QUESTIONS FOR FURTHER DISCUSSION:

1. Read **Luke 22:1-23** together.
2. This passage shows us that Jesus had full knowledge of the events that would follow this meal. What does it mean to you that He willingly faced death in order to save us?
3. **Read Exodus 6:6-7.** These verses contain the four promises of the Passover cups in Jewish tradition: “I will bring you out,” “I will deliver you,” “I will redeem you,” and “I will take you.” How does Jesus fulfill each of these promises to us?
4. Read **Luke 22:21-22** again. Do you see the tension present in this verse between God’s sovereign plan and man’s willful participation in evil? Do you gravitate toward God’s sovereignty *or* human freedom in your thinking? What do you think this reveals about you?
5. Jesus says that the cup at the Last Supper represents the new covenant in His blood. Thinking about the promises of this new covenant, have someone read **Ezekiel 36:22-27**. What stands out to you as you read these verses?
6. Jesus graciously warns us when we make decisions that lead to sin. How might you need to hear Him warning you today?
