4. Lastly, we saw that Christ is the ultimate Kinsman Redeemer to whom Boaz points us. Matt spoke about how a Kinsman Redeemer had to be a close relative, who was willing and able to rescue the one in need. Spend some time in discussion about how Christ is the ultimate fulfillment of the idea of a Kinsman Redeemer for all mankind.
