QUESTIONS FOR FURTHER DISCUSSION:

1. Do you enjoy true crime documentaries or crime dramas? What are your favorites? What about them draws you in?
2. Read **Luke 22:63-65**. Read through the verbs again. Which ones stand out to you the most?
3. Chris said that in verses 63-65, we see one of three responses to Jesus, which is to mock Him. How does mocking Jesus look in our world today? In what ways might you be responding to Jesus in this way?
4. **Read Luke 22:66-71**. In these verses, we see Jesus (the rightful Judge) judged. What are some ways you have seen people stand over Jesus in judgment? What are some ways you've seen this in your own heart?
5. In this passage, we see that when Jesus suffered *for* us, He also suffers *with* us. Name various ways that Jesus suffers in these verses. How does His suffering bring you comfort in your suffering? Try to be specific!
6. Read **Isaiah 53** together and answer these questions: a) How does our passage from Sunday fulfill what Isaiah 53 prophesies? b) What does this passage say Jesus took on for us? c) What does this passage say that Jesus' suffering accomplished?
