## Jn223 - Living Water Part 1 - John 7:1-24

<u>TODAY</u> - Jesus is going to "<u>Set the Stage</u>" for an absolute "<u>Crescendo Moment</u>" at the <u>Feast of Tabernacles</u>

It <u>comes</u> when Jesus <u>offers</u> <u>Israel</u> - & <u>US</u>
The "<u>LIVING WATER</u>" of <u>Salvation</u>

& he does it in <u>SUCH</u> a <u>Powerful</u> & <u>Dramatic</u> way – the <u>Holy Spirit</u> takes our <u>text</u> today – to <u>BUILD UP</u> to it

So - Here is today's <u>M.I.P.</u> - that <u>encapsulates</u> the <u>POINT</u> of our Vs's

#### **Most Important Point (MIP):**

Before Jesus can pour out Living Water into our lives, He must expose the dry wells of unbelief, poor judgment, and empty tradition — showing us that He alone is the true source of God's salvation.

**THAT** is what **Jesus** is doing today

He is **confronting** the **Unbelief**, **Poor Judgment**, & **Empty Tradition** of the **People** - & especially the **Religious Leaders** 

& Jesus **EXPOSING** the **Dry wells** people **TURN TO** today

is c<u>rucial</u> for us to <u>understand</u> the life-giving <u>POWER</u> of the <u>Living Water</u> He Freely <u>Offers</u>

# **Let's Pray**

From this point on – The Gospel of John is focused on the work of Jesus in Jerusalem & Judea - leading up to the cross

**Because** the Purpose of **JOHN** is to show Jesus - as the **SAVIOR** 

& so John sums up the remainder of Jesus' time in the Galilee in vs.1

## John 7:1 (NLT)

1 After this, Jesus traveled around Galilee. He wanted to stay out of Judea, where the Jewish leaders were plotting his death.

#### During the time of V.1

Jesus was staying out of Jerusalem & Judea

because He knew the <u>Jewish</u> <u>leaders</u> were <u>already</u> Plotting His Death

In the other <u>Gospels</u> – there is a <u>LOT</u> that still happens in the <u>Galilee</u>

But John is **moving us forward** with his single **focus** –

To present Jesus as "<u>The Christ</u> – <u>The Messiah</u> - The One come from God in the flesh"

& so <u>John</u> moves <u>straight</u> to <u>V.2</u>

#### John 7:2 (NLT)

2 But soon it was time for the Jewish Festival of Shelters, (Feast of Tabernacles)

The <u>Feast of Tabernacles</u> was <u>THE PINNACLE FEAST</u> to attend

Every <u>adult male</u> - within <u>traveliing</u> distance was <u>required</u> to attend the <u>Feast of Tabernacles</u>

It was the most <u>joyous</u>, & the most <u>attended</u> feast it was called the <u>season of gladness</u>

people <u>built shelters</u> (tabernacles) all over Jerusalem - & stayed in them

to remember how <u>God brought</u> their ancestors thru the 40 years in the <u>wilderness</u>

It was a **great time of celebration** of **God's Provision** 

& <u>Jesus</u> has the Greatest <u>Object Lesson</u> planned for the <u>Grand Finale</u> of this <u>FEAST</u>

& today – we're <u>watching</u> Jesus "<u>set the stage</u>" - & <u>PREPARE</u> the people - for this great moment

& it starts w/ His own half-brothers - still in Galilee

These are **other sons** of **Mary**, the mother of Jesus

## John 7:3-4 (NLT)

3 and Jesus' brothers said to him, "Leave here and go to Judea, where your followers can see your miracles!

4 You can't become famous if you hide like this! If you can do such wonderful things, show yourself to the world!"

This is "Sarcasim" -

Jesus' **brothers** are "**Taunting Him**"

They wanted Jesus to "**Prove Himself**" publicly

& we see their **True Heart Condition** (at this point) in V.5

## **John 7:5 (NLT)**

5 For even his brothers didn't believe in him.

at this point – His **brothers** were **UNBELIEVERS**But they didn't **stay** unbelievers

After the <u>Resurrection</u> – <u>James</u> (the brother of Jesus) wrote the book of <u>James</u> - & became the <u>leader</u> of the Jerusalem <u>church</u>

& Jesus' brother - <u>Jude</u> - wrote the book of <u>Jude</u>

But here – they are <u>unbelievers</u> - so **Jesus** tries to point them to – **The Heavenly Timetable** 

# John 7:6 (NLT)

6 Jesus replied, "Now is not the right time for me to go, but you can go anytime.

Jesus lived by a Heavenly Time-Table The timing of every step was set in Heaven

& so Jesus is c<u>ertaily not going</u> to the Feast <u>just because</u> his brothers are <u>"Chiding Him"</u> to go

But Jesus **DOES** give them – **MORE** to think about while they are **on** their **way** 

## John 7:7-9 (NLT)

7 The world can't hate you, but it does hate me because I accuse it of doing evil.

8 You go on. I'm not going (or, not yet going) to this festival, because my time has not yet come."

9 After saying these things, Jesus remained in Galilee.

Jesus is Preparing for a <u>Powerful</u>, <u>Dramatic</u>, & <u>Awesome</u> <u>OBJECT LESSON</u>- to Demonstrate <u>WHO He IS</u>

& His **OWN BROTHERS** - are the first ones in this Text to Prove they DON'T **YET** Understand

WHO Jesus IS – or WHAT He came to DO

& they are the <u>First Ones</u> here - to Receive "<u>TRUTH</u>" from Jesus – to try to <u>Prepare them</u> – for <u>what</u> is <u>coming</u>

## & then in John 7:10 we read (NLT)

10 But after his brothers left for the festival, Jesus also went, though secretly, staying out of public view.

His <u>brothers</u> wanted to <u>Travel</u> with him Because of his <u>growing FAME</u> – <u>NOT</u> because they <u>believed</u>

- But God is at work <u>NOT</u> on <u>man's</u> <u>Timetable</u> & <u>NOT</u> based on <u>Man's</u> <u>Understanding</u>
- & (again) Jesus' <u>OWN BROTHERS</u> Are the first ones here Jesus <u>TRIES</u> to Prepare for what we'll <u>SEE</u> Next Msg
- & now Jesus moves toward <u>Jerusalem</u> <u>Quietly</u>, <u>Discreetly</u> & on <u>Heaven's Timetable</u>
- & it took <u>NO TIME</u> for the <u>tension</u>, & the <u>drama</u> to start <u>building</u> at the <u>great feast</u>

& we see it next - in the <u>leaders</u> – <u>AND</u> among the <u>people</u>

# John 7:11 (NLT)

11 The Jewish leaders tried to find him at the festival and kept asking if anyone had seen him.

The "verb tense" here is continuous -

"The Jewish leaders <u>CONTINUALLY</u> tried to find him"

"& <u>CONTINUALLY asked</u> the people if they had SEEN Jesus"

The <u>Religious Leaders</u> (who were <u>supposed</u> to represent God) were <u>searching</u> hard for the "<u>Son of God</u>"

BUT - "NOT to KNOW him Better - but to KILL him Sooner"
"NOT to WORSHIP Him - But to SILENCE Him"

They were Far More CONCERNED
about Protecting their "Religious Traditions"

than they <u>were</u> in knowing the <u>TRUTH</u> of <u>God</u> in the <u>person</u> of <u>Jesus Christ</u>

But - The leaders' determination to silence Jesus

only served to make Him
the center of conversation throughout the feast

& so – <u>AS</u> the Religious Leaders are **BENT** on **SILENCING** Jesus

The people were STUCK on GRUMBLING & ARGUING - About Jesus

## **Look at - John 7:12-13 (NLT)**

12 There was a lot of grumbling about him among the crowds. Some argued, "He's a good man," but others said, "He's nothing but a fraud who deceives the people."

13 But no one had the courage to speak favorably about him in public, for they were afraid of getting in trouble with the Jewish leaders.

<u>Heaven</u> is making sure - <u>Jesus</u> is the <u>center of attention</u> at this <u>Greatest of Feasts</u>

But <u>Notice</u> – the people are <u>Mostly Grumbling</u> and <u>Arguing</u> about <u>WHO Jesus IS</u>

They were trying to <u>JUDGE Jesus</u> based on **APPEARANCES** & **RUMORS** 

& they were **making** very **POOR JUDGEMENTS** 

The **DRY WELL** of the People was – **POOR JUDGMENT** – Based on **APPEARENCES** 

They Knew **OF** Jesus – **SOME** even **knew him** growing up

**BUT** - By his **APPEARANCES**He didn't seem "**MESSIAH ENOUGH**" for them

So they **argued** & **debated** among themselves about him

#### & they "Poorly Judged" him

& so – <u>Jesus</u> is going to address <u>BOTH</u> the People <u>AND</u> the Religious <u>LEADERS</u>

& He's going to TRY to Point Out to them their POOR JUDGMENT
& their MISPLACED CONFIDENCE

& He's going to Try to **PREPARE** them all – **To Receive** the **Greatest Gift God** has for us in this life

The GIFT - of the Living Water of Salvation

Altho Jesus had <u>slipped</u> into this <u>highly charged situation</u> - very quietly

He *never intended* to remain quiet –

& now <u>suddenly</u> - in the middle of this <u>7 DAY FESTIVAL</u> - Jesus <u>walks</u> right up to the <u>temple</u> - & begins <u>teaching</u>

# John 7:14 (NLT)

14 Then, midway through the festival, Jesus went up to the Temple and began to teach.

Can you imagine **how fast** word **traveled** through the city

"The <u>prophet</u> from Galilee - who we're not even supposed to talk about -

He just walked right up to the temple & started teaching"

The <u>Religious Leaders</u> would've done <u>anything</u> to <u>keep Jesus</u> from teaching at this <u>feast</u>

But there <u>He was</u> - teaching <u>like He</u> was in <u>total control</u> – <u>Because He was in Total Control</u>

& so Jesus <u>walks right up</u> to the temple - & immediately <u>baffles</u> all those listening

## John 7:15 (NLT)

15 <u>The people</u> (The Jews) were surprised (marvelled) when they heard him. "How does he know so much when he hasn't been trained?" they asked.

The **NLT** uses the broader term, "the people"

But it is <u>LITERALLY</u> "The Jews" which <u>John</u> Primarily <u>uses</u> to refer to the <u>Jewish</u> <u>Leaders</u>

& so – In the <u>Broadest Sense</u> – it is the people - & <u>ESPECIALLY</u> the <u>Jewish Leaders</u> - asking themselves

"How does he know so much when he hasn't been trained?" (he hasn't even been to Rabbi School)

"Who does this guy think he is, the Son of God or what?"

& So – While the leaders - & the people are SNEERING at Jesus

But Jesus cuts through their Arrogance

& <u>declares</u> that His teaching is not <u>HIS OWN</u> – it comes <u>directly</u> from <u>THE FATHER</u> who sent Him

## John 7:16 (NLT)

16 So Jesus told them, "My message is not my own; it comes from God who sent me.

<u>Again</u> – Jesus <u>Boldly Declares</u> – that he has <u>come down</u> from <u>God</u>

& that his <u>words</u> are <u>NOT</u> His own But <u>they</u> are the <u>very words</u> of <u>GOD</u>

- & again, <u>Jesus</u> is giving everyone there (& <u>HERE</u>) the chance to <u>"WANT to BELIEVE"</u>
- & in <u>V.17</u> <u>–</u> Jesus Tells us <u>HOW</u> we can <u>KNOW</u> whether his <u>Words</u> are from <u>God</u> or <u>NOT</u>

# John 7:17 (NLT)

17 Anyone who wants to do the will of God will know whether my teaching is from God or is merely my own.

**Anyone** who Truly **WANTS to KNOW** the Will of God **Anyone** who Truly **WANTS to KNOW** God

WILL KNOW whether my teaching is from God

#### LAST WEEK we said

"If you are Willing to BELIEVE, then you will SEE"

& **Jesus** is saying something **SIMILAR** here

If you will <u>approach</u> the <u>Words</u> of Jesus – Genuinely **Desiring to KNOW the Will of God** 

<u>Then</u> you will <u>KNOW</u> – whether the Words of Jesus are From God – Or Not

This shows that the **Real Problem** is **NOT Intellectual** - **But SPIRITUAL** 

# Receiving the things of God depends on a willingness & desire - to KNOW GOD'S WILL - & DO IT

Jesus Christ redeems the lost -

He transforms the dead to the living -

He turns the wretched sinner into a saint

But you <u>must first</u> - by faith –

<u>Truly DESIRE to KNOW - & DO the Will of God</u>

You must First – **Be WILLING to BELIEVE** 

& <u>then</u> you will <u>Know</u> & <u>Experience</u> - that the <u>words</u> Jesus speaks - are the words <u>of life</u>

**BUT** - These people are **NOT THERE YET** 

So <u>Jesus</u> conintues to try to <u>SHOW</u> them

They must <u>TURN</u> from the <u>DRY WELLS</u> of <u>UNBELIEF</u>, & <u>POOR JUDGEMENT</u>, & <u>TRADITION</u>

**BEFORE** They can **Receive** the **Living Water** of **Eternal Life** - that he came to **FREELY OFFER THEM** 

& so - in <u>v.18</u> Jesus <u>CONTRASTS</u> – His <u>Teaching</u> with the <u>teaching</u> of the Religious Leaders

John 7:18 (NLT)  $\rightarrow$   $\rightarrow$ 

# John 7:18 (NLT)

18 Those who <u>speak for themselves</u> want glory only for themselves, but a person who <u>seeks to honor</u> the one who sent him speaks truth, not lies.

It was <u>no secret</u> – the <u>Religious Leaders SOUGHT</u>
<u>Self-Glory</u> - & <u>Man's Approval</u>

But **Jesus** speaks **ONLY** - to **honor** the **one** who sent him

& (<u>btw</u>) that is a huge <u>TEST</u> of <u>Spiritual Authenticity</u> "Whose HONOR, or GLORY, are you seeking?"

That is a Really Direct SHOT at the Religious Leaders

- & <u>Jesus</u> doesn't <u>Stop</u> There <u>Instead He LEANS IN</u>
- & His words are like a two-edged sword

## John 7:19 (NLT)

19 Moses gave you the law, but <u>none of you obeys it!</u> In fact, you are trying to kill me."

That is a **one-two punch** 

<u>Every Jew</u> in the <u>Temple</u> that day –
<u>held Moses</u> in the <u>highest</u> possible <u>regard</u>

These leaders <u>regarded themselves</u> as the "<u>keepers & interpreters</u>" of the law

Yet Jesus says - "none of you keeps the law"

& worse yet – these "Keepers of the Law" were – at that very moment –

planning to kill the one who came to FULFILL the law

Jesus <u>KNEW IT</u> – The Religious Leaders <u>KNEW IT</u> <u>BUT</u> – the Crowd <u>DID NOT KNOW IT</u>

## & so - in John 7:20 we read (NLT)

20 <u>The crowd</u> replied, "You're demon possessed! Who's trying to kill you?"

Notice – it says "The Crowd"

The <u>Crowd</u> didn't know the <u>Religious Leaders</u> were <u>Plotting</u> to <u>Kill</u> Jesus

So <u>this</u> just <u>gives</u> the crowd <u>"More Fuel"</u> for their <u>POOR JUDGMENT</u> – Based on <u>APPEARANCES</u>

But – Jesus <u>doesn't</u> <u>address</u> the <u>crowd's</u> insult – <u>Because</u> he is speaking to the <u>Religious</u> <u>Leaders</u> right now

& He's *going back* - to the *event* that *started* - their *PLOT* to kill him

John 7:21 (NLT)  $\rightarrow$   $\rightarrow$ 

# John 7:21 (NLT)

21 Jesus replied, "I did one miracle on the Sabbath, and you were amazed.

Jesus is **referring back** to the **last time** He was there - 1 yr ago

& on that <u>Sabbath</u> He <u>healed</u> the <u>paralytic</u> at Bethesda

& It was then that the leader's hatred toward Him began to burn -

**NOT** because He **healed** a man -

But <u>because</u> of his <u>disregard</u> for their <u>TRADITIONS</u> regardng the Sabbath

- & Jesus had **performed** this miracle **deliberately** with obvious **intent**
- & He had claimed *Divine Authority* to do so
- & the Religious Leaders had <u>never let</u> that event <u>go</u> so <u>Jesus brings it</u> right up, & <u>shows</u> it to them

& now – <u>Jesus</u> is going to <u>EXPLAIN</u> the <u>point</u> he was making with that <u>Amazing Healing</u> on the Sabbath

#### John 7:21 (again) & 22 (NLT)

21 Jesus replied, "I did one miracle on the Sabbath, and you were amazed.

22 But you work on the Sabbath, too, when you obey Moses' law

of circumcision. (Actually, this tradition of circumcision began with the patriarchs, long before the law of Moses.)

Under the <u>Law of Moses</u> - even tho <u>WORK</u> <u>was not allowed</u> on the Sabbath - <u>CIRCUMCISION</u> was

because **every** Jewish boy **must** be circumcised on the 8th day

So if that 8th day fell on the Sabbath

The Law of <u>Circumcision</u>

<u>took precedence</u> over the law of the <u>Sabbath</u>

#### **WHY** ???

Because **<u>circumcision</u>** was a **<u>type</u>** – it was a **<u>picture</u>** 

of the <u>removing</u> of the sinful flesh & <u>making a person right</u> (or whole) <u>before God</u>

& so - <u>because</u> it had to do with making a person <u>right</u> <u>before God</u>

it took precedent over the Law Of The Sabbath

& Jesus is <u>USING THIS</u> to Try to <u>Reveal</u> to the Religious Leaders

That He is <u>not compromising</u> the Law but instead he is <u>fulfilling it</u> to the ultimate degree

By coming to make people "Right with God" - Once & For All

#### So He says to them in v.23

## John 7:23 (NLT)

23 For if the correct time for circumcising your son (which is a picture of making him "right" before God) falls on the Sabbath, you go ahead and do it so as not to break the law of Moses. So why should you be angry with me for healing a man (making him "right" before God) on the Sabbath?

**Jesus** is showing the **Religious Leaders** –

their <u>Religious Rules</u> & <u>Traditions</u>
are an <u>EMPTY WELL</u> they are <u>trying</u> to <u>Drink</u> From

& he's <u>preparing</u> them to <u>hear</u> – <u>HE</u> is the <u>WELL</u> of the <u>Living Water of Eternal Life</u>

& then **Jesus Delivers** One Final **BOMB** 

to try to **Shake** the **people** up enough to **understand** what he is **about** to do with the **Living Water** 

## John 7:24 (NLT)

24 Look beneath the surface so you can judge correctly."

Jesus is **Confronting** our "Surface Level" Judgments

He's **Calling** us to to **LOOK DEEPER** - to **SEE** God's truth

So - In this text - <u>Jesus</u> has Directly <u>CHALLENGED</u>

His <u>BROTHERS</u> - <u>Unbelief</u>
The <u>CROWD'S</u> - <u>Poor Judgment</u>
& The <u>RELIGIOUS LEADERS</u> - <u>Rules & Traditions</u>

He is <u>CHALLENGING</u>
the <u>DRY WELLS</u> that <u>we</u> are <u>trying</u> to <u>Drink</u> From

& He is **giving** us **every opportunity** 

to **be able** to **RECEIVE** the **Free Gift** of **Living Water** he is **preparing** to **offer** us
