Mrk11 - Check Your Heart, Pt 2 - Mark 4:1-25

<u>Last week</u> – we did <u>Check Your Heart – Part ONE</u>

it would be good - to go back

& <u>LISTEN</u>, <u>WATCH</u>, or <u>READ</u> that msg on the <u>WBM Ph App</u>

Today - Check Your Heart - Part TWO

Where we FINISH looking at the Parable of the Sower

<u>AND . . .</u>

We <u>FINISH</u> <u>looking</u> at the <u>DEEP TRUTH</u> of <u>WHY</u> Jesus <u>taught in Parables</u>

There are some Challenging Vs's in today's msg

So – <u>Hold on Tight</u> & let's get Ready to "<u>Check Our Heart</u>" - <u>AGAIN</u>

Let's Pray

Remember - from last week

In <u>Mark 4:1</u> – Jesus <u>takes</u> a <u>radical SHIFT</u> in <u>HOW</u> he <u>teaches</u> the <u>CROWDS</u> - that are <u>chasing him</u> around

& he **begins teaching** them – **IN PARABLES**

We explained that a Parable IS

taking a **Deep Spiritual Truth**

& "Placing it alongside" - an Easily Understood Truth

& <u>then</u> we <u>dove into</u> the Jesus' <u>FIRST Parable</u> in <u>Mark</u>
The <u>Parable</u> of the <u>Sower & the Seed</u>

That Parable started in Mark 4:3

& described 4 TYPES of soil that a Farmer's seed will fall on

You'll have to go back to PART ONE

To **get** all **the details** on that

But - just to catch you up

In <u>Mark 4:14</u> Jesus <u>explains</u> this <u>first parable</u>
So <u>everyone</u> will <u>know</u> - <u>HOW</u> the parables <u>WORK</u>

& he says

The **SEED** is **God's Word**

& the **Soil Condition** represents the **Condition of OUR HEART**

& **Jesus** says

the Condition of our heart toward God's Truth

is **LIKE** - **ONE of FOUR SOILS**

1) Hard-Packed Soil

where the **enemy** can easily **SNATCH it away**

2) Shallow Soil

where the Word of God cannot take root

3) Thorny Soil

where the things of this world - CHOKE OUT God's Word

4) Fertile Soil

where **God's Wo**rd will bring **Real Eternal FRUIT**

Again – you **have** to **go back** to **Part ONE** for all that

But – the **Real DEEP TRUTH**

that we tried to clearly explain last week - was this:

The CONDITION of your heart – TOWARD God's Word DETERMINES your Ability to RECEIVE God's Word

Jesus makes it ABUNDANTLY CLEAR in this Parable

The CONDITION of your **Heart**

is what Determines your ABILITY to RECEIVE God's Word

& <u>then</u> – we kinda <u>skipped over Vs's 10-13</u> last week <u>Because</u> we <u>were saving</u> those <u>Vs's</u> for <u>THIS week</u>

Jesus had TAUGHT this Parable to the CROWD

& <u>then</u> – in <u>V.10</u> – the <u>Disciples</u> ask Jesus <u>WHAT</u> the <u>parables</u> <u>meant</u>

But he answers them
by telling them WHY he teaches in Parables

& **this** is **what** we **really want** to **GET TO** today (for Pt-2)

Mark 4:10-11(A) (NLT)

10 Later, when Jesus was alone with the <u>twelve disciples</u> and with <u>the others</u> who were gathered around, they asked him what the parables meant.

11 He replied, "You are permitted to understand the secret of the Kingdom of God . . .

Now - Remember - the Deep Truth of the Parable is

The CONDITION of your heart – TOWARD God's Word DETERMINES your Ability to RECEIVE God's Word

So – <u>when</u> Jesus <u>says</u> to <u>the 12</u>, <u>along</u> with the <u>OTHER Believers</u> who <u>were there</u>

in v.11(a) "You are permitted to understand the secret of the Kingdom of God . . .

v.11(a) "You are permitted to understand the secret of the Kingdom of God . . .

He's **NOT saying** - they **HAVE something SPECIAL**He's **NOT saying** - they **ARE something SPECIAL**

He's saying

they have HEARTS to RECEIVE
the Truths of the Kingdom of God

& we KNOW that Jesus is saying THAT

Because he CONTRASTS it

with **those** whose **Hearts** are **HARDENED** & **CLOSED** to the **Truths of God**

in Mark 4:11(B)-12 (NLT)

11(B) . . . But I use parables for everything I say to <u>outsiders</u>, 12 so <u>that the Scriptures might be fulfilled</u>: 'When they see what I do, they will learn nothing. When they hear what I say, they will not understand. Otherwise, they will turn to me and be forgiven."

& then we read - in Mark 4:13 (NLT)

13 Then Jesus said to them, "If you can't understand the meaning of this parable, how will you understand all the other parables?

It's <u>very critical</u> to <u>understand</u> the <u>Solemn Warning</u> in <u>these Vs's</u>

& to understand the Warning

we've <u>GOT to understand</u> the <u>CONTEXT</u> these <u>Vs's</u> were <u>written in</u>

Jesus is quoting from ISAIAH CH 6
Which is the "Calling of Isaiah"

For 250 yrs (+/-)

Israel had been on a Steady Spiritual Decline

since Solomon took over for King David

For 250 yrs (for the most part) Israel's heart had been growing harder & harder

toward the Lord - & toward his Word

& Isaiah was called - to Prophecy BOTH

About - The **Coming Messiah** - **AND**

About - The Judgment Coming BEFORE the Messiah

The Judgment that was coming

For the "<u>JUDAH PART</u>"

Of the <u>Divided Kingdom</u> of <u>Israel</u>

Was the EXILING of God's people to BABYLON

& the **Destruction** of **Jerusalem** & **the Temple**

But – the **REASON** for **that Judgment** – was **because**

the people's hearts

had grown **SO HARD** toward **God**

& they had become

SO REJECTING of **God's Word**

that they could NO LONGER - HEAR or RECEIVE the Word of God

& IN these two vs's

that **Jesus Quotes** in **Mark 4:12**

God Telling Isaiah

that **even tho**

Isaiah is to **call** the **people** to **Repentance**

God Already KNOWS

they will REJECT both Isaiah - & God

God already KNOWS

that their hearts are hardened BEYOND the ability to RECEIVE His Word

God's Word makes it clear - there is a time

when a person's heart

becomes **SO HARD** towards **God**

& their Rejection

of **God** becomes **SO ENGRAINED**

that it becomes impossible for them

to *Receive God's Word* and *Be Saved*

& so - your question - HAS to be

How do I KNOW

When I've reached that point

that I can no longer RECEIVE God's Word - & Be Saved

& the answer is SIMPLE - TRY IT!

TRY - Right Now

To **Ask God** to **FORGIVE YOU**

for your Hard Heart - & your Closed Mind to his Word

TRY - Right Now - To say

Lord Jesus, please take this Hard Heart from me

- & give me a heart that can RECEIVE your Word
- & Save me from my Sin

& <u>I promise you</u> – if you <u>can say that</u> – <u>RIGHT NOW</u> – to <u>God</u> <u>THEN</u> . . . <u>it is NOT too late, for you</u>

Because - God will HEAR Your Prayer
& he will SAVE YOU - Before it is too late

WHY were there TWO thieves on the other Crosses with Jesus

Wasn't it - So that we could see what it looks like

for **one Sinner**

to **have** a **Hard Heart** toward Jesus - **till the end**

& <u>another Sinner</u> to <u>suddenly</u> have a *RECEPTIVE Heart* toward <u>Jesus</u>

You will ALWAYS have the Choice
To RECEIVE God's Word

to <u>RECEIVE</u> God's Word

I promise you

If you will Sincerely Ask God - for a Heart to be able to Receive the truths of His Word

God will GIVE YOU a Heart

to be able to Receive the truths of His Word

So – in <u>Vs's 14-20</u> - <u>Jesus</u> goes <u>on</u> – to <u>explain</u> the <u>Parable</u> (we went thru that last week)

Then – in Mark 4:21
We Pick Up our Focus today

With Jesus "Shedding Light" on what the Disciples must've been THINKING

Jesus had just told the Disciples (& other believers)

That only those with a 'Heart to Receive' God's Word

Would be able to grasp the truths in his Parables

& <u>That may've</u> been a <u>HARD THING</u> for the <u>Disciples</u> to <u>Accept</u>

& so – Jesus wants to make it CLEAR

He is **NOT HIDING ANYTHING** - **from ANYBODY**

Jesus came – As the **Light of the World**

<u>In John 8:12 (NLT)</u>

12 [Jesus said] . . . "I am the light of the world. If you follow me, you won't have to walk in darkness, because you will have the light that leads to life."

Jesus came - AS the Light of the World - so that

ALL who followed him would have the LIGHT that LEADS to LIFE

Maybe the Disciples were thinking

Jesus should only share His Words
with people who already had a Heart To Receive his Word

But - In Mark 4:21 - Jesus uses a 'MINI-PARABLE'

to explain that <u>He came</u> - to <u>let</u> the <u>light of the truth</u>
Shine on <u>every person</u>

Mark 4:21 (NLT)

21 Then Jesus asked them, "Would anyone light a lamp and then put it under a basket or under a bed? Of course not! A lamp is placed on a stand, where <u>its light will shine</u>.

It seems to me – that Jesus is saying

<u>I CAME</u> – to <u>Shine</u> the <u>Light</u> of the <u>Truth of God</u> on <u>EVERYONE</u> – <u>whether</u> they will <u>RECEIVE</u> it or <u>NOT</u>

The Light Of The Truth is NOT HIDDEN for a select few

It's meant to BRING EVERYTHING - into the light

Look at the Next Vs - Mark 4:22 (NLT)

22 For everything that is hidden will eventually be brought into the open, and every secret will be brought to light.

Ultimately - the **LIGHT of the Truth**

will **Bring Everything** into **the Open**

& **Every Secret** will be **brought** into **the light**

& then – Jesus repeats what he often says at the beginning - or end of his parables

Mark 4:23 (NLT)

23 Anyone with ears to hear should listen and understand."

Jesus is LIFE & DEATH SERIOUS Here

Because this is An Eternal Life & Death Issue

& **he's** giving us **Every Reason**AND **No Small Warning**

To **get us** to **have** a **Heart** to **RECEIVE his Word**

& so <u>he says again</u> here in <u>V.23</u>

If you have Ears to hear – & a Heart to receive Please - Pay Attention!

& Then he says it AGAIN

in Mark 4:24 (NLT)

24 Then he added (for emphasis), "Pay close attention to what you hear. The closer you listen, the more understanding you will be given—and you will receive even more.

Do you HEAR That?

The <u>closer you listen</u> – the <u>more understanding</u> will be <u>given</u>

& <u>then</u> he <u>says</u> it – <u>AGAIN in V.25</u> (for the 3rd time !!)

Mark 4:25 (NLT)

25 To those who listen to my teaching, more understanding will be given. But for those who are not listening, even what little understanding they have will be taken away from them."

We dealt with this Vs last week
It's an Encouragement - AND a Warning

IF we have a Heart to RECEIVE then we will Receive even more

IF we have a Heart to REJECT

then even what <u>little understanding</u> we have will <u>eventually</u> be <u>taken away from us</u>

The <u>parables of Jesus</u> will <u>reveal to us</u> The TRUTHS of the <u>Kingdom of God</u>

IF - we will Come

with 'Ears to Hear'
& a 'Heart To Receive'

& PLS HEAR ME - - if we DON'T Receive
the life-changing POWER of the Words of Jesus

the <u>Problem</u> is the <u>CONDITION of OUR HEART</u>

The parables are <u>designed</u> – to <u>help</u> us <u>CHECK Our Heart</u>
To <u>help</u> us <u>acknowledge WHICH</u> heart we <u>have</u>

One last thing

After we RECEIVE God's Word into our heart We've GOT to continue . . .

to <u>TEND the truth</u> of <u>God's Word</u> in our <u>hearts</u>

<u>JUST AS</u> a <u>Farmer tends</u> a <u>crop</u> - while it's <u>growing</u>

Listen please: If seed falls on GOOD SOIL

BUT that farmer does not continue to TEND to its Growth

<u>Ultimately</u> that <u>seed</u> will <u>be just</u> as <u>UNFRUITFUL</u>
as the seed that fell on the HARDENED FOOTPATH

Jesus refers to this truth

in the seed that fell on SHALLOW SOIL

& the seed that fell among the THORNS

<u>Don't let</u> that <u>seedling</u> of <u>God's Word</u> <u>DIE</u> in <u>your heart</u>

when the Hot Sun of Trials - rises over your life

& <u>Don't let</u> that <u>seedling</u> of <u>God's Word</u> <u>DIE</u> in <u>your heart</u>

when the <u>Thorns of this world</u>
start trying to <u>CHOKE</u> the <u>Spiritual Life</u> out of <u>you</u>

Tend to the seed of God's Word that's been planted in your heart

& <u>give God TIME</u> – to <u>Water</u> & <u>Mature</u> & <u>Grow</u>
The <u>truths</u> of <u>His Word</u> - that <u>you've</u> <u>RECEIVED</u>

& have an absolute confidence

that as you <u>Receive</u> - & <u>Tend</u>
the <u>Truths</u> of <u>Gods Word</u> - <u>planted</u> in <u>your heart</u>

God will see to it

that **your life** will **produce** - an **Eternal Spiritual Harvest**
