 3:1-2 (NLT)

1 Then the Lord said to me (Hosea), "Go and love your wife again, even though she commits adultery with another lover. This will illustrate that the Lord still loves Israel, even though the people have turned to other gods and love to worship them."

2 So I bought her back for fifteen pieces of silver and five bushels of barley and a measure of wine.

Hosea didn't just ALLOW Gomer to Come back to him -He BOUGHT her BACK

He **BOUGHT HER BACK** - Out of the **Sin** She had **returned** to - **AFTER** he had already **BOUGHT** Her out of that sin **ONCE**

This is a <u>Picture</u> - a <u>Real Life</u> <u>Illustration</u> of the <u>EXTENT</u> of God's <u>FORGIVENESS</u> - toward US

WE - have <u>turned our back</u> on God - & Committed <u>Spiritual Adultery</u> & God has <u>BOUGHT US BACK</u> - some of us - <u>MANY TIMES</u>

Tho we **NEVER** Deserved it - He has **FORGIVEN** us & He **RESTORED US** - **Completely**

THAT - is a Picture - of God's Divine Forgiveness

- & God wants to bring THAT Divine Forgiveness into YOUR life
 - #1) Because it is one of the MOST VISIBLE Signs of GOD'S Life Taking over YOUR Life
 - #2) Because UnForgiveness is DESTROYING YOUR LIFE

<u>Unforgiveness</u> - & the <u>sins</u> that com<u>e FROM IT</u> <u>destroy you from the INSIDE</u> OUT

& it is **one** of the **Enemy's** "**Most Used**" Tools to bring **BONDAGE** & **DESTRUCTION** - into a **Christian's Life**

But <u>God Loves</u> you <u>SO MUCH</u> - that He has <u>Given you a way</u> to <u>BREAK</u> the <u>Bondage</u> & <u>Destruction</u> of <u>Unforgiveness</u>

Now <u>Let me say</u> (before we cont) - I know that <u>SOME</u>
Who <u>have</u> had <u>Very Serious</u> & <u>Very Traumatic</u> events in their <u>lives</u>

& I am **NOT saying** - this is **EASY** - or happens **INSTANTANEOUSLY**

But I <u>am saying</u> - God <u>Desires</u> to <u>FREE you</u> from the <u>BONDAGE</u> & <u>DESTRUCTION</u> of <u>Unforgiveness</u> in your life

& so - I'd like YOU to ask GOD right now - to SHOW you

that <u>PERSON</u> - you have <u>NOT Forgiven</u> that <u>SITUATION</u> - you have <u>NOT Forgiven</u>

& as **we Go On** - Please - **ALLOW** the **Holy Spirit** to Continue to **Bring up** that **PERSON** or **SITUATION** in your mind

<u>Today</u> I want to give you - <u>3 SUPERNATURAL Steps</u> to <u>Experiencing</u> Divine Forgiveness in your life

& can I just say again - these are SUPERNATURAL Steps

<u>Divine Forgiveness</u> is the <u>Life of Jesus Christ</u> - <u>IN YOU</u> - <u>Doing</u> What You could <u>NEVER do</u> in <u>YOURSELF</u>

- 3 Supernatural Steps to Divine Forgiveness
- #1) We must Make the Comparison
- #2) We must Receive God's Mercy
- #3) We must Give Out God's Grace

These are **Supernatural** - **Transforming Steps** to **Experiencing** God's **Divine Forgiveness**

& **IF** you will **Commit** to **CONTINUALLY EMBRACING** them

God <u>WILL SAVE YOU</u> from the <u>DESTRUCTION</u> that <u>UNFORGIVENESS</u> is <u>currently causing</u> in your life

#1) We Must MAKE the Comparison

Turn to Mat 18 - Jesus has just finished the section on how to "Correctly" Correct another Believer

& Then (vs 21) - Peter asks Jesus the Question - "Lord, how often should I forgive someone who sins against me? Seven times?"

<u>Jesus</u> replies (<u>vs 22</u>) - "No, not seven times, but seventy times seven!"

- & many of us have heard that but still . . . we REFUSE to do it
- & so <u>Jesus tells us</u> an incredible parable to help us <u>DESIRE</u> to <u>BRING</u> God's <u>Divine Forgiveness</u> into our lives
- We must <u>First DESIRE IT</u> We must <u>Truly WANT</u> to **Experience** God's **Divine Forgiveness** in our life
- & <u>THAT</u> is what this <u>Parable is about</u> We call it "*Making the Comparison*"

I'll Use the NLT - & just read thru it - commenting as I go

Matthew 18:23-35 (NLT)

23 "Therefore, the Kingdom of Heaven can be compared to a king who decided to bring his accounts up to date with servants who had borrowed money from him.

24 In the process, one of his debtors was brought in who owed him millions of dollars.

An un-payable debt - in the orig = over 300 TONS of silver

25 He couldn't pay, so his master ordered that he be sold—along with his wife, his children, and everything he owned—to pay the debt. (normal debt collection procedure)

26 "But the man fell down before his master and begged him, 'Please, be patient with me, and I will pay it all.'

27 Then his master was <u>filled with pity for him</u>, and he <u>released</u> him and <u>forgave</u> his debt.

The Master here is GOD -

& **YOU** are the **servant** with the **UNPAYABLE** Debt

& <u>if you</u> are <u>Saved</u> today - it is <u>because God</u> had <u>COMPASSION</u> on you

He RELEASED you - & He FORGAVE Your Un-Payable Debt

Now we move to a picture of YOU

& the **person** who has **wronged you**

28 "But when the man left the king, he went to a fellow servant who owed him a few thousand dollars . . .

pocket-change compared to what he had been forgiven

- 28... He grabbed him by the throat and demanded instant payment.
- 29 "His fellow servant fell down before him and begged for a little more time. 'Be patient with me, and I will pay it,' he pleaded.
- 30 But his creditor (the one who'd just been forgiven) wouldn't wait. He had the man arrested and put in prison until the debt could be paid in full.
- 31 "When some of the other servants saw this, they were very upset. They went to the king and told him everything that had happened.
- 32 Then the king called in the man he had forgiven and said, 'You evil servant! I forgave you that tremendous debt because you pleaded with me.
- 33 (our Key vs) Shouldn't you have mercy on your fellow servant, just as I had mercy on you?'
- Shouldn't you have mercy on your fellow servant, just as (in the same way as) I had mercy on you?'
- Shouldn't <u>WE</u> have <u>MERCY</u> on others in the same way that God has had <u>MERCY</u> on US?
- We <u>MUST</u> <u>MAKE THIS COMPARISON</u>
 Because <u>HERE</u> is <u>God's RESPONSE</u> if we DON'T
- To <u>the Servant</u> who would <u>NOT Forgive</u>

 <u>AS</u> He had <u>BEEN</u> Forgiven <u>V.34</u> says . . .
- Mat 18:34 Then the angry king sent the man to prison to be tortured until he had paid his entire debt.
- What do you mean TO BE TORTURED That's pretty RadicalEven MORE Radical is the Final Vs

35 "That's what my heavenly Father will do to you if you refuse to forgive your brothers and sisters from your heart."

Very <u>Often</u> - <u>Unforgiveness</u> becomes <u>Mental</u> & <u>Emotional</u> <u>TORTURE</u> in our Lives

We want to CONTROL our "Right" to NOT Forgive

But our **Unforgiveness ALWAYS** ends up - **Controlling US**

But <u>God says</u> - I've <u>MADE</u> a way - & I've given you <u>MYSELF</u> as the <u>POWER</u> to be <u>FREED</u> from that <u>torture</u>

But **YOU** must **CHOOSE** - To **WALK** in it - (live in it)

We must CHOOSE - to GIVE OVER to God

What we Cannot FIX

What we Cannot HANDLE

What we **Cannot CONTROL**

God has <u>MADE</u> a Supernatural <u>WAY</u> - to <u>HEAL</u> You - & to <u>FREE you</u> from the **TORTURE** of **Unforgiveness**

The First Step - is to Truly & Earnestly - DESIRE IT

Let me give you just ONE Cross-Reference - For Motivation

FORGIVENESS is SUCH a HUGE DEAL to God - that He has put Serious Warnings in Scripture about it

When **Jesus finished** what we call the **Lord's Prayer** . . .

of <u>ALL</u> the <u>truths</u> He could've <u>gone back</u> & <u>commented</u> on <u>Jesus</u> only <u>commented</u> on <u>ONE</u> truth from that <u>prayer</u>

The **Two Vs** that **FOLLOW** the **Lord's Prayer**

Matthew 6:14-15 (NLT)

14 "If you forgive those who sin against you, your heavenly Father will forgive you.

15 But if you refuse to forgive others, your Father will not forgive your sins.

WHAT ?? - Does that mean if I haven't forgiven somebody that I am NOT SAVED ?? - - - No

This is **NOT referring** to "**POSITIONAL**" Forgiveness this **IS referring** to "**RELATIONAL**" Forgiveness

I <u>means</u> that the <u>SIN</u> of Unforgiveness <u>KEEPS</u> you from a <u>Right Relationship</u> with God

Just write ISA 59:1-2 down - & Read it later

The <u>Sin of Unforgiveness</u>
<u>Separates you</u> from a <u>Right Relationship</u> with God

So - the <u>1st STEP</u> - is to "<u>Make The Comparison</u>" - & <u>Truly DESIRE</u> to <u>Experience Divine Forgiveness</u> in your life

Step #2 is - We must RECEIVE God's MERCY

When I say RECEIVE - I don't mean (so much)
Receive it for our OWN Benefit

I Mean <u>RECEIVE IT</u> as in - <u>Receiving</u> the <u>Nature of God</u> <u>TO TAKE OVER</u> your <u>SIN NATURE</u>

Allowing God's MERCY - to "Take Over" our UNFORGIVENESS

As <u>Christians</u> - we <u>MUST</u> Allow <u>GOD'S</u> nature to begin to <u>TAKE OVER</u> - <u>OUR</u> Nature

& to <u>experience Divine Forgiveness</u> - you must <u>ALLOW</u> the <u>MERCY of GOD</u> - to <u>TAKE OVER</u> your <u>UNFORGIVENESS</u>

<u>DEFINITION of Mercy</u>: *NOT Giving someone what they Deserve*

That is exactly what God has done for YOU & that is exactly what God calls you to Do - to Someone else

The word means Literally - to TEAR UP the NOTE (the Debt)

& again - back in Mat 18:33 - Jesus said - Shouldn't YOU show Mercy to that person - because I have shown Mercy to you?

Again - <u>Jesus turns it around</u> as **BOTH** a <u>BLESSING</u> & a <u>WARNING</u> in the Beatitudes

Matthew 5:7 (ESV)

7 "Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy.

& so - what about when we DO NOT show Mercy THEN what do we receive?

Guys - God calls us to Forgive
IN THE SAME WAY as He has Forgiven us . . .

Col 3:13 says We must forgive one another JUST AS the Lord has Forgiven US ("Just As" = In the same WAY)

BECAUSE (Listen Closely)

It is **GOD** Doing the **FORGIVING** - Inside Us

It is **GOD** Showing **MERCY** - Inside Us

It is **GOD** Giving **GRACE** - Inside Us

This is **NOT Something WE** do
This is **Something GOD DOES** - *IN US*

& Once we Truly Recognize our NEED to EXPERIENCE Divine Forgiveness in our life

The **Next Step** is to **ALLOW** God's **Supernatural MERCY** to **Take OVER** - the **PAIN** of our **Unforgiveness**

HOW DAVE?-HOW?

HOW do we **allow** the **MERCY of God** - to **TAKE OVER** - our **UNFORGIVENESS** ??

We do it - By GIVING UP

By Giving UP, Giving IN, & Giving OVER

We do it by GIVING OVER

The **Things** we Can't **FIX**

The **Things** we Can't **HANDLE**

The **Things** we Can't **CONTROL**

RELEASING those **things** to God - & **TRUSTING** Him - to **REPLACE** them - **with HIS MERCY**

& Not just ASKING ONCE - This Must become a LIFESTYLE of ASKING - SEEKING & KNOCKING

Just like Jesus said in LUKE 11:9-10

Ask & Keep on Asking
Seek & Keep on Seeking
Knock & Keep on Knocking

(v.10) For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened - (Lk 11:9-10)

God wants to TRANSFORM you - INTO Forgiving AS Christ Forgave you (2Cor 3:18)

But you MUST Surrender Full Control to Him You must GIVE OVER - Your Unforgiveness - to God & RECEIVE His MERCY toward others

- & **FINALLY** After we've "**Made the Comparison**"
- & After we **BEGIN** to **Allow God** o **REPLACE** Our **Unforgiveness** with **HIS Mercy**

Then, Step #3 - We Must GIVE OUT GOD'S Grace

NOT Our Grace - **God's Grace** that **HE plants IN US**

We're talking about the LIFE of Jesus Christ IN YOU
Truly Transforming your HEART, & Your ACTIONS

& <u>WHEN</u> that <u>Begins</u> to <u>Truly HAPPEN</u> - You will <u>Begin to see</u> <u>God's GRACE</u> - Truly <u>SHOWING</u> in your <u>life</u>

GRACE - is GIVING Someone - what they DON'T Deserve

MERCY - is NOT GIVING Someone - what they DO Deserve GRACE - is GIVING Someone - what they DON'T Deserve

GRACE - is GIVING Someone - what they DON'T Deserve & GRACE - CHANGES - EVERYTHING

But <u>THIS Grace</u> - The <u>Grace of God</u> - <u>You Don't Have</u> in <u>Yourself</u>
<u>This Grace</u> must be <u>POURED INTO</u> your <u>Life</u>

Romans 5:5 (ESV)

5... God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

You can't WORK this UP

<u>God's LOVE</u> - & <u>GRACE</u> - Must be <u>POURED</u> into your <u>Heart</u> <u>THRU the Holy Spirit</u> Who's been <u>given to you</u>

& when you Truly GIVE UP
& begin to Receive God's MERCY & His LOVE

God will begin -

to TRANSFORM YOUR Heart - into HIS HEART

You will **BEGIN** - To GIVE OUT - HIS Grace

It <u>requires</u> a <u>Transformed Life</u> - to <u>Truly LIVE</u> the <u>Character Traits</u> of God - Especially <u>Divine Forgiveness</u>

It Requires FULL SURRENDER - Of ALL that we HOLD ON to

Ephesians 4:31–32 (NLT)

31 Get rid of all bitterness, rage, anger, harsh words, and slander, as well as all types of evil behavior.

32 Instead, be <u>kind</u> to each other, <u>tenderhearted</u>, <u>forgiving</u> one another, <u>just as God</u> through Christ <u>has forgiven you</u>.

JUST AS - In the SAME WAY - that God has Forgiven You So you are Called to FORGIVE

But what God DOES NOT SAY is - You have to WORK THIS UP Or - You have to FIGURE this OUT

What **God says** is - You **have** to **Earnestly DESIRE it** & **Wholeheartedly RECEIVE it**

& if you will <u>TRULY Begin</u> to <u>DO THAT</u> - <u>God</u> will <u>Begin</u> to <u>POUR *HIS* Mercy</u> & <u>*HIS* Grace</u> - into <u>Your HEART</u>

& it <u>WILL CHANGE YOU</u> - <u>& at some point</u> - you <u>WILL experience</u> in your life - <u>Divine Forgiveness</u>

God wants to **FREE YOU** - from **the BONDAGE** & **DESTRUCTION** of your **Unforgiveness**

He wants you to **SURRENDER IT** - He wants you to GIVE UP

He wants you to Earnestly SEEK HIM - to Create in you

a **NEW Heart**

a **CLEAN Heart**

HIS Heart

Listen carefully to 3 vs from Psa 51 - then we'll Pray

Psalm 51:10-12 (NLT)

10 Create in me a clean heart, O God. Renew a loyal spirit within me.

11 Do not banish me from your presence, and don't take your Holy Spirit from me.

12 Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and make me willing to obey you.

What God wants - is a Surrendered & Willing Heart

& <u>IF</u> you <u>HAVE</u> a <u>Surrendered</u> & <u>Willing Heart</u> - & iof you will <u>Earnestly SEEK IT</u> . . .

God <u>WILL Bring</u> the <u>MIRACLE</u> of <u>Divine Forgiveness</u> into <u>YOUR life</u>

Let's Pray

Mark 11:25 (ESV)

25 And whenever you stand praying, forgive, if you have anything against anyone, so that your Father also who is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses."
