Acts 14 - Rise & Go - Acts 8:26-40

Let me share with you something I <u>haven't</u> shared in a long time but something forever <u>ETCHED</u> in my mind

- The <u>first</u> major <u>spiritual attack</u> against this church was <u>especially hard</u> on me & my family
- In fact the wounds of that attack are still very sensitive
- & <u>in the midst</u> of a battle I <u>found myself</u> asking God <u>WHY</u> did you <u>send us</u> here ??
- <u>I know</u> it wasn't just to get <u>beat up</u> & be <u>taken out</u> by the enemy So . . . <u>WHY God</u>, WHY?
- & <u>during</u> that time I <u>had a dream</u>,
 & I <u>don't have</u> many <u>dreams</u> like this
- <u>most</u> of my dreams are <u>pure crazy</u>, <u>like</u> most of <u>yours</u> but <u>this one</u> stuck with me as a <u>message from God</u>
- I saw a **living room** in an **older house**, possibly a **mobile**
- <u>The carpet</u> was <u>multicolored</u> long shag from <u>the 70's</u> in various <u>shades</u> - of <u>burnt orange</u>
- & <u>sitting</u> in the <u>middle</u> of the floor in that living room was a <u>young boy</u> <u>playing</u> with his <u>toys</u>, & <u>oblivious</u> to everything around him
- & <u>God spoke</u> to my <u>heart</u> that night very clearly & He said to me *"you're here for ONE PERSON"*
- & I <u>wasn't clear</u> if it was <u>THAT</u> child, or <u>even</u> who that child was but <u>God's encouragement</u> to me that night was <u>CLEAR</u>

<u>I had come</u> expecting something <u>different</u> but God let me know - I brought you here for ONE PERSON!

So <u>STOP worrying</u> about the <u>battles</u>, the <u>attacks</u>, or the <u>struggles</u> & <u>remember</u> you are here for <u>one person</u>,

- & I've never Forgotten that
- <u>Our text</u> today is about God calling Philip to <u>RISE & GO</u> for the Benefit of <u>ONE PERSON</u>
- & so this text REALLY speaks a lot to me

<u>Let's Pray</u>

Last week - Philip was leading a Revival that was off the hook

<u>Simon</u> the magician had been <u>defeated</u> The entire town was being <u>SAVED</u> & <u>HEALED</u> & <u>DELIVERED</u>

The <u>Spiritual Fruit</u> is <u>MASS PRODUCING</u> - - - & <u>suddenly</u> the Lord tells Philip - <u>take a hike</u>

Literally **TAKE A HIKE**

to **barren place** in the middle of the **DESERT**

- So Philip begins <u>a 60 MILE Walk</u> <u>AWAY</u> from a city-wide Revival <u>toward</u> a lonely desert road - and <u>ONE</u> person
- It would have been pretty easy to get discouraged right there
- <u>Put yourself</u> in Philip's <u>place</u>. You're <u>not even</u> one of the <u>Twelve</u>, but <u>suddenly</u> you're leading the <u>First Revival</u> of the N.T.

& suddenly God says - RISE & GO - to the Desert ??

<u>Maybe</u> we would've said: "Lord, Have I done something wrong? Is there some other way we can work this out?

You know - <u>I've got</u> an entire city being <u>saved</u> here, <u>are you sure</u> there's not <u>someone else</u> we can send to handle that - <u>Desert thing</u>

Maybe That's how <u>WE</u> would've responded But that's <u>NOT</u> how Philip responded

<u>Philip</u> was <u>ready</u> to serve <u>anywhere anytime</u> & he's a <u>WONDERFUL example</u> - for you & I to follow

So - Philip's got <u>a Revival</u> exploding in <u>Samaria</u>, & <u>right</u> in the <u>midst</u> of it - <u>we read</u> in

Acts 8:26 (esv)

26 Now an angel of the Lord said to Philip, "Rise and go toward the south to the road that goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza." This is a desert place.

(LIT - that last sentence is "this is a barren or uninhabited place")

Hey Philip - Nice job bringing the Gospel to Samaria Now . . . <u>LEAVE</u> . . . <u>Rise, & GO</u>

& this was <u>NO</u> - "Take a Super Shuttle to the Airport & fly off to the Bible conference - & we'll see you next Monday"

This was a 60 Mile WALK - It was Long, Hot, Difficult, & LONELY

Guys - THIS - was a COMPLETE SURRENDER - of the WILL

Oswald Chambers:

True surrender is not simply surrender of our external life but surrender of our will - and once that is done, surrender is complete.

Philip's <u>WILL</u> was <u>Surrendered to God</u> - & so he was willing to Do <u>ANYTHING</u> - Go <u>ANYWHERE</u> that God called him

<u>& so - Acts 8:27 begins (esv)</u> 27 And he rose and went . . .

Philip's *walking . . . walking . . . walking . . .* <u>ALONE</u> - to the <u>Dry</u>, <u>Hot</u>, <u>Barren</u>, Desert

& then - **FINALLY** - **Imagine** how Philip's heart must've **JUMPED** when - in the distance - on the horizon - he sees . . . **PEOPLE**

lt's <u>a caravan</u> - a <u>BIG one</u>

(Acts 8:27 cont.) . . . And there was an Ethiopian, a eunuch, a court official of Candace, queen of the Ethiopians, who was in charge of all her treasure. He had come to Jerusalem to worship

This was the **Secretary of the Treasury** for the Kingdom of **Ethiopia**

<u>Which</u> at that time was just <u>South of Egypt</u> where <u>Northern Sudan</u> is today - & <u>North of Ethiopia</u> today

Now - there is some Speculation from Chuck Misler & a few others -

that this <u>Eunuch MIGHT HAVE</u> actually had the <u>Mercy Seat</u>, from the <u>Ark of the Covenant</u> - with him

& that he had come looking for the Messiah to give it to

There <u>some scriptures</u> that <u>MAY</u> support that idea But it's <u>mostly Cool Speculation</u>

What we <u>do know</u> is - this high ranking <u>Gov't Official</u> from <u>Ethiopia</u> an <u>African Gentile</u> - would've been <u>travelling</u> with a <u>large Caravan</u>

& <u>he's returning</u> from what <u>could have been</u> close to a <u>THOUSAND MILE</u> religious <u>pilgrimage</u> to Jerusalem

PLUS (we'll see in a minute) he has a copy of the Isaiah Scroll with him - so he was very serious about his pilgrimage

Which may give some credence to Chuck Misler's theory

It's <u>also interesting</u> that <u>Deut 23</u> forbids a eunuch from <u>becoming a part</u> of the Jewish community

because they were considered "Mutilated"

<u>However</u>, in <u>Isaiah 56</u> (which we'll see today) this <u>ban is prophetically</u> removed

saying that Eunuchs will be BLESSED by the Lord
& it seems this Eunuch is the First to fulfill that Prophecy

& so <u>as we continue</u> the Narrative - We're Really <u>FOCUSED MORE</u> today On <u>Phillip</u> - & on HIS actions

Acts 8:28-29 (esv)

28 and [the eunuch] was returning [from Jerusalem], seated in his chariot, and he was reading the prophet Isaiah.
29 And the Spirit said to Philip, "Go over and join this chariot."

So there's a KEY Gov't Official of Ethiopia

Who just <u>HAPPENS</u> to be in the middle of <u>NO WHERE</u> <u>READING</u> the <u>ISAIAH SCROLL</u>

& <u>Suddenly</u> Phillip <u>FINDS HIMSELF</u> there & the Spirit <u>SAID</u> to Phillip - *"Go over and join this chariot."*

Let's look at that a minute - And the Spirit SAID to Philip

<u>The leading</u> of the <u>Holy Spirit</u> can sometimes be a <u>difficult</u> thing to <u>learn</u> - & there are <u>definitely people</u> who can take this <u>too far</u>

<u>I guy told me</u> once he was <u>driving</u> down the <u>freeway</u> & he <u>felt the Spirit</u> tell him to <u>get off</u> the freeway, so he <u>did</u>,

then he <u>felt like</u> he should turn <u>left</u>, & he <u>did</u>, then <u>right</u>, and he <u>did</u>, then <u>left</u> again, and <u>so on & so on</u>

& after a while he realized he was just LOST

& So - <u>we've got</u> to learn how to <u>Truly Discern</u> <u>the leading</u> of the Lord in our lives

The <u>Holy Spirit</u> speaks <u>differently</u> to <u>each</u> Spirit-Filled Believer & so we've got to learn <u>HOW</u> He speaks <u>TO US</u> <u>personally</u> How do we <u>LEARN</u> how to be sensitive to what the <u>Holy Spirit</u> wants us to <u>DO</u> or <u>SAY</u> ??

The <u>same way</u> I've <u>learned</u> to be <u>sensitive</u> to what my <u>WIFE</u> would like me to <u>DO</u> or <u>SAY</u> . . . By developing a <u>Close</u>, <u>Intimate</u> <u>relationship</u> with my <u>Wife</u>, I've come to <u>KNOW HER</u> very well

& I can SENSE what she would have me DO or SAY

& we can do the Exact same thing with the Holy Spirit

If we will <u>develop</u> a <u>close</u> & <u>intimate</u> <u>relationship</u> with the Holy Spirit then we will be <u>sensitive</u> to His <u>leading</u>,

& then we'll know HOW & WHEN - to respond to Him

& So - <u>because</u> Philip <u>HAD</u> that <u>relationship</u> with the Holy Spirit the <u>Next Verse</u> just came <u>naturally</u>

Acts 8:30 (esv) 30 So Philip ran to him . . .

I <u>love the fact</u> that - the Spirit said <u>GO</u> in <u>V.29</u> & in <u>response</u> - Philip <u>RAN</u> to him

... and heard him reading Isaiah the prophet and asked, "Do you understand what you are reading?" 31 And he said, "How can I, unless someone <u>guides</u> me?" And he invited Philip to come up and sit with him.

This word for <u>GUIDE</u> - is the word used for <u>TEACHING</u> it means - *to GUIDE someone into knowledge or understanding*

It's ALSO the word used in Jn 16:13 13 When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth . . .

So - *Right now* - Philip is going to **GUIDE** this Eunuch

But <u>*in a minute*</u> - Philip is going to be G<u>O</u>NE & the <u>Holy Spirit</u> is going to <u>GUIDE</u> this Eunuch from then on

& <u>Now</u> - I really want us to <u>notice carefully</u> what happens next

<u>When Christians</u> have an opportunity to <u>GUIDE</u> someone to Jesus we <u>very often</u> make One of <u>TWO HUGE MISTAKES</u>

#1 HUGE Mistake - - We talk about OURSELVES

2 HUGE Mistake - - We talk about Our OWN OPINIONS or ACCOMPLISHMENTS

& <u>when</u> we do <u>Either</u> one of these two things <u>ALL</u> we end up <u>really doing</u> - is <u>Getting in God's WAY</u>

<u>Philip</u> doesn't jump in this guy's <u>ESCALADE</u> & <u>start</u> talking about <u>himself</u>

Hey - glad to meet you - I was just at the head of this huge Revival in Samaria - Man, you shoulda seen me, Yeah the Lord was using me in A BIG WAY

& Hey - did you hear about the Day of Pentecost? Yeah I was in the Tent with Pastor Chuck on the Day of Pentecost, Yep, I was there . . . Saw it all

<u>PLEEEAAASE</u> - Help God out a Bit - & <u>ZIP IT !!</u>
<u>#1 rule</u> in Spirit-Led Christianity - IT'S NOT ABOUT YOU !!

<u>It's about</u> what <u>GOD</u> is doing in <u>the life</u> of the <u>person</u> you're <u>talking</u> to & so - <u>THAT</u> is where we have to <u>START</u>
& <u>THAT</u> is where we have to <u>STAY</u>
& <u>THAT</u> is HOW God can <u>USE</u> us - in that person's life

& so - watch closely - How the Holy Spirit Guides Philip here

1st - we read in Acts 8:32-33 (esv)

32 Now the passage of the Scripture that he was reading was this: "Like a sheep he was led to the slaughter and like a lamb before its shearer is silent, so he opens not his mouth. 33 In his humiliation justice was denied him. Who can describe his generation? For his life is taken away from the earth."

So - The Eunuch **JUST HAPPENS** to be reading from **ISA 53**

& there may be **<u>NO BETTER place</u>** in all the O.T. <u>from which</u> to share <u>Jesus</u> with someone

But you & I both <u>know people</u> - who can take a <u>SPOON FED opportunity</u> like that . . .

& still manage to talk about <u>THEMSELVES</u>, Their <u>OPINIONS</u> & Their <u>ACCOMPLISHMENTS</u>

Guys - <u>the Holy Spirit</u> will <u>SET US UP</u> perfectly - to <u>USE</u> us If we'll just <u>CRUCIFY</u> our <u>SELF</u> Focus

If we will Simply be QUICK to Hear, & SLOW to Speak (Jas 1:19)

If <u>we will develop</u> a <u>relationship</u> with the Holy Spirit where He can actually <u>Lead</u> & <u>Guide</u> us - - <u>THEN</u> He can use us & we certainly <u>see THAT</u> in our text today As <u>Philip</u> shows us - <u>what</u> we like to call - - - <u>The RIGHT WAY</u>

Acts 8:34-35 (esv)

34 And the eunuch said to Philip, "About whom, I ask you, does the prophet say this, about himself or about someone else?" 35 Then Philip <u>opened his mouth</u>, and <u>beginning with this</u> <u>Scripture</u> he told him the good news about Jesus.

The phrase *"Philip opened his mouth"* implies the <u>Holy Spirit</u> is <u>guiding</u> his <u>thoughts</u> & his <u>words</u>

& <u>because</u> Philip was "<u>In Tune</u>" with the <u>Spirit</u> he <u>opened</u> his mouth - - & <u>beginning with this Scripture</u> he told him the good news about Jesus

Man - that is Beautiful !!

- No doubt Philip took the Eunuch thru the entire Ch of ISA 53
- <u>Guys</u> if we would <u>just learn</u> this <u>ONE CH OF ISA</u> We would have the <u>Entire Gospel</u> Message <u>DOWN</u> - from the <u>O.T.</u>
- & so, **Philip** begins explaining **WHO** Jesus is from **ISA 53**
- <u>& when he gets to the end of the CH he reads in V.12</u> ... yet he bore the sin of many, and makes intercession for the transgressors.
- & <u>Philip</u> probably says: Would you LIKE Him to do that for YOU? & this <u>Eunuch</u> - gets <u>SAVED</u> !!

How could he not? - God had lined it all up & Philip was being obedient to the leading of the Spirit If we will Let the <u>Word of God</u> do its job - <u>Salvation</u> will be the <u>natural outcome</u> - for <u>the people</u> God <u>leads</u> us to

& <u>So</u> - the <u>NEXT Natural Response</u> for the Eunuch who had <u>just been saved</u> is - - - <u>Get Baptized</u> !

Acts 8:36 (esv)

36 And as they were going along the road they came to some water, and the eunuch said, "See, here is water! What prevents me from being baptized?"

<u>Maybe</u> the Eunuch <u>new</u> about <u>baptism</u> as a <u>convert</u> to Judaism or <u>maybe</u> <u>Philip</u> <u>explained</u> it to him during their <u>Bible Study</u>

But <u>either way</u> - this Eunuch <u>KNEW</u> the <u>RIGHT thing</u> to do now - was <u>get Baptized</u>

Now - <u>V.37</u> is <u>NOT</u> found in <u>NINE</u> of the top <u>TEN</u> manuscripts that exist today - & so it is not found in the <u>ESV</u> or the <u>NLT</u>

If you have a <u>V.37</u> - that verse <u>IS</u> consistent with all scripture regarding <u>Faith</u> & <u>Baptism</u>

it just isn't in the majority of early manuscripts that exist

Acts 8:37 (NKJV)

37 Then Philip said, "If you believe with all your heart, you may." And he answered and said, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God."

So - <u>The Eunuch</u> sees <u>water</u> - - <u>KNOWS</u> he should be <u>Baptized</u> - & we <u>read in V.38</u> . . .

<u>Acts 8:38 (esv)</u> 38 And he commanded the chariot to stop, and they both went down into the water, Philip and the eunuch, and he baptized him.

<u>This</u> is the <u>Eunuch's</u> <u>public profession</u> of faith & it must have been **SO COOL** to see

As this <u>High Official</u> <u>HUMBLES</u> himself & is <u>Baptized Literally</u> - in the middle of <u>no-where</u>

With only his Entourage - to Witness it

& <u>NOW</u> - From <u>THIS</u> Point - <u>The Holy Spirit</u> is going to <u>Take Over</u> the "<u>GUIDING</u>" of this Eunuch

Because for <u>Reasons UNKNOWN</u> to us <u>Philip's</u> job here is <u>finished</u> !!

& it's **Finished** in True **STAR-TREK Fashion** As Philip gets **BEAMED UP** - to God's "<u>Starship Enterprise</u>"

Acts 8:39 (esv)

39 And when they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord <u>carried</u> Philip away, and the eunuch saw him no more, and went on his way rejoicing.

I guess he went on his way **REJOICING** !!

<u>This guy</u> just showed up <u>out of no where</u> <u>Explained</u> a <u>Prophetic Scripture</u> that he <u>couldn't</u> understand

Tells him how he can have his Sins Forgiven & Receive Eternal Life & then he <u>Literally Disappears</u> when <u>he</u> <u>comes up</u> out of the water !!

I guess that would've MADE this Eunuch's DAY

& <u>look</u> at that <u>word</u> <u>CARRIED</u> Philip away That's <u>one</u> of our Favorite <u>GREEK</u> Words - <u>HARPAZO</u>

<u>THAT'S the same word used for the RAPTURE in 1Thes 4:17</u> 17 Then we who are alive, who are left, will be <u>caught up</u> together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will always be with the Lord.

THIS - is **Early Rapture Training** for Philip !! - - **very cool**

& so - <u>the Eunuch</u> goes on his way <u>REJOICING</u> & probably <u>continuing to read</u> the <u>ISAIAH</u> Scroll

<u>& just 3 Ch's later this Eunuch would read - in Isa 56:3-5</u> 3 Let not the foreigner who has joined himself to the Lord say, "The Lord will surely separate me from his people"; and let not the eunuch say, "Behold, I am a dry tree."

4 For thus says the Lord: "<u>To the eunuchs</u> who keep my Sabbaths, who choose the things that please me and hold fast my covenant,

5 I will give in my house and within my walls a monument and a name better than sons and daughters; I will give them an everlasting name that shall not be cut off.

& now - this Eunuch has gotta just be goin balistic

As <u>God's Word</u> is speaking to him - <u>PERSONALLY</u> & <u>as</u> the Holy Spirit <u>GUIDES</u> him into the <u>understanding</u> In fact - Irenaeus & other <u>church fathers</u> credit <u>THIS</u> Eunuch with the <u>SPREAD</u> of the Gospel in <u>Ethiopia</u>

& he **apparently** did a **Great Job**

cause <u>Ethiopia</u> is the only <u>African Nation</u> that had <u>Christian Roots</u> <u>long before</u> any <u>missionaries</u> were ever sent there

Alright - Let me Blow your Mind with One Other Thing

Do you <u>remember</u> last week - we said this was the <u>BEGINNING</u> of the <u>Gospel</u> being spread to the <u>End of the Earth</u> (<u>Acts 1:8</u>)?

OK - <u>After the FLOOD</u> - <u>WHO</u> <u>Populated</u> the Entire Earth ?? Noah's Sons <u>HAM</u>, <u>SHEM</u>, <u>JAPETH</u> - -(those are <u>not</u> the 3 stooges)

Alright - Watch this;

Everything I'm about to say is Traced Back to GEN CH 10

Here, in Acts 8, this Ethiopian was a descendant of Ham

- In <u>Acts 9</u>, <u>Saul</u> of Tarsus will be saved, who is a Jew and therefore a <u>descendant of Shem</u>
- In <u>Acts 10</u>, the <u>Gentiles</u> Receive Christ & they are the <u>descendants of Japheth</u>
- in <u>3 Ch's</u> <u>Descendants</u> of <u>EACH</u> of the <u>Three Sons of Noah</u> <u>who populated</u> the entire earth <u>ALL get saved</u>

As a Sign - that God wants the Entire World to hear the Gospel Man - - THAT is an INCREDIBLE story !!

But <u>WAIT a minute</u> - Philip just got <u>BEAMED UP</u> to the Lord's <u>STARSHIP ENTERPRISE</u>

What happened to Philip?

Acts 8:40 (esv)

40 But Philip found himself at Azotus, and <u>as he passed through</u> <u>he preached the gospel</u> to all the towns until he came to <u>Caesarea</u>.

This **might be** the most **incredible part** of the entire story

Let's just Follow Philip for a minute

- 1) He was chosen <u>as a Deacon</u> in Jerusalem
- 2) **Persecution** drove him to Samaria
- 3) He leads an *incredible Revival*, & coulda had a Mega-Church
- He wakes up 1 morning & <u>Leaves</u> the Revival to <u>meet ONE GUY</u> in the desert 60 miles away
- 5) He gets him Saved & <u>then is BEAMED UP</u> to a small town on the coast - about <u>20 miles</u> from there
- 6) Then he <u>walks over 50 miles</u> back up the coast <u>preaching</u> the gospel as he <u>goes</u>
- 7) Finally <u>settling in Caesarea</u> which is <u>only 20 Miles</u> from where he <u>originally started</u> in Samaria

& the **most amazing** thing is - Philip **NEVER returned** to **Samaria**

He could have gone back as a HERO - a Spiritual Super-Star !!

But instead - He Continued to FOLLOW the LEADING of the LORD

The next time we see Philip - It's 20 yrs later

& he's still living in <u>Caesarea</u>
He's still serving God as an <u>Evangelist</u>
& He's got <u>FOUR Daughters</u> - Who are all Prophetesses

LUKE is writing in Acts 21:8 - & He's Traveling with PAUL

Acts 21:8-9 (ESV)

8 On the next day we departed and came to Caesarea, and we entered the house of Philip the evangelist, who was one of the seven, and stayed with him.

9 He had four unmarried daughters, who prophesied.

PAUL - who's persecution drove Philip out of Jerusalem & into his early ministry success

Is now **STAYING** at Philips House

- & <u>those days</u> that <u>PAUL spent</u> at Philip's house were <u>actually</u> the <u>LAST DAYS</u> of Paul's Freedom
- He was <u>about</u> to be <u>sent to Rome</u> as a <u>Prisoner</u> where he would <u>eventually</u> be <u>Martyred</u>

WOW! - How the World Turns

as we just **continue Serving** the Lord !!

So - In the FIRST YEAR of his ministry

Philip did Incredible, Note Worthy things for the Lord

& then - for the next 20 years he served quietly as an Evangelist & raised Four Daughters who all became Prophetesses Which to me - is more important - than FOUR Mega-Churches

But **STILL** - The question **BEGS to be ASKED** . . .

<u>WHY</u> did God <u>use Philip</u> in such <u>LARGE PUBLIC</u> ways for the <u>first year</u> of his ministry

& <u>THEN</u> - <u>send him</u> up the <u>coast</u> to <u>quietly</u> tell people about Jesus & <u>raise</u> four <u>Spirit-Filled Daughters</u>

WHY ?? - Philip was simply **DOING** what **God LEAD HIM** to Do !!

Whether it was:

Starting a **Revival**

Or **Saving a Eunuch** in the Desert

Or Raising Four daughters in a small town

Philip <u>**DID</u>** - What God <u>**LED Him**</u> to <u>**DO**</u> - by the Holy Spirit</u>

& <u>whether</u> the <u>results</u> seemed <u>Great</u> or <u>Small</u> It <u>didn't seem to matter</u> to Philip

When God said RISE & GO - - - Philip WENT

<u>& so - For Today - The REAL Lesson is;</u>
 <u>NOT</u> to Desire to <u>IMITATE</u> Philips <u>Brilliant Beginnings</u>
 <u>BUT</u> to Desire to <u>IMITATE</u> Philip's <u>Consistent Life of Obedience</u>

When God told Philip to RISE & GO - Philip - ROSE UP, & WENT !!

& the **SAME GOD** Who Spoke to Philip - **Still speaks** to us **TODAY**

Let's Pray
