

RECAPPING WEEK 5 – IS THE OLD TESTAMENT AUTHENTIC?

- The NT was written by the apostles and those who walked with the apostles.
- The early dating of the NT meant the eye witnesses were around to validate the content
- The cannon was formed early (organically not institutionally) well before the Council of Hippo (397 AD)
- There were many gospels excluded because they were late productions (not by apostles, forgeries or was not in line with OT / NT theology)
- Like the OT, the NT has a lot of archaeological, geographical evidence
- We learnt the new testament writers got the details right and did not compromise on the little details.

People, places, and practices confirmed

Willingness to die gruesome deaths

9 Strands of Evidence for NT

Got the small details right e.g.
Names

Embarrassment Factor e.g. Peter

Early Dating of the NT books

NT distributed during the life time of the eye witnesses.



IS THE BIBLE FULL OF CONTRADICTION

Defining the terms

A contradiction is where a statement cannot be true and false at the same time in the same sense.

For example, I can't be a 172cm tall and 142cm tall while standing straight barefoot.

IS THE BIBLE FULL OF CONTRADICTION

Many of the times what we see in the Bible is apparent contradictions.

- In most cases <u>reading the passage in context</u> gives you the clarity.
- Some times, it is a matter of getting a bible dictionary, concordance or commentary to shed light. What does the word in Hebrew / Greek mean?


IS THE BIBLE FULL OF CONTRADICTION

There are difficult passages, but there are also reasonable explanations

- So it is important that when we approach the Bible, to have the attitude of "innocent till proven guilty".
- Sadly many critics start from "guilty till proven innocent"



- Without being exhaustive
 - E.g. the details of the childhood of Jesus
 - E.g. the silent years of Paul after his conversion
- When there is no external evidence to back a biblical claim
 - E.g. Jericho was not destroyed
- When it uses ordinary language to describe complex process
 - Setting of the sun or the falling of rain
 - •This does not mean the sun rotates around the Earth




- When it is not precise with the numbers
 - During OT time, decimal point precision was not required
 - •1 Kings 7:23-26. E.g. Pi = 3 not 3.1415926535897
- When using loose quotations " ... "
 - Zach 12:10 (God speaking), John 19:37 John writing.
- Copyist errors
 - •2 Chron 22:2 (KJV Ahaziah 42 years), 2 Kings 8:6 (22 years)



- Assuming the Unexplained Is Unexplainable
 - E.g. Historians believed Moses didn't write the Pentateuch because literacy came after Moses' time.
- Partial reports are False reports
 - E.g. Peter's confession of Christ. Matt 16:16, Mk 8:29, Lk 9:20. Ex. 20:8-11 with Deut. 5:12-15 (10 commandments)
- Same event different accounts
 - Matt 28:5, one angel at tomb. Jn 20:12 two angels
 - Temptations of Jesus (Matt / Luke reverse order of temptation 2 and 3, Mark gives a short account



- Getting the sequence right
 - Matthew says scarlet robe placed on Jesus (Matthew 27:28)
 - John says purple robe placed on Jesus (John 19:2)
 - Understanding the sequence of events and context helps with the explanation
- Presuming the Bible approves all records
 - 2 Sam 11:4 David's sin
- When the Bible uses metaphors, hyperboles
 - I am the door, pluck out your eye



The underlying assumptions in this question are

- The Bible was written very long time ago
- It was written to tribal, nomadic, ancient bronze / iron age people
- They were not educated or technologically advanced like us in the 21st century
- Given how different the our world is and their world was, the Bible is not relevant

Another underlying assumption is

- The questions we grapple with are different from the questions people 2000-4000 years ago grappled with.
- Therefore the answers are also dated
- Therefore the Bible is irrelevant.

What are some of the questions that pre-occupy 21st century man?

- Artificial Intelligence (what is the implication to humanity from AI)
- Challenges from urbanization, globalization?
- The science of gene editing and designer humans, creation Human 2.0
- Evolution of human sexuality and gender issues
- Challenges from new theories of race, identity / tribal political thought
- Digitization and the impacts on democracy and society
- How free will societies be in the phase of secularization, government control
- What is the future of economics (centralized or decentralized)
- Will capitalism remain or evolve in the coming years

On the face of these types of questions we as Christians can ..

- Feel defeated
- Develop the belief of "privatizing" our faith
- Abandoning our faith
- Ignoring the challenges altogether

- I do want to propose an alternative
 - It is called integration.
- Francis Schaeffer, once famously said
 "All truth is God's truth".
- There is nothing for us to be afraid of even when we don't have answers or we go digging for answers to answer some of these challenges.



- Our understanding of God (theology) has to inform our life in the world.
- As C S Lewis points out, we have to see everything through the eyes of Scripture.
- Remember ultimately all these challenges are
 - 1. Raised by humans
 - 2. About humans
 - 3. The world that is inhabited by humans (digital and physical).
- Every human has a worldview (the lenses through which we look at and interpret everything about life).

EVERYONE HAS A WORLDVIEW





- These worldviews in turn influence how we look at world, it's challenges and the solutions.
- As Christians we can be confident, the Christian worldview is grounded in Truth because
 - It is logically consistent (there are no contradictions in what is being asserted)
 - There is a evidence for the truth statements made
 - The answers when applied to real life, it is relevant
- So we as Christians, in obedience to Romans 12:2 and 2 Corinthians 10:5, we have to replace our wrong beliefs, thinking and assumptions with the truth that is found in the Scriptures.

Critics of the Bible have introduced a false dichotomy between Faith and Science.

1. Worldviews

- Most critics of the Bible are agnostic or atheistic.
- They believe all that is visible and invisible in this universe is purely natural.
- In a naturalistic universe, the only explanations available are materialistic
- And the only way to true knowledge and objective facts is through science.
- This worldview is called scientism

The fool sets in his heart, "There is no God"...

Psalm 14:1

Our willingness to accept scientific claims that are against common sense is the key to an understanding of the real struggle between science and the supernatural. We take the side of science in spite of the patent absurdity of some of its constructs . . . in spite of the tolerance of the scientific community for unsubstantiated just-so stories, because we have a prior commitment, a commitment to materialism. It is not that the methods and institutions of science somehow compel us to accept a material explanation of the phenomenal world, but, on the contrary, that we are forced by our a priori adherence to material causes to create an apparatus of investigation and a set of concepts that produce material explanations, no matter how counterintuitive, no matter how mystifying to the uninitiated. Moreover, that materialism is absolute, for we cannot allow a Divine Foot in the door.

2. Miracles

- The implication of this view is that all supernatural records are false.
- David Hume's objections to miracles is still prevalent today

Objection

Can't depend on eye witness testimony not educated.
 Miracle has to be reproduced to give a naturalistic explanation

Response

- A person does not have to be highly educated to be a good witness. Honesty is not based on education.
- Moses, Daniel, Luke, Paul were highly educated for their time and they believed in the miraculous
- Miracles are not natural, they are supernatural
- If there is a God, there can always be miracles.
- Based on Hume's criteria for eye witnesses, all of history will have to be rejected

Objection

 Miracles don't happen today therefore miracles didn't happen then

Response

- Hume can't himself prove no miracles happen today. This is his opinion, not a fact.
- Surely, Hume didn't deny the existence of dinosaurs because they don't exist today!
- Miracles are unique. They are special events
- Just because miracles happen infrequently doesn't mean it doesn't happen at all.
- How about lottery winners, they have 1 in 13,983,816 probability of winning (6 numbers)
- If there is a God, there can always be miracles.

Objection

 Testimonies of miracles in one religion should cancel out the other religion

Response

- How is this even an objection.
- Every miraculous event has to be checked on its own merits.
- Jesus' resurrection was testified and believed by the entire Christian community in real time.
- The song in 1 Corinthians 15 that Paul uses is now dated to within 2-5 years after the death of Christ.
- Other miracles in other religions is possible
- But their attestation with eye witness testimonies is dated to much later (100s of years later)
- Furthermore there is no other religion that claims resurrection miracle. It stands 100% unique.





THE UNIVERSE

THE UNIVERSE WAS CREATED

- What does the Bible affirm?
 - There was a beginning! At a finite point in the past there was **NO** universe.
 - The Bible affirms the universe was created Ex Nihilo (out of nothing)
- What does science and philosophy affirm
 - Philosophical
 - Everything that exists has a cause (something can't come out of nothing).
 - Scientific Evidence
 - 2nd Law of Thermodynamics (Universe is loosing heat)
 - Universe expands (moving from a core outwards)
 - Science terms the start of the cosmos is the Big Bang

UNIVERSE TUNED FOR LIFE

- Modern physics have identified 30 cosmological constants (so far)
- Each of the constants have to be precise (to the billionth)
- Not only individually but across all the constants and with each other
- Any change to even 1 constant or quantity by billionth of a fraction and life will not be possible.
- The rate of expansion of the universe, strength of gravity, charge of an atom, charge of neutron to a proton, etc.
- Critics claim there is an appearance. But there is never order and surgical precision from chaos



FINE TUNING IN US - DNA

- Every DNA has 8000 books of information
- Linking all your DNA one after another, the chain will extend from Earth to the Sun and back! 600 times!
- This is not jumbled characters. It is code information like a computer programmer writing software code, all perfectly working in harmony directing every bit of operation in the human body.

- Evidence for macro evolution not available in fossil records.
 - Micro evolution is not contradictory to Christianity
- Early conditions on Earth too harsh for basic building blocks for life to be formed i.e. amino acids
- Non-life (amino acids) cannot give life
- O Mutation (defect) does not lead to progress but regress. Underlying assumption is learning from mistake and adjusting but this assumes intelligence and directedness. Natural Selection is an impersonal, non-intelligent process.
- Knowledge has to precede design (complexity of a single cell)
- O Discovery of the human genetic code DNA



INTERPRETATIONS OF GENESIS 1 AND 2

Literal Days

Day Age (spans of (time)

Framework (metaphorical)

Analogical (God's work days)

- Historical most Jews or early Christians did not look at the Genesis days as literal days.
- God does not tell us "how" He created life.
- What the Bible affirms is God is the creator of all. The forces of nature are not gods (Frozen 2)
- In the absence of God Evolution according to Darwin is the only explanation.

ISN'T THE EARTH MILLIONS YEARS OLD?

- One of the points of contention between science and Christianity is around the "age of the Earth".
- The Bible seems to indicate an Earth the Earth is about 6000-10000 years.
- Science seems to affirm millions of years
