

IS THE BIBLE RELIABLE?

The word reliable means whether a person can rely or depend on something or someone.

IS THE BIBLE RELIABLE?

Reliability is always associated with truth and fact.

THE \$1000 WORD - INERRANCY

Theologians use the term Inerrancy when it comes to the topic of <u>errors</u> in Scripture.

THE \$1000 WORD - INERRANCY

Inerrancy is that what God communicated through the authors in its **original form** and manuscript did not have any errors in them.

THE \$1000 WORD - INERRANCY

Every word written by the prophets and apostles were 100% error free.

It's Complicated

DO WE HAVE THE ORIGINAL MANUSCRIPTS?

•Time, weather, animals, decay...

 God in His providence and choice has not chosen to preserver the originals as we know it

DO WE HAVE THE ORIGINAL MANUSCRIPTS?


For both Old and New Testaments we only have copies and copies of copies.

It is the case for <u>all writings in history</u> whether sacred or not to have only copies.



SINCE WE DON'T HAVE, SHOULDN'T WE STOP TRUSTING?




HISTORY IS NOT AN ALL OR NOTHING APPROACH, I.E. IF YOU DON'T KNOW THE WHOLE TRUTH THEN YOU CAN'T KNOW ANYTHING AT ALL IS A FALLACY AND SHOULD NOT BE APPLIED TO HISTORY

IF WE TAKE THE STANCE OF THE SCEPTIC THEN ALL OF HUMAN HISTORY AND CIVILIZATION HAS TO BE ERASED. NOT EVEN THE MOST CRITICAL SCHOLAR IS WILLING TO SAY IT EXCEPT IN THE CASE OF THE BIBLE


Number of Manuscripts for Ancient Works




Years Between Date Written and Earliest Fragment or Manuscript

HOW DID THEY COPY?

- Everything was copied by hand
- It was a meticulous process that was taken very seriously.
- The copies were always
 "peer reviewed" to catch any
 issues with the copying
 process.



GREAT! SO DO ALL THE COPIES MATCH?

- The answer is no.
- There are 138,612 words in the New Testament.
- However, there are 400,000
 variations between the
 different manuscripts we
 have.




More the manuscripts, more the variants!

Quantity vs. Quality

A variation is where there is a difference for one part of text, with one or more manuscripts...

GETTING CLOSER TO THE TRUTH





There are so many variants in those 4 messages. But the message has not changed



More the copies, more the variants.


However more the copies, the closer we get to the truth We have close 25,000 odd copies of copies to compare and contrast


TEXTUAL CRITICISM

- This method allows the interpreters to compare word for word, passage for passage across
 - Time (dating of manuscript or fragment)
 - Language (Greek, Latin, Syriac)
 - Geographies (Europe, Africa, Asia)
- Identify all the differences
- Identify what is the likeliest original message



TEXTUAL CRITICISM





70-80% are spelling differences

Minor differences in synonyms

Meaningful difference unlikely in the autograph

Meaningful difference likely in the autograph

FALSE IDEAS ABOUT INERRANCY



BIBLE IS ONLY INERRANT ON SPIRITUAL MATTERS

- The Bible is inerrant (truthful) in the areas of faith and practice
 - This means that the scriptures can made false statements about other contents, claims and recordings e.g. Noah's Ark, Jesus walking on Water, Jonah in the belly of a big fish
 - The Bible does not restrict itself to what it makes statements about e.g. there are 600,000 men who left Egypt for instance.
 - 2 Tim 3:16 all Scripture is God breathed. Ps 12:6 all words are pure.
 - Jesus and Apostles did not make such distinctions and qualifications and we need to be all err.

BIBLE IS ONLY INERRANT ON SPIRITUAL MATTERS

The Bible cannot be separated from history.

Real people, Real Events, Real Names in Real Times.

INERRANT IS TOO HIGH A STANDARD

- God's word as recorded by the original authors in the original manuscripts were error free.
- Denying this reality is dangerous as it undermines both God and man.
- It also places us in a dangerous place of "who determines what is right and wrong"
- We soon find ourselves, humans, being the final arbiter of truth

INERRANT IS TOO HIGH A STANDARD

In the garden of Eden was man wanting to define what is the right vs wrong, not submit to God's revelation.

INNOCENT TILL PROVEN GUILTY



- Without being exhaustive
 - •E.g. the details of the childhood of Jesus
- •E.g. the silent years of Paul after his conversion
- •When there is no external evidence to back a biblical claim
 - •E.g. Jericho was not destroyed
- •When it uses ordinary language to describe complex process
 - Setting of the sun or the falling of rain
- •When it is not precise with the numbers
- •During OT time, decimal point precision was not required
- Rounding, approximations
- •When using loose quotations " ... "
- Zach 12:10 (God speaking), John 19:37 John writing.
- Copyist errors
 - •2 Chron 22:2 (KJV Ahaziah 42 years), 2 Kings 8:6 (22 years)

INNOCENT TILL PROVEN GUILTY

The Bible is true even

- Assuming the Unexplained Is Unexplainable
- E.g. Historians believed Moses didn't write the Pentateuch because literacy came after Moses' time.
- Partial reports are False reports
- E.g. Peter's confession of Christ. Matt 16:16, Mk 8:29, Lk 9:20. Ex. 20:8-11 with Deut. 5:12-15 (10 commandments)
- Same event different accounts
- Matt 28:5, one angel at tomb. Jn 20:12 two angels
- Temptations of Jesus (Matt / Luke reverse order of temptation 2 and 3, Mark gives a short account
- Presuming the Bible approves all records
- 2 Sam 11:4 David's sin
- When the Bible uses metaphors, hyperboles
- I am the door, pluck out your eye
