KEY SCRIPTURE

Matthew 4:19

And He said to them, "Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men."

Acts 2:42–47

42 They were continually devoting themselves to the apostles'

teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.

43 Everyone kept feeling a sense of awe; and many wonders and signs were taking place through the apostles.

44 And all those who had believed were together and had all things in common;

45 and they began selling their property and possessions and were sharing them with all, as anyone might have need.

46 Day by day continuing with one mind in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they were taking their meals together with gladness and sincerity of heart, 47 praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord was adding to their number day by day those who were being saved.

2 Corinthians 3:18

18 But we all, with unveiled faces, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as from the Lord, the Spirit.

WHAT IS A DISCIPLE?

Read Matthew 4:19

Head: Committed to following Christ

Heart: Committed to being changed by Christ

Hands: Committed to the mission of Christ

Feet: Committed to walking it out where you live, learn, work, and play

CONNECT

Read Acts 2:42-47

In the passage, identify and discuss the ways the early church connected with each other.

GROW

DEEPEN RELATIONSHIPS WITH GOD AND OTHERS

Read 2 Cor 3:18

Discuss the many ways a believer grows in the Christian life.

SERVE

Refer back to Acts 2:42-47

In the passage, identify and discuss the ways the early church served to enable the ways of connection found earlier. What would someone have to do so God's people could connect? For example, in verse 46, "someone had to bake the bread".

What are the ways people serve behind the scenes at Mountainside?

EVALUATION

Take some time as a small group to review the blessing of meeting together. Maybe some can share how God has blessed you through your small group.
