## QUESTIONS FOR FURTHER DISCUSSION:

1. Read Luke 18:9-18 together.
2. In your own words, describe the two tables that James talked about Sunday. In what ways does your life reflect each one?
3. In verse 11, the Pharisee lists different people that he looks down on. Who are the people to whom you tend to compare yourself?
4. In verses 11 and 12, the Pharisee lists certain deeds that he believes make him righteous. What “good deeds” are you tempted to base your righteousness on? (A good test: when you don’t perform these good deeds, do you believe that God loves you less?)
5. James said that asking God for mercy includes an admission of guilt. Have you come to a point in life where you genuinely asked God to have mercy on you? Tell that story to your group.
