START DISCUSSING

PRINCIPLES OF DECISION MAKING

Take some time to work through each step and discuss both, the reason for the step and why the step can be a challenge.

#1 - Study God's Word — Submission to God

Read Proverbs 3:1-2 and 2 Timothy 3:14-17

Discuss strategies for making Bible reading/study a permanent part of your life.

#2 - Develop a Heart for God — Submission of My Heart

Read Proverbs 3:5-6 and Psalm 37:4

An idol is anything that we love, desire, or serve more than God; essentially anything that takes the place of God as the primary focus and priority in our lives.

What are some of the things that can become idols? How do we conquer the idols of our heart?

#3 - Seek Wise Counsel — Submission of My Will

Read Proverbs 15:22 and 19:20

Jeremiah 17:9 is a frightening verse, my heart can deceive me.

It is easy to confuse my will with God's will.

How does seeking advice help me to think clearly about the decisions? How do we decide who to ask for advice?

#4 - Apply Wisdom — Submission of My Thinking

Read Proverbs 4:7

Discuss the implications of a book of the Bible focused on wisdom.

How is wisdom different than obeying a specific command?

#5 - Trust God's Providence — Submission of My Plans

Read Proverbs 19:21 and 20:24

How do we learn to accept God's prevention of a good thing? Read Rom. 1:13 & Acts 16:7 and discuss God's providence in Paul's life.

#6 - Prayerfully submitting to Him throughout the whole process

Read Proverbs 2:3-6 and Philippians 4:6-7

Discuss how principles 1-5 are applied in an atmosphere of prayer. How does prayer protect my heart from disappointment when either God says "no" or I must say "no" to something my heart really wanted.
